Hi Tracie,

Attached are some of my local and recent records to be included in my appeal.

Basically, I am facing "brain surgery" to remove the tumor. This is a big decision that I will ultimately have to face. With this surgery comes a high risk of facial nerve destruction (facial/eye lid drop)and possible facial reconstruction. Complete loss of hearing in the right ear (I currently wear hearing aids that help with my continual loss of hearing) and disturbance to the balance nerve (possible temporary use of walker and rehab).

The tumor is benign and the tumor is monitored with MRIs as needed or annually. When the tumor effects my life daily and/or poses a situation where it gets too close to my spinal chord I will make the decision to have it removed. it could be next year it could be 10 years from now. I deal/cope with the symptoms the best I can as they arise. Until then I do the best I can to deal with the symptoms as they arise. Unfortunately I can't control when the symptoms come unfortunately I was not well when my treasury report was due on Nov 4th, 11.

#### Tracie.

I have been on the fence about disclosing my medical condition since receipt of the FEC letter several weeks ago. However, per our conversation on 1/8/12 I have attached my medical documents pertaining to the diagnosis and treatment of my brain tumor since 2008. I temporarily relocated to Philadelphia to get the best treatment possible in 2008:

MRI of brain showing tumor

Letter confirming treatment ( 26 days of thermostatic radiation June, July Aug 2008)

Letter confirming diagnosis and need for continual follow up 3 Audio tests showing loss of hearing since original diagnosis and post radiation of the brain(2008, 2010 and most recently 2011- I suffer from continual loss of hearing)

Please add this info to the agenda.

Unfortunately as of my last MRI the tumor did not shrink as most tumors do after sterotatic radiation and still I suffer from intermittent symptoms of the tumor such as vertigo, dizziness, nausea, pain in the side of face and continual loss of hearing (I wear hearing aids).

I am in the process of getting my medical records from my local physician in Florida to support the attached and to demonstrate that I was suffering from the above symptoms during the time frame when the Treasury Report was due. I will forward upon receipt.



#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR HEARING ON APPEAL OF AUTOMATIC FINE

Please be advised that other cases have been scheduled for the same time. Therefore, your case may not be called exactly at the time set forth on this notice.

At the automatic fine hearing, the Florida Elections Commission will decide whether Respondent's campaign treasurers report was timely filed or whether there were unusual circumstances that excuse his failure to timely file his report.

Rule 2B-1.0055, Florida Administrative Code, defines unusual circumstances as "uncommon, rare or sudden events over which the actor has no control and which directly result in the failure to act in accordance with the filing requirements. Circumstances which allow for time in which to take those steps necessary to assure compliance with the filing requirement shall be deemed not to constitute unusual circumstances."

The hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.07(8)(c), *Florida Statutes*, if Respondent is a candidate, a political committee, or an electioneering communications organization; Section 106.04(8)(c), *Florida Statutes*, if Respondent is a committee of continuous existence; or Section 106.29(3)(c), *Florida Statutes*, if Respondent is a political party; and Commission Rules 2B-1.005, 1.0052, & 1.0055, *Florida Administrative Code*.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Before making a decision, the Commission will review the written documents submitted by Respondent and staff at least ten days before the hearing and the information presented at the hearing. Rule 2B-1.005, *Florida Administrative Code*, provides that <u>unless good cause is shown</u>, the Commission will not consider any written document unless it has been filed with the Commission Clerk at least ten days before the hearing.

When the case is called, the Chair will read a brief statement and may ask the Respondent and his attorney, if one is present, to state their names for the record. Respondent will then have time to present his case to the Commission. Witnesses may be called to testify under oath on Respondent's behalf. If Respondent calls witnesses, the staff attorney may cross-examine those witnesses after Respondent's questioning is finished. After Respondent's presentation, staff will have the same amount of time to present its case. If the staff attorney calls witnesses, Respondent may cross-examine those witnesses after staff's questioning is finished.

At any time during the presentations the Commissioners may ask questions of Respondent, his attorney, the witnesses, and staff. After the presentations are concluded, the Commissioners will discuss the case and decide whether Respondent's report was timely filed or whether there were unusual circumstances that excuse his failure to file timely his report. The Commission will make a decision by a majority vote of those members present and voting.

After the Commission meeting, the Commission will send Respondent a written order reflecting the Commission's decision. If the Commission upholds the fine, Respondent will have 30 days to pay the fine.

<b>SUMMARY:</b> Sheryl Denan was a candidate for City Council in the 2011 municipal elections. Ms. Denan was her own treasurer.			

Ms. Denan is appealing the fine claiming she was never informed that a fine would be assessed for each late day. However, she was given, and acknowledged receiving, the Handbook, which included the penalties for the untimely filing of a report. Ms. Denan states that her participation in several election-

related events and personal obligations caused the untimely filing of her report.

