Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 minutes to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 *minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.


If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE

THIS MATTER was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting on August 17, 2016, in Tallahassee, Florida.

Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following violation(s):

Count 1:

On or about February 10, 2015, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because it had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the 2015 M1 Report.

Count 2:

On or about March 10, 2015, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because it had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the 2015 M2 Report.

Count 3:

On or about April 10, 2015, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because it had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the 2015 M3 Report.

Count 4:

On or about December 12, 2015, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because it had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the 2015 M11 Report.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by <u>consent order</u> where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s)s and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

Second, you may request an informal hearing held before the Commission, if you do not dispute

any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to make written or oral arguments to the Commission concerning the legal issues related to the violation(s) and the potential fine. At the request of Respondent, the Commission will consider and determine willfulness at an informal hearing. Otherwise, live witness testimony is unnecessary.

Third, you may request a <u>formal hearing</u> held before an administrative law judge in the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH), if you dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to present evidence relevant to the violation(s) listed in this order, to cross-examine opposing witnesses, to impeach any witness, and to rebut the evidence presented against you.

If you do not elect to resolve the case by consent order or request a formal hearing at the DOAH or an informal hearing before the Commission within 30 days of the date this Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission, the case will be sent to the Commission for a formal or informal hearing, depending on whether the facts are in dispute. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.07(7)**, **Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on May 11, 2016, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

- 1. On January 13, 2016, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a referral from the Department of State, Division of Elections, alleging that Personhood Florida ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
- 2. On July 31, 2009, Respondent registered as a political committee with the Division of Elections; John C. Rogers is listed as the committee's chairperson and Kitti Hataway is listed as the committee's treasurer. (ROI Exhibit 1)¹
- 3. Complainant alleged that Respondent failed to notify the filing officer in writing that no reports would be filed on the applicable reporting date for the following reports: 2015 M1, 2015 M2, 2015 M3, and the 2015 M11 Reports.
- 4. On March 17, 2015, the Executive Director notified Respondent in writing that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provision:

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, for each of the following reporting periods, Respondent failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because he had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the reporting periods:

- 2015 M1
- 2015 M2
- 2015 M3
- 2015 M11

¹ The Report of Investigation is referred to herein as "ROI."

Alleged Violation: Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes

- 5. On August 10, 2009, Respondent filed an appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository (DS-DE 6) and updated it on March 19, 2014. (ROI Exhibit 1)
- 6. On March 21, 2014, an acknowledgement letter to Respondent's Treasurer was mailed to the address provided on Respondent's DS-DE 6 advising Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms are available on their website, including Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the *Political Committee Handbook*, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*; a copy of this letter was also was sent to Respondent's Chairperson. (ROI Exhibit 2)
- 7. Ms. Bronson's letter further advised Respondent to print a copy of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, 2014 Political Committee Handbook, 2013 Calendar of Reporting Dates, and Rule 1S-2.017, Florida Administrative Code. (ROI Exhibit 2)
- 8. The *Political Committee Handbook* explained the requirement of filing a waiver-of-report when there is no financial activity to disclose. (ROI Exhibit 3)
- 9. The *Political Committee EFS User's Guide* explains the process for filing a waiver-of-report using the electronic filing system (EFS). Listed on page 13 are specific instructions about checking the box next to "waiver" when there is no financial activity to disclose. (ROI Exhibit 4)
 - 10. In pertinent part, Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, states:

[A]ny candidate or political committee not reporting by virtue of this subsection on dates prescribed elsewhere in this chapter shall notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that no report is being filed on that date. (emphasis added)

11. The table below reflects Respondent's untimely written notifications to the Division:

12. Respondent did not provide a response to the referral, nor return any phone calls to staff, nor return the Questionnaire-Affidavit. (See ROI, paragraphs 7, 8, and 11)

