ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE

The facts articulated in Staff's Recommendation are adopted by reference and incorporated herein. Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following violation(s):

Count 1:

On or about March 7, 2018, Respondent violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to file an addendum to the campaign's 2017 M2 report correcting the errors identified by the Division within seven days of receiving notice from the filing officer that the report was incomplete.

Count 2:

On or about March 7, 2018, Respondent violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to file an addendum to the campaign's 2017 M3 report correcting the errors

identified by the Division within seven days of receiving notice from the filing officer that the report was incomplete.

Count 3:

On or about March 7, 2018, Respondent violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to file an addendum to the campaign's 2017 M5 report correcting the errors identified by the Division within seven days of receiving notice from the filing officer that the report was incomplete.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by <u>consent order</u> where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s) and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

Second, you may request an <u>informal hearing</u> held before the Commission, if you <u>do not</u> dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.07(2)(b)1.**, **Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on February 11, 2019, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

- 1. On August 3, 2018, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a referral from the Division of Elections ("Division") alleging Al Jacquet ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
- 2. Respondent was a 2018 candidate for re-election to the office of State Representative, District 88. An Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates form ("DS-DE 9") appointing Respondent as his own treasurer was filed with the Division on January 25, 2017. (ROI Exhibit 1)¹
- 3. By letter dated December 18, 2018, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provision:

Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2018 candidate for State Representative, District 88, acting as his own treasurer, failed to timely make necessary amendments to the following campaign treasurer reports, as alleged in the complaint: 2017 M2, 2017M3, and 2017 M5.

- 4. By letter dated January 26, 2017, Kristi Reid Bronson, Division of Elections, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, notified Respondent that his DS-DE 9 was filed with the Division on January 25, 2017. The letter also contained a security envelope containing Respondent's confidential PIN number to access the Division's electronic filing system. (ROI Exhibit 2)
- 5. Ms. Bronson's January 26, 2017, letter also informed Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms were available on the Division's website, including Chapters 104 and 106, Florida Statutes, the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*, and

the Calendar of Reporting Dates. The letter notified Respondent that it was his responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. (Id.)

- 6. On January 25, 2017, Respondent filed a Statement of Candidate with the Division in which he acknowledged that he had been provided access to read and understand the requirements of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. (ROI Exhibit 7)
- 7. In an affidavit dated February 1, 2019, Respondent attested that he possessed a copy of and had read Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*. Respondent asserted, "I have taken time to Review Ch. 106 FL Stat...I have also read and re-read our Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook." (ROI Exhibit 5)
- 8. On January 12, 2018, and February 7, 2018, the Division sent Respondent a letter notifying him that the following campaign treasurer reports were incomplete, and that Respondent had seven days to correct the errors or provide the missing information noted in the attached error reports: 2017 M2, 2017 M3, and 2017 M5. The letter dated January 12, 2018, also stated that if the information was reported accurately, Respondent should provide a written explanation to the Division addressing the issues noted in the error report attached to the notification letter. (ROI Exhibit 3)
- 9. On February 23, 2018, the Division sent Respondent a letter marked Final Notice notifying Respondent that the following campaign treasurer reports were incomplete, and that Respondent had seven days to correct the errors or provide the missing information noted in the attached error report: 2017 M2, 2017 M3, and 2017 M5. The letter also stated that if the information was reported accurately, Respondent should provide a written explanation to the Division addressing the issues noted in the error report attached to the notification letter. The February 23, 2018, letter was confirmed delivered on February 28, 2018. (Attachment A)
- 10. The Division confirmed via email dated February 4, 2019, that the 2017 M2 and 2017 M3 reports were corrected on January 31, 2019, but the 2017 M5 report was still not correct. (ROI Exhibit 6)
- 11. In an affidavit dated February 1, 2019, Respondent attested that the three reports at issue were not timely amended due to, "Absolute miscommunication on my part. I received a letter in Feb. 2018, after briefly believing the letter indicated an "Error" in my Report. [illegible] admitted, I reviewed the reports and noticed No Errors showing. I erroneously dismissed the letters that followed (on the same subject) as Not Accurate. I Finally see to what the letters were pointing and Have Resolved it." Respondent added that, "This will not happen again, as I will call immediately upon receiving ANY communication from our Div. of Elections." (ROI Exhibit 5)
- 12. Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, requires that, within seven days of receipt of notification from the filing officer that a report is incomplete and requires amendment, a treasurer must file an addendum to the report providing all information necessary to complete the report.
- 13. Based upon the information above, it appears that Respondent failed to file amended reports for the following campaign treasurer reports correcting all the errors identified

by the Division within seven days of receiving notice from the filing officer that the reports were incomplete: 2017 M2, 2017 M3, and 2017 M5.

- 14. "Probable Cause" is defined as a reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. *Schmitt v. State*, 590 So.2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. *Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino*, 667 So.2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).
- 15. The above facts show that Respondent was a 2018 candidate for the office of State Representative, District 88, and was acting as his own treasurer. The following campaign treasurer reports were filed incomplete: 2017 M2, 2017 M3, and 2017 M5. The Division sent letters to Respondent on January 12, 2018, February 7, 2018, and February 23, 2018, notifying him that the reports were incomplete, and that Respondent had seven days from receipt of the letters to correct the errors noted in the attached error reports and file amended reports.
- 16. The facts further show that Respondent acknowledged receipt of at least one letter in February 2018, and the delivery confirmation showed that the Final Notice was delivered on February 28, 2018. The Division confirmed that Respondent did not correctly amend the 2017 M2 and 2017 M3 reports until January 31, 2019, which is approximately 11 months after receipt of notice from the filing officer that the reports were incomplete and required amendment. Further, the Division confirmed that as of February 4, 2019, the 2017 M5 report had not been satisfactorily amended. Respondent's articulated reason for failing to timely amend the reports does not justify that failure.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following:

Count 1:

On or about March 7, 2018, Respondent violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to file an addendum to the campaign's 2017 M2 report correcting the errors identified by the Division within seven days of receiving notice from the filing officer that the report was incomplete.

