STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on September 8, 2015, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

1 On August 4, 2015, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a referral from the Department of State, Division of Elections, alleging that J.A.I.L. 4 Judges ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

2. Respondent is a political committee currently registered with the Division of Elections, and Nancy Grant is listed as the committee's chairperson and registered agent. (ROI Exhibit 1)¹

3. Complainant alleged that Respondent failed to notify its filing officer in writing that no reports would be filed on the applicable reporting date for the following reports: 2015 M4, 2015 M5, and the 2015 M6 Reports.

4. By letter dated September 16, 2015, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provision:

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, for each of the following reporting periods, Respondent failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because it had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the reporting periods:

- 2015 M4
- 2015 M5
- 2015 M6

¹ The Report of Investigation is referred to herein as "ROL."

5. Respondent filed its State of Florida Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Political Committees form ("DS-DE 6"), on April 15, 2013, and appointed Dorothy Carter as its treasurer (ROI Exhibit 1)

6. By letter dated April 16, 2013, the Division acknowledged receipt of Respondent's DS-DE 6 form. The letter provided Respondent with its initial pin number and password to logon to the Division's electronic filing system ("EFS"). (ROI Exhibit 2)

7 Ms Bronson's letter also informed Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms are available on its website. The letter instructed Respondent to print a copy of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, 2013 Calendar of Reporting Dates, and the 2012 Political Committee Handbook Id.

8. The 2012 Political Committee Handbook explained the requirement of filing a waiver-of-report when the political committee has no financial activity to disclose. (ROI Exhibit 3, pages 2 and 4)

9. The *Political Committee EFS User's Guide* explained the process of filing a waiver-of-report using the electronic filing system. Listed on page 13 are specific instructions about checking the box next to "waiver" when there is no financial activity to disclose (ROI Exhibit 4, pages 4-6)

Alleged Violation: Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes

10 In pertinent part, Section 106 07(7), Florida Statutes, state:

[A]ny candidate or political committee not reporting by virtue of this subsection on dates prescribed elsewhere in this chapter shall notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that no report is being filed on that date. (emphasis added)

11. The table below reflects Respondent's untimely written notifications to the Division:

12 During a phone interview with Commission staff on September 21, 2015, Nancy Grant, the committee's chairperson, stated "We weren't doing anything with the committee anyway so I could care less what happens at this point." According to Ms. Grant, "[I] [am] done with this committee and [I] [will] not be returning anything that [is] forwarded to [my] attention." (See Attachment "A")

13. Despite having access to read and/or print Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the 2012 Political Committee Handbook, and the Political Committee EFS Guide Book, Respondent failed to timely notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting dates that no reports would be filed for the 2015 M4, 2015 M5, and the 2015 M6 Reports. (ROI Exhibit 5)

14. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged *Schmitt v State*, 590 So 2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed *Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v Favino*, 667 So 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995)

15 The facts set forth above show that Respondent is a political committee currently registered with the Division of Elections, and Dorothy Carter is the committee's treasurer. During the 2014 election cycle, Ms Carter failed to timely notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting dates that no reports would be filed for the 2015 M4, 2015 M5, and the 2015 M6 Reports

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find probable cause to charge Respondent with violating the following statutory provision:

<u>Count 1:</u>

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On or about May 11, 2015, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because it had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the 2015 M4 Report.

Count 2:

On or about June 10, 2015, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because it had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the 2015 M5 Report.

Count 3:

On or about July 10, 2015, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because it had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the 2015 M6 Report Respectfully submitted on September <u>18</u>th, 2015.

I. Preliminary Information:

1 An appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository (DS-DE 6) was filed on April 15, 2013 (Ex. 1)

2. An acknowledgement letter was mailed to the address provided on Respondent's DS-DE 6 on April 16, 2013 advising Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms are available on their website, including Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the 2012 Political Committee Handbook, and the Calendar of Reporting Dates (Ex. 2)

3. The 2012 Political Committee Handbook, discusses filing a waiver when there is no activity to disclose on page 29 (Ex. 3)

4 Pages 12, 13, 45, and 46 of the *Political Committee EFS User's Guide* discuss how to notify the Division on the prescribed reporting date that no report will be filed using the EFS Specifically, page 13 instructs the user to click the box next to "waiver" if there is no activity to disclose (Ex 4)

5. In a telephone interview on April 2, 2015, Kristi Reid-Bronson clarified that once the waiver box is chosen and a new report is opened as shown on Page 12, the only available option on the report summary screen will be "Go To File Report" as shown on Page 13 Choosing "Go To File Report" will take the user directly to the screens where the chairman/treasurer PINS are entered as shown on Page 45 and 46

II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes:

6. Respondent's filing history reflects the untimely filed notifications summarized below. (Ex 5)







When an election is called for an issue to appear on the ballot at a time when no candidates are scheduled to appear on the ballot, all political committees and committees of continuous existence making contributions or expenditures in support of or in opposition to such issue shall file reports on the 18th and 4th days prior to such election

Committees are to include on the special election campaign treasurer's reports <u>only</u> <u>expenditures related to the special election made by the committee during the special election reporting periods.</u> All contributions received and all expenditures made not related to the special election during the current quarter should be filed on the next quarterly report. Once a committee has participated in the special election and has filed a special election campaign report, all other special election reports remaining must also be filed by the committee, even if there is no further special election activity

On August 4, 2015, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging that you violated Florida's election laws I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more legally sufficient allegations. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violations:

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, for each of the following reporting periods, Respondent failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because it had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the reporting periods:

- 2015 M4
- 2015 M5
- 2015 M6

You may respond to the allegations above by filing a notarized statement providing any information regarding the facts and circumstances surrounding the allegations. Your response will be included as an attachment to the investigator's report

When we conclude the investigation, a copy of the Report of Investigation will be mailed to you at the above address. You may file a response to the report within 14 days from the date the report is mailed to you. Based on the results of the investigation, legal staff will make a written recommendation to the Commission on whether there is probable cause to believe you have violated Chapter 104 or 106, Florida Statutes A copy of the Staff Recommendation will be mailed to you and you may file a response within 14 days from the date the recommendation is

mailed to you Your timely filed response(s) will be considered by the Commission when determining probable cause

The Commission will then hold a hearing to determine whether there is probable cause to believe you have violated Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. You and the complainant will receive a notice of hearing at least 14 days before the hearing. The notice of hearing will indicate the location, date, and time of your hearing. You will have the opportunity to make a brief oral statement to the Commission, but you will not be permitted to testify or call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence.

At any time before a probable cause finding, you may notify us in writing that you want to enter into negotiations directed towards reaching a settlement via consent agreement.

The Report of Investigation, Staff Recommendation, and Notice of Hearing will be mailed to the above address as this letter. Therefore, if your address changes, you must notify this office of your new address. Otherwise, you may not receive these important documents. Failure to receive the documents will not delay the probable cause hearing.

Under section 106.25, Florida Statutes, complaints, Commission investigations, investigative reports, and other documents relating to an alleged violation of Chapters 104 and 106, Florida Statutes, are <u>confidential</u> until the Commission finds probable cause or no probable cause. The confidentiality provision does not apply to the person filing the complaint. However, it does apply to you unless you waive confidentiality in writing. The confidentiality provision does not preclude you from seeking legal counsel. However, if you retain counsel, your attorney must file a notice of appearance with the Commission before any member of the Commission staff can discuss this case with him or her.
