ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE

THIS MATTER was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting on February 7, 2024, in Tallahassee, Florida.

Count 2:

On or about March 10, 2020, Christopher Lloyd Duncan, Jr. violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when he failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that he would not be filing the campaign's 2020 M2 Report.

Count 3:

On or about April 10, 2020, Christopher Lloyd Duncan, Jr. violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when he failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that he would not be filing the campaign's 2020 M3 Report.

Count 4:

On or about May 11, 2020, Christopher Lloyd Duncan, Jr. violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when he failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that he would not be filing the campaign's 2020 M4 Report.

Count 5:

Count 6:

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STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the sworn complaint in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.07(7)**, **Florida Statutes**, and **no probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.19(1)(c)**, **Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on April 21, 2023, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

- 1. On August 24, 2020, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a sworn complaint from Terese Jones ("Complainant"), alleging that Christopher Lloyd Duncan, Jr. ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
- 2. Respondent was a 2020 candidate for Mayor of the City of Palm Bay. Respondent's Statement of Candidate form ("DS-DE 84") was filed on May 29, 2019. (ROI Exhibit 3)¹
- 3. By letter dated April 21, 2021, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provisions:

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent, a 2020 candidate for Mayor of the City of Palm Bay, may have failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because he had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the following reporting periods:

- 2020 M1
- 2020 M2
- 2020 M3
- 2020 M4
- 2020 M5
- 2020 P1
- 2020 TR²

¹ The Report of Investigation is referred to herein as "ROI."

² Commission staff did not investigate any alleged violations regarding the 2020 TR reporting period as the report was due on September 10, 2020, after the date the complaint was filed. (ROI Exhibit 1)

Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent, a 2020 candidate for Mayor of the City of Palm Bay, failed to timely file his 2020 Termination Report reflecting the disposition of all remaining campaign funds.

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent, a 2020 candidate for Mayor of the City of Palm Bay, may have falsely reported or deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, during the following reporting periods:

- 2020 M1
- 2020 M2
- 2020 M3
- 2020 M4
- 2020 M5
- 2020 P1
- 2020 TR
- 4. On May 29, 2019, Respondent's filing officer provided Respondent with Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and a weblink to the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*. (ROI Exhibit 4, pages 1 & 2) On May 29, 2019, Respondent acknowledged that he had been provided access to read the requirements of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. (ROI Exhibit 3)
- 5. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by failing to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting dates that no reports would be filed or by falsely reporting or deliberately failing to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, during the following reporting periods: 2020 M1, 2020 M2, 2020 M3, 2020 M4, 2020 M5, and 2020 P1.
- 6. Respondent's 2020 M1, 2020 M2, 2020 M3, 2020 M4, 2020 M5, and 2020 P1 reports were due to be filed by February 10, 2020, March 10, 2020, April 10, 2020, May 11, 2020, June 10, 2020, and June 19, 2020, respectively; however, Respondent failed to timely file the reports or notify the filing officer that no reports would be filed. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 7) Respondent's filing officer sent a reminder email prior to the due date of each report. (ROI Exhibit 5) Respondent's filing officer sent ten letters and six emails notifying Respondent that his reports had not been received. (ROI Exhibits 6-11)
- 7. A subpoena was issued to Respondent's designated campaign depository to ascertain whether any financial activity occurred during the relevant reporting periods, i.e., January 1, 2020 January 31, 2020, February 1, 2020 February 29, 2020, March 1, 2020 March 31, 2020, April 1, 2020 April 30, 2020, May 1, 2020 May 31, 2020, and June 1, 2020 June 12, 2020. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 7) The financial institution did not have records responsive to the subpoena. (ROI Exhibit 12)
- 8. Respondent was given multiple opportunities to respond to Commission staff's investigation but failed to do so. (ROI, p. 3, ¶¶15-16; ROI Exhibit 13)

