**ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE**


**THIS MATTER** was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting held on August 20, 2025, at 1:00 p.m. via Zoom teleconferencing.

On June 25, 2024, Staff recommended to the Commission that there was probable cause to believe that the Florida Election Code was violated. The facts articulated in Staff's Recommendation are adopted by reference and incorporated herein. Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following violation(s):

**Count 1:**

On or about April 7, 2023, Maxwell Herrle violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when he failed to timely file an addendum to the committee's 2023 M1 Report within seven days after receiving notice from the Department of State, Division of Elections, that the report required amendment.

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by consent order where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s) and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

Second, you may request an informal hearing held before the Commission, if you do not dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to make written or oral arguments to the Commission concerning the legal issues related to the violation(s) and the potential fine. At the request of Respondent, the Commission will consider and determine willfulness at an informal hearing. Otherwise, live witness testimony is unnecessary.

Third, you may request a formal hearing held before an administrative law judge in the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH), if you dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to present evidence relevant to the violation(s) listed in this order, to cross-examine opposing witnesses, to impeach any witness, and to rebut the evidence presented against you.

If you do not elect to resolve the case by consent order or request a formal hearing at the DOAH or an informal hearing before the Commission within 30 days of the date this Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission, the case will be sent to the Commission for a formal or informal hearing, depending on whether the facts are in dispute. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order.

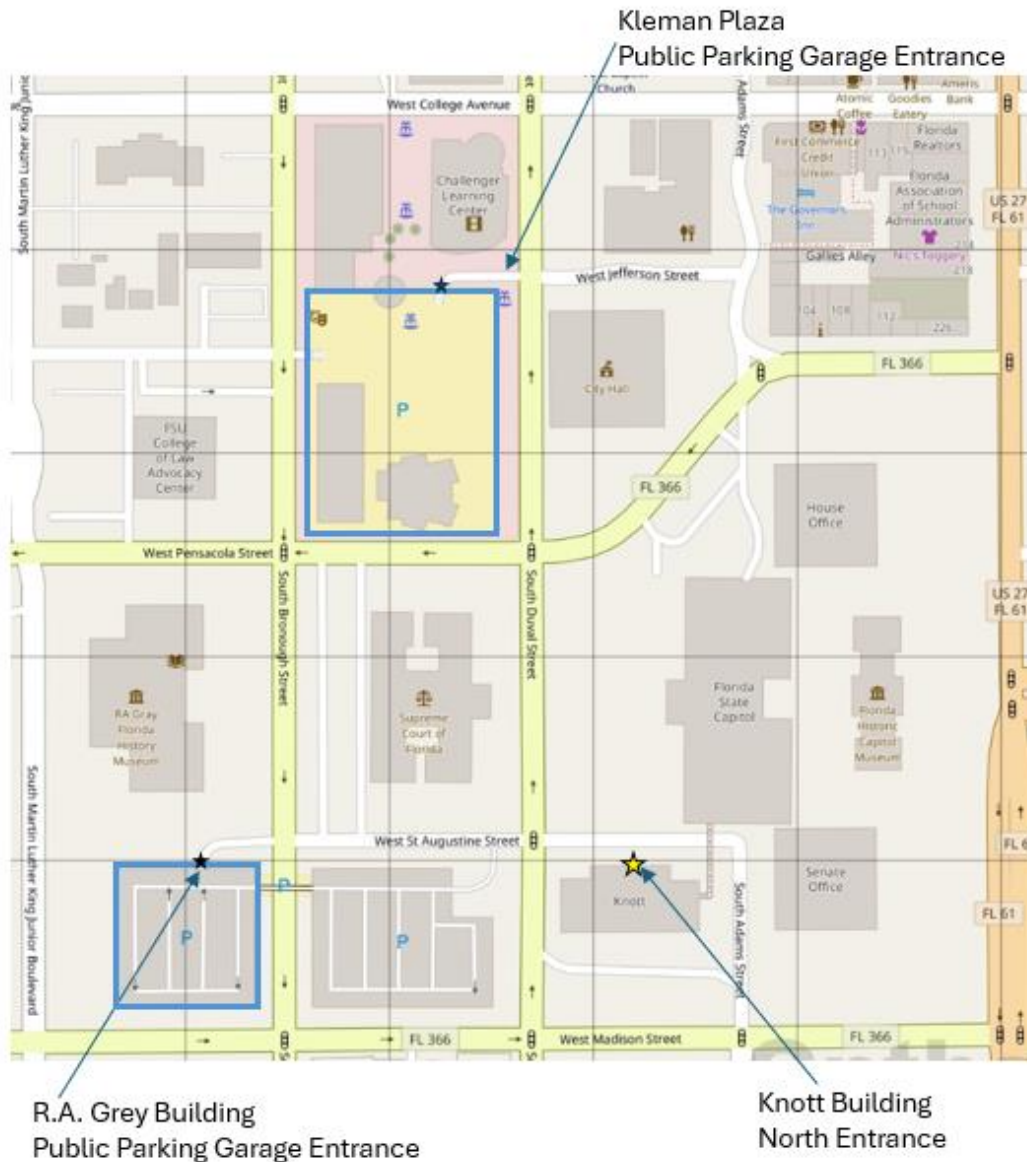

Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION**

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on March 29, 2024, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

1. On July 5, 2023, the Florida Elections Commission (“Commission”) received a referral from the Department of State, Division of Elections (“Division”), alleging that Maxwell Herrle (“Respondent”) violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

2. Respondent is the treasurer for Dude, Where’s My Park?, a political committee registered with the Division. (ROI Exhibit 1)<sup>1</sup>

3. By letter dated March 8, 2024, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provision:

**Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes:** Respondent, treasurer for Dude, Where’s My Park?, a political committee registered with the Division of Elections, failed to timely make necessary amendments to the 2023 M1 campaign treasurer’s report, as alleged in the complaint.