Ms. Denan also expresses concern regarding the manner in which the filing officer calculated her fine. Section 106.07(8)(b), Florida Statutes, states "the fine shall be \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, \$500 for each late day, not to exceed 25% of contributions or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covering the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report." Ms. Denan's report was due 11/4/11, four days before the general election. A fine based on the number of days the report was late would have totaled \$1,500. Therefore, the filing officer correctly assessed a fine of \$641.25 which is based on Ms. Denan's total contributions for the period covered by the late report.

#### Dear Sirs:

I hereby appeal Ms. Montanaro's decision to fine me \$641.25 for filling a late Campaign Treasurers Report based on the following facts per FS 106.8 (c):

- 1. Ms. Monternaro originally waived candidate Pat Gibbons Treasury Report late fee on Oct 21 only to impose his fee 19 days later on Nov. 9th th. This fine to Mr. Gibbons was initiated only after I submitted a Treasury Report on Nov 7th due on Nov 4th. Her words to Pat Gibbons when he filed his late report on Oct 24th were:"I could fine you if I wanted but I will not". This demonstrates that Mrs. Monternaro simply wanted to impose a substantial fine against me personally and against my personal account and would probably not have levied any fine against Pat Gibbons if I did not file my campaign report late near then end of the campaign.
- 2. The certified mail regarding both fines for both candidates were sent out on Nov. 8<sup>th</sup> (Election Day). Neither candidate was notified "immediately" that a daily fine that was going to be imposed for the late filling. On Monday Nov 7<sup>th</sup> Mrs. Monterano called and advised me that I did not file my report on Nov 4<sup>th</sup> and I immediately brought the report to City Hall where it was dated. There was no mention of a potential fine for filling late. Again Mrs. Monternaro chose not to notify me of any impending fine even though she had an opportunity to do so.
- 3 Mrs. Monteranro did not fine Pat Gibbons the maximum fine outlined in FS 106 (\$50.00) yet I was imposed the maximum fine (\$641.25). This

- demonstrates that Mrs. Montemaro clearly chooses not to interpret FS 106 fairly.
- 3. Mrs. Monternaro did e-mail me on Nov 10<sup>th</sup> to "give me a heads up" that would be receiving a certified letter regarding the fine. This was the first time I was aware of any fine imposed. (6 days after the filing date).
- 4. The certified letters dated Nov 8th reference the "handbook" that was provided to each candidate when we qualified in August. I did read the handbook however I did not memorize the book nor did I remember that such steep fines would be imposed for filing a report late. The letter confirms that I was "reminded" on Nov 7<sup>th</sup> that the report was late. I was called however, I was never told I was going to be accessed a fine for each late day. I also filed the report immediately upon receipt of the call on Nov 7<sup>th</sup>.
- 5. I feel Mrs. Monternaros capacity as election official/ filing official/clerk (17 years) was tainted during this specific election. Mrs. Montemaro and her husband (former councilman Dominic Monternaro- 8 years-termed out until next year) openly supported and endorsed two candidates (incumbent (Chase) and former mayor/councilman for 9 years (Brimer)) during the Satellite Beach election. Mr. Monternaro was openly vocal and an active participant in the campaign for both Mr. Brimer and Mr. Chase. Many times during the election Mrs. Montemaro's capacity as election official was called into question by the public because of some of her actions and favoritism towards the above candidates due to her husbands active campaigning during the election. During the election process it was apparent that Mirs. Monternaro was not willing to assist me as a new candidate running on their own merit. Mr. Monternaros hostility towards other candidates other than those he endorsed caused friction in the community and added a great deal of stress to me and my family. I prefer not to get into specifics regarding all the issues encountered during the election unless asked by this Committee as part of this appeal but would be happy to provide additional information if requested
- 6. Pat Gibbons was not assessed a fine in Oct for his late report immediately and was only assessed a fine of 11.52 weeks after the infraction because he has lived in Satellite Beach all his life and has a long standing relationship with the elections official Mrs. Montemaro. He would not have been assessed a fine at all had I not failed to turn in my report on Nov 4<sup>th</sup> at which time we were both sent a certified letter.

I have never run for an elected position before and chose to be my own Campaign Treasurer. I realize now after the fact, that I should have delegated a treasured due to amount of work it takes to be the actual candidate and to run a campaign. I found my self getting physically exhausted the last week of October. I took 4 hours personal time from work on Nov 4th to allow time to get the treasurers report done. I was also in the process of preparing for the Founders. Day Parade the next morning at 9AM in which all candidates are invited to participate and 2. To packing up to leave immediately after the parade for my sons Pee Wee second round playoff football game at 1PM (I am the team mom) which was being hosted in another city 15 miles away. I simply forgot to prepare and submit the Treasury Report on Nov 4<sup>th</sup>. There was not a malicious attempt to hide records or to hide and expenditures or contributions. I am a working mom with two young boys who had an excessively busy week, with an unexpected additional playoff football game, a parade topped off with the anxiety of the upcoming election the following Tuesday on the 8th My husband was also out of town for an extended trip which added to the chaos that week/ weekend with Halloween, sign walving, canvassing, maintaining the household, working and taking care of my grade school boys.