- 9. Respondent's filing officer's records indicate that Palm Bay began using an electronic filing system for campaign reports starting with the 2020 M2 reporting period. (ROI Exhibit 14, page 1) The records show four emails to Respondent regarding registering to submit reports electronically. (ROI Exhibit 14) The records also show that the filing officer's office was notified by Respondent that he needed a log-in on or around April 8, 2020. (ROI Exhibit 14, page 4)
- 10. As it appears that Respondent had no financial activity, Respondent was required to notify the filing officer in writing that he would not be filing his 2020 M1, 2020 M2, 2020 M3, 2020 M4, 2020 M5, and 2020 P1 reports on the prescribed reporting dates but failed to do so. Therefore, it does not appear that Respondent falsely reported or deliberately failed to include information in his reports as the reports were waived due to a lack of reportable financial activity. Respondent was not a first-time candidate. (ROI, p.1, ¶1)
- 11. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. *Schmitt v. State*, 590 So. 2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. *Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino*, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).
- 12. The facts set forth above show that Respondent was a 2020 candidate for Mayor of the City of Palm Bay. Respondent failed to timely file his 2020 M1, 2020 M2, 2020 M3, 2020 M4, 2020 M5, and 2020 P1 reports or notify the filing officer that no reports would be filed. It appears that Respondent had no financial activity during the relevant reporting periods, and therefore, was required to notify the filing officer in writing that he would not be filing his reports on the prescribed reporting dates but failed to do so. It does not appear that Respondent falsely reported or deliberately failed to include information in his reports as the reports were waived due to a lack of reportable financial activity.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find no probable cause to charge Respondent with violating Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, and find probable cause to charge Respondent with violating the following:

Count 1:

On or about February 10, 2020, Christopher Lloyd Duncan, Jr. violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when he failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that he would not be filing the campaign's 2020 M1 Report.

Count 2:

On or about March 10, 2020, Christopher Lloyd Duncan, Jr. violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when he failed to notify the

filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that he would not be filing the campaign's 2020 M2 Report.

Count 3:

On or about April 10, 2020, Christopher Lloyd Duncan, Jr. violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when he failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that he would not be filing the campaign's 2020 M3 Report.

Count 4:

On or about May 11, 2020, Christopher Lloyd Duncan, Jr. violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when he failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that he would not be filing the campaign's 2020 M4 Report.

Count 5:

On or about June 10, 2020, Christopher Lloyd Duncan, Jr. violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when he failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that he would not be filing the campaign's 2020 M5 Report.

Count 6:

On or about June 19, 2020, Christopher Lloyd Duncan, Jr. violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when he failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that he would not be filing the campaign's 2020 P1 Report.

Sections 106.07(7) and 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, failure of a candidate or political committee that did not receive any contributions or make any expenditures during a reporting period to notify timely the filing officer, in writing, that no report is being filed or failure to file a campaign report to reflect financial activity.¹

Respondent: Christopher Lloyd Duncan, Jr.

Complainant: Terese Jones, City Clerk of the City of Palm Bay (City Clerk)

Complaint Filed: August 24, 2020

I. Preliminary Information:

1. Respondent was a 2020 candidate for Mayor of the City of Palm Bay; he failed to qualify. Respondent was not a first-time candidate. To review an email from the City Clerk listing candidates who qualified, refer to Exhibit 1.

