He also notes that the organization was transitioning due to the death of its former President and the retirement of the previous office manager. During the transition, they had to switch bank accounts and plan their first annual meeting without the former staff members.

- The 2022 P1 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created and filed on 06/28/22.
- Florida Beer Wholesalers Political Committee reported receiving zero contributions, while making 1 expenditure.

On September 14, 2022 we received a letter from the Division of Elections notifying us of a \$250 fine for the **Florida Beer Wholesalers Political Committee**. I am writing this letter of appeal on behalf of the Political Committee as President of the Florida Beer Wholesalers Association.

This fine is in reference to our June 24, 2022 campaign treasurer's report, which was not filed until June 28, 2022. While the report was filed late, our office manager, Jordan Wheeler, who files the reports, made an honest mistake. At the time of this filing, we were in a major transition mode in our organization. Our longtime President, Mitch Rubin, had passed away from a long battle with cancer. Our longtime office manager, Jan Sykes, had retired, and we were in the middle of planning our first Annual Meeting (held that first week of June) without Mr. Rubin or Ms. Sykes. On top of that, we had to switch our bank accounts from SunTrust/Truist to Hancock Bank because of the many issues we were having trying to transition the accounts after Mr. Rubin's death. Because of these circumstances, Ms. Wheeler made an honest mistake. She believed that when she entered the information into our Campaign Toolbox software, it had sent the report properly. Ms. Wheeler did not know she had to go one step further for the report to actually be delivered. She has since learned the full process of filing a campaign report and, as you can see, we have had no issues since June 28th, when this report was due.

We ask that you please eliminate the fine as a first offense misunderstanding, and we assure you, this will not happen again. If you need any further information, please do not hesitate to contact me directly.

Dear Mr. Daley:

Our records indicate that you have not filed either your campaign treasurer's report or notification that no reportable activity occurred, whichever is applicable. The filing date was June 24, 2022.

The law (s. 106.07(8)(b), Fla. Stat.) requires the filing officer to immediately notify you about the missed filing date and the automatic fines that will be assessed for late filing of a report, if a report was due.

- If reportable activity occurred and you have not filed a report, statutory fines are automatically assessed as follows until you file your report:

\$50 per day for the first 3 days late

\$500 per day for each day after the 3rd day late

If the required report immediately precedes a primary and general election, the automatic fine is \$500 for each late day.

The total fine for the untimely report cannot exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the cover period. Even if you end up filing your report late, we cannot waive the statutory fines. We will notify you of the specific amount of fines owed once you file your report. You have 20 days from the day you receive the notice to pay the fine or to appeal the fine to the Florida Elections Commission.

- If no reportable activity occurred for the report date(s), you are still required to notify us in writing, via the Division's Electronic Filing System, that no reportable activity occurred. No automatic fines are statutorily assessed.

However, in all cases, failure to file and/or untimely filing of a report of reportable activity, or if applicable, a notice that no reportable activity occurred, may constitute an apparent violation of chapter 106, Fla. Stat. If we refer such matter to the Florida Elections Commission, the Commission may subsequently impose a civil penalty for each violation under chapter 106.265(1), Fla. Stat.

Pin Numbers

Pin numbers are confidential secure credentials that allow you to submit reports and update information. The enclosed sealed envelope provides a confidential pin number for the chairperson. By copy of this letter, a confidential pin number to access the EFS was sent to the treasurer.

Each political committee chairperson is required to provide the Division of Elections with confidential personal information that may be used to allow access in the event that the password is forgotten or lost. When you enter the campaign account screen, there will be a drop down box where you pick a question (such as *What is your mother's maiden name?*) and supply an answer. All passwords and answers to questions are stored as encrypted data and cannot be viewed by Division staff and given out over the phone. Please notify the Division if your credentials have been compromised.

Timely Filing

All reports must be completed and filed through the EFS no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date is subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the chairperson and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.
