Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 minutes to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 *minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Executive Director Florida Elections Commission August 5, 2025 Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

STAFF MEMORANDUM

This matter is scheduled as an appeal of an automatic fine imposed by the Division of Elections ("Division" or "Filing Officer") against Conservatives For A Better Miami-Dade ("Appellant") following the late filing of the 2024 G6 Report pursuant to Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes.

Appellant is a political committee currently registered with the Division. Appellant's 2024 G6 Report was due on November 1, 2024. On November 1, 2024, Appellant submitted a waiver of the 2024 G6 Report pursuant to Section 106.07(7), Fla. Stat. Three (3) days later, on November 4, 2024, Appellant filed the 2024 G6 Report under Section 106.07(1), Fla. Stat. The report reflected one (1) contribution from another political committee totaling \$1,000.00. Pursuant to Section 106.07(8)(b), Fla. Stat., the Division assessed a fine of \$150.00 based on the number of days late.

The Commission's objective for automatic fine appeals is to determine whether the aggrieved party's report was timely filed and, if not, whether the party demonstrated unusual circumstances—or other circumstances beyond the party's control—that directly caused the report to be late. Florida Administrative Code Rule 2B-1.005(3); § 106.07(8)(c), Fla. Stat.; *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook* (2022), page 74. Unusual circumstances are rare or sudden events that directly prevented the party from timely filing. Fla. Admin. Code R. 2B-1.0055(1). Examples of unusual circumstances include natural disasters and emergencies; death, illness, disability, or necessary surgery of the candidate, treasurer, or immediate family thereof; and unanticipated technological failures. Most of the subsections enumerate corroborative evidence that the aggrieved party needs to provide for the claim, such as a newspaper article, death certificate, or a physician's certification on professional letterhead. Fla. Admin. Code R. 2B-1.0055(1)(a)-(d). The Division's Advisory Opinion, DE 91-02 (1991), specifies that, "before the

FEC may label these occurrences as 'unusual circumstances,' the FEC must determine that the

persons involved took all steps necessary to ensure that a timely report was filed."

The submission at issue before the Commission is the 2024 G6 Report filed on November

4, 2024, which discloses one (1) contribution, rather than the notice of no report filed on November

1, 2024. Campaign reports contain all contributions received and all expenditures made during a

reporting period. § 106.07(1) and (4), Fla. Stat. A committee with no activity may waive the

required report for a specified period under Section 106.07(7), Fla. Stat., but must notify the filing

officer in writing that "no report is being filed." Handbook, page 54. Committees registered with

the Division do so by selecting the "waiver" option in the Division's Electronic Filing System

("EFS"). § 106.0705(2)(a); Candidate EFS User's Guide, page 13; Handbook, page 54. A waiver

filed pursuant to Section 106.07(7), Fla. Stat., is not a report but a notice stating that no report has

been filed due to no reportable activity; however, the Commission may choose to consider a party's

reasons for filing a waiver under mitigating and aggravating circumstances as outlined in Section

106.265(3), Fla. Stat.

Rule 2B-1.005(2), Fla. Admin. Code, specifies that the appealing party has twenty (20)

days from acceptance of the appeal to submit any documents supporting the appeal. Appellant

timely submitted an initial statement. While the Commission may consider subsequent

supplemental documents no later than five (5) business days before the hearing, i.e., August 12,

2025, the record currently reflects that the 2024 G6 Report was not timely filed.

SUMMARY: Conservatives For A Better Miami-Dade is a political committee (PC) registered with the State of Florida. The PC's chair is Representative Juan Porras, and its treasurer is Brian A. Quintana.

The PC is appealing the fine. According to the treasurer, Mr. Quintana, a waiver was initially submitted for the 2024 G6 period. However, due to administrative oversight, they amended the submission, which resulted in the fine. He states that a \$1,000 contribution was reported on the 2024 G6 Report for the campaign of Juan Porras instead of the committee. They amended the report to reflect that activity and request a waiver of the fine due to the circumstances.

- The 2024 G6 Original Report covers the period from 10/19/24-10/31/24; it was due on 11/01/24.
- The 2024 G6 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created and filed on 11/01/24.1
- Conservatives For A Better Miami-Dade reported receiving 1 contribution while making zero expenditures.
- FEC staff was advised, "The committee filed a notice of no activity (waiver) on 11/01/24. A waiver is not a report. On 11/04/24, the committee filed a report showing \$1,000.00 of activity. The fine is based on the number of days late."
- The Division of Elections does not have any notes that pertain to Conservatives For A Better Miami-Dade's 2024 G6 Report.

PRIOR CASES: NONE.

Conservatives for a Better Miami-Dade is in receipt of a notice from the Florida Department of State and is being assessed a penalty of \$150 for filing Report G6 late. The letter is claiming that the due date was Friday, 11/1/2024, and our report was filed on Monday, 11/4/2024.

We understand that the original G6 Report that was filed was a waiver report, and as a result, because we added a contribution after the fact, that is what is triggering the penalty.

This was an administrative oversight, as the \$1,000 contribution that was added to the Amended G6 Report for Conservatives for a Better Miami Dade, was originally reported on the G6 Report for the Campaign of Juan Porras (83689), which was also filed on Friday, 11/1/2024.

When we returned to the office on Monday, 11/4/2024, it was noticed that even though the contribution was deposited into the correct bank account of Conservatives for a Better Miami-Dade, the actual contribution was reported in the Campaign report, and not the PAC report.

We immediately amended both G6 reports to reflect this.



This information appears to comply with the requirements of Section 106.03, Florida Statutes, and the name of this organization has been placed on our active committee list as a political committee.

Campaign Treasurer's Reports

Your first campaign treasurer's report will be due on **June 10, 2022**. The report will cover the period of May 1-31, 2022 (2022 M5). All political committees that file reports with the Division of Elections are required to file by means of the Division's Electronic Filing System (EFS).

Timely Filing

All reports must be completed and filed through the EFS no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the

due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date is subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first three days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the chairperson and campaign treasurer, and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.

Instructions and Assistance

An online instruction guide is available to you on the EFS to assist with navigation, data entry, and submission of reports. The Division of Elections will also provide assistance to all users by contacting the EFS Help Desk at (850) 245-6280.

All of the Division's publications and reporting forms are available on the Division of Elections' website at https://dos.myflorida.com/elections. It is your responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws.