- 2. An Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository (DS-DE 9) was filed on May 29, 2019. Vanessa M. Scott was appointed as campaign treasurer. On October 23, 2019, a second DS-DE 9 was filed updating Respondent's contact information and mailing address. To review the DS-DE 9s, refer to Exhibit 2.
- 3. Respondent filed a Statement of Candidate with the City Clerk on May 29, 2019, in which he certified he had been provided access to read and understand the requirements of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. To review the Statement of Candidate, refer to Exhibit 3.
- 4. In an affidavit, Terri Lefler, Deputy City Clerk of the City of Palm Bay, asserted that Respondent was provided copies of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and the *Candidate & Campaign Treasurer Handbook* on May 29, 2019. On June 18, 2019, Ms. Lefler emailed Respondent a link to publications available on the Division of Elections website. In a Candidate Information sheet attached to the candidate packet, the reader was reminded to file regular campaign treasurer reports or waivers of report; the sheet included links to various resources such as the *Candidate & Campaign Treasurer Handbook*. To review Ms. Lefler's affidavit and email, refer to Exhibit 4, pages 1-4. To review the Candidate Information sheet, refer to Exhibit 4, pages 5-6. To review the 2020 Calendar of Reporting Dates, refer to Exhibit 4, page 7.
- 5. For each of the following reporting periods, the City Clerk sent reminder emails to Respondent and his campaign treasurer prior to the due dates: 2020 M1, 2020 M2, 2020 M3, 2020 M4, 2020 M5, and 2020 P1. Each reminder email specified the report name, cover period, and due date. To review the email reminders, refer to Exhibit 5.

¹ The letter of legal sufficiency referenced a failure to file the 2020 Termination Report (TR) or waiver of TR and cited Section 106.141(1), F.S., regarding the 2020 TR, but those issues are not covered in this report because the investigation found that the 2020 TR was not due until September 10, 2020, which was after the date the complaint was filed.

- 6. The City Clerk notified Respondent and his campaign treasurer via email that each of the following reports had not been filed: 2020 M1, 2020 M2, 2020 M3, 2020 M4, 2020 M5, and 2020 P1. The emails attached failure to file letters that were also sent via certified mail. To review the failure to file emails, refer to Exhibit 6.
- 7. On February 11, 2020, the City Clerk sent Respondent's campaign treasurer a letter with delivery confirmation to the address specified on Respondent's original DS-DE 9 stating that the 2020 M1 report had not been filed. The letter was confirmed delivered on February 15, 2020. To review the letter and delivery confirmation, refer to Exhibit 7.
- 8. On March 24, 2020, the City Clerk sent Respondent's campaign treasurer letters with delivery confirmation to the address specified on Respondent's original DS-DE 9² stating that the 2020 M1 and 2020 M2 reports had not been filed. The letters were returned to sender unclaimed. To review the letters and delivery envelope, refer to Exhibit 8, pages 1-5.
- 9. On April 13, 2020, the City Clerk sent Respondent's campaign treasurer a letter with delivery confirmation to the address specified on Respondent's original DS-DE 9 stating that the 2020 M2 report had not been filed. The letter was confirmed delivered on April 17, 2020. To review the letter and delivery confirmation, refer to Exhibit 8, pages 6-7.
- 10. On May 12, 2020, the City Clerk sent Respondent's campaign treasurer letters with delivery confirmation to the address specified on Respondent's original DS-DE 9 stating that the 2020 M3 and 2020 M4 reports had not been filed. The letters were confirmed delivered on May 16, 2020. To review the letters and delivery confirmation, refer to Exhibit 9.
- 11. On June 11, 2020, the City Clerk sent Respondent's campaign treasurer letters with delivery confirmation to the address specified on Respondent's original DS-DE 9 stating that the 2020 M4 and 2020 M5 reports had not been filed. The letters were confirmed delivered on June 15, 2020. To review the letters and delivery confirmation, refer to Exhibit 10, pages 1-5.
- 12. On June 24, 2020, the City Clerk sent Respondent's campaign treasurer a letter with delivery confirmation to the address specified on Respondent's original DS-DE 9 stating that the 2020 M5 report had not been filed. The letter was returned to sender unclaimed. To review the letter and delivery envelope, refer to Exhibit 10, pages 6-10.
- 13. On June 22, 2020, the City Clerk sent Respondent's campaign treasurer a letter with delivery confirmation to the addresses specified on Respondent's original DS-DE 9 stating that the 2020 P1 report had not been filed. The letter was returned to sender unclaimed. To review the letter and delivery envelope, refer to Exhibit 11.

II. Alleged Violation of Sections 106.07(7), and 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes:

14. I investigated whether Respondent violated these sections of the election laws either by not notifying the filing officer, in writing, that no report would be filed due to not receiving any contributions or making expenditures during the following reporting period(s) or by not filing campaign report(s) to reflect financial activity for the reporting period(s). To review the 2020 Calendar of Reporting Dates, refer to Exhibit 4, page 7.

