**NOTICE OF HEARING (REVIEW AND CONSIDERATION OF APPEAL OF REVOCATION)**

A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on, **August 16, 2022 at 8:30 am**, *or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard*, at the following location: **House Office Building, 402 South Monroe Street, 306 HOB, Mashburn Hall, Tallahassee, Florida 32399.**

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

**If you are the Respondent**, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

**If you are the Complainant**, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

**If you are an Appellant**, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

Dear Florida Elections Commission:

We are in receipt of the "Final Notice of Intent to Cancel Registration" from the Bureau of Election Records dated February 17, 2022. This letter serves as a formal request for a hearing to appeal this cancellation.

It's clear the intent of 15-2.021 (FAC) is to provide a process for purging inactive PACs. The rulemaking development could not have anticipated a two-year long pandemic, nor would they foresee cancelling the registration of a PAC actively engaged in fundraising.


The state of Florida has given agencies broad discretion due to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on our state's economy. Government and private industry had to adapt to the circumstances and uncertainty of dealing with a global disaster. Beginning in March 2020 our sole focus was on the survival of our member businesses and our industry. The pandemic was not a prudent time to fundraise for our FA-PAC due to the financial challenges our member businesses faced during their closure. As a driver of Florida's economy, we understood our responsibility to ensure our members could reopen safe, smart and step-by-step.

Our industry is coming back strong and now is the right time to commence soliciting contributions from our members in anticipation of this November's elections. Our M2 Report covering 2/1/22-2/28/22 shows \$1675 collected from 16 contributors. Since then, an additional \$700 has been received. Our PAC is actively engaged in fundraising.

If the decision to cancel our PAC Registration is sustained, the only impact will be the immediate re-registration of our Florida Attractions PAC and the necessary work your team will be required to cancel and then re-register the Florida Attractions PAC. That would be an exercise in futility. I hope you'll agree that these unique circumstances warrant a measured response to our unintended error and allow both the Division of Elections and the Florida Attractions PAC proceed unincumbered.

Government and private industry had to adapt to the circumstances and uncertainty of dealing with a global tragedy. Beginning in March 2020 our sole focus was on the survival of our member businesses and our industry. The pandemic was not a prudent time to fundraise for our FA-PAC due to the financial challenges our member businesses faced during their closure. As a driver of Florida's economy, we understood our responsibility to ensure our members could reopen safe, smart and step-by-step.

Our industry is coming back strong and now is the right time to commence soliciting contributions from our members in anticipation of this November's elections. Beginning earlier this month, we relaunched our PAC's fundraising efforts. On February 15 (last week), FA-PAC contributions solicitations were mailed to our members and as of this morning, over \$500 has been received.

If the decision to cancel our PAC Registration is sustained, the only impact will be the immediate re-registration of our Florida Attractions PAC and the necessary work your team will be required to perform to cancel and then re-register the Florida Attractions PAC. That would be an exercise in futility. I hope you'll agree that these unique circumstances warrant a measured response to our unintended error and allow both the Division of Elections and the Florida Attractions PAC proceed unincumbered.





## **1S-2.021 Cancellation of Registration of Political Committees and Electioneering Communications Organizations.**

(1) Definitions:

(a) "Organization" means an electioneering communications organization.

(b) "Committee" means a political committee.

(c) "Limited activity" means:

1. For a committee, the committee's aggregate reported financial activity in each of two consecutive calendar years is \$500 or less, unless the committee is only registered and required to report as the sponsor of a proposed constitutional amendment by initiative who intended to seek the signatures of registered voters; and,

2. For an organization, the organization's aggregate reported financial activity in each of two consecutive calendar years is \$5,000 or less.

(d) "Most recent address on file" means the address provided in the most recent statement of appointment or written statement of change filed pursuant to Section 106.022, F.S.