Count 2:

On or about March 7, 2018, Respondent violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to file an addendum to the campaign's 2017 M3 report correcting the errors identified by the Division within seven days of receiving notice from the filing officer that the report was incomplete.

Count 3:

On or about March 7, 2018, Respondent violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to file an addendum to the campaign's 2017 M5 report correcting the errors identified by the Division within seven days of receiving notice from the filing officer that the report was incomplete.

Complainant: Division of Elections

Pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, on August 3, 2018, the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) received information from the Division of Elections (Division) that Respondent violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. Commission staff, therefore, investigated whether Respondent violated the following statute:

Section 106.07(2)(b)1, Florida Statutes, failure of the treasurer of a candidate to file an addendum to an incomplete report after receiving notice from the filing officer.

I. Preliminary Information:

- 1. Respondent, Al Jacquet, was a 2018 candidate for re-election to State Representative, District 88; he was re-elected without opposition.
 - 2. Complainant is the Division.
- 3. Respondent's filing officer was Kristi Reid Bronson¹, Chief, Bureau of Election Records.

II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(2)(b)1, Florida Statutes:

- 4. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by failing to file an amended 2017 M2, 2017 M3 and 2017 M5 campaign report after receiving notice from the filing officer.
- 5. On January 25, 2017, Respondent filed his Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository form (DS-DE 9) with the Division, appointing himself as campaign treasurer of his campaign. To review the DS-DE 9 form, refer to Exhibit 1.
- 6. On January 26, 2017, Ms. Bronson sent Respondent a letter acknowledging that his name had been placed on the active candidate list. The letter advised Respondent that all candidates filing reports with the Division are required to use the electronic filing system (EFS) and provided him with his user identification number and initial password allowing him access to


- 7. The letter also advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms are available on their website, including Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook* and the Calendar of Reporting Dates. To review a copy of the acknowledging letter, refer to Exhibit 2.
- 8. On January 12, 2018 and February 7, 2018, the Division sent Respondent letters informing him that one or more of his campaign reports were incomplete. The letters included an error report referencing the 2017 M2, 2017 M3 and 2017 M5 campaign reports. The letters were sent to Respondent's address provided on his DS-DE 9 form that was filed with the Division on January 25, 2017. To review the two letters and the error reports, refer to Exhibit 3.
- 9. On February 23, 2018, the Division sent Respondent a letter marked "Final Notice" informing him that one or more of his campaign reports were incomplete. The letter included an error report referencing the 2017 M2, 2017 M3 and 2017 M5 campaign reports. The letter was sent to Respondent's address provided on his DS-DE 9 form that was filed with the Division on January 25, 2017. To review the Final Notice letter and delivery confirmation, refer to Exhibit 4.
- 10. On August 3, 2018, the Commission staff received a referral from the Division alleging that Respondent failed to file an addendum to the 2017 M2, 2017 M3 and 2017 M5 campaign reports after receiving notice.
- 11. In a questionnaire-affidavit, Respondent was asked the reason why he did not amend the campaign reports after being notified. Respondent stated that it was "absolute miscommunication" on his part. Respondent explained, "I received a letter in Feb 2018, after briefly believing the letter indicated an 'Error' in my report. I reviewed the reports and notice No Error showing. I erroneously dismissed the letters that followed (on same subject) as not relevant. I finally see to what the letters were pointing and have resolved it." To review Respondent's response to the questionnaire-affidavit, refer to Exhibit 5.
- 12. In an e-mail dated February 4, 2019, Ms. Willis stated that the 2017 M2 and 2017 M3 campaign reports were corrected on January 31, 2019; the 2017 M5 campaign is still not correct. To review the e-mail from Ms. Willis, refer to Exhibit 6.
- 13. No record was found to indicate that Respondent has previously violated this section of the election laws.

III. FEC History:

14. Respondent has no prior history with the Florida Elections Commission.

Conclusion:

15. On February 11, 2019, I interviewed Respondent for the purpose of providing him with a brief overview of the case and to afford him an opportunity for questions or comments. Respondent was advised that, according to the Division, his 2017 M5 report was deemed as not



- 16. In a questionnaire-affidavit, Respondent attested that does possess and has read Chapter 106, Florida Statutes as well as the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*. Respondent was asked what actions he had taken to determine his responsibilities under Florida's election laws. He stated, "I have taken time to Review Ch 106 Fl Stat and All of Title IX, Electors and Elections. I have also read and re-read our Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook." To review Respondent's response to the questionnaire-affidavit, refer to Exhibit 5.
- 17. Respondent executed a Statement of Candidate form indicating that he had been provided access to read and understand the requirements of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes; the form is dated as having been signed January 25, 2017. To review the Statement of Candidate form, refer to Exhibit 7.
- 18. The telephone log reflecting Commission staff's contact in this matter is provided as Exhibit 8.