² In one of these letters and other failure to file letters sent later, the City Clerk noted that other letters they had sent to the address specified on Respondent's second DS-DE 9 had been returned to sender as not deliverable/unable to forward. 15. Respondent did not respond to the complaint.

16. I attempted to contact Respondent on three occasions for the purpose of providing an opportunity to discuss the allegations made in the complaint. As of the date of this report, neither my telephone calls nor email have been returned. Therefore, I am unable to ascertain whether he has read Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and/or the *Candidate & Campaign Treasurer Handbook*. To review the phone log and email, refer to Exhibit 13.

17. The investigation found that the City Clerk transitioned to electronic filing of campaign treasurer reports in early 2020. The first report for which electronic filing was required was the 2020 M2. In an email dated March 2, 2020, the City Clerk notified candidates, including Respondent and his campaign treasurer that, "This will be the first month that the Campaign Treasurer Reports shall be submitted through the EasyVote electronic filing system (PLEASE NOTE: hard copies shall not be submitted to the City Clerk's Office). [emphasis in original] If you have not already done so, please register on the Easy Campaign Finance Portal." In a previous email about the transition sent on February 24, 2020, the City Clerk noted, "If there are some hiccups along the way, please be patient...we are all new to this process." According to emails, Respondent contacted the City Clerk on April 8, 2020, stating that he needed a log-in for the electronic filing system. On the same date, the City Clerk emailed Respondent and his campaign treasurer instructions on how to register. To review the City Clerk's emails regarding the transition to an electronic filing system, refer to Exhibit 14.

Attached is a candidate packet for the City's municipal primary/general elections.

The first document a person must file to become a candidate is the "Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates" (Form DS-DE 9). This form must be on file with the City Clerk prior to opening the campaign account, receiving contributions, or making expenditures. Designating a campaign depository does not mean physically opening the account; it is merely naming the financial institution in which your campaign funds are to be deposited. A candidate may appoint himself/herself as campaign treasurer or deputy treasurer.

A Candidate for City Council in any election shall be a resident for at least two (2) years immediately preceding the election, shall be a registered voter residing at a city address, and shall qualify for such office by complying with the Florida Statutes and in such manner as may be prescribed by ordinance and shall continue to be a resident and an elector of the city during the term of office.

Each candidate must file a "Statement of Candidate" (Form DS-DE 84) with the City Clerk within ten (10) days after filing the "Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates" stating that the he/she has read and understands the requirements of Chapter 106. Florida Statutes.

In addition to the above forms, each candidate must file the "Affidavit – Residency of Candidate", "Political and Campaign Sign Registration", and "Candidate Biographical Data" form (optional).

All original forms as stated above are required and must be filed with the Office of the City Clerk in order to announce your candidacy. Additional forms will be required only during the qualifying period which begins at noon on June 8, 2020 and ends at noon on June 12, 2020.

Once you establish your account, you must begin filing monthly campaign treasurer's reports on the 10th day following the end of each calendar month, except that if the 10th day occurs on a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, the report shall be filled on the next business day that is not a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday until qualifying. Please refer to the schedule that is


To any candidate that has submitted hardcopy contribution and/or expenditure reports to our office (prior to electronic filing):

We have discovered an issue when candidates are electronically filing their current Campaign Treasurer's Report Summary Form DS-DE 12. The online campaign portal wizard automatically calculates the "Total Monetary

Contributions/Expenditures to Date" totals on the Summary Page, but since all previous campaign reports are not online, the calculations will be incorrect. In the wizard, under Steps 8 and 9 (Contribution Totals and Expenditure Totals, respectively), you will need to check the box next to "Override Total Monetary Contributions/Expenditures to Date". This will allow you to manually input the correct amounts. Below is a screenshot for your use. This should be the only time you have to input manually. The computer should automatically calculate future reports based on the figures from this report.