Although I filed Form DS-DE 84 stating that I read and understood the requirements of SF 106, I am not a political strategist, long time politician nor did I have the ability to memorize the FS verbatim. I did not have a campaign team with a background in elections or election processes. I did the best I could in an environment where new comers are not welcome and the same council members have revolved in the council chambers in Satellite Beach for 27 years.

I believe the filing official per FS 106 should notified us (the candidates immediately) of the fines being assessed contrary to Gibbons case (19 days) my case (6 days) post violation via a certified letter. Had I been notified on Friday at 4:30 when City Hall closes on Nov 4<sup>th</sup> that the report was not submitted I could tried to have the report post marked by midnight and this would be a non issue.

I truly believe election officials and filing officials are there to assist candidates with qualifying issues, deadlines etc. and are there to help elections run efficiently and smoothly unfortunately in this case Mrs. Monternaro's actions by levying a fine against me is nothing more than a I attack on my families personal finances. Had she immediately fined Pat Gibbons in Oct in the same manor including the greater fee my position might be different. Until the Commission's position is rendered I will not release any of my family's personal finances to the City's General Fund.

I would appreciate your consideration with respect to this appeal and I would like you to consider waiving the fee (641.25) due to the filing official's inability to assess the fees fairly, without prejudice and due to unusual circumstances surrounding my failure to the file the appropriate reports on the designated due date. I would also like the Commission to consider waiving Pat Gibbon's fine of

\$11.52. This minimal fine was only imposed on Nov  $8^{th}$  to Pat in order for the City to justify imposing a fee against me and would have not been levied against him had I turned in my report on Nov  $4^{th}$ . I will be happy to supply any additional information if requested.



At the time of qualifying, I provided a list of important dates with deadlines for filing Campaign Treasurers' Reports and a copy of the Campaign Treasurers' Handbook. 



This memo is in response to your November 10, 2011, email 1) questioning how fees were assessed; 2) comparing the amount of the fine for Candidate Gibbons to the amount of your fine; and 3) why you were not advised immediately that a fine was going to be assessed.

- 1. The fines were assessed pursuant to Section 106.07(8)(b), Florida Statutes. (Attachment #1) The Statutes call for a \$50 per day fine for each day late for all Campaign Treasurer's Reports *EXCEPT* the report immediately before the election, which is \$500 per day for each day late. The Statute sets a limit on the fine by stating, "not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the later report."
- 2. During the period when Mr. Gibbons was late, he had Expenditures of \$46.09 and no Contributions; therefore, his fine was based on 25 percent of \$46.09, for a fine of \$11.52. In your case, you had Expenditures of \$158.51 and Contributions of \$2,560 (\$180 cash and checks, plus \$2,385 in-kind). Therefore, your fine was based on 25 percent of \$2,565, for a fine of \$641.25.
- 3. Regarding your question about giving notice that a fine would be assessed, you were given the following:
  - Notice in your initial campaign packet "NOTE: IT IS IMPORTANT TO FILE REPORTS ON TIME. THE STATE IMPOSES A FINE FOR EACH DAY A REPORT IS LATE." (Page 2 of Instructions to Candidates Attachment #2);
  - Copy of Candidate and Campaign Treasurers Handbook from the Florida Department of State Division of Elections, which serves as a guide to Florida Election Laws and in particular showing the penalty for late filing per Sec. 106.07, FS (page 48) (Attachment #3);

[NOTE: You filed Form DS-DE 84 certifying that you had been provided access to read and understand the requirements of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. (Attachment #4)]

- Email reminder at least 3 days prior to each due date. (Attachment #5)
- On November 7 after USPS delivered weekend mail, I called to advise that the report was late.

In response to your questions regarding notice to Mr. Gibbons, I provided him verbal notice on October 24 that a fine would be assessed. I provided notice to both you and Mr. Gibbons on November 8 by certified mail. The copies you requested are enclosed. (Attachment #6)

Florida Statutes on fines for late filing are clear; I do not have authority to waive or ignore the Statutes. If you do not agree, you can file an appeal pursuant to Section 106.07(8)(c), Florida Statutes. (Attachment #7)

Otherwise, a payment in the amount of \$641.25 is due before close of business (4:30 p.m.) Wednesday, November 30, 2011. This payment must come from personal funds, not the campaign account.

Section 106.07, Florida Statues, outlines the fine process as follows:

"... for the reports immediately preceding each special primary election, special election, primary election, and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipt or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report."

