This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE

THIS MATTER was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting held on August 20, 2025, at 1:00 p.m. via Zoom teleconferencing.

On July 14, 2025, Staff recommended to the Commission that there was probable cause to believe that the Florida Election Code was violated. The facts articulated in Staff's Recommendation are adopted by reference and incorporated herein. Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following violation(s):

Count 1:

On or around November 21, 2022, Anthony Lance Alred violated Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes, when he deliberately failed to accurately reflect the disposition of all remaining campaign funds in the 2022 TR, as evidenced by the four transactions made during the relevant reporting period that were not disclosed, and the surplus balance that existed at the end of the relevant reporting period.

Count 2:

On or around November 21, 2022, Anthony Lance Alred violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when he deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2022 Termination Report, as evidenced by the four

transactions made during the relevant reporting period that were not reported.

The Commission finds that there is **no probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by consent order where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s) and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

Second, you may request an informal hearing held before the Commission, if you do not dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to make written or oral arguments to the Commission concerning the legal issues related to the violation(s) and the potential fine. At the request of Respondent, the Commission will consider and determine willfulness at an informal hearing. Otherwise, live witness testimony is unnecessary.

Third, you may request a formal hearing held before an administrative law judge in the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH), if you dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-

hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to present evidence relevant to the violation(s) listed in this order, to cross-examine opposing witnesses, to impeach any witness, and to rebut the evidence presented against you.

If you do not elect to resolve the case by consent order or request a formal hearing at the DOAH or an informal hearing before the Commission within 30 days of the date this Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission, the case will be sent to the Commission for a formal or informal hearing, depending on whether the facts are in dispute. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the sworn complaint in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Sections 106.141(1), and 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes**, and **no probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on January 12, 2024, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

1. On March 2, 2023, the Florida Elections Commission (“Commission”) received a sworn complaint from Kaiti Lenhart, Flagler County Supervisor of Elections (“Complainant” or “filing officer”), alleging that Anthony Lance Alred (“Respondent”) violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

2. Respondent was a 2022 candidate for Flagler County School Board, District 2. (ROI page 1, paragraph 1¹). Respondent was defeated in the primary election on August 23, 2022, and was a first-time candidate. (Attachment A, page 2; ROI Exhibit 3, page 2; ROI Exhibit 9, page 1)

3. By letter dated August 14, 2023, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provisions:

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2022 candidate for Flagler County School Board, District 2, failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because he had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the 2022 TR reporting period, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2022 candidate for Flagler County School Board, District 2, failed to file his 2022 Termination Report reflecting the disposition of all remaining campaign funds, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2022 candidate for Flagler County School Board, District 2, may have

falsely reported or deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, during the 2022 TR reporting period, as alleged in the complaint.

4. On January 18, 2022, Respondent filed a Statement of Candidate form (“DS-DE 84”) in which Respondent certified he had been provided access to read and understand Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. (ROI Exhibit 2)

5. On January 18, 2022, Respondent filed his Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates form (“DS-DE 9”), serving as his own treasurer. (ROI Exhibit 1)

6. On January 18, 2022, Respondent signed an Acknowledgement of Receipt of the 2022 Candidate Qualifying Handbook published by the Flagler County Supervisor of Elections. (ROI Exhibit 3, page 4)

7. Complainant, via affidavit, attested that Respondent was emailed copies of Chapters 104 and 106, Florida Statutes, as well as the *Candidate & Campaign Treasurer Handbook* on January 20, 2022. The email contained links to the Florida Election Code, *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*, and Calendar of Reporting Dates. The email also contained log-in credentials for access to the online electronic filing system and an attached document labeled “How to File Financial Reports Online.” (ROI Exhibit 3)

Alleged Violation: Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes

8.. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida’s election laws by failing to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed.

