**If you are the Respondent**, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 minutes to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

**If you are the Complainant**, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

**If you are an Appellant**, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 *minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.


If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

#### **ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE**

**THIS MATTER** was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting on August 17, 2016, in Tallahassee, Florida.

Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following violation(s):

#### Count 1:

On or around October 24, 2014, Jennifer Nolan Hager violated Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes, when she failed to report contributions required to be reported by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2014 G6 Report.

#### Count 2:

On or around October 31, 2014, Jennifer Nolan Hager violated Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes, when she failed to report contributions required to be reported by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2014 G7 Report.

#### Count 3:

On or around October 3, 2014, Jennifer Nolan Hager violated

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when she deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2014 G3 Report.

#### Count 4:

On or around February 2, 2015, Jennifer Nolan Hager violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when she deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2015 Termination Report.

#### Count 5:

On or around October 3, 2014, Jennifer Nolan Hager violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when she falsely reported information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2014 G3 Report.

The Commission finds that there is **no probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes.

#### NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by <u>consent order</u> where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s)s and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

Second, you may request an <u>informal hearing</u> held before the Commission, if you <u>do not</u> dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to make written or oral arguments to the Commission concerning the legal issues related to the violation(s) and the potential fine. At the request of Respondent, the Commission will consider and determine willfulness at an informal hearing. Otherwise, live witness testimony is unnecessary.

Third, you may request a <u>formal hearing</u> held before an administrative law judge in the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH), if you dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to present evidence relevant to the violation(s) listed in this order, to cross-examine opposing witnesses, to impeach any witness, and to rebut the evidence presented against you.

If you do not elect to resolve the case by consent order or request a formal hearing at the DOAH or an informal hearing before the Commission within 30 days of the date this Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission, the case will be sent to the Commission for a formal or informal hearing, depending on whether the facts are in dispute. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order.

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#### STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the complaint in this case recommending that there is probable cause to charge Respondent with violating Sections 106.19(1)(b), and 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, and no probable cause to charge Respondent with violating Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on March 7, 2016, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

- 1. On July 6, 2015, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a sworn complaint from Susan Bucher, the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections ("Complainant"), alleging that Jennifer Nolan Hager ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes
- 2. Respondent was a 2014 candidate for re-election to the Indian Trail Improvement District Board of Supervisors, Seat 1. Respondent's Statement of Candidate form ("DS-DE 84") was filed on June 13, 2014 (ROI Exhibit 10)<sup>1</sup>
- 3. By letter dated September 29, 2015, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provisions:

Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes: Jennifer Hager, 2014 candidate for Indian Trail Improvement District Board of Supervisors, Seat 1, acting as her own treasurer, may have failed to report one or more contributions required to be reported by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes: Jennifer Hager, 2014 candidate for Indian Trail Improvement District Board of Supervisors, Seat 1, acting as her own treasurer, may have falsely reported or deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes

Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes: Jennifer Hager, 2014 candidate for Indian Trail Improvement District Board of Supervisors, Seat 1, acting as her own treasurer, may have made or

authorized one or more expenditures prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

#### Alleged Violation: Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes

- 4. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by failing to report contributions required to be reported by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. The reporting periods at issue begin with the 2014 P1 Report (from June 1, 2014) and end with the 2015 Termination Report (through February 2, 2015).
- 5. A subpoena was issued to Respondent's designated campaign depository to ascertain whether any contributions were received during the relevant reporting periods which were not reported.
- 6. Respondent's bank records show that Respondent failed to report four contributions, as shown in Table 1, below (ROI Exhibit 3).

- 7. Respondent stated that the failure to report contributions was simply an oversight. (ROI Exhibit 4, pages 1 & 3)
- 8. Respondent failed to report contributions which were required to be reported by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2014 G6 and G7 reports.

#### Alleged Violation: Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes

9. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by falsely reporting or deliberately failing to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. The reporting periods at issue begin with the 2014 P1 Report (from June 1, 2014) and end with the 2015 Termination Report (through February 2, 2015).

10. A subpoena was issued to Respondent's designated campaign depository to ascertain whether any contributions were received or expenditures were made during the relevant reporting periods which were not reported or falsely reported.

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11. Respondent's bank records show that Respondent failed to report four contributions, as shown in Table 1, above (ROI Exhibit 3) Respondent's bank records also show that Respondent failed to report four expenditures, as shown in Table 2, below (ROI Exhibit 6)

- 12. Also, the campaign's 2014 G3 Report shows a \$53 expenditure to Hendrick Services on September 25, 2014, for campaign signage which does not have a corresponding bank record. (ROI Exhibit 5)
- Respondent stated that the failure to report expenditures was simply an oversight. She stated that she used her personal debit card when making the expenditure to Hendrick Services, and therefore, it should have been reported as an in-kind contribution from self. (ROI Exhibit 4)
- Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, requires candidates to report any contributions received and any expenditures made for the purpose of influencing the results of an election. Respondent deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, when she failed to report contributions received on the campaign's 2014 G6 and G7 reports. As the unreported contributions were charged under Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes, above, Commission staff recommends that the Commission exercise its discretion and forgo charging under Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, even though Respondent's actions allow for the charging of the violations under both sections of law However, Respondent deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2014 G3 and 2015 Termination reports, and falsely reported information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2014 G3 Report