### Chapter 106.07(8), Florida Statutes

(8)(a)Any candidate or political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date is subject to a fine as provided in paragraph (b) for each late day, and, in the case of a candidate, such fine shall be paid only from personal funds of the candidate. The fine shall be assessed by the filing officer and the moneys collected shall be deposited:

1.In the General Revenue Fund, in the case of a candidate for state office or a political committee that registers with the Division of Elections; or

2.In the general revenue fund of the political subdivision, in the case of a candidate for an office of a political subdivision or a political committee that registers with an officer of a political subdivision.

No separate fine shall be assessed for failure to file a copy of any report required by this section.

(b)Upon determining that a report is late, the filing officer shall immediately notify the candidate or chair of the political committee as to the failure to file a report by the designated due date and that a fine is being assessed for each late day. The fine shall be \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each special primary election, special election, primary election, and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. For reports required under s. 106.141(7), the fine is \$50 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. Upon receipt of the report, the filing officer shall determine the amount of the fine which is due and shall notify the candidate or chair or registered agent of the political committee. The filing officer shall determine the amount of the fine due based upon the earliest of the following:

- 1. When the report is actually received by such officer.
- 2. When the report is postmarked.
- 3. When the certificate of mailing is dated.
- 4. When the receipt from an established courier company is dated.
- 5. When the electronic receipt issued pursuant to s. <u>106.0705</u> or other electronic filing system authorized in this section is dated.

Such fine shall be paid to the filing officer within 20 days after receipt of the notice of payment due, unless appeal is made to the Florida Elections Commission pursuant to paragraph (c). Notice is deemed complete upon proof of delivery of written notice to the mailing or street address on record with the filing officer. In the case of a candidate, such fine shall not be an allowable campaign expenditure and shall be paid only from personal funds of the candidate. An officer or member of a political committee shall not be personally liable for such fine.

Any candidate failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first three days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports due August 20 and October 29, 2010, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. For a candidate's termination report, the fine shall be \$50 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater for the period covered by the late report. All fines must be paid from the candidate's personal funds—not campaign funds.

(Section 106.07(2) and (8), F.S.)

## Waiver of Report

In any reporting period during which a candidate has not received funds or made any expenditures, the filling of the required report for that period is waived; however, the candidate must indicate there is no activity by filling a waiver of report. (Walvers filed with the Division of Elections must be filed using the EFS.) The next report filed must specify that the report covers the entire period between the last submitted report and the report being filed.

(Section 106.07, F.S.)

The treasurer of an electioneering communications organization shall file a written report with the filing officer by the prescribed reporting date when the organization has not received funds, made any contributions, or expended any reportable funds. This report filed with the Division of Elections must be filed using the EFS.

(Section 106,0703; F.S.)

# Incomplete Reports

If a campaign treasurer files a report that is deemed incomplete, it shall be accepted on a conditional basis. The campaign treasurer will be notified by the filing officer as to why the report is incomplete. The campaign treasurer must file an addendum to the incomplete report within three days of notification. The addendum must include all necessary information to complete the report.

(Section 106.07(2), F.S.)

# Reporting Total Sums

Each campaign treasurer's report required by Chapter 106, F.S., shall contain the total sums of all loans, in-kind contributions, and other receipts by or for such candidate, and total sums of all expenditures made by such candidate during the reporting period. The reporting forms shall be designed to elicit separate totals for in-kind contributions, loans, and other receipts.

(Section 106.07, F.S.)

(c)Any candidate or chair of a political committee may appeal or dispute the fine, based upon, but not limited to, unusual circumstances surrounding the failure to file on the designated due date, and may request and shall be entitled to a hearing before the Florida Elections Commission, which shall have the authority to waive the fine in whole or in part. The Florida Elections Commission must consider the mitigating and aggravating circumstances contained in s. 106.265(1) when determining the amount of a fine, if any, to be waived. Any such request shall be made within 20 days after receipt of the notice of payment due. In such case, the candidate or chair of the political committee shall, within the 20-day period, notify the filing officer in writing of his or her intention to bring the matter before the commission.

(d)The appropriate filing officer shall notify the Florida Elections Commission of the repeated late filing by a candidate or political committee, the failure of a candidate or political committee to file a report after notice, or the failure to pay the fine imposed. The commission shall investigate only those alleged late filing violations specifically identified by the filing officer and as set forth in the notification. Any other alleged violations must be separately stated and reported by the division to the commission under s. 106.25(2).

(9) The Department of State may prescribe by rule the requirements for filing campaign treasurers' reports as set forth in this chapter.

