ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On February 26, 2024, Staff recommended to the Commission that there was probable cause to believe that the Florida Election Code was violated. 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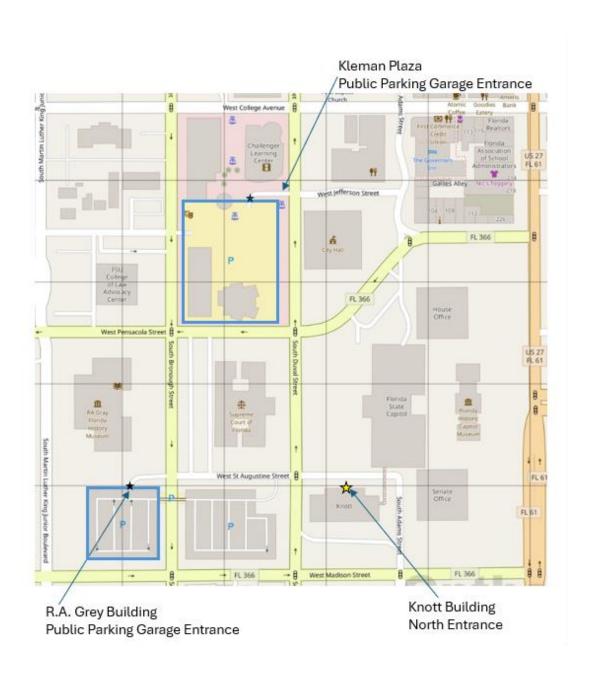

If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing*. The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.19(1)(c)**, **Florida Statutes**, and **no probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Sections 106.07(5)**, and 106.141(1), **Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on July 14, 2023, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

- 1. On March 5, 2021, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a referral from the Department of State, Division of Elections ("Division" or "Complainant"), alleging that Tammyette Thomas ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
- 2. Respondent was a 2020 candidate for State Representative, District 15. Respondent's Statement of Candidate form ("DS-DE 84") was filed October 25, 2019. (ROI Exhibit 2)¹
- 3. By letter dated October 7, 2022, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provisions:²

Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2020 candidate for State Representative, District 15, may have certified one or more campaign treasurer's reports were true, correct, and complete when they were not, based upon an apparent surplus balance after the 2020 TR was filed, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2020 candidate for State Representative, District 15, filed a 2020 TR report that may have failed to accurately reflect the disposition of all remaining campaign funds, based upon an apparent surplus balance after the 2020 TR report was filed, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2020 candidate for State Representative, District 15, may have falsely reported or deliberately failed to include information in one or more

² The references to the 2020 TR are scrivener's errors. The referral's supporting documentation alleges violations occurring during the 2021 TR reporting period.

campaign treasurer reports, as required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, based upon an apparent surplus balance after the 2020 TR report was filed, as alleged in the complaint.

- 4. On October 30, 2019, Respondent filed her Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates form ("DS-DE 9") appointing Erica Gayden as treasurer for her campaign. (ROI Exhibit 1, page 1) On November 14, 2019, and June 10, 2020, Respondent filed additional DS-DE 9 forms appointing Kendra Kohn-Fitzpatrick and herself as deputy treasurers for her campaign, respectively. (ROI Exhibit 1, pages 2 & 3)
- 5. By letter dated October 31, 2019, Kristi Reid Willis, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, sent Respondent a letter acknowledging that the Division had received her DS-DE 9. (ROI Exhibit 3)
- 6. The acknowledgment letter advised Respondent that all candidates filing reports with the Division are required to use the electronic filing system ("EFS") and provided Respondent with a user identification number and initial password to grant access to the EFS. The letter further advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms were available on its website and directed Respondent to print out Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*, as well as other relevant documents. (ROI Exhibit 3)

Alleged Violation: Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes

- 7. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by failing to dispose of the funds on deposit in her campaign account. *See* Compl., pp. 1 & 2
- 8. Respondent was eliminated as a candidate during the 2020 General Election. (ROI, p. 1, ¶1) Respondent was required to dispose of the funds on deposit in her campaign account within 90 days after being eliminated as a candidate.
- 9. A subpoena was issued to Respondent's designated campaign depository. The campaign's bank records show that Respondent had a deficit balance of -\$24.24 as of the last day of the 2021 TR reporting period, i.e., February 1, 2021. (ROI Exhibit 5, page 13)
- 10. It does not appear that Respondent failed to dispose of the funds on deposit in her campaign account within 90 days after being eliminated as a candidate.

Alleged Violation: Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes

- 11. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by certifying that the campaign's 2021 TR Report was true, correct, and complete when it was not.
- 12. On March 4, 2021, Respondent notified the filing officer in writing that she would not be filing her 2021 TR Report. (ROI Exhibit 4; ROI Exhibit 6, pages 1-5 & 23) The requirement under Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes, to certify as to the correctness of a report does not apply to notifications of no activity submitted to the filing officer pursuant to Section 106.07(7), Florida

Statutes. Therefore, Respondent did not violate Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes, with regard to the 2021 TR reporting period.

