Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

**SUMMARY:** Judge Nancy Maloney is a candidate for Circuit Judge, Circuit 18, Group 23 in the 2020 elections. Edna McDonnell Maloney is her treasurer.

The Honorable Nancy Maloney is appealing the fine claiming she sought assistance from the Division of Election regarding filing the report. According to Judge Maloney, she discussed the circumstances with a representative and thought the matter was resolved. Judge Maloney also submitted a copy of the email she sent to Kristi Reid Willis, Elections Bureau Chief, regarding her receipt of the fine letter. The email states that the late filing was due to her mother, the treasurer, being hospitalized. She notes that she explained everything to a DOE staff member at the time but does not have notes on the conversation. She thought the matter was resolved and was surprised to receive the fine letter. She states that all other reports have been timely filed.

- The 2019 M8 Original Report covers the period from 08/15/19-08/31/19; it was due on 09/10/19.
- The 2019 M8 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created and filed on 09/10/19.
- Judge Nancy Maloney reported receiving 1 contribution, while making zero expenditures.
- FEC staff was advised, "The candidate filed a notice of no activity (waiver) on 09/10/19. A waiver is not a report. On 10/10/19, the candidate filed a report showing \$10,000.00 of activity. The fine is based on 25% of the activity.
- The Division of Elections has one entry dated October 10, 2019 that pertains to Judge Maloney's 2019 M8 report. Judge Maloney contacted DOE to discuss an "unreported contribution" to herself from her campaign. A representative helped her amend the 2019 M8 report to reflect that activity and discussed appealing the fine.

Dear Mrs. Wims,

I telephoned your office at the Florida Elections Cimmission in response to your email with reference to my appeal of the automatically assessed fine of \$2500.00 for the late campaign finance report due on September 10, 2019. I spoke to Ms. Donna at your office today and she was extremely helpful.

I am attaching the May 14, 2020 letter from the Florida Department of State Division of Elections informing me of the automatically assessed fine. I can not explain the long delay in the receipt of the letter. I am working remotely at home 4 days each week, so it is unlikely that I would have missed it. I do know that with the pandemic we at the Moore Justice Center in Viera, FL in the 18th Judicial Circuit only get mail pick up 3 days per week. As near as I can tell I received the letter late in the week (either Friday 5/28/2020 or Saturday 5/29/2020 after the Memorial Day holiday. The letter I received was in very bad condition being severly water damaged. The envelope pretty much disentigrated when I tried to open it, so I dried the letter out over the weekend and opened it Monday morning, June 1, 2020. I was not expecting a letter such as this at this time because I had sought assistance and then offered an explaination at the time of the reporting and I had heard nothing further about it. I am attaching that water marked letter to this email.

I immediately drafted a letter to Ms. Kristi Reid Willis, Chief of Bureau of Election Records in response to this troubling matter. My record for timely filing of my Campaign Treasurer's Report in my 2014 Campaign for Circuit Court was unblemished, and my record for timely filing of my Campaign Treasurer's Report for my 2020 Campaign for Circuit Court was unblemished as well save this one exception. My mother, Edna McDonnell Maloney, welcomed the opportunity in each campaign to serve as my Campaign Treasurer. My mother is 92 years of age.


I am also attaching my email response to Ms. Willis at Bureau of Elections on Monday, June 1, 2020 that outlines my response to her letter and my Notice of Appeal. I ask that that email letter to Ms. Willis and this email letter to you Mrs. Wims, be accepted as my "Notice of Appeal" of the fine.

I am reviewing my records and my reports and also am reviewing the rules referenced in the Florida Administrative Code in Ms. Willis' letter. When I am further along in my investigation, hopefully, I will be able to speak to one of the persons who assisted me in the October filing with reference to the circumstances surrounding it.

In my first review of 2B-1.0055 of the Florida Adminstrative Code, and if memory serves, I do believe I meet the stated critera so hopefully we can resolve this troubling matter with my Notice of Appeal, my appeal and without the imposition of a fine. I will have as much supporting information as I can gather when I file the appeal.

We have spoken before during the course of qualification for the November 2020 election. You and your staff have always been extremely helpful to me and I was greatly appreciative of that. I was seeking a new term as Circuit Judge. In the end with much difficulty, but with your help and the help of your staff, I did meet qualification requirements and have no opposition on the November 2020 ballot.

I received your May 14, 2020 letter just this morning, June 1,2020, referencing an automatically assessed late fine of \$2500.00 for the period of September 2019. As you can see with the water marks your letter, the letter got wet and I was unable to open it for a day or two. It does seem like the letter took a very long time to reach me, but again, I just received it.

I was surprised by the letter, although as I read through, I do remember having a problem one month with the reporting that I fully explained to the person ansering the phone at your office at the time. I will look but I do not think I have my noteson our coversation because it was so long ago, and because I thought the matter was resolved. If my memory is correct I believe the late filling had to do with my mother, and campaign treasurer, both in this election and my previous election November 2014 became hospitalized and I wasn't able to make the report on time. My mother turned 92 years on October 23, 2019. What I do remember is explaining everything to the person I spoke to at Division of Elections at the time of the late filling.

Since I did not hear anything at that time I thought that the matter was taken care of therefore my surprise at this point to receive this. All other reports were made timely.


Please accept this as a request to appeal the fine to the Florida Elections Commission under Rules 2B-1.005 and 2B-1.005 of the Florida Administrative Code.

Candidate called re what she considered an unreported contribuiton from herself to her own campaign. She had spoken to Darryl and Nathan before me.

She stated her depository is located at the same bank as her personal checking and savings. After some discussion she stated that she has learned that the three accounts have separate account numbers. She said she had transferred \$10,000 to the account with the account number for the depository on 8/27/19. (Her M8 was inaccurately filed as a waiver.) She said she did not know that she needed to report that activity as a candidate to self contribution. We discussed the side effects of not having a cleanly different camppaign depository and the problems that can cause. I told her that she needed to make sure this money was deposited into her campaign depository and she stated the bank had recently confirmed that the depository account had received the contribution 8/27/19.

I helped her amend the M8 report to reflect the contribution and she filed it while she was on the phone. I advised that a fine would be issued based on filing the AMD report reporting the activity for the first time a month after the due date. We discussed her options related to appealing the fine to the FEC, requesting a hearing, etc.

She discussed various issues in her life that could be considered as contributing to the late reporting of this activity and I told her the FEC would consider these circumstances if she chose to appeal the fine and make the FEC aware of them. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.
