A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on, **August 31, 2021, at 8:30 am EST, or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard.**

Please note that because of COVID-19, this will be a virtual meeting conducted by remote video or teleconference. Enclosed you will find additional details on joining the video conference via GoToWebinar, **9-Digit Webinar ID: 116499747** or via **teleconference by dialing (877) 309-2074** and entering the **meeting access code 339-753-920**, when prompted. **If you wish to speak before the Commission, you will need to appear by webcam and will be sworn in remotely.** Please be advised that the Commission will consider multiple cases, so you will need to wait until your case is considered. If you have any questions, please contact Commission staff at (850) 922-4539.

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

**If you are the Respondent**, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

**If you are the Complainant**, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

**If you are an Appellant**, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

**SUMMARY:** Terry Ann Williams Edden was a candidate for State Senator, District 33, in the 2020 elections. Terry Ann Williams Edden was her own treasurer.

Terry Ann Williams Edden is appealing the fine claiming that the report was filed timely. According to Ms. Edden, a notice of no activity was filed followed by a report to reflect changes during the reporting period. She states that “due to lack of understanding[,] the report should have remained as reported or an opportunity should have been provided by certified mail for cure within a given period.” She asks the Commission to grant her appeal and waive the fine.

- The 2020 P7 Original Report covers the period from 08/01/20-08/13/20; it was due on 08/14/20.
- The 2020 P7 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created and filed on 08/14/20<sup>1</sup>.
- Terry Ann Williams Edden reported receiving 4 contributions while making 4 expenditures.
- FEC staff was advised, “The candidate filed a notice of no activity (waiver) on 08/14/20. A waiver is not a report. On 08/24/20, the candidate filed a report showing \$6,000.00 of activity. The fine is based on 25% of the activity.” The report was also amended on 11/13/20.
- The Division of Elections does not have any notes that pertain to Terry Ann Williams Edden’s 2020 P7 report.

**PRIOR CASES:** None.

Please accept this as a notice of timely Appeal of Campaign Treasurer's report. I would like to appeal the \$1500.00 hundred dollars late reporting filing due for the period of 8/1/2020 to 8/13/2020.

The report was filed timely as required by campaign finance laws.

Respectfully, in lieu of F.S. 106.011 thru 106.36 regarding amending a report after being waived.

My campaign report had been initially waived for the reporting period and then somehow later amended to reflect a change on my campaign report. The law does not give specific guidance and therefore the



amendment took place in error not realizing a "Waiver" could not be amended or by the lack thereof.

Again, respectfully, and due to lack of understanding the report should have remained as reported or an opportunity should had been provided by certified mail for cure within a given period.

Based on standard election policy the Candidate usually receives a notice to cure said errors within 7 days, which did not occur as per F.S. 106.07, in its entirety. Therefore, in this case (I) the candidate never received any prior notices informing of this error, just a certified envelope with a letter dated October 22, 2020 that was only notifying me and or only giving me directions of the infractions and those options to appeal fine, well after my campaign accounts had been closed out, following the August 18, 2020 primary.

I did received previously an error report from the state regarding a different candidate's report, who filed late and I had took it upon myself to notify the Division of Elections of the said error.

The office at that time via phone and by a letter dated in August 2020, noted that I only owed a \$25.00 penalty which has been paid and cured timely.

Therefore, my campaign finances never experienced an issue like this without first having the opportunity by certified mail to correct defects and or have someone on elections to give me a 7 days cure letters that gives instructions as to curing the said concerns without penalty.

I pray that the commission respectfully GRANT my said appeal by suspending the fine due to an error, which was no fault of my own.

However, for reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. 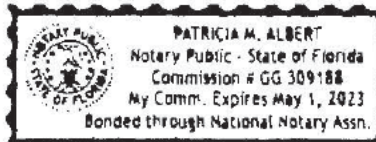


