A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on, November 28, 2017 at 8:30 am, or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard, at the following location: 412 Knott Building, Pat Thomas Committee Room, 404 South Monroe Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399.

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

**If you are the Respondent**, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 minutes to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

**If you are the Complainant**, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

**If you are an Appellant**, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 *minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: Dade County Fire Fighters Local 1403 is a political committee (PC) registered with the State of Florida. The PC's chair is Mr. Omar Blanco and its treasurer is Mr. Paul Blake.

The PC is appealing the fine claiming that it was an unintentional oversight. According to Mr. Blake, "There was an oversight on my part regarding the expenditures to the Senate District-40 and House-116 election, as I thought the expenditure could be reported during our regular reporting cycle for July. I was made aware by the Division of Elections on the 21<sup>st</sup>, towards the end of the day that our report had not been filed. The report that was late was an SP-2. I had to utilize the services of the help desk in order to complete this on the campaign finance online reporting system, the next business day which was Monday the 24<sup>th</sup>. I apologize for not realizing that as a special election, the reporting time-frame changes."

- The 2017 SP2 Report covers the time period from 06/09/17 through 07/20/17.
- The 2017 SP2 Queued-Transactions Report reflects that this report was created on 07/25/17 at approximately 10:07 am, before being filed on 07/25/17 at approximately 10:09 am.
- In an e-mail dated 09/05/17, Ms. Kristi Willis advised commission staff that when a special election has been called, the Division sends out a memo to PCs via the e-mail system, advising that a special election has been called and providing dates and information for filing special election reports. The information is also posted on the Division's website. In addition, the Division also sends out a report reminder to all PCs regarding special election reports, if the PC has provided an e-mail address in order to receive the reminder.
- There is no record of the PC providing an e-mail address.

PRIOR CASES: This PC has been involved with 5 prior appeals of automatic-fines. In FEC 98-124, the Commission upheld the fine of \$3,650.00 and issued a final order. In FEC 98-214, the Commission found unusual circumstances, and the assessed fine was waived in full. In FEC 01-218, the Commission found the PC timely filed the report on the designated due date, and waived the assessed fine. In FEC 04-355, the Commission found the PC timely filed the report on the designated due date, and waived the assessed fine. In FEC 04-398, the Commission upheld and increased the fine from \$2,312.50 to \$2,342.50.

A special election has been called for the office of State Senate, District 40. The special primary election for this race is scheduled for July 25, 2017. The special election for this race is scheduled for September 26, 2017.

When a special election is called to fill a vacancy in office, all political committees, electioneering communication organizations, political parties and affiliated party committees <u>making</u> contributions or expenditures to influence the results of such special election shall file campaign treasurer's reports with the filing officer on the dates set by the Department of State.

Committees or organizations are required to file special election campaign treasurer's reports <u>only</u> if the committee or organization makes a contribution to a special election candidate during the special election reporting periods (see chart on next page) or makes an expenditure to influence the results of the special election.

Please note that activities reported on special election reports are only expenditures that are made to influence the results of the special election. All other activity (e.g., contributions) is reported on the appropriate campaign treasurer's report.

Once a committee or organization has participated in the special election and has filed a special election campaign report, all remaining special election reports must be filed even if there is no further special election activity. If there is no further activity, a waiver must be filed.



MEMORANDUM May 10, 2017 Page Two

All reports must be filed through the Electronic Filing System (EFS) not later than midnight, Eastern Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by this time are late filed and subject to the penalties in Sections 106.07(8) and 106.29, Florida Statutes.

In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight, Eastern Time, of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.
