This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

**If you are the Respondent**, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

**If you are the Complainant**, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

**If you are an Appellant**, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal of an intent to revoke a registration**, of a Political Committee, Electioneering Communications Organization, or a Political Party, the Division of Elections has issued you a notice of intent, citing the reasons for which it intends to cancel your registration. By filing the appeal, you have asked the Commission to recommend that the Division's Notice of Intent be set aside. You are required to explain why you believe your registration should not be cancelled. **SUMMARY:** Gary McManus was a candidate for State Representative, District 15 in the 2024 elections. Gary McManus was his own treasurer.

Gary McManus is appealing the fine, claiming that there was a mix-up with his post office box that prevented the receipt of campaign materials. According to Mr. McManus, he became aware of the issue when a campaign contributor told him their check was returned. Once the issue was corrected, he received letters indicating fines and errors with his campaign reports. He notes that all transactions have been corrected and submissions are current. He requests a waiver of the fine due to the circumstances.

- The 2024 P3 Original Report covers the period from 06/29/24-07/12/24; it was due on 07/19/24.
- The 2024 P3 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created on 07/03/24 and filed on 07/22/24. The report was amended on 07/22/24 and 08/21/24.
- Gary McManus reported receiving 5 contributions, while making zero expenditures.
- The Division of Elections does not have any notes that pertain to Gary McManus' 2024 P3 report.

My key continued to work, but I wasn't receiving any mail. When one of my contributors inform me that their check had been returned to them, I discovered the problem. It took a while for me to fix it because USPS had no way of assigning me the same box number in their system, and that PO Box number has been on all of my campaign materials. Once I got it fixed, I received numerous letters indicating that I was being fined for problems with my campaign reports, I am endeavoring to fix the problems now so they won't be a problem in the future.

As of now, I have fixed all the transactions that were in error and I'm current on my submissions. I am hoping that these fines can be forgiven, and I will stay on top of this in the future.

Our records indicate that you have not filed either your campaign treasurer's report or notification that no reportable activity occurred, whichever is applicable. The filing date was July 19, 2024.

The law (s. 106.07(8)(b), Fla. Stat.) requires the filing officer to immediately notify you about the missed filing date and the automatic fines that will be assessed for late filing of a report, if a report was due.

- If reportable activity occurred and you have not filed a report, statutory fines are automatically assessed as follows until you file your report:
  - \$50 per day for the first 3 days late
