SUMMARY: Win America is a political committee (PC) registered with the State of Florida. The PC's chair is Marlon C. Bruce, and its treasurer is Nicholas A. Lahera.

The PC is appealing the fine and formally requests a hearing. According to Mr. Bruce, the delay in filing was due to a "series of extenuating circumstances" related to their filing officers. He states that the Deputy Treasurer was removed "due to a failure to complete his duties" and notes that the Treasurer was unavailable due to health reasons. Mr. Bruce states that he "filed waivers with the Department of State in order to remain in compliance with required filing deadlines." As soon as he received access to their internal financial records, he amended the report.

- The 2021 M11 Original Report covers the period from 11/01/21-11/30/21; it was due on 12/10/21.
- The 2021 M11 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created and filed on 12/10/21.1
- Win America reported receiving 23 contributions while making 47 expenditures.
- FEC staff was advised, "The committee filed a notice of no activity (waiver) on 01/02/22. A waiver is not a report. On 01/02/22, the committee filed a report showing \$2,237.40 of activity. The fine is based on 25% of the activity."
- The Division of Elections does not have any notes that pertain to Win America's 2021 M11 report.

This letter is being written to appeal the fines levied against Win America (PAC 75929). The fines in question are related to the delayed filing of the M9, M10, and M11 Reports.

On behalf of myself, our Committee Treasurer, and our entire organization, I would like to offer our sincerest apologies for this unintended error. I can only say that this is not our intended modus operandi, but rather the result of a series of extenuating circumstances relating to our filing officers.

On September 16, 2021, our Deputy Treasurer was removed from his position due to a failure to complete his duties. As the officer responsible for accessing and maintaining accurate internal records, this left a vacancy. This unplanned vacancy gave rise to an undue hardship. Unfortunately, at that time, our Treasurer also fell out of communication with the organization as he dealt with an emergent family health crisis.

Understanding the challenges facing our political committee, I made the decision to file waivers with the Department of State in order to remain in compliance with required filing deadlines. I believed this would also serve to prevent the filling of incomplete or false data. I believed this to be a suitable solution in the short term while I was unable to access our records and worked to collect the needed data. I have now come to understand that this action was improper.

As soon as I was able to access our internal financial records, I swiftly moved to amend State Filings so that they would be reported accurately. I also moved to ameliorate the issue of access, by moving all important records and documents to one central internal location and retaining outside support to ensure timely and accurate reporting.

However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the chairperson and campaign treasurer, and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.