4. On October 7, 2020, the Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Political Committees form (“DS-DE 6”) was filed appointing Respondent as treasurer for the committee. (ROI Exhibit 1)

5. By letter dated October 8, 2020, Kristi Reid Willis, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, sent the committee a letter acknowledging that the Division had received the DS-DE 6 and that the organization was placed on the active committee list. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 1)

6. The acknowledgment letter advised that all committees filing reports with the Division are required to use the electronic filing system (“EFS”) and provided the committee with a user identification number and initial password to grant access to the EFS. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 1) The letter further advised that all the Division’s publications and reporting forms were available

on its website and directed the committee to print out Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*, as well as other relevant documents. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 2)

**Alleged Violation: Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes**

7. The committee's 2023 M1 Report was filed on February 10, 2023. (ROI Exhibit 5, page 6) The report was incomplete when filed. (ROI Exhibit 4, pages 1-2) The report omitted the expenditure purpose for two transactions. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 2; ROI Exhibit 5, page 3)

8. The Division sent three letters regarding the erroneous report. The letters notified Respondent that the committee's report was incomplete and that Respondent was required to amend the report within seven days of receipt of the notifications. An Error Report showing why the report was incomplete was attached to each notification. (ROI Exhibits 3 & 4) The final notification letter was confirmed delivered on March 30, 2023. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 3)

9. As of June 25, 2024, Respondent had not filed the required amendments to the report. (Attachment A)

10. Respondent did not reply to the investigation. (ROI Exhibit 6)

11. Respondent failed to timely amend the committee's 2023 M1 Report within seven days of receiving notification from the Division.

12. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. *Schmitt v. State*, 590 So. 2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. *Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino*, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).

13. The facts set forth above show that Respondent is the treasurer for Dude, Where's My Park?, a political committee registered with the Division. Respondent failed to timely file the required amendment to the committee's 2023 M1 Report within seven days of receiving notification from the Division that the report was incomplete and required amendment.


Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating the following:

**Count 1:**

On or about April 7, 2023, Maxwell Herrle violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when he failed to timely file an addendum to the committee's 2023 M1 Report within seven days after receiving notice from the Department of State, Division of Elections, that the report required amendment.

#### I. Preliminary Information:

1. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by failing to file amended report(s) for the following campaign treasurer report(s) after receiving notice from the filing officer: 2023 M1.

2. An Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository (DS-DE 6) was filed on October 7, 2020. Respondent was appointed as campaign treasurer for Dude, Where's My Park?, a political committee registered with the Division. To review the DS-DE 6, refer to Exhibit 1.

3. On October 8, 2020, the Division sent Respondent a letter acknowledging Respondent's appointment as the campaign treasurer for Dude, Where's My Park?. The letter advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms are available on their website, including Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the *Political Committee Handbook*, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*. The letter further advised that it was Respondent's responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. #### II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(2)(b)(1), Florida Statutes:

4. The Division sent correspondence to the address provided on the DS-DE 6 notifying Respondent that one or more campaign treasurer report(s) were incomplete. The correspondence included error report(s) referencing the following report(s): 2023 M1. To review the correspondence and error report(s), refer to Exhibit 3.

5. On March 23, 2023, the Division sent a letter marked "Final Notice" with delivery confirmation to the address provided on the DS-DE 6 notifying Respondent that one or more campaign treasurer report(s) were incomplete. The letter included an error report referencing the following report(s): 2023 M1. It was confirmed delivered on March 30, 2023. To review the "Final Notice," error report and delivery confirmation, refer to Exhibit 4.

6. As noted above, the "Final Notice" was confirmed delivered on March 30, 2023. The Division filed the referral on July 5, 2023. By filing the referral, the Division affirmed that as of that date, the report(s) at issue had not been amended to correct all errors identified by the Division. To review the report(s) at issue, refer to Exhibit 5.

7. Respondent did not respond to the referral.

8. I attempted to contact Respondent on three occasions for the purpose of providing an opportunity to discuss the allegations made in the referral. As of the date of this report, my telephone calls have not been returned. Therefore, I am unable to ascertain whether Respondent has read Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and/or the *Political Committee Handbook*. To review the phone log, refer to Exhibit 6.

On July 5, 2023, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging that you violated Florida's election laws. I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more **legally sufficient allegations**. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violation:

**Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes:** Respondent, treasurer for Dude. Where's My Park?, a political committee registered with the Division of Elections, failed to timely make necessary amendments to the 2023 M1 campaign treasurer's report, as alleged in the complaint.

When we conclude the investigation, a copy of the Report of Investigation (ROI) will be mailed to you at the above address. Based on the results of the investigation, a staff attorney will prepare and present a written Staff Recommendation (SR) to the Commission as to whether there is probable cause to charge you, the Respondent, with violating Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. You will have an opportunity to respond to both the ROI and the SR. The Commission will then hold one or more hearings to determine whether the alleged violation occurred and, if so, the amount of the fine to be imposed upon you. Notice will be mailed to you and the Complainant at least 14 days before any hearing at which your case is to be considered.

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(i)3., Florida Statutes, the Commission may enter into a consent agreement with a Respondent to settle a complaint prior to a finding of probable cause. If you are interested in entering negotiations directed towards reaching a consent agreement to resolve this matter, please contact the Commission and request to speak with the attorney assigned to this case.

**Please note that all documents related to this matter will be mailed to the above address unless you notify us of a new address.**
