Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

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**CONSENT FINAL ORDER**

Respondent, Brevard Parents Action Committee, and the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) agree that this Consent Order resolves all of the issues between the parties in this case. The parties jointly stipulate to the following facts, conclusions of law, and order.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On April 25, 2017, a complaint was filed with the Commission alleging that Respondent violated Florida's election laws.
2. On December 15, 2017, the Commission entered an Order of Probable Cause finding there was probable cause to charge Respondent with five counts of violating Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes.
3. Respondent has expressed a desire to enter into negotiations directed toward reaching a consent agreement.

4. Respondent and staff stipulate to the following facts:
  - a. Respondent is a political committee registered with the Brevard County Supervisor of Elections.
  - b. Respondent failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because it had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the 2016 M2, 2016 G5, 2017 M1, 2017 M2, and 2017 M3 reporting periods.
  - c. On March 11, 2016, Respondent filed a notice of no activity for the 2016 M2 reporting period. On October 23, 2016, Respondent filed a notice of no activity for the 2016 G5 reporting period. On February 11, 2017, Respondent filed a notice of no activity for the 2017 M1 reporting period. On March 19, 2017, Respondent filed a notice of no activity for the 2017 M2 reporting period, and on April 11, 2017, Respondent filed a notice of no activity for the 2017 M3 reporting period.

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

5. The Commission has jurisdiction over the parties to and subject matter of this cause, pursuant to Section 106.26, Florida Statutes.
6. The Commission staff and the Respondent stipulate that staff can prove the facts in paragraph four above by clear and convincing evidence and to the Commission's ability to impose a civil penalty in this case.

#### **ORDER**

7. The Respondent and the staff of the Commission have entered into this Consent Order freely and voluntarily.
8. The Respondent shall bear its own attorney's fees and costs that are in any way associated with this case.
9. The Commission will consider this Consent Order at its next available meeting.

10. Respondent voluntarily waives the right to any further proceedings under Chapters 104, 106, and 120, Florida Statutes, and the right to appeal this Consent Order.

11. This Consent Order is enforceable under Sections 106.265 and 120.69, Florida Statutes. Respondent expressly waives any venue privileges and agrees that if enforcement of this Consent Order is necessary, venue shall be in Leon County, Florida, and Respondent shall pay all fees and costs associated with enforcement.

12. Payment of the civil penalty by cashier's check, or money order, good for at least 120 days, or attorney trust account check, is a condition precedent to the Commission's consideration of this Consent Order.


#### **PENALTY**

**WHEREFORE**, based upon the foregoing facts and conclusions of law, the Commission finds that the Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, on five occasions and imposes a civil penalty in the amount of **\$300**.


Therefore, it is

**ORDERED** that the Respondent shall remit to the Commission a civil penalty in the amount of **\$300**, inclusive of fees and costs. The civil penalty shall be paid cashier's check or money order, good for at least 120 days, or attorney trust account check. The civil penalty shall be payable to the Florida Elections Commission and sent to 107 West Gaines Street, Collins Building, Suite 224, Tallahassee, Florida, 32399-1050.

**Respondent** hereby agrees and consents to the terms of this Consent Order on February 16, 2018.

**ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE**

**THIS MATTER** was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting on November 28, 2017, in Tallahassee, Florida.

On October 13, 2017, Staff recommended to the Commission that there was probable cause to believe that the Florida Election Code was violated. The facts articulated in Staff's Recommendation are adopted by reference and incorporated herein. Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following violation(s):

**Count 1:**

On or about March 10, 2016, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to notify its filing officer in writing on or before March 10, 2016, that Respondent would not be filing a 2016 M2 Report on the prescribed due date.

**Count 2:**

On or about October 21, 2016, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to notify its filing officer in writing on or before October 21, 2016, that Respondent would not be filing a 2016 G5 Report on the prescribed due date.

**Count 3:**

On or about February 10, 2017, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to notify its filing officer in writing on or before February 10, 2017, that Respondent would not be filing a 2017 M1 Report on the prescribed due date.

**Count 4:**

On or about March 10, 2017, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to notify its filing officer in writing on or before March 10, 2017, that Respondent would not be filing a 2017 M2 Report on the prescribed due date.

**Count 5:**

On or about April 10, 2017, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to notify its filing officer in writing on or before April 10, 2017, that Respondent would not be filing a 2017 M3 Report on the prescribed due date.