#### Alleged Violation: Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes

- 15. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by making or authorizing expenditures prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. The reporting periods at issue begin with the 2014 P1 Report (from June 1, 2014) and end with the 2015 Termination Report (through February 2, 2015).
- 16. A subpoena was issued to Respondent's designated campaign depository to ascertain whether Respondent made or authorized expenditures prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
- Respondent's bank records do not reflect a negative balance, as shown in the campaign's 2015 Termination Report, but rather reflects that there were sufficient funds available during the relevant reporting periods. (ROI Exhibit 7) The negative balance shown in the report stems from Respondent's failure to report contributions and expenditures and the false reporting of an expenditure as set forth above
- 18. It does not appear that Respondent made or authorized expenditures prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
- "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged Schmitt v State, 590 So 2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).
- The facts set forth above show that Respondent was a 2014 candidate for reelection to the Indian Trail Improvement District Board of Supervisors, Seat 1 Respondent failed to report contributions which were required to be reported by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2014 G6 and G7 reports. Respondent deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2014 G3 and 2015 Termination reports, and falsely reported information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2014 G3 Report. It does not appear that Respondent made or authorized expenditures prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find no probable cause to charge Respondent with violating Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes, and find probable cause to charge Respondent with violating the following:

#### Count 1:

On or around October 24, 2014, Jennifer Nolan Hager violated Section 106 19(1)(b), Florida Statutes, when she failed to report

contributions required to be reported by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2014 G6 Report

#### Count 2:

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On or around October 31, 2014, Jennifer Nolan Hager violated Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes, when she failed to report contributions required to be reported by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2014 G7 Report.

#### Count 3:

On or around October 3, 2014, Jennifer Nolan Hager violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when she deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2014 G3 Report.

#### Count 4:

On or around February 2, 2015, Jennifer Nolan Hager violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when she deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2015 Termination Report

#### Count 5:

On or around October 3, 2014, Jennifer Nolan Hager violated Section 106 19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when she falsely reported information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2014 G3 Report.

# FLORIDA ELECTIONS COMMISSION REPORT OF INVESTIGATION

Case No.: FEC 15-377

Respondent: Jennifer Nolan Hager

Complainant: Susan Bucher

On July 6, 2015, the Florida Elections Commission received a sworn complaint alleging that Respondent violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. The Commission staff investigated whether Respondent violated the following statutes:

Section 106.19(1)(b), Florida Statutes, failure of a person or organization to report a contribution required to be reported by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes;

Section 106 19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, prohibiting a person or organization from falsely reporting or deliberately failing to report information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes; and

Section 106 19(1)(d), Florida Statutes, prohibiting a person or organization from making or authorizing any expenditure prohibited by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes

#### I. Preliminary Information:

- Respondent, Jennifer Nolan Hager, was a candidate for re-election to the Indian Trail Improvement District, Seat 1; she was re-elected to office on November 4, 2014 Respondent was first elected to office in November 2010
- On September 15, 2014, Respondent's "APPOINTMENT OF CAMPAIGN TREASURER AND DESIGNATION OF CAMPAIGN DEPOSITORY FOR CANDIDATES" form (DS-DE 9) was filed with the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections' office. Respondent appointed herself as campaign treasurer. To review the DS-DE 9 form, refer to Exhibit 1
- 3. Complainant, the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections, was Respondent's filing officer

#### II. Alleged Violation of Section 106,19(1)(b), Florida Statutes:

4 I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by

#### failing to report contributions

- 5. In her response, Respondent did not specifically address this allegation Respondent stated that she "missed the deadline for the Campaign Termination Report" and added that she believed that she owed herself money from the campaign and that she did not know "where the mistake is nor how to correct it." Respondent further stated that she tried to seek help from the supervisor of elections' office in amending her termination report. To review Respondent's response, refer to Exhibit 2.
- I secured Respondent's campaign account records and compared the bank records to her campaign reports on file with the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections' office. Table 1 lists four contributions that were not reported. To review copies of the checks, refer to Exhibit 3.

- In a questionnaire-affidavit, Respondent had been asked why she did not report the contributions. She stated, "Simply an oversight" Respondent added that she did not know why the contributions were not reported and stated, "I own up to that simply being an oversight on my part." To review Respondent's response to the questionnaire-affidavit, refer to Exhibit 4.
- 8. No record was found to indicate that Respondent has previously violated this section of the election laws.

#### III. Alleged Violation of Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes:

- 9. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by falsely reporting or deliberately failing to disclose information.
  - 10 As noted in Table 1, Respondent did not report four contributions
- In addition, a review of Respondent's campaign reports and campaign account records indicate that Respondent reported an expenditure for which the bank has no record Respondent's 2014 G3 report, covering the reporting period of September 13 September 26,

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2014, discloses an expenditure to "Hendrick Services" on September 25, 2014, in the amount of \$53.00 for the reported purpose of "Campaign Signage" However, there are no bank records to substantiate the reported expenditure<sup>2</sup> To review the page from the 2014 G3 report depicting the expenditure, refer to Exhibit 5

Furthermore, a review of Respondent's campaign account records also reflect that she did not report various bank fees and/or charges on any of her campaign reports. To review the bank statements relative to the fees/charges, refer to Exhibit 6.