Summary: I stated I was aware that the Candidate Instructions she gave to Ms. Denan clearly say that the State imposes a fine for each day a report is late. I asked Ms. Montanaro if there was a reason she did not notify Ms. Denan when she called her on November 7<sup>th</sup> that a daily fine was being assessed. Ms. Montanaro stated she didn't tell Ms. Denan about the daily fine assessment because Ms. Denan told her she would bring the report in that afternoon, which she did, and at that point the fine had stopped accruing. I asked if she told Ms. Denan when the report was dropped off that there would be a fine; Ms. Montanaro stated no because Ms. Denan left the report with the receptionist. I asked Ms. Montanaro to describe the circumstances regarding Mr. Gibbons' fine. Montanaro stated that although she felt bad about having to fine Mr. Gibbons (because she knew he was spending his own money which he did not have a lot of), she never told him "I could fine you if I wanted but I will not." Ms. Montanaro stated Mr. Gibbons was first notified he would be fined when he brought his report in (10/24) and that it was very busy in the office at the time which is the reason she didn't get a chance to mail his actual fine letter until 11/8. I asked Ms. Montanaro if Ms. Denan was present when Mr. Gibbons brought in his report; she stated no. I asked if she had any idea how Ms. Denan would be aware of Ms. Montanaro's conversation with Mr. Gibbons if she wasn't even present when the report was delivered; Ms. Montanaro stated she didn't know. Ms. Montanaro reiterated that she did not discuss the fines when she called to remind them that their reports had not been filed because they both told her they would deliver their reports that day. #### Dear Sirs:

I hereby appeal Ms. Montanaro's decision to fine me \$641.25 for filling a late Campaign Treasurers Report based on the following facts per FS 106.8 (c):

- 1. Ms. Monternaro originally waived candidate Pat Gibbons Treasury Report late fee on Oct 21 only to impose his fee 19 days later on Nov. 9th th. This fine to Mr. Gibbons was initiated only after I submitted a Treasury Report on Nov 7th due on Nov 4th. Her words to Pat Gibbons when he filed his late report on Oct 24th were:"I could fine you if I wanted but I will not". This demonstrates that Mrs. Monternaro simply wanted to impose a substantial fine against me personally and against my personal account and would probably not have levied any fine against Pat Gibbons if I did not file my campaign report late near then end of the campaign.
- 2. The certified mail regarding both fines for both candidates were sent out on Nov. 8<sup>th</sup> (Election Day). Neither candidate was notified "immediately" that a daily fine that was going to be imposed for the late filling. On Monday Nov 7<sup>th</sup> Mrs. Monterano called and advised me that I did not file my report on Nov 4<sup>th</sup> and I immediately brought the report to City Hall where it was dated. There was no mention of a potential fine for filling late. Again Mrs. Monternaro chose not to notify me of any impending fine even though she had an opportunity to do so.
- 3 Mrs. Monteranro did not fine Pat Gibbons the maximum fine outlined in FS 106 (\$50.00) yet I was imposed the maximum fine (\$641.25). This

- demonstrates that Mrs. Montemaro clearly chooses not to interpret FS 106 fairly.
- 3 Mrs. Monternaro did e-mail me on Nov 10<sup>th</sup> to "give me a heads up" that would be receiving a certified letter regarding the fine. This was the first time I was aware of any fine imposed. (6 days after the filling date).
- 4. The certified letters dated Nov 8th reference the "handbook" that was provided to each candidate when we qualified in August. I did read the handbook however I did not memorize the book nor did I remember that such steep fines would be imposed for filing a report late. The letter confirms that I was "reminded" on Nov 7<sup>th</sup> that the report was late. I was called however, I was never told I was going to be accessed a fine for each late day. I also filed the report immediately upon receipt of the call on Nov 7<sup>th</sup>.
- 5. I feel Mrs. Montemaros capacity as election official/filing official/clerk (17 years) was tainted during this specific election. Mrs. Monternaro and her husband (former councilman Dominic Monternaro- 8 years-termed out until next year) openly supported and endorsed two candidates (incumbent (Chase) and former mayor/councilman for 9 years (Brimer)) during the Satellite Beach election. Mr. Monternaro was openly vocal and an active participant in the campaign for both Mr. Brimer and Mr. Chase. Many times during the election Mrs. Monternaro's capacity as election official was called into question by the public because of some of her actions and favoritism towards the above candidates due to her husbands active campaigning during the election. During the election process it was apparent that Mrs. Montemaro was not willing to assist me as a new candidate running on their own merit. Mr. Montemaros hostility towards other candidates other than those he endorsed caused friction in the community and added a great deal of stress to me and my family. I prefer not to get into specifics regarding all the issues encountered during the election unless asked by this Committee as part of this appeal but would be happy to provide additional information if requested
- 6. Pat Gibbons was not assessed a fine in Oct for his late report immediately and was only assessed a fine of 11.52 weeks after the infraction because he has lived in Satellite Beach all his life and has a long standing relationship with the elections official Mrs. Monternaro. He would not have been assessed a fine at all had I not failed to turn in my report on Nov 4<sup>th</sup> at which time we were both sent a certified letter.

