#### ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE

THIS MATTER was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting on November 19, 2019, in Tallahassee, Florida.

On September 30, 2019, Staff recommended to the Commission that there was probable cause to believe that the Florida Election Code was violated. The facts articulated in Staff's Recommendation are adopted by reference and incorporated herein. Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following violation(s):

#### Count 1:

On or about October 27, 2018, Sunshine State Heritage Political Action Committee Corporation violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2018 D1 Report.

#### Count 2:

On or about October 28, 2018, Sunshine State Heritage Political Action Committee Corporation violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2018 D2 Report.

#### Count 3:

On or about October 29, 2018, Sunshine State Heritage Political Action Committee Corporation violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2018 D3 Report.

#### Count 4:

On or about October 30, 2018, Sunshine State Heritage Political Action Committee Corporation violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2018 D4 Report.

#### Count 5:

On or about October 31, 2018, Sunshine State Heritage Political Action Committee Corporation violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2018 D5 Report.

#### Count 6:

On or about November 1, 2018, Sunshine State Heritage Political Action Committee Corporation violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2018 D6 Report.

## **NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING**

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by <u>consent order</u> where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s) and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

Second, you may request an <u>informal hearing</u> held before the Commission, if you <u>do not</u> dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to make written or oral arguments to the Commission concerning the legal issues related to the violation(s) and the potential fine. At the request of Respondent, the Commission will consider and determine willfulness at an informal hearing. Otherwise, live witness testimony is unnecessary.

Third, you may request a <u>formal hearing</u> held before an administrative law judge in the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH), if you dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 *minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing*. The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Sections 106.07(7)**, and **106.19(1)(c)**, **Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on July 10, 2019, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

1. On February 11, 2019, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a referral from the Department of State, Division of Elections ("Division" or "Complainant"), alleging that Sunshine State Heritage Political Action Committee Corporation ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

2. Respondent is a political committee registered with the Division. (ROI Exhibit 1)<sup>1</sup>

3. By letter dated April 4, 2019, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provisions:

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent, a political committee registered with the Division of Elections, failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because it had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the following reporting periods:

- 2018 D1
- 2018 D2
- 2018 D3
- 2018 D4
- 2018 D5
- 2018 D6
- 2018 G7

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent, a political committee registered with the Division of Elections, may have falsely reported or deliberately

failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, during the following reporting periods:

- 2018 D1
- 2018 D2
- 2018 D3
- 2018 D4
- 2018 D5
- 2018 D6
- 2018 G7

4. By letter dated March 8, 2016, Kristi Reid Bronson, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, sent Respondent a letter acknowledging that the Division had received its Statement of Organization and Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Political Committees forms. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 1)

5. The acknowledgment letter advised Respondent that all political committees filing reports with the Division are required to use the electronic filing system ("EFS"), and provided Respondent with a user identification number and initial password to grant access to the EFS. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 1) The letter further advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms were available on its website and directed Respondent to print out the *Calendar* of *Reporting Dates* as well as other relevant documents. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 3)

6. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by failing to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting dates that no reports would be filed or by falsely reporting or deliberately failing to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, during the following reporting periods: 2018 D1, 2018 D2, 2018 D3, 2018 D4, 2018 D5, 2018 D6, and 2018 G7. See Compl.

7. Respondent's 2018 D1, 2018 D2, 2018 D3, 2018 D4, 2018 D5, 2018 D6, and 2018 G7 reports were due to be filed by October 27, 2018, October 28, 2018, October 29, 2018, October 30, 2018, October 31, 2018, November 1, 2018, and November 2, 2018, respectively; however, Respondent failed to timely file the reports or notify the filing officer that no reports would be filed. The Division sent 21 letters to Respondent notifying the committee that its reports had not been received. The letters also notified Respondent that it was still required to notify the Division if the committee had no reportable financial activity. (ROI Exhibits 3-11) The letters sent by certified mail were confirmed delivered. (ROI Exhibit 11, page 8)

8. A subpoena was issued to Respondent's designated campaign depository to ascertain whether any financial activity occurred during the relevant reporting periods, i.e., October 20, 2018 – October 26, 2018, October 27, 2018, October 28, 2018, October 29, 2018, October 30, 2018, October 31, 2018, and October 20, 2018 – November 1, 2018.<sup>2</sup> Respondent's bank records do not show any reportable financial activity for the 2018 D1, 2018 D2, 2018 D3,

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Political committees are required to disclose contributions in the daily "D" reports, however, expenditures are not required to be reported. If a committee does not report expenditures in the daily reports, then they must be reported during the 2018 G7 Report which covers the period of October 20, 2018 – November 1, 2018.

