NOTICE OF HEARING (AUTOMATIC FINE)

A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on May 20, 2015, at 8:30 am, or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard, at the following location: Department of Business and Professional Regulation, 1940 North Monroe Street, Tallahassee FL 32399.

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 minutes to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an en masse vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will not be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 minutes to present your case to the Commission

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider an appeal from an automatic fine, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106 265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing. The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be charged with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1 004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: Miriam Steinberg was a candidate for State Representative, District 64 in the 2014 elections. Michael Steinberg was her treasurer and is representing her as an attorney in this matter.

Michael Steinberg is appealing the fine claiming that the election was unusual; therefore, he does not believe the \$500 fine is appropriate. According to Mr. Steinberg, since a general or primary election did not take place in this race, the fine should be no more than \$50 per day or 25% of the contributions or expenditures for the period reported. Mr. Steinberg also notes that he attempted to file the report on 10/31/14 but had difficulty utilizing the system and was not able to compete the filing until shortly after midnight.

- The 2014 G7 Report covers the period from 10/18/14-10/30/14; it was due on 10/31/14
- The 2014 G7 Queued Transaction Report reflects that the report was created on 10/31/14 at 11:55pm, filed on 11/1/14 at 12:20am and amended the same day at 1:57am
- Miriam Steinberg reported receiving 1 contribution, while making 5 expenditures.
- The Division of Elections does not have any notes of file.

Dear Sirs:

Miriam Steinberg is in receipt of a copy of your letter advising that she will be fined \$500 for filing a late report. Although I am her husband and the campaign treasurer, I am also a licensed Florida attorney and will be representing her in this capacity for the purposes of objecting to the fine.

This election was a little unusual, therefore, I do not believe the \$500 fine is appropriate

Under section 106.07 (8) (b), for reports immediately preceding an election, the fine is \$500 per day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Although the general election was scheduled to take place on November 4, 2014, the State of Florida, First District Court of Appeals, found that an earlier decision by a Circuit Court Judge disqualifying a write-in candidate, was improper, and therefore, the election between the two Republican candidates should have been a closed election to Republicans only, and not an open election to all voters. The decision was made just a few days prior to the election, and there was insufficient time to remove the names of the candidates from the ballot and not to tally the votes, however, the election between the two candidates in this race was a nullity, and since a general election or primary election did not take place in this race, the fine should be no more than \$50 per day or 25% of the contributions or expenditures for the period reported

Notwithstanding the above, the candidate was without fault in filing the report late I, as the treasurer, attempted to file the report on October 31, 2014, but had difficulty utilizing the program provided by the Department of Elections. By the time I was able to determine how to complete and file the report (I had filed other reports, but usually there was a waiver because there were few contributions and expenditures), it was shortly after the midnight deadline on the day that it was due. I was at fault by waiting until the night it was due to file the report and not Miriam

Under these mitigating circumstances, the candidate would request that the fine be waived