I have never run for an elected position before and chose to be my own Campaign Treasurer: I realize now after the fact, that I should have delegated a treasured due to amount of work it takes to be the actual candidate and to run a campaign. I found my self getting physically exhausted the last week of October. I took 4 hours personal time from work on Nov 4th to allow time to get the treasurers report done. I was also in the process of preparing for the Founders Day Parade the next morning at 9AM in which all candidates are invited to participate and 2. To packing up to leave immediately after the parade for my sons Pee Wee second round playoff football game at 1PM (I am the team mon) which was being hosted in another city 15 miles away. I simply forgot to prepare and submit the Treasury Report on Nov 4<sup>th</sup>. There was not a malicious attempt to hide records or to hide and expenditures or contributions. I am a working mom with two young boys who had an excessively busy week, with an unexpected additional playoff football game, a parade topped off with the anxiety of the upcoming election the following Tuesday on the 8th. My husband was also out of town for an extended trip which added to the chaos that week/ weekend with Halloween, sign waiving, canvassing, maintaining the household, working and taking care of my grade school boys.

Although I filed Form DS-DE 84 stating that I read and understood the requirements of SF 106, I am not a political strategist, long time politician nor did I have the ability to memorize the FS verbatim. I did not have a campaign team with a background in elections or election processes. I did the best I could in an environment where new comers are not welcome and the same council members have revolved in the council chambers in Satellite Beach for 27 years.

I believe the filing official per FS 106 should notified us (the candidates immediately) of the fines being assessed contrary to Gibbons case (19 days) my case (6 days) post violation via a certified letter. Had I been notified on Friday at 4:30 when City Hall closes on Nov 4<sup>th</sup> that the report was not submitted I could tried to have the report post marked by midnight and this would be a non issue.

I truly believe election officials and filing officials are there to assist candidates with qualifying issues, deadlines etc. and are there to help elections run efficiently and smoothly unfortunately in this case Mrs. Monternaro's actions by levying a fine against me is nothing more than a I attack on my families personal finances. Had she immediately fined Pat Gibbons in Oct in the same manor including the greater fee my position might be different. Until the Commission's position is rendered I will not release any of my family's personal finances to the City's General Fund

I would appreciate your consideration with respect to this appeal and I would like you to consider waiving the fee (641.25) due to the filing official's inability to assess the fees fairly, without prejudice and due to unusual circumstances surrounding my failure to the file the appropriate reports on the designated due date. I would also like the Commission to consider waiving Pat Gibbon's fine of

#### CHRONOLOGY OF ELECTION ISSUES

September 9: Received email from Candidate **Denan** citing 3 locations where there were two signs on the same lot for Candidate Chase and Candidate Brimer.

September 9: Called campaign worker and all duplicate signs for Candidates **Chase** and **Brimer** were removed that day.

September 14: email to Candidate **Denan** advising her of two locations where she had two signs on same lot.

September 19: email to all five candidates reminding them of sign code and asking them to bring their signs into compliance – move out of right of way and remove banners and duplicate signs.

September 26: email from Ed **Kinberg** advising 1) Candidates Gibbons and Brimer did not have the work "for" on their campaign signs; 2) signs in right of way for various candidates; and 3) requesting a ruling on signs at duplexes.

September 26: email advising Candidate **Brimer** that his signs did not contain the required word "for." Telephone conversation with Candidate **Gibbons** advising him of the same.

[NOTE: Both candidates have corrected the situation by adding the word "for" to their signs.]

September 26: email from candidate **Denan** asking for a copy of the letter from the FOP Lodge that endorsed Candidates **Brimer** and **Chase**.

September 26: email to Candidate **Denan** advising that I did not have access to that information; it is not something that candidates are required to turn in to me.

September 26: email from Candidate **Denan** requesting that I investigate this matter and have the candidates provide a copy of the written endorsement.

INOTE: Candidate Denan received the endorsement directly from the FOP Lodge.

September 27: email from Ed Kinberg regarding placement of signs and enforcement of the Code.

September 28: email to all five candidates reminding them of sign code and asking them to bring their signs into compliance – move out of right of way and remove banners and duplicate signs. Advised that signs in the right of way would be pulled by staff, starting Monday, October 3. Asked them to correct sign issues to eliminate the need for staff time to pull the signs.

September 28: email from Candidate **Gibbons**, citing page 30-89 of City sign code referring to banner signs as his reason for putting up the banner.

September 28: email to Candidate **Gibbons** advising that the only section of the sign Code (p. 30-89) that applies to the campaign is the section entitled "Political Campaign."

September 29: string of emails from Ed **Kinberg** alleging aggressive, uneven, and/or delayed enforcement of rules, bias, and appearance of impropriety on the part of the City Clerk, together with responses from the City Clerk.

September 30: Campaign workers for Brimer and Chase advised me that they had moved their signs.

