ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by <u>consent order</u> where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s) and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its

approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

Second, you may request an <u>informal hearing</u> held before the Commission, if you <u>do not</u> dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have thirty (30) days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to make written or oral arguments to the Commission concerning the legal issues related to the violation(s) and the potential fine. At the request of Respondent, the Commission will consider and determine willfulness at an informal hearing. Otherwise, live witness testimony is unnecessary.

Third, you may request a <u>formal hearing</u> held before an administrative law judge in the Division of Administrative Hearings ("DOAH"), if you dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have thirty (30) days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to present evidence relevant to the violation(s) listed in this order, to cross-examine opposing witnesses, to impeach any witness, and to rebut the evidence presented against you.

If you do not elect to resolve the case by consent order or request a formal hearing at the DOAH or an informal hearing before the Commission within thirty (30) days of the date this Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission, the case will be sent to the Commission for a formal or informal hearing, depending on whether the facts are in dispute. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order.

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

STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Sections 106.07(5) and 106.09(1)(b)**, **Florida Statutes**, and that there is **no probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.07(2)(b)1.**, **Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on February 13, 2024, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

- 1. On August 29, 2022, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a referral from the Florida Division of Elections ("Complainant" or "Division") alleging that Christopher Proia ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
- 2. Respondent was a 2022 candidate for State Senator, District 27. (ROI Exhibit 1, page 1; ROI Exhibit 2, page 1)¹ Respondent was defeated in the general election held on November 8, 2022. (Attachment A, page 1)
- 3. Respondent's Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository form ("DS-DE 9") was filed on May 27, 2022, wherein Respondent appointed himself to serve as the campaign's treasurer. (ROI Exhibit 1, page 2)
- 4. By letter dated February 2, 2023, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provisions:

Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2022 candidate for State Senator, District 27, acting as his own treasurer, failed to timely make necessary amendments to the 2022 P1 and 2022 P2 campaign treasurer's reports, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2022 candidate for State Senator, District 27, may have certified the 2022 P1 campaign treasurer's report was true, correct, and complete when it was not, based on reported cash contributions in excess of the \$50 per campaign limit, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.09(1)(b), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2022 candidate for State Senator, District 27, may have accepted one or

more cash contributions in excess of the \$50 per campaign limit, based upon contributions reported during the 2022 P1 reporting period, as alleged in the complaint.

- 5. By letter dated May 31, 2022, Donna S. Brown, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, sent Respondent a letter acknowledging that the Division had received his DS-DE 9 and that his name was placed on the 2022 active candidate list. (ROI Exhibit 3, page 1)
- 6. The acknowledgment letter advised Respondent that all candidates filing reports with the Division are required to use the electronic filing system ("EFS") and provided Respondent with a user identification number and initial password to grant access to the EFS. (ROI Exhibit 3, page 1) The letter further advised Respondent that all the Division's publications and reporting forms were available on its website and directed Respondent to print out Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*, as well as other relevant documents. (ROI Exhibit 3, page 2)

Alleged Violation: Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes

- 7. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by failing to make amendments to the campaign's 2022 P1 and 2022 P2 Reports.
- 8. The campaign's 2022 P1 Report was filed on June 24, 2022, and the campaign's 2022 P2 Report was filed on July 8, 2022. (ROI Exhibit 8, pages 6 & 12) The reports were incomplete when filed. (ROI Exhibit 4, pages 1-7)
- 9. The Division sent five letters notifying Respondent that the campaign's reports were incomplete and that Respondent was required to amend the reports within seven days of receipt of the notifications. (ROI Exhibit 4, pages 1, 6 & 8; ROI Exhibit 5, page 1; ROI Exhibit 6, page 1) Error Reports were attached to the notifications showing why each report was incomplete. (ROI Exhibit 4, pages 2-5, 7, 9-12; ROI Exhibit 5, pages 2-6; ROI Exhibit 6, pages 2-6)
- 10. Delivery confirmation was not verified; however, the Division's website does not reflect that the letters were returned. (ROI Exhibit 7, pages 1-2; Attachment B, page 1)
- 11. Respondent did not specifically comment on whether he received the Division's notices but stated that he did not keep up with contributions, rules, or any regulations about campaign financing. Respondent stated that he did not keep any records and did not take good notes about "who gave what," so he was not able to provide corrections to the reports at issue. Respondent indicated that he did not familiarize himself with Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, or the Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook. (ROI Exhibit 10, pages 2-3)
- 12. Pursuant to Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, the filing officer is required to notify the campaign treasurer by certified mail or mail requiring proof of delivery as to why the report is incomplete. Thereafter, the campaign treasurer has a duty to file an addendum to an incomplete report within seven days after receiving notice from its filing officer. This section of

law is clear that the "[f]ailure to file a complete report after such notice constitutes a violation of this chapter." §106.07(2)(b)1., Fla. Stat. [Emphasis added.]