9. Respondent was eliminated as a candidate during the 2022 Primary Election that took place on August 23, 2022. (Attachment A, page 2) Respondent’s 2022 Termination Report, which covered the period of August 19, 2022, to November 21, 2022, was due on November 21, 2022. (Attachment B, page 3; ROI Exhibit 4, pages 1-2)

10. Respondent failed to file his 2022 Termination Report or notify the filing officer that no report would be filed. (See Compl). As of January 8, 2024, Respondent had not filed a waiver or a 2022 Termination Report. (ROI Exhibit 9, page 1, paragraph 2)

11. A subpoena was issued to Respondent’s designated campaign depository to ascertain whether there was a surplus balance and any financial activity that occurred during the 2022 TR reporting period, i.e. August 19, 2022 – November 21, 2022. Respondent’s bank records showed one expenditure in the amount of \$13,000.00 on September 7, 2022, which was a check issued to Respondent from his campaign. (ROI Exhibit 7, page 5)

12. Respondent’s bank records also showed two transactions totaling \$750.75 during the 2022 TR reporting period. The first transaction was a deposit of \$275.00 on August 19, 2022,

which was comprised of two contribution checks dated June 9, 2022, and August 12, 2022. (ROI Exhibit 7, pages 1 and 3). The second transaction was in the form of a Paypal transfer credit in the amount of \$475.75 on September 22, 2022. (ROI Exhibit 7, page 5)

13. Since Respondent had reportable financial activity during 2022 TR reporting period, Respondent was not required to notify the filing officer in writing that he would not be filing his 2022 TR report due to not having any reportable financial activity.

Alleged Violation: Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes

14. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by failing to accurately reflect the disposition of all remaining campaign funds in his 2022 Termination Report.

15. Respondent was eliminated as a candidate during the 2022 Primary Election that took place on August 23, 2022. ((Attachment A, page 2)) Respondent was required to dispose of the funds on deposit in his campaign account and file the campaign's 2022 Termination Report accurately within 90 days after being eliminated as a candidate.

16. Respondent's 2022 TR was due on November 21, 2022. (Attachment B, page 3; ROI Exhibit 4, pages 1-2) However, Respondent failed to submit his 2022 TR report. (See Compl.)

17. A subpoena was issued to Respondent's designated campaign depository to ascertain whether there was a surplus balance and any financial activity that occurred during the 2022 TR reporting period, i.e. August 19, 2022 – November 21, 2022. Respondent's bank records showed one expenditure in the amount of \$13,000.00, and three contributions totaling \$750.75, for a total of \$13,750.75 in financial activity during the relevant reporting period. (ROI Exhibit 7, pages 1, 3, and 5)

18. Respondent's bank records show that Respondent had a surplus balance of \$784.10 as of the last day of the 2022 TR reporting period. (ROI Exhibit 7, page 8)

19. As it appears that Respondent had unreported financial activity during the 2022 TR reporting period, as well as a surplus balance at the end of the 2022 TR reporting period, Respondent failed to accurately reflect the disposition of all remaining campaign funds in his 2022 Termination Report.

Alleged Violation: Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes

20. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by falsely reporting or deliberately failing to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2022 TR Report. The reporting period at issue ran from August 19, 2022, through November 21, 2022. (See Compl.)

21. Based on the above analysis, Respondent had reportable financial activity during the relevant reporting period and was required to report the activity on the campaign's 2022 Termination Report.

22. The local filing officer reminded Respondent via phone and email of the 2022 TR report being due on November 21, 2022, as well as reminders informing Respondent that the 2022 TR report was past due. (ROI Exhibit 4; ROI Exhibit 5, page 1).

23. Despite reminders from the filing officer, Respondent failed to disclose one expenditure in the amount of \$13,000.00, and three contributions totaling \$750.75, for a total of \$13,750.75 in financial activity, during the relevant reporting period. (ROI Exhibit 5; ROI Exhibit 7, pages 1, 3, and 5)

24. On January 18, 2023, Respondent notified the local filing officer that he needed help with the 2022 TR report. On January 20, 2023, Respondent met with the local filing officer in person to obtain assistance. Respondent was advised to review his reports, submit amendments as necessary, and then submit his 2022 TR report. (ROI Exhibit 5, page 2)

25. Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, requires candidates to report any contributions received and any expenditures made for the purpose of influencing the results of an election. Respondent deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2022 Termination Report.

26. As it appears that Respondent had financial activity during the 2022 TR reporting period, Respondent was required to report this activity but failed to do so.