Alleged Violation: Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes

- 13. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by falsely reporting or deliberately failing to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2021 TR Report. The reporting period at issue ran from October 30, 2020, through February 1, 2021. (ROI Exhibit 6, page 1)
- 14. The campaign's 2021 TR Report was due on February 1, 2021. On March 4, 2021, Respondent notified her filing officer that she had no reportable financial activity during the 2021 TR reporting period. (ROI Exhibit 4; ROI Exhibit 6, pages 1-5 & 23)
- 15. A subpoena was issued to Respondent's designated campaign depository to ascertain whether any financial activity occurred during the relevant reporting period. Respondent's bank records show financial activity that was required to be reported on the 2021 TR Report. (ROI Exhibit 5)
- 16. On April 1, 2021, Respondent filed a report. (ROI Exhibit 6, page 24) On July 1, 2021, and July 16, 2021, Respondent filed two amendments to the report. (ROI Exhibit 6, pages 35 & 42) The second amended report disclosed 77 contributions totaling \$146.47 and 60 expenditures totaling \$34,121.99. (ROI Exhibit 6, pages 6-22)
- 17. Respondent stated that she did not have the bank records necessary to file the 2021 TR. She stated that she later obtained and reviewed the records which showed activity that was not reported by the treasurer. (ROI Exhibit 8, page 1)
- 18. On February 15, 2021, the Division contacted Respondent's treasurer regarding the 2021 TR Report which was overdue. (ROI Exhibit 7, page 2) On March 2, 2021, the Division received a request from Respondent to reset her EFS password and provided Respondent with a new password by phone that same day. (ROI Exhibit 7, pages 1 & 3) Two days later the notice of no activity was filed despite the bank records showing financial activity. (ROI Exhibit 4; ROI Exhibit 5; ROI Exhibit 6, pages 1-5 & 23)
- 19. Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, requires candidates to report any contributions received and any expenditures made for the purpose of influencing the results of an election. Respondent deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2021 TR Report, as evidenced by the filing of a notice of no activity, followed by a report and two amended reports.
- 20. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. *Schmitt v. State*, 590 So. 2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an

offense has been committed. Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).

21. The facts set forth above show that Respondent was a 2020 candidate for State Representative, District 15. Respondent deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2021 TR Report. It does not appear that Respondent failed to dispose of the funds on deposit in her campaign account within 90 days after being eliminated as a candidate. Respondent did not violate Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes, with regard to the 2021 TR reporting period.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find no probable cause to charge Respondent with violating Sections 106.07(5), and 106.141(1), Florida Statutes, and find probable cause to charge Respondent with violating the following:

Count 1:

On or around March 4, 2021, Tammyette Thomas violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when she deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2021 TR Report.

I. Preliminary Information:

- 1. Respondent was a 2020 candidate for the Florida House, District 15; she was defeated in the general election held on November 3, 2020. Respondent was a first-time candidate.
- 2. An Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository (DS-DE 9) was filed on October 30, 2019. Erica Gayden was appointed as campaign treasurer. Subsequent DS-DE 9s were filed appointing Kendra Fitzpatrick and Respondent as deputy campaign treasurers. To review the DS-DE 9s, refer to Exhibit 1.
- 3. Respondent filed a Statement of Candidate with the Division on October 25, 2019, in which Respondent certified she had been provided access to read and understand the requirements of Chapter 106, F.S. To review the Statement of Candidate, refer to Exhibit 2.
- 4. An acknowledgement letter was mailed to the address provided on the DS-DE 9 on October 31, 2019. The letter advised Respondent that all candidates filing reports with the Division are required to file by means of the Division's electronic filing system (EFS). Respondent was provided with a user identification number and initial password allowing access to the EFS.
- 5. The acknowledgement letter also advised Respondent that all the Division's publications and reporting forms are available on their website, including Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the *Candidate & Campaign Treasurer Handbook*, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*. The letter further advised that it was Respondent's responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. To review the acknowledgement letter, refer to Exhibit 3.

II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes:

6. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by not disposing of all remaining campaign funds within 90 days of being eliminated. To review Respondent's filing history, refer to Exhibit 4.

7. On the date the 2021 TR was due, campaign account records reflect that the balance was \$-24.24. To review the relevant bank statement, refer to Exhibit 5, page 13.