(2) Conduct warranting cancellation. The filing officer shall initiate the cancellation of the registration of a committee or an organization for one or more of the following reasons:

(a) The committee or organization fails to maintain a registered office and a registered agent as required by Section 106.022, F.S., including the failure to have a physical office space and hours of operation or if correspondence sent by the filing officer is returned as undeliverable;

(b) The committee or organization fails to file the appointment of a successor within 10 days after the death, resignation or removal of its treasurer;

(c) The committee fails to file the appointment of a successor within 10 days after the death, resignation or removal of its chairperson;

(d) The committee or organization fails to file 2 or more consecutive reports;

(e) The committee or organization has limited activity;

(f) The organization fails to file the appointment of a successor within 10 days after the death, resignation or removal of its top-ranking principal officer; or

(g) The committee or organization has an unpaid fine or civil penalty imposed under Chapter 106, F.S., which has become final, meaning all appeals regarding the imposition of the fine or civil penalty have been exhausted or the time for such appeals has passed.

(3) Cancellation procedures.

(a) **Initial notice of intent to cancel.** The filing officer shall notify the committee's chairperson or organization's top-ranking principal officer and its registered agent of the intent to cancel the registration and include the facts and conduct which warrant the intended cancellation. The notice shall be sent to the most recent address on file for both the chairperson or top-ranking principal officer, as applicable, and registered agent. The initial notice shall state that all future notifications regarding cancellation of the committee's or organization's registration shall be sent only to the most recent address on file for the registered agent. The committee or organization has 15 days from the date of the initial notice to provide additional documentation to the filing officer showing that the committee's or organization's registration should not be canceled.

(b) **Final notice of intent to cancel.** After receiving the documentation under paragraph (a), from the committee or organization or after the 15-day deadline to provide additional information, whichever occurs first, the filing officer shall review all information and determine whether the registration should still be canceled.

1. If the filing officer determines that the registration should not be canceled, then the filing officer shall notify the registered agent at the most recent address on file.

2. If the filing officer determines that the registration should be canceled, then the filing officer shall send a final notice of intent to cancel to the most recent address on file for the registered agent.

(c) **Notice returned as undeliverable.** If the initial notice of intent to cancel is returned as undeliverable, and the committee or organization's most recent address on file has not changed since the filing officer sent the initial notice, then the filing officer need not send a final notice of intent to cancel and shall instead send the final order of cancellation. If the initial notice of intent to cancel is returned as undeliverable, but the committee or organization's most recent address on file has changed since the filing officer sent the initial notice, then the filing officer will provide an initial notice of the intent to cancel to that updated address; thereafter, the filing officer shall follow the procedures in this rule.

(d) Final order of cancellation. The final order of cancellation shall be sent to the most recent address on file for the registered agent, notwithstanding that the final order may be returned as undeliverable due to previous undelivered notices.

(4) Appeals. Appeal of Final Notice of Intent to Cancel. A committee or organization may appeal a final notice of intent to cancel within 30 days of the date of such final notice. The appeal may be accompanied by any documentation or evidence supporting the claim. The appeal must be filed with the filing officer. The filing officer will forward the appeal to the Florida Elections Commission.

(a) Failure to timely file an appeal shall constitute a waiver of any such entitlement.

(b) A committee or organization desiring a hearing before the Florida Elections Commission must include in the appeal a request for hearing.

(c) Appeals to the Florida Elections Commission under this rule are exempt from the confidentiality provisions of Section 106.25, F.S.

## The 2021 Florida Statutes

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[Title IX](#)[ELECTORS AND ELECTIONS](#)[Chapter 106](#)[CAMPAIGN FINANCING](#)[View Entire Chapter](#)**106.03 Registration of political committees and electioneering communications organizations.—**

(1)(a) Each political committee that receives contributions or makes expenditures during a calendar year in an aggregate amount exceeding \$500 or that seeks the signatures of registered electors in support of an initiative shall file a statement of organization as provided in subsection (3) within 10 days after its organization. If a political committee is organized within 10 days of any election, it shall immediately file the statement of organization required by this section.

(b)1. Each group shall file a statement of organization as an electioneering communications organization within 24 hours after the date on which it makes expenditures for an electioneering communication in excess of \$5,000, if such expenditures are made within the timeframes specified in s. [106.011\(8\)\(a\)2](#). If the group makes expenditures for an electioneering communication in excess of \$5,000 before the timeframes specified in s. [106.011\(8\)\(a\)2](#)., it shall file the statement of organization within 24 hours after the 30th day before a primary or special primary election, or within 24 hours after the 60th day before any other election, whichever is applicable.