27. In response to the allegations, Respondent stated that this was his first campaign, and it was his fault that he had not filed the 2022 TR report due to discrepancies that he had to resolve. Respondent understood that there was a mistake, and he was still trying to fix the error. Respondent acknowledged being provided with the *Candidate Handbook*, Chapter 106, F.S., and other materials, which he read. (ROI Exhibit 9, pages 1-2)

28. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. *Schmitt v. State*, 590 So. 2d 404, 409 (Fla.1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. *Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino*, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).

29. The facts set forth above show that Respondent was a 2022 candidate for Flagler County School Board, District 2. Respondent deliberately failed to accurately reflect the disposition of all remaining campaign funds on the campaign's 2022 Termination Report and deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. Respondent did not violate Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, with regard to the 2022 TR reporting period.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find **no probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.07(7)**, and find **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating the following:

Count 1:

On or around November 21, 2022, Anthony Lance Alred violated Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes, when he deliberately failed to accurately reflect the disposition of all remaining campaign funds in the 2022 TR, as evidenced by the four transactions made during the relevant reporting period that were not disclosed, and the surplus balance that existed at the end of the relevant reporting period.

Count 2:

On or around November 21, 2022, Anthony Lance Alred violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when he deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2022 Termination Report, as evidenced by the four transactions made during the relevant reporting period that were not reported.

Sections 106.07(7), and 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, failure of a candidate who did not receive any contributions or make any expenditures during the TR reporting period to notify timely the filing officer, in writing, that no TR is being filed or failure to file the TR to reflect financial activity.

1. Respondent was a 2022 candidate for Flagler County School Board, District 2; he was defeated in the primary election held on August 23, 2022. Respondent was a first-time candidate.

2. An Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository form (DS-DE 9) was filed on January 18, 2022. Respondent was appointed as campaign treasurer. To review the DS-DE 9, refer to Exhibit 1.

3. Respondent filed a Statement of Candidate with the SOE on January 18, 2022, in which Respondent certified he had been provided access to read and understand the requirements of Chapter 106, F.S. To review the Statement of Candidate, refer to Exhibit 2.

4. On January 18, 2022, Respondent signed an Acknowledgment of Receipt of 2022 Candidate Qualifying Handbook published by the SOE. In an affidavit, the SOE attested that Respondent was emailed copies of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and the *Candidate & Campaign Treasurer Handbook* on January 20, 2022. The SOE provided a copy of the email, which provided Respondent links to the Election Code, *Candidate & Campaign Treasurer Handbook*, and Calendar of Reporting Dates; the email also provided log in credentials for access to the online electronic filing system and attached a document titled "How To File Financial Reports Online." To review the affidavit, acknowledgment, and email, refer to Exhibit 3.

5. SOE staff sent Respondent an email reminding him to file the 2022 TRP by November 21, 2022. On November 30, 2022, and January 17, 2023, SOE staff emailed Respondent notifying him the 2022 TRP was late and had not been filed. On January 18, 2023, Respondent replied stating he had attempted several times to file the report without success. SOE staff asked if Respondent was having a problem logging into the reporting system and offered their assistance. Respondent replied stating, "I'm having problems looking at the report to make sure it's okay to submit. When I pull up anything it's blank. I'm very confused." To review the emails, refer to Exhibit 4.

6. The SOE stated in the complaint that SOE staff called Respondent on January 19, 2023, and advised he could come to their office, and they would answer his questions and help with his report. The SOE further stated that on January 20, 2023, Respondent came to their office, and SOE staff answered his questions and provided advice in the filing of his 2022 TRP. To review the SOE complaint statement, refer to Exhibit 5.

II. Alleged Violation of Sections 106.07(7), 106.141(1), and 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes:

7. I investigated whether Respondent violated these sections of the election laws by not notifying the filing officer, in writing, that no TRP would be filed due to not receiving any contributions or making expenditures during the TRP reporting period or by not filing a TRP to reflect financial activity during the TRP reporting period. I also investigated whether Respondent violated Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes, by not disposing of all campaign funds within 90 days of being eliminated. To review Respondent's filing history, refer to Exhibit 6.

8. Campaign account records disclose that one expenditure transpired during the TRP reporting period in amount of \$13,000.00 to Respondent, and two deposits occurred in the amounts of \$275.00² and \$475.75.

