If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

SUMMARY: Floridians for Opportunity is a political committee (PC) registered with the State of Florida. The PC's chair is Representative David Santiago, and its treasurer is Randall Woodruff.

The PC is appealing the fine claiming that they did not have electronic credentials to file the report due to the resignation of the Chair. According to Representative Santiago, "There was a several day period between the cancellation of Mr. LaRosa's credentials and my receipt of my credentials." He states they attempted to contact the Division several times but was unable to timely file the report.

- The 2020 D1 Original Report covers the period from 10/17/20-10/23/20; it was due on 10/24/20.
- The 2020 D1 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created on 10/27/20 and filed on 10/30/20.
- Floridians for Opportunity reported receiving zero contributions while making 6 expenditures.
- The Division of Elections has two notes that pertain to Floridians for Opportunity's 2020 D1 report. Entries made on 10/27/20 and 10/28/20 discuss a request for EFS credentials.

I am writing to appeal the late fine assessed to Floridians for Opportunity for the report due October 24, 2020 that was filed October 30, 2020.

On October 21, 2020 a letter was filed with the Florida Division of Elections to file an officer change. Mike LaRosa has taken a position as a member of the Public Service Commission and had to resign as Chairman. I was appointed the new Chairman.

Due to Mr. LaRosa's required resignation, his electronic filing credentials were no longer active, and new electronic filing credentials were mailed to me. There was a several day period between the cancellation of Mr. LaRosa's credentials and my receipt of my credentials. Myself and the committee treasurer made several attempts to reach Florida Division of Elections office and find a solution to the inability to file according to the report filing timelines. We did not received any guidance or additional support with our inability to file timely.

It is based upon these facts that we are requesting an abatement of the \$1650 fine assessed in the attached letter.

Dear Mr. LaRosa:

Our records indicate that you have not filed either your campaign treasurer's report or notification that no reportable activity occurred, whichever is applicable. The filing date was October 24, 2020.

The law (s. 106.07(8)(b), Fla. Stat.) requires the filing officer to immediately notify you about the missed filing date and the automatic fines that will be assessed for late filing of a report, if a report was due.

- If reportable activity occurred and you have not filed a report, statutory fines are automatically assessed as follows until you file your report:

\$50 per day for the first 3 days late

\$500 per day for each day after the 3rd day late

If the required report immediately precedes a primary and general election, the automatic fine is \$500 for each late day.

The total fine for the untimely report cannot exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the cover period. Even if you end up filing your report late, we cannot waive the statutory fines. We will notify you of the specific amount of fines owed once you file your report. You have 20 days from the day you receive the notice to pay the fine or to appeal the fine to the Florida Elections Commission.

- If no reportable activity occurred for the report date(s), you are still required to notify us in writing, via the Division's Electronic Filing System, that no reportable activity occurred. No automatic fines are statutorily assessed.

However, in all cases, failure to file and/or untimely filing of a report of reportable activity, or if applicable, a notice that no reportable activity occurred, may constitute an apparent violation of chapter 106, Fla. Stat. If we refer such matter to the Florida Elections Commission, the Commission may subsequently impose a civil penalty for each violation under chapter 106.265(1), Fla. Stat.



Pin Numbers

Pin numbers are confidential secure credentials that allow you to submit reports and update information. The enclosed sealed envelope provides a confidential pin number for the chairperson. By copy of this letter, a confidential pin number to access the EFS was sent to the treasurer.

Each political committee chairperson is required to provide the Division of Elections with confidential personal information that may be used to allow access in the event that the password is forgotten or lost. When you enter the campaign account screen, there will be a drop down box where you pick a question (such as *What is your mother's maiden name?*) and supply an answer. All passwords and answers to questions are stored as encrypted data and cannot be viewed by Division staff and given out over the phone. Please notify the Division if your credentials have been compromised.

Timely Filing

All reports must be completed and filed through the EFS no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date is subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the chairperson and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.