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by consent order where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s) and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

Second, you may request an informal hearing held before the Commission, if you do not dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to make written or oral arguments to the Commission concerning the legal issues related to the violation(s) and the potential fine. At the request of Respondent, the Commission will consider and determine willfulness at an informal hearing. Otherwise, live witness testimony is unnecessary.

Third, you may request a formal hearing held before an administrative law judge in the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH), if you dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to present evidence relevant to the violation(s) listed in this order, to cross-examine opposing witnesses, to impeach any witness, and to rebut the evidence presented against you.

If you do not elect to resolve the case by consent order or request a formal hearing at the DOAH or an informal hearing before the Commission within 30 days of the date this Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission, the case will be sent to the Commission for a formal or informal hearing, depending on whether the facts are in dispute. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION**

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the complaint in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on September 29, 2017, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation.

1. On April 25, 2017, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a complaint from Lori Scott, the Brevard County Supervisor of Elections ("BCSOE"), alleging that Brevard Parents Action Committee ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

2. Respondent is a political committee registered with the Brevard County Supervisor of Elections. Respondent's initial Statement of Organization of Political Committee form ("DS-DE 5"), Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Political Committees form ("DS-DE 6"), and Registered Agent Statement of Appointment form ("DS-DE 41") were filed with the BCSOE on February 11, 2013. Respondent's February 11, 2013 filings identified David Rees as its chairman, Toby Napier as its treasurer, and Margaret Goudelock as its registered agent.<sup>1</sup> (ROI Exhibit 6; and Attachment A)<sup>2</sup>

3. On February 27, 2013, Respondent filed a second DS-DE 6 appointing Vida Escue as its treasurer. (ROI Exhibit 1)

4. On August 6, 2013, Respondent filed an updated DS-DE 5 naming Gregory Cope as its chairman and filed an updated DS-DE 41 appointing Scott Wideman as its registered agent. (Attachments B and C)

5. On February 12, 2013, the BCSOE's office sent an email to Respondent's registered agent informing Respondent that campaign finance reports should be filed electronically through the Campaign Financial Reporting System ("CFRS") and provided Respondent with credentials to access the CFRS. The email included the *2013 Calendar of Reporting Dates, How to File Financial Reports Online PDF* ("Guide"), and *Political Committee Handbook* ("Handbook") published by the Division of Elections. The email also informed Respondent that the documents were available on the BCSOE's website and the Division's website. (Attachment D)

6. On June 14, 2017, the Executive Director sent Respondent notification that Commission staff would investigate the following alleged violations:

**Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes:** As alleged in the complaint, for each of the following reporting periods, Respondent failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because it had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the reporting periods:

- 2016 M2
- 2016 G5
- 2017 M1
- 2017 M2
- 2017 M3

7. Page 26 of the Handbook states:

When there has been no reportable activity in the campaign account during a reporting period (no funds expended or received) the filing of the report is waived. The political committee shall notify the filing officer in writing on or before the prescribed reporting date that no report is being filed on that date.

*(Section 106.07, F.S.)*

(ROI Exhibit 3)

8. Pages 47 and 48 of the Guide explain the steps a political committee should take using the CFRS to notify the BCSOE in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it had no contributions or expenditures during a reporting period. More specifically, the Guide directs the committee to submit a "Waiver of Report" and provides instructions about creating and submitting a waiver electronically. (ROI Exhibit 4)



9. Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, provides:

Notwithstanding any other provisions of this chapter, in any reporting period during which a candidate or political committee has not received funds, made any contributions, or expended any reportable funds, the filing of the required report for that period is waived. However, the next report filed must specify that the report covers the entire period between the last submitted report and the report being filed, and any candidate or political committee not reporting by virtue of this subsection on dates prescribed elsewhere in this chapter **shall notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that no report is being filed on that date.** (Emphasis added)

10. The table below reflects Respondent's untimely written notifications to the Division:

11. Investigator Spore attempted to call Respondent's chairman twice to discuss the case. Investigator Spore left a message each time requesting Respondent's chairman to return her call, which he failed to do. (Attachment E, Phone Log Entries 1 and 2)

12. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. *Schmitt v. State*, 590 So.2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. *Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino*, 667 So.2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1<sup>st</sup> DCA 1995).

