SUMMARY: Gabrielle M. Fox was a candidate for State Representative, District 94 in the 2024 elections. Ms. Fox was her own treasurer.

Gabrielle M. Fox is appealing the fine, claiming that she was unaware that the filing frequency changed. According to Ms. Fox, she called the office on June 21, 2024, the due date, when she received an email reminder stating that she had not filed the report. She claims she was confused; having recently submitted her last report on June 10, 2024, she was not aware that the reporting frequency had changed. Ms. Fox also claims that during her phone conversation, a DOE staff member said she might have received the email by mistake from their system and that she didn't have any pending reports. Upon receipt of a subsequent notice, she contacted the Division and was made aware of the change in reporting.

- The 2024 P1 Original Report covers the period from 06/01/24-06/14/24; it was due on 06/21/24.
- The 2024 P1 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created and filed on 06/28/24.
- Gabrielle M. Fox reported receiving 10 contributions, while making 3 expenditures.
- The Division of Elections does not have any notes that pertain to Gabrielle M. Fox's 2024 P1 report.

This notice is to kindly request the fines assessed in regards to the June 21, 2024 report be removed. The reason for this request is due to the fact that the Division of Elections Office Staff informed me my account was "good to go and up to date" on June 21, 2024 via phone call.

The Florida Division of Elections Office should have a record of the call made on the 21st, as I believe they record calls. I have a screenshot record of the call that lasted 40 minutes, as I was on hold for 15-20 min I believe.

After receiving an email on June 21st, 2024 the due date, reminding me my report had not been filed, I called the office. I was unaware the filing frequency had changed at this point, so I was confused as I had just submitted my last report on June 10, 2024.

When I spoke to the gentleman on the phone, he indicated he would "check on this" and looked up my account. He indicated I had no pending reports, and that I may have received the email in error by their system. He told me not to worry and my account was "good to go".

The next reminder email I received from the efs system was June 28th. I called the office that day as well which is when a female staff member informed me of the change in filing requirement frequency to weekly versus bi-monthly. Dear Ms. Fox:

Our records indicate that you have not filed either your campaign treasurer's report or notification that no reportable activity occurred, whichever is applicable. The filing date was June 21, 2024.

The law (s. 106.07(8)(b), Fla. Stat.) requires the filing officer to immediately notify you about the missed filing date and the automatic fines that will be assessed for late filing of a report, if a report was due.

- If reportable activity occurred and you have not filed a report, statutory fines are automatically assessed as follows until you file your report:
 - \$50 per day for the first 3 days late
 - \$500 per day for each day after the 3rd day late
 - ^o If the required report immediately precedes a primary and general election, the automatic fine is \$500 for each late day.

The total fine for the untimely report cannot exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the cover period. Even if you end up filing your report late, we cannot waive the statutory fines. We will notify you of the specific amount of fines owed once you file your report. You have 20 days from the day you receive the notice to pay the fine or to appeal the fine to the Florida Elections Commission.

• If no reportable activity occurred for the report date(s), you are still required to notify us in writing, via the Division's Electronic Filing System, that no reportable activity occurred. No automatic fines are statutorily assessed.

However, in all cases, failure to file and/or untimely filing of a report of reportable activity, or if applicable, a notice that no reportable activity occurred, may constitute an apparent violation of chapter 106, Fla. Stat. If we refer such matter to the Florida Elections Commission, the Commission may subsequently impose a civil penalty for each violation under chapter 106.265(1), Fla. Stat.

However, for reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the candidate and campaign treasurer, and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5).