2.a. In a statewide, legislative, or multicounty election, an electioneering communications organization shall file a statement of organization with the Division of Elections.

b. In a countywide election or any election held on less than a countywide basis, except as described in subparagraph c., an electioneering communications organization shall file a statement of organization with the supervisor of elections of the county in which the election is being held.

c. In a municipal election, an electioneering communications organization shall file a statement of organization with the officer before whom municipal candidates qualify.

d. Any electioneering communications organization that would be required to file a statement of organization in two or more locations need only file a statement of organization with the Division of Elections.

(2) The statement of organization shall include:

(a) The name, mailing address, and street address of the committee or electioneering communications organization;

(b) The names, street addresses, and relationships of affiliated or connected organizations, including any affiliated sponsors;

(c) The area, scope, or jurisdiction of the committee or electioneering communications organization;

(d) The name, mailing address, street address, and position of the custodian of books and accounts;

(e) The name, mailing address, street address, and position of other principal officers, including the treasurer and deputy treasurer, if any;

(f) The name, address, office sought, and party affiliation of:

1. Each candidate whom the committee is supporting;

2. Any other individual, if any, whom the committee is supporting for nomination for election, or election, to any public office whatever;

(g) Any issue or issues the committee is supporting or opposing;

(h) If the committee is supporting the entire ticket of any party, a statement to that effect and the name of the party;

(i) A statement of whether the committee is a continuing one;

- (j) Plans for the disposition of residual funds which will be made in the event of dissolution;
  - (k) A listing of all banks, safe-deposit boxes, or other depositories used for committee or electioneering communications organization funds;
  - (l) A statement of the reports required to be filed by the committee or the electioneering communications organization with federal officials, if any, and the names, addresses, and positions of such officials; and
  - (m) A statement of whether the electioneering communications organization was formed as a newly created organization during the current calendar quarter or was formed from an organization existing prior to the current calendar quarter. For purposes of this subsection, calendar quarters end the last day of March, June, September, and December.
- (3)(a) A political committee which is organized to support or oppose statewide, legislative, or multicounty candidates or issues to be voted upon on a statewide or multicounty basis shall file a statement of organization with the Division of Elections.
- (b) Except as provided in paragraph (c), a political committee which is organized to support or oppose candidates or issues to be voted on in a countywide election or candidates or issues in any election held on less than a countywide basis shall file a statement of organization with the supervisor of elections of the county in which such election is being held.
- (c) A political committee which is organized to support or oppose only candidates for municipal office or issues to be voted on in a municipal election shall file a statement of organization with the officer before whom municipal candidates qualify.
- (d) Any political committee which would be required under this subsection to file a statement of organization in two or more locations need file only with the Division of Elections.
- (4) Any change in information previously submitted in a statement of organization shall be reported to the agency or officer with whom such committee or electioneering communications organization is required to register within 10 days following the change.
- (5) Any committee which, after having filed one or more statements of organization, disbands or determines it will no longer receive contributions or make expenditures during the calendar year in an aggregate amount exceeding \$500 shall so notify the agency or officer with whom such committee is required to file the statement of organization.
- (6) If the filing officer finds that a political committee has filed its statement of organization consistent with the requirements of subsection (2), it shall notify the committee in writing that it has been registered as a political committee. If the filing officer finds that a political committee's statement of organization does not meet the requirements of subsection (2), it shall notify the committee of such finding and shall state in writing the reasons for rejection of the statement of organization.
- (7) The Division of Elections shall adopt rules to prescribe the manner in which committees and electioneering communications organizations may be dissolved and have their registration canceled. Such rules shall, at a minimum, provide for:
- (a) Notice which shall contain the facts and conduct which warrant the intended action, including but not limited to failure to file reports and limited activity.
  - (b) Adequate opportunity to respond.
  - (c) Appeal of the decision to the Florida Elections Commission. Such appeals shall be exempt from the confidentiality provisions of s. 106.25.
