If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: John Christopher Canter was a candidate for Broward School Board, District 6, in the 2022 elections. Mr. Canter was his own treasurer.

John Christopher Canter is appealing the fine claiming there were extenuating health circumstances surrounding the late submission of the report. According to Mr. Canter, he was very sick with bronchitis followed by the flu, which lasted several weeks. He states that the illness left him “bed-confined” while out of town and continued upon his return to South Florida. He sought treatment from multiple emergency care facilities and has provided documents to support his appeal. Mr. Canter states that his “grass-roots campaign” did not have staff to assist with administrative matters once he became incapacitated. He requests a waiver of the fine due to these circumstances.

- The 2022 P1 Original Report covers the period from 06/01/22-06/17/22; it was due on 06/24/22.
- The 2022 P1 Original Report shows that it was submitted on 07/05/22.
- John Christopher Canter reported receiving 1 contribution while making 1 expenditure.
- The Broward County Supervisor of Elections office provided an email that pertains to John Canter’s 2022 P1 Report. On July 5, 2022, Mr. Canter sent an email to SOE staff stating that he filed the late report and that he was “deathly ill with flu and pneumonia.” He also mentions filing an appeal based on those circumstances.

Dear Esteemed Florida Elections Commissioners:

I am submitted the enclosures as an appeal of a fine of \$475.00 for my Campaign Treasurer's Report, which was due on June 24, 2022, and submitted on July 5, 2022.

I became very sick with bronchitis and then the flu, lasting a number of weeks, I initially sought treatment at Piedmont Urgent Care in Dallas, Ga., during an out-of-town trip to Atlanta on June 20, 2022 (notes included herein). The illness left me bed-confined in an effort to get well. Upon returning to South Florida, I visited the Emergency Room at HCA University Hospital in Davie, Florida, on June 27, 2022, due to fever and continued, worsening cough (notes included herein).

Although I was able to get out of bed long enough to submit my report on July 5, 2022, I remained sick, evidenced by yet another follow-up visit to the same Emergency Room on July 6, 2022, at which time I was diagnosed with the flu. In fact, I just tested flu-negative this week.

As I am local school board candidate running a grass-roots campaign, I did not have additional volunteers or staff supporting me in these administrative matters when I become incapacitated. I humbly request that the Commission review the enclosed documentation and waive the associated fines due to the extenuating health circumstances surrounding the late submission of the report.

Subject: Treasurer's Report- Late & Fine

Your Campaign Treasurer's Report (P1) which was due 6/24/2022, covering the period 6/1/2022 to 6/17/2022 was not received until 7/5/2022. According to Section 106.07(8)(b), Florida Statutes, a fine of \$50 per day for the first three days late and \$500 each day thereafter, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report shall be assessed. **Therefore, you are fined \$475.00, 25% of your Total Contributions of \$1,900.00.**

The fine shall be paid to the Supervisor of Elections within 20 days of receipt of this notice unless appealed to the Florida Elections Commission, 107 West Gaines Street, Suite 224, Tallahassee, FL 32399-1050. Section 106.7(8)(c), Florida Statutes, provides for appealing or disputing the assessed fine by submitting a notice of appeal in writing to the Florida Elections Commission within 20 days of the date of receipt of the notice of payment due, stating any unusual circumstances surrounding the failure to file on the designated due date. A failure to file such notice will constitute a waiver of the right of appeal.

Moreover, the notice of appeal must be accompanied by any and all supporting evidence you wish the Commission to consider in making its determination. Examples of such evidence that the Florida Elections Commission will consider are: 1) an affidavit attesting, in specific detail, to a timely mailing; 2) an affidavit or letter from the post office documenting a mailing problem; or 3) an affidavit or statement from an attending physician or a hospital bill, setting forth specific dates, if there is a health-related reason as to why your report was not timely filed.

If you fail to submit documentation or evidence demonstrating the unusual circumstances which prevented you from timely filing your report within the 20 day period stated above, no documentation or evidence submitted thereafter will be considered by the Florida Elections Commission.

You also have the right to a hearing before the Commission. However, if you desire a hearing before the Commission, you must request such hearing in the notice of appeal within the 20 days of receipt of this notice. If no timely request for hearing is made in your notice of appeal, you will be deemed to have waived your right to a hearing and the Commission's determination shall be based upon the written record.

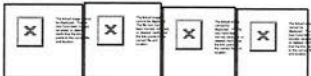


