According to Dr. Ighodaro, he prepared the report before midnight and was unable to hit send on the "efs.dos website" and claims that the internet would not respond. He requests "consideration based on an unexpected and unavoidable error in transmittal of the prepared report". He notes that he submitted the report approximately two hours after midnight.

- The 2020 P7 Original Report covers the period from 08/01/20-08/13/20; it was due on 08/14/20.
- The 2020 P7 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created and filed on 08/15/20 at approximately 12:50am.
- Dr. Erhabor Ighodaro reported receiving 17 contributions, while making 11 expenditures.
- The Division of Elections does not have any notes that pertain to Dr. Ighodaro's 2020 P7 report.