9. On the date the TRP was due, campaign account records reflect that the balance was \$784.10.³ To review the relevant bank statement, refer to Exhibit 7, page 8.

10. Respondent did respond to the complaint. Respondent stated, "I have to file a termination waiver and then, go back, and amend several expenses that were misreported and recorded...To do this, I will be obtaining my past statements and reports..." To review Respondent's response, refer to Exhibit 8.

11. I called Respondent for the purpose of providing an opportunity to discuss the allegations made in the complaint. Respondent stated this was his first campaign. He acknowledged that it was his fault he had not filed the TRP since there were discrepancies he had to resolve. Respondent stated he wanted it known that he understood there was a mistake and that he is still trying to fix the error. Respondent acknowledged that he was provided the *Candidate Handbook*, Chapter 106, F.S., and other materials, and that he read over the materials. To review the phone log, refer to Exhibit 9.

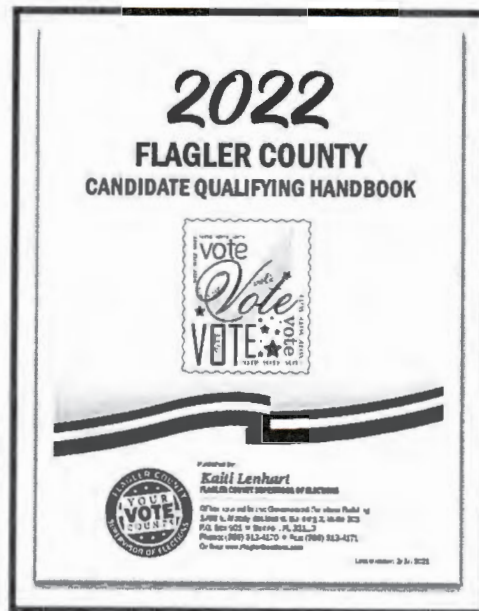

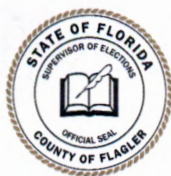

1-18-2023: The candidate emailed back that he needed help with his report.

1-19-2023: Karen Sousa called the candidate to let him know that he could come in and that we would answer his questions and help with his report.

1-20-2023: Lance Alred came to the office and sat down with Karen Sousa. She answered his questions and directed him to go back through his reports and submit amendments for any reports that need to have changes and then submit his TRP report. She advised that he would need to make sure that box 9 and box 10 on the report were the same so that they balanced to zero. He stated that he was going to go home and work on his reports and then submit them.

There is no indication that the candidate has logged into the financial system to work on the reports, nor has there been any further communication with this office. Please reference the Status of Candidate Reports and Candidate Reporting login information from Voter Focus.

On March 2, 2023, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging that you violated Florida's election laws. I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more **legally sufficient allegations**. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violations:

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2022 candidate for Flagler County School Board, District 2, failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because he had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the 2022 TR reporting period, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2022 candidate for Flagler County School Board, District 2, failed to file his 2022 Termination Report reflecting the disposition of all remaining campaign funds, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2022 candidate for Flagler County School Board, District 2, may have falsely reported or deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, during the 2022 TR reporting period, as alleged in the complaint.

When we conclude the investigation, a copy of the Report of Investigation (ROI) will be mailed to you at the above address. Based on the results of the investigation, a staff attorney will prepare and present a written Staff Recommendation (SR) to the Commission as to whether there is probable cause to charge you, the Respondent, with violating Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. You will have an opportunity to respond to both the ROI and the SR. The Commission will then hold one or more hearings to determine whether the alleged violations occurred and, if so, the amount of the fine to be imposed upon you. Notice will be mailed to you and the Complainant at least 14 days before any hearing at which your case is to be considered.

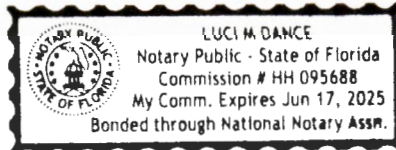

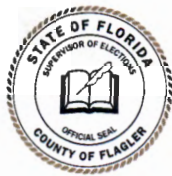

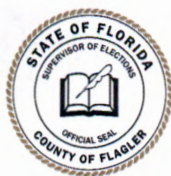