<sup>3</sup> On October 4, 2017, Jennifer D'Agostino, the BCSOE Candidate Coordinator, told Investigator Spore that a copy of the reporting schedule is available at the top of the web-page when a committee signs into the CFRS and there is an "alert" informing committees when the next report is due. Additionally, a week before a report is due, the BCSOE sends an email reminder to candidates and committees that a reporting date is coming up. (Attachment E, Phone Log Entry 5)

13. The above facts show that Respondent is a political committee registered with the Brevard County Supervisor of Elections. Respondent's chairman is Gregory Cope and Vida Escue is Respondent's treasurer. Respondent failed to notify its filing officer in writing on the prescribed due date for the 2016 M2, 2016 G5, 2017 M1, 2017 M2, and 2017 M3 Report that it had no reportable activity and would not be filing a report for the applicable reporting period.

Based on the foregoing, I recommend that the Commission find probable cause to charge Respondent with the following violations:

**Count 1:**

On or about March 10, 2016, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when Respondent failed to notify its filing officer in writing on or before March 10, 2016, that Respondent would not be filing a 2016 M2 Report on the prescribed due date.



5. In a telephone interview on September 29, 2017, Jennifer D'Agostino clarified that the handbook to file financial reports and waivers of report is found on their website, and that political committees are directed to read and familiarize themselves with this handbook before filing reports or waiver of reports.

Unless the electronic filing requirements of Section 106.0705, Florida Statutes, apply, reports shall be filed no later than 5 p.m. of the day designated. A report postmarked by the U.S. Postal Service no later than midnight of the day designated is deemed timely filed. A report received by the filing officer within 5 days after the designated due date that was delivered by the U.S. Postal Service is deemed timely filed unless it has a postmark indicating the report was mailed after the designated due date. A certificate of mailing obtained from and dated by the U.S. Postal Service at the time of mailing or a receipt from an established courier company, which bears a date on or before the date on which the report is due, is proof of mailing in a timely manner. Reports filed with the Division through the Electronic Filing System (EFS) are due no later than midnight, Eastern Time, of the due date. (See Chapter 12, Electronic Filing of Campaign Reports.)

(Sections 106.07, 106.0705 and 106.141, F.S.)

### Penalty for Late Filing

Any political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first three days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports due immediately prior to the primary and general elections, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

(Section 106.07(8), F.S.)

### Notice of No Activity

When there has been no reportable activity in the campaign account during a reporting period (no funds expended or received) the filing of the report is waived. The political committee shall notify the filing officer in writing on or before the prescribed reporting date that no report is being filed on that date. The next report filed must specify that the report covers the entire period between the last submitted report and the report being filed.

(Section 106.07, F.S.)

A notice of no activity filed with the Division must be filed electronically using the Division's electronic filing system.

(Section 106.0705, F.S.)

### Special Election Reports

When a special election is called to fill a vacancy in office, all political committees making contributions or expenditures to influence the results of the special election shall file campaign treasurers' reports with the filing officer on the dates set by the Department of State pursuant to Section 100.111, F.S.

When an election is called for an issue to appear on the ballot at a time when no candidates are scheduled to appear on the ballot, all political committees making contributions or expenditures in support of or in opposition to such issue shall file reports on the 18th and 4th days prior to such election.

You must submit a Waiver of Report.

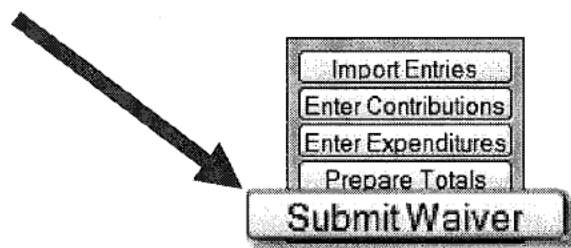

On April 24, 2017, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging that you violated Florida's election laws. I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more **legally sufficient allegations**. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violations:

**Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes:** As alleged in the complaint, for each of the following reporting periods, Respondent failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because it had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the reporting periods:

- 2016 M2
- 2016 G5
- 2017 M1
- 2017 M2
- 2017 M3

When we conclude the investigation, a copy of the Report of Investigation (ROI) will be mailed to you at the above address. Based on the results of the investigation, a staff attorney will make a written recommendation (Staff Recommendation or SR) to the Commission as to whether there is probable cause to charge respondent with violating Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. You will have an opportunity to respond to both the ROI and the SR. The Commission will then hold one or more hearings to determine whether the alleged violations occurred and, if so, the amount




of the fine to be imposed. You and the complainant will receive notice at least 14 days before any hearing at which your case is to be considered.
