SUMMARY: Black Jax PAC, Inc. is a political committee (PC) registered with the State of Florida. The PC's chair is Eric K. Mann, and its treasurer is Timothy H. Johnson.

The PC is appealing the fine. According to the treasurer, Mr. Johnson, the late filing was "solely due to the reporting requirements early on in the establishment of the BJP and our understanding of the EFS." He claims the PC received their EFS credentials on September 15, 2020, and notes they were instructed to file the first report on September 18, 2020. Mr. Johnson states they had difficulty mastering the EFS system and needed technical support from the Division. He notes that the 2020 G2A, 2020 G4, and 2020 G4A Reports were the first reports due by the PC. He requests a waiver of the fine.

- The 2020 G4A Original Report covers the period from 10/03/20-10/09/20; it was due on 10/16/20.
- The 2020 G4A Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created and filed on 10/21/20.
- Black Jax PAC, Inc. reported receiving 1 contribution while making zero expenditures.
- The Division of Elections does not have any notes that pertain to Black Jax PAC, Inc.'s 2020 G4A report.

I am writing with regard to fines assessed on the Black JAX PAC (BJP). And, to explain mitigating circumstances associated with these fines.

The three fines assessed on the BJP are as follows. The fines cover report periods September 5-October 9, 2020 and report deadlines of September 18, October 9 and 16, respectively. The fines are substantial and represent a substantial portion of the funds raises.

Report: 2020 - G2A, \$375.00 Report: 2020 - G4, \$1,150.00 Report: 2020 - G4A, \$125.00

As way of background, this BJP was established by a group of 13 individuals who are dedicated to improving the overall wellbeing of Jacksonville's underprivileged and underserved communities. The BJP became an official political action committee and was given EFS access on September 15, 2020. The Division of Election acceptance letter, received by BJP on September 18, 2020, instructed the committee to begin the first campaign treasurer's report on September 18, 2020.

Please be aware that this lack of timely action on part of the BJP was in no way designed to circumvent reporting requirements, but was solely due to reporting requirements early on in the establishment of the BJP and our understanding of the EFS. These were among the first reports filed with contribution and expense details. In studying the handbook, receiving technical support from the help desk and spending hours on the EFS; it is a difficult system to master which requires experience and practice.

Our request is that you consider these circumstances and waive the fines on this new PAC.

The BJP has gained a great deal of knowledge about the EFS in the past several weeks. The BJP is up-to-date on its filings and all future actions will be consistent with policies and regulations as stated in the Political Committee handbook. Your consideration in this matter is greatly appreciated.

Dear Mr. Mann:

Our records indicate that you have not filed either your campaign treasurer's report or notification that no reportable activity occurred, whichever is applicable. The filing date was October 16, 2020.

The law (s. 106.07(8)(b), Fla. Stat.) requires the filing officer to immediately notify you about the missed filing date and the automatic fines that will be assessed for late filing of a report, if a report was due.

 If reportable activity occurred and you have not filed a report, statutory fines are automatically assessed as follows until you file your report:

\$50 per day for the first 3 days late \$500 per day for each day after the 3rd day late If the required report immediately precedes a primary and general election, the automatic fine is \$500 for each late day.

The total fine for the untimely report cannot exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the cover period. Even if you end up filing your report late, we cannot waive the statutory fines. We will notify you of the specific amount of fines owed once you file your report. You have 20 days from the day you receive the notice to pay the fine or to appeal the fine to the Florida Elections Commission.

• If no reportable activity occurred for the report date(s), you are still required to notify us in writing, via the Division's Electronic Filing System, that no reportable activity occurred. No automatic fines are statutorily assessed.

However, in all cases, failure to file and/or untimely filing of a report of reportable activity, or if applicable, a notice that no reportable activity occurred, may constitute an apparent violation of chapter 106, Fla. Stat. If we refer such matter to the Florida Elections Commission, the Commission may subsequently impose a civil penalty for each violation under chapter 106.265(1), Fla. Stat.

All reports must be completed and filed through the EFS no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the

due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date is subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first three days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the chairperson and campaign treasurer, and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.

An online instruction guide is available to you on the EFS to assist with navigation, data entry, and submission of reports. The Division of Elections will also provide assistance to all users by contacting the EFS Help Desk at (850) 245-6280.