III. Alleged Violation of Sections 106.07(5), 106.141(1), and 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes:

- 8. I investigated whether Respondent violated these sections of the election laws by certifying that one or more campaign treasurer report(s) were true, correct, and complete when they were not, falsely reporting or deliberately failing to include information in one or more campaign treasurer report(s) and failing to accurately reflect disposition of all remaining campaign funds in a termination report due to an apparent surplus balance after the TR was filed.
- 9. I reviewed bank records from the designated campaign depository and compared them with campaign treasurer report(s) covering the following reporting period(s): 2021 TR.² Respondent filed the original 2021 TR on March 4, 2021, which was 31 days late. However, the report did not include any activity. Therefore, none of the reportable financial activity that transpired through the campaign account during the TR reporting period and was required to be included on the TR was reported by the TR due date.³ A review of the bank records reveals that numerous expenditures transpired during the TR reporting period in amounts varying from \$1.87 to \$2,633.27 for purposes such as food, office supplies, online contribution platform fees, and ATM withdrawals. Also, many deposits/credits occurred during the TR reporting period in amounts varying from \$0.44 to \$1,438.32. To review Respondent's filing history, refer to Exhibit 4. To review the bank records, refer to Exhibit 5. To review Division records of the original 2021 TR, refer to Exhibit 6, pages 1-5 and 23.
- 10. On April 1, 2021, which was almost a month after this referral was filed, Respondent filed an amended 2021 TR in which she disclosed 77 contributions in amounts varying from \$1.00 to \$8.69, and 62 expenditures in amounts varying from \$1.87 to \$2,633.27. She filed further amended TRs in July 2021, in which she revised and/or deleted some of these transactions from the TR. To review the amended 2021 TRs, refer to Exhibit 6, pages 6-22 and 24-44.
- 11. According to Division records, Division staff spoke with Respondent's campaign treasurer, Erica Gayden, on February 15, 2021. Division staff advised Ms. Gayden that a TR had not been filed for Respondent. Ms. Gayden reportedly indicated that she would file the TR the next day. However, as noted above, the original TR was not filed until March 4, 2021, and it did not include any activity. An amended TR disclosing a large amount of activity was filed on April 1, 2021, which was after this referral was filed. Division records show Respondent had requested a reset of EFS credentials on March 2, 2021, and Division staff released them to her by phone on the same date. To review the Division records, refer to Exhibit 7.
 - 12. Respondent did not respond to the referral.

¹ I subpoenaed campaign account records from the designated campaign depository. The account was taken to a -\$88.24 balance on 2/19/21, after which \$590.00 was deposited into the account to cover outstanding check #1073, leaving the account balance at \$1.76 on 2/19/21. On 3/22/21, the \$1.76 balance was transferred to another account, which zeroed out the campaign account. The account remained open and was charged off and closed on 1/8/22.

² The review was reflective of original reports filed and applicable bank records of deposits, debits, bank fees, and checks drawn on the campaign account, but it did not reflect activity associated with online contribution platforms where the investigation was unable to obtain records itemizing the sources of such contributions.

³ Some checks that posted to the account during the TR reporting period were dated prior to the TR reporting period, and some deposits that occurred during the TR reporting period were disbursements from online contribution platforms that may have been comprised of online contributions made prior to the TR reporting period.

⁴ The accuracy of the amended TR is not analyzed in this report since it was not filed until after this referral was filed.

13. I called Respondent for the purpose of providing an opportunity to discuss the allegations made in the referral. Respondent stated she was a first-time candidate and had a first-time campaign treasurer. Respondent stated she did not have bank records to file her TR, but she later obtained and reviewed the bank records, which showed a lot of activity that was not reported by the campaign treasurer. Respondent stated that on April 1, 2021, she filed a TR to reflect that activity. To review the phone log, refer to Exhibit 8.

Your first campaign treasurer's report will be due on **November 12, 2019**. The report will cover the period of October 1-31, 2019 (2019 M10). All candidates who file reports with the Division of Elections are required to file by means of the Division's Electronic Filing System (EFS).

Timely Filing

All reports filed must be completed and filed through the EFS no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any candidate failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first three days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the candidate and campaign treasurer, and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.

On March 5, 2021, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging that you violated Florida's election laws. Our Executive Director has reviewed the complaint and finds that it contains one or more legally sufficient allegations. I will investigate the following alleged violations:

Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2020 candidate for State Representative, District 15, may have certified one or more campaign treasurer's reports were true, correct, and complete when they were not, based upon an apparent surplus balance after the 2020 TR was filed, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2020 candidate for State Representative, District 15, filed a 2020 TR report that may have failed to accurately reflect the disposition of all remaining campaign funds, based upon an apparent surplus balance after the 2020 TR report was filed, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2020 candidate for State Representative, District 15, may have falsely reported or deliberately failed to include information in one or more campaign treasurer reports, as required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, based upon an apparent surplus balance after the 2020 TR report was filed, as alleged in the complaint.

I will contact you by phone at the number provided above to conduct a phone interview within the next week regarding information I have obtained and the allegations in the complaint. When the investigation is concluded, a copy of the Report of Investigation (ROI) will be mailed to you at the above address.