- 13. Despite having received and/or read Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the *Political Committee Handbook*, *Calendar of Reporting Dates*, *Political Committee EFS User's Guide* and Rule 1S-2.017, Florida Administrative Code, Respondent failed to timely notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting dates that no reports would be filed for the 2015 M1, 2015 M2, 2015 M3, and the 2015 M11 Reports. (ROI Exhibit 5)
- 14. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. Schmitt v. State, 590 So.2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino, 667 So.2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).
- 15. The facts set forth above show that Respondent is a political committee currently registered with the Division of Elections, and John C. Rogers is the committee's chairperson and Kitti Hataway is the committee's treasurer. During 2015, Respondent failed to timely notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting dates that no report would be filed for the 2015 M1, 2015 M2, 2015 M3, and the 2015 M11 Reports.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find probable cause to charge Respondent with violating the following statutory provision:

Count 1:

On or about February 10, 2015, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because he had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the 2015 M1 Report.

Count 2:

On or about March 10, 2015, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because he had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the 2015 M12 Report.

Count 3:

On or about April 10, 2015, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because he had not received funds, made

contributions, or expended reportable funds during the 2015 M3 Report.

Count 4:

On or about December 12, 2015, Respondent violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because he had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the 2015 M11 Report.

I. Preliminary Information:

- 1. An appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository (DS-DE 6) was filed initially on August 10, 2009, and updated on March 19, 2014. (Ex. 1)
- 2. An acknowledgement letter was mailed to the address provided on Respondent's DS-DE 6 on March 21, 2014 advising Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms are available on their website, including Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the *Political Committee Handbook*, and the Calendar of Reporting Dates. (Ex. 2)
- 3. The *Political Committee* Handbook, discusses filing a waiver when there is no activity to disclose on page 18. (Ex. 3)
- 4. Pages 12, 13, 45, and 46 of the *Political Committee EFS User's Guide* discuss how to notify the Division on the prescribed reporting date that no report will be filed using the EFS. Specifically, page 13 instructs the user to click the box next to "waiver" if there is no activity to disclose. (Ex. 4)
- 5. In a telephone interview on April 2, 2015, Kristi Reid-Bronson clarified that once the waiver box is chosen and a new report is opened as shown on Page 12, the only available option on the report summary screen will be "Go To File Report" as shown on Page 13. Choosing "Go To File Report" will take the user directly to the screens where the chairman/ treasurer PINS are entered as shown on Pages 45 and 46.

II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes:

6. Respondent's filing history reflects the untimely filed notifications summarized below. (Ex. 5)

- 7. Respondent did not provide a written response to the referral.
- 8. On April 4, 2016, a questionnaire-affidavit was mailed to Respondent; however, it was not completed and returned.

III. FEC History:

9. Respondent had one prior case before the Commission. FEC 15-066 alleged a possible violation of Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes. The case was heard at the August 2015 Commission meeting. The Commission approved a consent order that included a \$500 fine. The fine was paid on June 22, 2015.

Conclusion:

- 11. I attempted to contact Respondent's treasurer on three occasions by telephone to give her an opportunity to discuss the allegations in the referral. Additionally, an affidavit was mailed to Respondent's chairman on April 4, 2016. As of the date of this report, Respondent's treasurer has not returned my calls, nor has Respondent's chairman returned an affidavit.
- 12. Because Respondent's chairman and treasurer have not contacted the Commission or returned an affidavit, I am unable to ascertain whether they have read Chapter 106, Florida Statutes and/or the Political Committee Handbook.

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Waiver of Report

When there has been no reportable activity in the campaign account during a reporting period (no funds expended or received) the filing of the report may be waived by notifying the filing officer in writing that no activity has occurred. This notification must be made on the prescribed reporting date.

(Section 106.07, F.S.)

All waivers filed with the Division must be filed electronically using the Division's electronic filing system.

(Section 106.0705, F.S.)

Special Election Reports

When a special election is called to fill a vacancy in office, all political committees making contributions or expenditures to influence the results of the special election shall file campaign treasurers' reports with the filing officer on the dates set by the Department of State pursuant to Section 100.111, F.S.