October 3: Staff began pulling signs in the right of way.

October 3: email to Candidate **Gibbons** reminding him that the banner is in violation of political advertising.

October 3: email from Candidate **Gibbons** asking for a second opinion and asking that we "let this go and rewrite the regulation for clarity" since there are only 30 days left.

October 3: email to Candidate **Gibbons** restating that any regulations in the sign Code other than "Political Campaign" apply to commercial activity and expressing surprise that anyone would suggest ignoring the Code. Again, I advised him that the banner needs to come down.

October 3: email from Candidate **Gibbons** asking to get an unbiased interpretation on the regulation and suggesting that he would like to talk with Lori Scott, Brevard County Supervisor of Elections.

October 3: email to Candidate **Gibbons** letting him know that he can call Lori Scott; but she will probably refer him to me.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES - NOVEMBER 8<sup>th</sup> ELECTION CANDIDATE QUALIFYING PERIOD AUGUST 11-24, 2011

- Candidates must be registered voters and have resided in Satellite Beach for one year prior to qualifying date.
- Term of office is 3 years. This year, there are two Council seats to be filled.
- Candidates shall be ranked according to total votes received from high to low, with those ranked highest to be declared elected in order to fill the number of vacant positions and expiring terms.
- ♦ Council members serve without salary; however, each Council Member receive \$50 per month compensation for expenses.

#### PART A

Execute Form DS-DE9 entitled "Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates". A candidate may <u>not</u> accept contributions or make expenditures until Form DS-DE9 is filed. The form must be on file with the City Clerk prior to opening the campaign account.

The campaign treasurer or deputy campaign treasurer must be a registered voter in Florida. A candidate may appoint himself/herself as campaign treasurer or deputy treasurer.

The treasurer's duty is to ensure that the account is kept current within two days of the date when the contribution is received or the expenditure is made. When the campaign is over, the treasurer must preserve all account records for the number of years equal to the term of office (three years).

The campaign depository must be a bank, savings and loan association or credit union authorized to do business in the State of Florida. All contributions must be deposited into the account and all expenditures must be drawn by check on the account. The campaign account must be separate from any personal or other account and used only for depositing campaign contributions and making expenditures.

Campaign checks must contain the statement, "Campaign Account of \_\_\_\_\_\_," the account number, and the name of the bank. The information may be typed on starter checks until printed checks arrive.







#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

DEADLINE FOR FILING - Reports shall be filed no later than 5 p.m. of the day designated. However, any report postmarked by the U.S. Postal Service no later than midnight of the day designated shall be deemed to have been filed in a timely manner. A Certificate of Mailing, obtained from and dated by the U.S. Postal Service at the time of mailing, or a receipt from an established courier service, which bears a date on or before the date on which the report is due, shall be proof of mailing in a timely manner.

**FILING OFFICER** - All reports required of a candidate shall be filed with the officer before whom the candidate is required by law to qualify. Reports required of political committees shall be filed with the agency or officer before whom such committee registers. All committees of continuous existence shall file reports with the Division of Elections.

(IMPORTANT NOTE: Rule 1S-2.017, F.A.C. requires that all candidates, political committees and committees of continuous existence, who file with the Department of State must file electronically. Any candidate, political committee, or committee of continuous existence who is unable to file a campaign treasurer's report on magnetic diskette, must file a statement to this effect with the Division of Elections. Thereafter, such reports may be filed in hard copy. An original and duplicate copy of the Campaign Treasurer's Report Summary (Form DS-DE 12), and a magnetic diskette of the information required by Chapter 106, F.S., must be filed with the Division of Elections.)

WAIVER OF REPORTS - In any reporting period when there has been no activity in the account (no funds expended or received) the filing of the required report is waived. HOWEVER, THE FILING OFFICER MUST BE NOTIFIED IN WRITING ON THE PRESCRIBED REPORTING DATE THAT NO REPORT IS BEING FILED. (Section 106.07(7), F.S.)

PENALTY FOR LATE FILING - Any candidate or political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Any committee of continuous existence failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

REGISTERED POLITICAL COMMITTEES AND COMMITTEES OF CONTINUOUS EXISTENCE - Registered political committees and committees of continuous existence must file reports on all dates listed below, with the exception of the 90 day termination report. In addition, committees of continuous existence must file an annual report with the Division of Elections during the month of January. (Section 106.04(4)(a), F.S.)

Dear Ms. Denan:

The Florida Elections Commission received your letter appealing the fine assessed against you for failing to timely file your campaign treasurer's report. I anticipate that the Commission will hear your case at its next meeting, which is **presently scheduled for February 21 and 22, 2012,** in Tallahassee. However, please call our office to verify when your case will be heard.

