### NOTICE OF HEARING (AUTOMATIC FINE)

A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on, May 18, 2016 at 8:30 am, or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard, at the following location: Senate Office Building, 404 South Monroe Street, Room 110-S, Tallahassee, Florida 32399

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

**If you are the Respondent**, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 minutes to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

**If you are an Appellant**, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 *minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Executive Director Florida Elections Commission May 3, 2016 Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

Dear: Mr. Yeager

The Campaign Treasurer's Report (G4) which was due October 30, 2015 was received on November 5, 2015. According to Florida Statutes Section 106.07 the fine shall be \$50.00 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding the primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500.00 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. For the G4 Campaign Treasure's Report, the fine shall be \$500.00 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Your fine of \$750.00 must be paid to the City of Minneola, within 20 days of the receipt of this notice unless appealed to the Florida Elections Commission.

Florida Statutes Section 106.07 provides for appealing or disputing the assessed fine by submitting a notice of appeal in writing within 20 days of receipt of the notice of payment due, stating definite unusual circumstances surrounding the failure to file on the designated due date. This notice must include any and all supporting evidence. Failing to timely file such notice will constitute a waiver of the right of appeal.

Should you desire a hearing before the commission, you must so state in the notice of appeal. If no request is made, the Commission's determination shall be based upon the notice and supporting evidence, but a hearing will be provided if solicited. The City of Minneola City Clerk's Office must be notified in writing of your intention to file an appeal with the Commission.

Mayor Yeager,

I received your "Notice of Appeal" letter this week. However, I am unable to schedule the hearing with the Florida Elections Commission on your behalf. You will need to file a notice of appeal with the Commission Agency Clerk within 20 days of the date you received my letter regarding the \$750.00 late filing fine. The letter receipt returned states you received the letter on December 2, 2015. Therefore the deadline to file a notice of appeal and request a hearing with the Commission is December 22, 2015. I suggest calling their office to get more specific information on what needs to be included when filing your appeal.

My filing officer has fined me for filing my campaign report late. How do I appeal the automatic fine to the Florida Elections Commission?

To appeal a fine imposed pursuant to Section 106.07(8), 106.0703(7)(c) or 106.29(2)(c), Florida Statutes, the candidate, chairman of a political committee, or treasurer of an electioneering

communications organization shall file a notice of appeal. The notice of appeal shall be filed with the Agency Clerk, and a copy filed with the filing officer, within 20 days of the appealing party's receipt of notice that a fine is being imposed. The notice of appeal shall contain:

- The name, address, and telephone number of the appealing party; a.
- A copy of the notice of imposition of fine issued by the filing officer; and b.
- A request for hearing if a personal appearance before the Commission is desired.

If no hearing request is made, the appeal shall be decided solely on the documents submitted by the appealing party and Commission staff,

Failure to timely file a notice of appeal shall result in waiver of the right to appeal the fine and a final order upholding the fine shall be entered by the Chairman of the Commission without further notice. Unless good cause is shown, the Commission will not consider at the hearing any written document unless the party offering the document has filed it with the Agency Clerk at least 10 days before the hearing.

## Will the filing officer waive my fine if I provide him with credible evidence of unusual circumstances?

No. Only the Commission can waive the fine. The filing officer's duty is to notify a candidate or committee of the failure to file a report, to determine the amount of the fine based upon the formula provided by statute, and to notify the candidate or committee of the amount of the fine due. See Division of Elections Opinion 00-04.

## What happens to my appeal if I do not request a hearing?

When the Agency Clerk receives your notice of appeal, she will send you a letter explaining unusual circumstances and requesting that you send written evidence of unusual circumstances. If no hearing request is made, the appeal shall be decided solely on the documents submitted by the appealing party and Commission staff. At the meeting, the Commission will review all written evidence you submitted and decide the appeal. Unless good cause is shown, the Commission will not consider at the hearing any written document unless the party offering the document has filed it with the Agency Clerk at least 10 days before the hearing.