When an election is called for an issue to appear on the ballot at a time when no candidates are scheduled to appear on the ballot, all political committees making contributions or expenditures in support of or in opposition to such issue shall file reports on the 18th and 4th days prior to such election.

Committees are to include on the special election campaign treasurer's reports only expenditures related to the special election made by the committee during the special election reporting periods. All contributions received and all expenditures made not related to the special election during the current quarter should be filled on the next quarterly report. Once a committee has participated in the special election and has filled a special election campaign report, all other special election reports remaining must also be filled by the committee, even if there is no further special election activity.

(Section 106.07(1), F.S.)

Incomplete Reports

Note: The Division's Electronic Filing System will allow a committee to file an incomplete report, however, filing a report that is incomplete means filing a report that is not in compliance with the Florida Statutes.

If a campaign treasurer files a report that is deemed incomplete, he or she will be notified by the filing officer by certified mail, or by another method using a common carrier that provides a proof of delivery as to why the report is incomplete. The campaign treasurer must file an addendum to the incomplete report within seven days of notification. The addendum must include all necessary information to complete the report. Failure to file a complete report after notice constitutes a violation of Chapter 106, F.S.

(Section 106.07(2), F.S.)

Reporting Total Sums

Each campaign treasurer's report required by Chapter 106, F.S., shall contain the total sums of all loans, in-kind contributions, and other receipts, and total sums of all expenditures made during the reporting period. The reporting forms shall be designed to elicit separate totals for in-kind contributions, loans, and other receipts.

(Section 106.07, F.S.)


Reporting Contributions

Each report must contain:

- Full name, address, specific occupation, amount, and date of each person making a contribution. Reports must provide as clear a description as practicable of the principal type of business conducted for corporations contributing. Occupations or principal type of business are not required if the contribution is \$100 or less.
- Name, address, amount, and date of each political committee or organization making any transfer of funds.

Dear Mr. Rodgers:

On January 13, 2016, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging that you violated Florida's election laws. I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more legally sufficient allegations. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violations:

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, for each of the following reporting periods, Respondent failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because it had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the reporting periods:

- 2015 M1
- 2015 M2
- 2015 M3
- 2015 M11

You may respond to the allegations above by filing a notarized statement providing any information regarding the facts and circumstances surrounding the allegations. Your response will be included as an attachment to the investigator's report.

When we conclude the investigation, a copy of the Report of Investigation will be mailed to you at the above address. You may file a response to the report within 14 days from the date the report is mailed to you. Based on the results of the investigation, legal staff will make a written recommendation to the Commission on whether there is probable cause to believe you have violated Chapter 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. A copy of the Staff Recommendation will be mailed to you and you may file a response within 14 days from the date the recommendation is

mailed to you. Your timely filed response(s) will be considered by the Commission when determining probable cause.

The Commission will then hold a hearing to determine whether there is probable cause to believe you have violated Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. You and the complainant will receive a notice of hearing at least 14 days before the hearing. The notice of hearing will indicate the location, date, and time of your hearing. You will have the opportunity to make a brief oral statement to the Commission, but you will not be permitted to testify or call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence.

At any time before a probable cause finding, you may notify us in writing that you want to enter into negotiations directed towards reaching a settlement via consent agreement.

The Report of Investigation, Staff Recommendation, and Notice of Hearing will be mailed to the above address as this letter. Therefore, if your address changes, you must notify this office of your new address. Otherwise, you may not receive these important documents. Failure to receive the documents will not delay the probable cause hearing.

Under section 106.25, Florida Statutes, complaints, Commission investigations, investigative reports, and other documents relating to an alleged violation of Chapters 104 and 106, Florida Statutes, are confidential until the Commission finds probable cause or no probable cause. The confidentiality provision does not apply to the person filing the complaint. However, it does apply to you unless you waive confidentiality in writing. The confidentiality provision does not preclude you from seeking legal counsel. However, if you retain counsel, your attorney must file a notice of appearance with the Commission before any member of the Commission staff can discuss this case with him or her.