In reaching its decision, the Commission will consider the documents gathered by Commission staff and any documents you submit for the Commission's consideration before its meeting. Unless good cause is shown, the Commission will not consider any written document unless it has been filed with the Commission Clerk at least ten days before the meeting. Rules 2B-1.005, 1.0052, and 1.0055, Florida Administrative Code, are the Commission's rules on the appeal of automatic fines.

The Commission will uphold the fine imposed by the filing officer unless you provide credible evidence that the report was timely filed or credible evidence that unusual or other circumstances caused the report to be filed late.

If you are a county, municipal, or special district candidate or committee and your report was received by the filing officer without a postmark or with an illegible postmark more than five days after the due date or it was delivered to the filing officer by a mail delivery service other than the United States Postal Service, it will not be found timely filed unless you submit a copy of a proof of mailing or at a hearing before the Commission, presents the oral testimony of the person who timely mailed the report.

The proof of mailing submitted shall reflect that it was obtained from the United States Postal Service or other mail delivery service at the time of mailing and shall reflect that the report was mailed before midnight on the due date. A metered postage mark does not constitute a postmark or a proof of mailing.

If you cannot show that your report was timely filed, the Commission may still grant you relief, but only if you show unusual circumstances. Unusual circumstances is defined in Rule 2B-1.005(4), Florida Administrative Code, to mean "uncommon, rare, or sudden events over which the actor has no control and which directly result in the failure to act in accordance with the filing requirements." Unusual circumstances must occur within a time period that would clearly have prevented you from filing the report in a timely manner. Unusual circumstances shall not include the failure of the United States Postal Service or other mail delivery service to postmark an envelope, legibly postmark an envelope, or timely deliver mail. Further, unusual circumstances shall not include the failure of the sender to affix sufficient postage to a report that is being mailed.

Without credible evidence, the Commission will not find unusual circumstances. The following circumstances may constitute unusual circumstances so long as credible evidence is presented that unusual circumstances caused the report to be filed late.

- 1. Natural disaster or other emergency that prevented timely filing. Evidence submitted must include copies of newspaper reports or other documents from an independent and reliable source that shows the nature, date, and location of the natural disaster or emergency.
- 2. Death of the candidate or campaign treasurer or an immediate family member of the candidate or campaign treasurer. Evidence submitted must include a copy of the death certificate, newspaper obituary, or funeral program, or notice.
- 3. Serious illness, disability or non-elective surgery of the candidate or campaign treasurer. Evidence submitted must include a physician's certification on professional letterhead stationery that includes the dates of the illness, disability, or surgery; a statement regarding the period of time that the patient was incapacitated; and a statement that surgery, if any, was not elective. Copies of hospital records reflecting the dates of hospitalization may also show the period of incapacitation.
- 4. Serious illness, disability, or non-elective surgery of the immediate family member of the candidate or campaign treasurer. Evidence submitted must include evidence of the relationship of the candidate or treasurer to the family member, the location of the family member, and the reason the presence of the candidate or campaign treasurer was required. Evidence submitted must also include a physician's certification on professional letterhead stationary that includes the dates of the illness, disability or surgery; a statement regarding the period of time that the patient was incapacitated; a statement that surgery, if any, was not elective; and a statement that the patient required the care of a family member.
- 5. Computer or equipment failure caused by events that could not have been anticipated and that made timely filing of the report impossible. Power outages or program failure does not constitute unusual circumstances

unless it is established that reasonable precautions to assure the safety of the equipment or the ability of the program to perform as anticipated were taken before the events causing failure of the equipment or program. Evidence must include a written statement made under oath in the presence of a notary or other person authorized to administer oaths indicating the cause and the duration of the power outage and the reasonable precautions taken to assure the safety of the equipment or the ability of the program to perform as anticipated.

6. The abrupt and unexpected loss of the campaign treasurer, over which you had no control. The loss of the campaign treasurer does not constitute unusual circumstances if the appealing party failed to monitor the campaign treasurer's performance before his or her departure or if the appealing party failed to assure prompt preparation of the report after the treasurer's departure. Evidence must include a written statement made under oath in the presence of a notary or other person authorized to administer oaths explaining the departure of your treasurer and the steps taken to monitor the treasurer's performance before his or her departure.

You may, of course, send any additional evidence that you believe supports your position that your report was timely filed or that unusual circumstances cause your report to be filed late. Rule 2B-1.005(3), Florida Administrative Code, provides that if you send additional documentary evidence, the Commission must receive it no later than 20 days from the date of this letter. Remember that the Commission will not consider any written document unless it has been filed with the Commission Clerk at least ten days before the meeting, unless good cause is shown. If the documentary evidence is timely received, it will be presented to the Commission when it considers your appeal of the assessed fine.

It is your responsibility to provide the Commission with credible evidence that the report was timely filed or credible evidence that unusual circumstances caused the report to be filed late. If you do not provide the evidence requested in this letter or in the Commission rules, the Commission will uphold the fine assessed by the filing officer.
