Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

**If you are the Respondent**, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

**If you are the Complainant**, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

**If you are an Appellant**, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

**FINAL ORDER**

**THIS MATTER** was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (“Commission”) at its regularly scheduled meeting held on May 17, 2023, in Tallahassee, Florida.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. The Commission is charged with enforcing Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the campaign financing law.
2. Respondent’s campaign treasurer’s report was not filed with the filing officer on October 28, 2022, the designated due date. Instead, the report was filed one day late on October 29, 2022.
3. The filing officer fined Respondent \$50.00 for the late filing of the report based on the number of days late. Respondent timely appealed claiming that he was unable to access his account on the evening the report was due.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

4. The Commission has jurisdiction over the parties to and subject matter of this case, pursuant to Section 106.07, Florida Statutes.
5. Respondent’s claim that he was unable to access his account does not justify Respondent’s failure to timely file the report.

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6. In determining the amount of the fine, if any, to be waived, the Commission considered the mitigating and aggravating circumstances set forth in Section 106.265(2), Florida Statutes.

**ORDER**

Based on the foregoing facts and conclusions of law, the Commission finds that Respondent failed to file the report on October 28, 2022, the designated due date. Therefore, it is

**ORDERED** that the assessed fine of \$50.00 is affirmed. The fine shall be paid to the Duval County Supervisor of Elections, 105 East Monroe Street, Jacksonville, Florida 32202, within 30 days of the date this Final Order is filed with the Commission.

The party must attach to the notice of appeal a copy of this order and include with the notice of appeal filed with the district court of appeal the applicable filing fees. **The notice of administrative appeal must be filed within 30 days of the date this order is filed with the Commission.** The date this order was filed with the Commission appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of this order.

The Clerk of the Florida Elections Commission will send a copy of this order to Respondent. The Final Order directs the Respondent to pay the Filing Officer. If the Filing Officer is not paid within 30 days of the date this order is filed with the Commission, the Filing Officer can file an enforcement action in circuit court to enforce the fine that is due and owing to the county or municipality. **SUMMARY:** The Honorable TK Waters was a candidate for Duval County Sheriff in the 2022 elections. William Stafford Jones was his treasurer.

Sheriff TK Waters is appealing the fine. According to the treasurer, Mr. Jones, he was unable to log into the "Voter Focus System by VR Systems" on the evening the report was due. He claims the system rejected their login information. After multiple attempts, they successfully logged in after clearing the cookies and cache from the browser. Mr. Jones states that he informed the SOE's office of the issue and provided a copy of the email. He requests a waiver of the fine due to the circumstances.

- The 2022 SG5 Original Report covers the period from 10/08/22-10/21/22; it was due on 10/28/22.
- The 2022 SG5 Report shows that it was filed on 10/29/22 at 4:47 p.m.
- TK Waters reported receiving 40 contributions while making 26 expenditures.
- The Duval County Supervisor of Elections office provided one email that pertains to TK Waters' 2022 SG5 report. On 10/29/22, Mr. Jones emailed the Candidate and Records Director and informed her of their issues with the system. On 10/31/22, Ms. Lana Self responded that it is a known issue with the vendor and advised them to appeal.



Esteemed Commissioners,

On Friday, October 28<sup>th</sup>, a report was due for the TK Waters Campaign. As we went to file that report, that evening, we could not log into the Voter Focus system by VR Systems (the system that the counties use for filing and reporting). The system was rejecting our login, as if it didn't know who we were.

As the supervisor staff was gone for the day, there was no one to reach out to. We tried several more times, that evening and then again, the next morning.

Before firing off an email to the very capable staff at the Duval County Supervisor of Elections, to inform them of our trouble, we tried clearing cookies and cache from the browser. Low and behold, that worked. I wish we would have tried that sooner, but it didn't occur to us.

I then emailed Lana, at the Duval County Supervisor of Elections to let her know what had happened. She emailed me back, Monday morning, with a sympathetic response, indicating that others have had this problem, at times, and that the recommendation by the software vendor was to do exactly what we did . . . clear the cookies and cache from the browser.

Also, please note that when reports are filed, they still have to be approved by the Supervisor's office in order to be made public. Our report was still made public at the same time as the others, in this race, on Monday morning. Because we persisted and figured out what to do, even though the report filing was late, there was no delay in public disclosure, at all.

As this was a technology problem, this was not a willful violation of Florida Statute and the reporting requirements. I would ask that you take that into consideration, along with the fact that we persisted until we found the solution and that there was no delay in public disclosure.

Given these extraordinary circumstances, I am asking that you waive the \$50 fine. There have been no other late filings on this campaign, or any other campaigns that we are working with.

Attached is the letter from the Supervisor of Elections, as well as the email communication between myself and Lana Self, at the Duval County Supervisor of Elections.

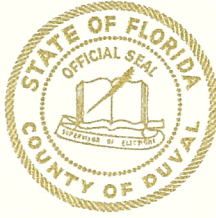