2018 D4, 2018 D5, and 2018 D6 reporting periods. (ROI Exhibit 12, page 4) Respondent's bank records show one expenditure in the amount of \$14 that was authorized or occurred during the 2018 G7 reporting period but was not disclosed. (ROI Exhibit 12; *See* ROI, p.4, n.3)

9. As it appears that Respondent had no financial activity during the 2018 D1, 2018 D2, 2018 D3, 2018 D4, 2018 D5, and 2018 D6 reporting periods, Respondent was required to notify the filing officer in writing that it would not be filing its 2018 D1, 2018 D2, 2018 D3, 2018 D4, 2018 D5, and 2018 D6 reports on the prescribed reporting dates, but failed to do so. As it appears that Respondent had financial activity during the 2018 G7 reporting period, Respondent deliberately failed to include information in its 2018 G7 Report in violation of Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes.

10. On February 8, 2019, Respondent submitted notices of no activity for the relevant reporting periods, including the reporting period where there was reportable financial activity. The notifications were between 99 and 104 days late. (*See* ROI, p. 3, Table 1)

11. David M. Nash, chairperson for Respondent, stated that he did not realize that he had to file notifications of no activity for the election if the committee was not participating in it. (Attachment A) It should be noted that the committee has been in existence since March of 2016 and has previously filed notifications of no activity during the 2016 election cycle.

12. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. Schmitt v. State, 590 So. 2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).

13. The facts set forth above show that Respondent is a political committee registered with the Division. Respondent failed to timely file its 2018 D1, 2018 D2, 2018 D3, 2018 D4, 2018 D5, 2018 D6, and 2018 G7 reports or notify the filing officer that no reports would be filed. It appears that Respondent had no reportable financial activity during the 2018 D1, 2018 D2, 2018 D3, 2018 D4, 2018 D5, and 2018 D6 reporting periods, and therefore, was required to notify the filing officer in writing that it would not be filing its 2018 D1, 2018 D2, 2018 D3, 2018 D4, 2018 D5, and 2018 D6 reports or the prescribed reporting dates, but failed to do so. It appears that Respondent deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the committee's 2018 G7 Report.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating the following:

#### Count 1:

On or about October 27, 2018, Sunshine State Heritage Political Action Committee Corporation violated Section 106.07(7), Florida

Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2018 D1 Report.

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#### Count 2:

On or about October 28, 2018, Sunshine State Heritage Political Action Committee Corporation violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2018 D2 Report.

#### Count 3:

On or about October 29, 2018, Sunshine State Heritage Political Action Committee Corporation violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2018 D3 Report.

#### Count 4:

On or about October 30, 2018, Sunshine State Heritage Political Action Committee Corporation violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2018 D4 Report.

#### Count 5:

On or about October 31, 2018, Sunshine State Heritage Political Action Committee Corporation violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2018 D5 Report.

#### Count 6:

On or about November 1, 2018, Sunshine State Heritage Political Action Committee Corporation violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2018 D6 Report.

## Count 7:

On or about November 2, 2018, Sunshine State Heritage Political Action Committee Corporation violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when it deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the committee's 2018 G7 Report.

**Complainant:** Division of Elections

Pursuant to Section 106.25(2), Florida Statutes, on February 11, 2019, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received information from the Division of Elections ("Division") that Respondent violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. Commission staff, therefore, investigated whether Respondent violated the following statutes:

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, failure of a political committee that did not receive any contributions or make any expenditures during a reporting period to notify timely the filing officer, in writing, that no report was being filed; and

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, prohibiting a person or organization from falsely reporting or deliberately failing to report information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.


## I. Preliminary Information:

- 1. Respondent is a political committee registered with the Division.
- 2. Complainant is the Division of Elections ("Division").
- 3. Respondent's filing officer is Kristi Willis, Chief, Bureau of Election Records.

## II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes:

4. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by not notifying the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because the political committee had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the following reporting periods: 2018 D1, 2018 D2, 2018 D3, 2018 D4, 2018 D5, 2018 D6, and 2018 G7.

5. On February 25, 2016, David M. Nash filed the Statement of Organization of Political Committee (DS-DE 5 form) and the Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Political Committees (DS-DE 6 form), indicating he was the chairperson. He named Laura Nash as treasurer. To review the DS-DE 5 and DS-DE 6 forms, refer to Exhibit 1.



7. The 2018 D1 campaign treasurer's report was due on October 27, 2018. On October 29, 2018, the Division mailed Respondent notification that the 2018 D1 campaign treasurer's report had not been filed. To review a copy of the October 29, 2018 notification regarding the 2018 D1 campaign treasurer's report, refer to Exhibit 3.

8. The 2018 D2 campaign treasurer's report was due on October 28, 2018. On October 29, 2018, the Division mailed Respondent notification that the 2018 D2 campaign treasurer's report had not been filed. To review a copy of the October 29, 2018 notification regarding the 2018 D2 campaign treasurer's report, refer to Exhibit 4.

9. The 2018 D3 campaign treasurer's report was due on October 29, 2018. On October 30, 2018, the Division mailed Respondent notification that the 2018 D3 campaign treasurer's report had not been filed. To review a copy of the October 30, 2018 notification regarding the 2018 D3 campaign treasurer's report, refer to Exhibit 5.

