If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 minutes to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 *minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE CASES, VACATE DEFAULT FINAL ORDER AND HOLD HEARING ON AUTOMATIC FINE APPEAL

COMES NOW, staff, by and through the undersigned attorney, files its Motion to

Consolidate Cases, Vacate Default Final Order and Hold Hearing on Automatic Fine Appeal,

and states:

1. People for a Better Volusia ("Appellant") is a political committee registered with

the Division of Elections ("Division").

2. Appellant did not timely file its 2018 D1 Report, and the Division imposed an

automatic fine of \$298.75 based on 25% of Respondent's expenditures.

3. On January 22, 2019, Appellant's Treasurer filed an appeal of the fine with the

Florida Elections Commission ("Commission"). However, only a political committee's

chairperson may appeal a fine for a late report.

4. On January 23, 2019, the Commission notified Appellant that the wrong person

had filed its appeal and requested that Appellant's Chairperson provide a signed statement

confirming the appeal within 14 days from the date of the letter.

5. On February 11, 2019, the Commission received a letter of appeal filed by

Appellant's Chairperson. Upon receipt of the letter signed by the Chairperson appealing the fine,

staff opened a new case (FEC 19-044) rather than adding the letter to the file in this case (FEC

19-021), which was opened when the Treasurer submitted the appeal letter.

Motion to Consolidate and Vacate

6. On March 15, 2019, a Default Final Order was mistakenly entered in this case because the Chairperson's appeal letter was placed in the new case file (FEC 19-044) instead of being placed in this case file (FEC 19-021). If the Chairperson's letter requesting an appeal had been placed in this case file, Commission staff would not have entered a Default Final Order in relation to Appellant's 2018 D1 Report.

7. Because a Default Final Order would not have been entered if the Chairperson's appeal letter had been placed in the instant file, staff requests the Commission to combine this case with FEC 19-044, vacate the Default Final Order in this case entered on March 15, 2019, and hear Appellant's appeal relating to the 2018 D1 Report.¹

WHEREFORE, staff requests the Commission enter an order consolidating FEC 19-021 with FEC 19-044, vacating the Default Final Order in FEC 19-021, and hold a hearing on the appeal of the automatic fine at issue.

DEFAULT FINAL ORDER

THIS MATTER was referred to the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) by the filing officer for failure of the Respondent to pay the assessed fine.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Commission is charged with enforcing Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the campaign financing laws.
- 2. Respondent is a committee registered with the state. Respondent's 2018 D1 campaign treasurer's report was not filed with the filing officer on October 27, 2018, the designated due date.
- 3. On January 11, 2019, the filing officer sent a final fine notice to the Respondent by delivery confirmation advising them that the amount of the fine was \$298.75. The notice also advised Respondent, as required by Section 106.07(8)(b), Florida Statutes, that they must either pay the fine or appeal to the Florida Elections Commission within 20 days after receipt of the notice of payment due. On January 22, 2019, the commission received an appeal from the campaign treasurer. A subsequent letter was sent on January 23, 2019 advising them that as required by section 106.07(8)(c), Florida Statutes, only the candidate or the chairman of a political committee may appeal a fine assessed by a filing officer, and that Respondent's failure to timely file an amended appeal within 14 days would result in the Commission entering a

Default Final Order ordering the payment of the fine assessed by the filing officer.

4. Respondent has failed to pay the assessed fine or to appeal to the Commission.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 5. The Commission has jurisdiction over the parties to and subject matter of this case, pursuant to Section 106.07, Florida Statutes.
- 6. Respondent's failure to timely file a notice appealing the assessed fine constitutes a waiver of entitlement to an appeal.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing facts and conclusions of law, it is hereby

ORDERED that the assessed fine of \$298.75 is affirmed. The fine shall be paid to the Division of Elections at the R.A. Gray Building, Room 316, 500 South Bronough Street, Tallahassee, FL 32399 within 30 days of the date this Final Order is filed with the Commission.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL

This order is final agency action. Any party who is adversely affected by this order has the right to seek judicial review pursuant to Section 120.68, Florida Statutes, by filing a notice of administrative appeal pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, with the Clerk of the Florida Elections Commission at 107 West Gaines Street, Suite 224, Collins Building, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-1050, and by filing a copy of the notice of appeal with the appropriate district court of appeal. The party must attach to the notice of appeal a copy of this order and include with the notice of appeal filed with the district court of appeal the applicable filing fees. The notice of administrative appeal must be filed within 30 days of the date of this order is filed with the Commission. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order.

Notice to Filing Officer

The Clerk of the Florida Elections Commission will send a copy of this order to Respondent. The Final Order directs the Respondent to pay the Filing Officer. Dear Ms. Lane:

The Florida Elections Commission received a letter from Kim Brown-Crawford, Treasurer, appealing the fine assessed against your committee for failing to timely file a required report. However, Section 106.07(8)(c), Florida Statutes, provide that only a *candidate or the chairman* of a political committee, may appeal a fine assessed by a filing officer for the late filing of a campaign treasurer's report.

Therefore, to preserve your right to appeal the fine, the Commission must receive a written statement signed by you indicating that the person signing the letter was representing you when the appeal was filed.

If we do not hear from you within 14 days from the date of this letter, we will assume that the person signing the letter is neither your attorney nor your personal representative and that you have waived your right to appeal. The Commission will then enter a Default Final Order, ordering you to pay the fine assessed by your filing officer for failing to timely file your campaign treasurer's report.

Dear Ms. Lane:

Our records indicate that you have not filed either your campaign treasurer's report or notification that no reportable activity occurred, whichever is applicable. The filing date was October 27, 2018.

The law (s. 106.07(8)(b), Fla. Stat.) requires the filing officer to immediately notify you about the missed filing date and the automatic fines that will be assessed for late filing of a report, if a report was due.

- If reportable activity occurred and you have not filed a report, statutory fines are automatically assessed as follows until you file your report:
 - \$50 per day for the first 3 days late
 - \$500 per day for each day after the 3rd day late
 - If the required report immediately precedes a primary and general election, the automatic fine is \$500 for each late day.

The total fine for the untimely report cannot exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the cover period. Even if you end up filing your report late, we cannot waive the statutory fines. We will notify you of the specific amount of fines owed once you file your report. You have 20 days from the day you receive the notice to pay the fine or to appeal the fine to the Florida Elections Commission.

• If no reportable activity occurred for the report date(s), you are still required to notify us in writing, via the Division's Electronic Filing System, that no reportable activity occurred. No automatic fines are statutorily assessed.

However, in all cases, failure to file and/or untimely filing of a report of reportable activity, or if applicable, a notice that no reportable activity occurred, may constitute an apparent violation of chapter 106, Fla. Stat. If we refer such matter to the Florida Elections Commission, the Commission may subsequently impose a civil penalty for each violation under chapter 106.265(1), Fla. Stat.

the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date is subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the chairperson and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.

An online instruction guide is available to you on the EFS to assist with navigation, data entry, and submission of reports. The Division of Elections will also provide assistance to all users by contacting the EFS Help Desk at (850) 245-6280.

It is your responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws.
