This cause came on to be heard before the Florida Elections Commission (“Commission”) at its meeting held on February 8, 2011, in Tallahassee, Florida.


On July 23, 2010, Craig McCarthy filed a sworn complaint against the above-named respondent. The complaint alleged that Respondent accepted campaign contributions prior to designating a campaign depository and appointing a campaign treasurer.

In a letter dated and notarized on December 9, 2010, Mr. McCarthy requested to withdraw the complaint against Respondent. The Commission has reviewed Complainant’s request and the Executive Director’s Recommendation regarding the disposition of the request to withdraw the complaint. Pursuant to section 106.25(2), Florida Statutes, the Commission finds the Complainant has demonstrated good cause to withdraw his complaint.

Therefore, it is

ORDERED that Complainant’s request to withdraw the complaint is **APPROVED**.
