**ORDER GRANTING WITHDRAWAL OF COMPLAINT**

This cause came on to be heard before the Florida Elections Commission (“Commission”) at its meeting held on February 9, 2011, in Tallahassee, Florida.

On November 8, 2010, Joseph Whitehead filed a sworn complaint against the above-named respondent. The complaint alleged that Respondent accepted contributions in excess of the limits prescribed in Section 106.08, Florida Statutes.

In a notarized statement filed on November 24, 2010, Mr. Whitehead requested to withdraw the complaint against Respondent. The Commission has reviewed Complainant’s request and the Executive Director’s Recommendation regarding the disposition of the request to withdraw the complaint. Pursuant to section 106.25(2), Florida Statutes, the Commission finds the Complainant has demonstrated good cause to withdraw his complaint.