10. The 2018 D4 campaign treasurer's report was due on October 30, 2018. On October 31, 2018, the Division mailed Respondent notification that the 2018 D4 campaign treasurer's report had not been filed. To review a copy of the October 31, 2018 notification regarding the 2018 D4 campaign treasurer's report, refer to Exhibit 6.

11. The 2018 D5 campaign treasurer's report was due on October 31, 2018. On November 1, 2018, the Division mailed Respondent notification that the 2018 D5 campaign treasurer's report had not been filed. To review a copy of the November 1, 2018 notification regarding the 2018 D5 campaign treasurer's report, refer to Exhibit 7.

12. The 2018 D6 campaign treasurer's report was due on November 1, 2018. On November 2, 2018, the Division mailed Respondent notification that the 2018 D6 campaign treasurer's report had not been filed. To review a copy of the November 2, 2018 notification regarding the 2018 D6 campaign treasurer's report, refer to Exhibit 8.

13. The 2018 G7 campaign treasurer's report was due on November 2, 2018. On November 3, 2018, the Division mailed Respondent notification that the 2018 G7 campaign treasurer's report had not been filed. To review a copy of the November 3, 2018 notification regarding the 2018 G7 campaign treasurer's report, refer to Exhibit 9.

14. On November 19, 2018, the Division mailed Respondent second notifications that the 2018 D1, 2018 D2, 2018 D3, 2018 D4, 2018 D5, 2018 D6, and 2018 G7 campaign treasurer's reports had not been filed. To review the November 19, 2018 second notifications, refer to Exhibit 10.

15. On December 10, 2018, the Division mailed Respondent final notification with delivery confirmation that the 2018 D1, 2018 D2, 2018 D3, 2018 D4, 2018 D5, 2018 D6, and 2018 G7 campaign treasurer's reports had not been filed. To review the December 10, 2018 final



notification with delivery confirmation, refer to Exhibit 11.

16. Respondent's filing history indicates that all seven notices-of-no-activity were filed on February 8, 2019, as indicated in Table 1 below.

17. On May 2, 2019, Respondent's bank account records were received as a result of a subpoena to Wells Fargo Bank, Respondent's primary depository listed on the most recent DS-DE 5 and 6 forms filed on February 25, 2016; Exhibit 1. Records indicate that Respondent did not have reportable financial activity during the 2018 D1, 2018 D2, 2018 D3, 2018 D4, 2018 D5 and 2018 D6<sup>1</sup> reporting periods. To review Respondent's bank account records, refer to Exhibit 12.

18. Respondent's bank account records revealed that Respondent had one reportable expenditure that fell within the report cover period for the 2018 G7 reporting period<sup>2</sup>, therefore, a notice-of-no-activity was not appropriate, and a campaign treasurer's report was required to be filed; Exhibit 12.

## III. Alleged Violation of Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes:

19. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by falsely reporting of deliberately failing to include information in one or more campaign reports.

20. As previously discussed in paragraph 16 and Table 1, Respondent filed notices-ofno-activity for the 2018 D1, 2018 D2, 2018 D3, 2018 D4, 2018 D5, 2018 D6, and 2018 G7 reporting periods.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> The 2018 D1 through D6 campaign treasurer's reports need only contain information on all previously unreported contributions received as of the preceding day; however, expenditures can be reported if desired. If expenditures have already been reported during the daily reports, they are not to be duplicated in 2018 G7 campaign treasurer's report.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Respondent had one expenditure on October 31, 2018. Since Respondent did not report this expenditure on the daily report (2018 D6), he was required to report it in the 2018 G7 campaign treasurer's report.



21. As previously discussed in paragraph 18, Respondent's bank account records revealed that there was reportable financial activity that fell within the 2018 G7 reporting period, therefore, a notice-of-no-activity was inappropriate, and a campaign treasurer's report should have been filed.

22. Respondent's bank account records indicate a monthly service fee of \$14.00 was withdrawn from the account on October 31, 2018<sup>3</sup>; Exhibit 12. As noted in footnote 2, Respondent did not report the expenditure in the 2018 D6 daily campaign treasurer's report, thus, it should have been reported in the 2018 G7 campaign treasurer's report.

23. Respondent has had many cases in front of the Florida Elections Commission, as indicated in Table 2 below.

Therefore, please print a copy of the following documents: Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, *Political Committee Handbook, Calendar of Reporting Dates*, and Rule 1S-2.017, Florida Administrative Code; Exhibit 2.

#### Pin Numbers

When you enter the campaign account screen, there will be a drop down box where you pick a question (such as *What is your mother's maiden name?*) and supply an answer. All passwords and answers to questions are stored as encrypted data and cannot be viewed by Division staff and given out over the phone. Please notify the Division if your credentials have been compromised.


#### **Timely Filing**


All reports must be completed and filed through the EFS no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date is subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

#### Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the chairperson and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.





#### Instructions and Assistance

An online instruction guide is available to you on the EFS to assist with navigation, data entry, and submission of reports. The Division of Elections will also provide assistance to all users by contacting the EFS Help Desk at (850) 245-6280.

It is your responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws.