- In a questionnaire-affidavit, Respondent was asked about the bank fees and the reported expenditure to "Hendrick Services" Concerning the bank fees, Respondent stated, "Simply an oversight" Respondent added she did not know why the bank fees were not reported and stated that it was "simply an oversight and completely unintended." With regard to the expenditure reported to "Hendrick Services" but with no corresponding bank record, Respondent said that she used her own personal debit-card to make the purchase Respondent added that the expenditure should have been reported as an in-kind contribution from her. To review Respondent's response to the questionnaire-affidavit, refer to Exhibit 4.
- Respondent's Termination Report (TR) was filed with the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections' office on February 2, 2015. According to the campaign account records, the campaign depository had a balance of \$60.95 on the date that the TR was filed. It appears that Respondent did not dispose of funds remaining in her account within 90 days after she was elected to office pursuant to Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes. To review the February bank statement, refer to Exhibit 7
- 15. In addition, bank records reveal a \$12 00 Maintenance Fee on February 27, 2015, and a \$48.95 Closing Debit on March 2, 2015—activity that occurred after Respondent filed her

- No record was found to indicate that Respondent has previously violated this section of the election laws

#### IV. Alleged Violation of Section 106.19(1)(d), Florida Statutes:

- 17. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by making prohibited expenditures from the campaign account
- A review of Respondent's campaign account records was made and the account records did not reflect any expenditures when funds were unavailable. According to the account records, the account was closed on March 2, 2015, with a zero balance following a "Closing Debit" in the amount of \$48.95. To review the March bank statement, refer to Exhibit 8
- As previously addressed, Respondent offered an e-mail in response to questions asked of her in a questionnaire-affidavit. Respondent stated, "I have not been able to match up the numbers and 'make them equal zero." Furthermore, I have no intention of 'fudging' the numbers so that they do so I accept responsibility for the inconsistencies of my reports and stand by my assertions that these mistakes were erroneously, yet innocently, made." To review Respondent's e-mail response, refer to Exhibit 4, page 1
- 20. No record was found to indicate that Respondent has previously violated this section of the election laws

#### V. FEC History:

21. Respondent has no prior history with the Florida Elections Commission.

#### Conclusion:

- On March 7, 2016, I interviewed Respondent for the purpose of providing her with a brief overview of the case and to afford her an opportunity for questions or comments. Respondent said that the only comment she had was to reiterate that she owned up to her mistakes in the reports and added that perhaps she should not have served as her own campaign treasurer
- In an affidavit, Supervisor of Elections Susan Bucher attested that all candidates are verbally directed to the Division of Elections' website for publications, such as Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*. To review the affidavit of Susan Bucher, refer to Exhibit 9
- In an affidavit, Respondent attested that she had not sought elective office prior to first being elected to office in 2010. Additionally, Respondent attested that although she does not possess a copy of the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*, she has read the handbook. To review Respondent's response to the questionnaire-affidavit, refer to Exhibit 4.
  - 25 Respondent signed a "Statement of Candidate" form indicating that she had been

provided access to read and understand the requirements of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes; the form is dated as having been signed June 13, 2014. To review the Statement of Candidate form, refer to Exhibit 10.

As per paragraph 14, I found that Respondent did not dispose of funds remaining in her account within 90 days after she was elected to office pursuant to Section 106 141(1), Florida Statutes However, because this violation was not alleged in the complaint, I did not investigate this information

I do acknowledge that I missed the deadline for the Campaign Termination Report. Herein lies the problem / discrepancy: I apparently owe myself money from this campaign and I still do not know where the mistake is not how to correct it. In an email dated 02/24/15 I asked HOW to "amend" the Termination Report, as I was having difficulties with the form online I received no response. In an email dated 03/03/15 I asked once again HOW to amend this report, as I have been unable to do so online. Again, no response offering explanation, except to visit the office, which isn't always conducive to my school hours (I have other obligations at school after normal school hours and the elections office is closed before I can get there.)

I received a certified letter dated July 6, 2015. It was signed for by my daughter and was NOT given to me, but instead, misplaced I then received a yellow postcard dated 08/21/15 noting "Urgent Reminder - Act Now" It was mixed in with "junk mail" and thankfully I found it before shredding everything. I suppose these things happen.

So, I offer my apologies instead of excuses and the reasons that I have not been available to physically go to the elections office I can assure you that I do NOT have ANY means to pay fines for this alleged violation

I have copied my local elections office in this email so that they are aware that I have received this notice. I will also personally go to the elections office to address this matter



Again, no response offering explanation, except to visit the office, which isn't always conducive to my school hours (I have other obligations at school after normal school hours and the elections office is closed before I can get there)

I received a certified letter dated July 6, 2015. It was signed for by my daughter and was NOT given to me, but instead, misplaced. I suppose these things happen.