13. In the absence of direct evidence confirming Respondent's receipt of the notices, it does not appear that Respondent violated Florida's election laws when he failed to timely file an addendum to the campaign's 2022 P1 and 2022 P2 Reports. The filing officer's notification to Respondent was a condition precedent that was not met.

Alleged Violation: Section 106.09(1)(b), Florida Statutes

- 14. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by accepting several excessive cash contributions.
- 15. Under Section 106.09(1)(b), Florida Statutes, a candidate may not accept a cash contribution exceeding \$50 total per contributor per election. However, per Section 106.11(2), Florida Statutes, a contribution made through a bank account or debit card account may qualify as a bank check if cash is not received as part of the transaction.
- 16. The campaign's 2022 P1 Report listed 19 cash contributions totaling \$1,840.00, which ranged from \$55 to \$100 per transaction. (ROI Exhibit 8, page 2)
- 17. A subpoena was issued to Respondent's designated campaign depository to verify the financial activity that occurred during the relevant reporting period, i.e., June 1, 2022, to June 17, 2022. (ROI Exhibit 8, page 1)
- 18. Bank records show that Respondent made an opening cash deposit totaling \$60.00. A deposit from a money transfer service, Venmo, was also made, which totaled \$1,804.84. (ROI Exhibit 9, pages 1, 3 & 4)
- 19. Respondent stated that he did not keep records or good notes about "who gave what." However, Respondent admitted that the contributions at issue were made in cash. He explained that the cash contributions were received at a small party event to raise money for his campaign. Respondent further explained that someone assisted him in collecting and holding the contributions until the campaign account was created. Respondent stated that he later received the cash contributions via a Venmo deposit. (ROI Exhibit 10, pages 2-3)
- 20. It appears from Respondent's admission and self-reporting that he accepted 19 excessive cash contributions totaling \$1,840.00 though it is uncertain whether the number of contributions and amounts are accurate. What is verifiable is that Respondent received one \$1,804.84 Venmo deposit, which originated as cash per Respondent, and an additional \$60 cash contribution, which was not disclosed.

Alleged Violation: Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes

21. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by certifying that the campaign's 2022 P1 Report was true, correct, and complete when it was not based on

several excessive cash contributions. Further, Respondent certified that the campaign's 2022 P1 and 2022 P2 Reports were true, correct, and complete when they were not based on the identified omissions in the Division's Error Reports.

- 22. Under Section 106.07, Florida Statutes, a campaign treasurer's report is required to contain all contributions received and all expenditures made during the reporting period as well as the date, full name, address, and occupation or purpose associated with each transaction.
- 23. The campaign's 2022 P1 Report was filed on the designated due date of June 24, 2022, and covered the period from June 1, 2022, to June 17, 2022. (ROI Exhibit 8, pages 1 & 6) The report listed 19 cash contributions totaling \$1,800.00, one ActBlue contribution totaling \$7.14, and two expenditures totaling \$1,808.77. (ROI Exhibit 8, pages 1-3) The report omitted the address for the 19 cash contributions and the date for one cash contribution. (ROI Exhibit 8, pages 2) The date for one expenditure was omitted but later added. (ROI Exhibit 8, pages 3 & 6)
- 24. Bank records confirmed the expenditures but showed an opening cash deposit totaling \$60.00, a Venmo deposit totaling \$1,804.84, and one ActBlue deposit totaling \$6.64. (ROI Exhibit 9, pages 1 & 3)
- 25. The campaign's 2022 P2 Report was filed on the designated due date of July 8, 2022, and covered the period from June 18, 2022, to July 1, 2022. (ROI Exhibit 8, pages 7 & 12) The report listed one ActBlue contribution totaling \$179.48 that did not include a date or address. (ROI Exhibit 8, page 8)
- 26. Bank records showed five ActBlue deposits totaling \$114.59 and one unreported expenditure totaling \$19.25. (ROI Exhibit 9, page 1)
- 27. As of June 25, 2024, Respondent has not corrected the campaign's reports. (Attachment C, page 1)
- 28. Respondent stated that he did not keep any records and did not keep up with contributions, rules, or any regulations about campaign financing. Respondent stated that he did not take good notes about "who gave what," so he was not able to provide corrections to the reports at issue. Respondent indicated that he did not familiarize himself with Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, or the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*. (ROI Exhibit 10, pages 2-3)
- 29. It appears that Respondent certified that the campaign's 2022 P1 and 2022 P2 Reports were true, correct, and complete when they were not.
- 30. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. Schmitt v. State, 590 So. 2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).

31. The facts set forth above show that Respondent was a 2022 candidate for State Senator, District 27. Respondent did not violate Florida's election laws when he failed to timely file an addendum to the campaign's 2022 P1 and 2022 P2 Reports because the filing officer's notifications to Respondent were a condition precedent that was not met. Respondent accepted two excessive cash contributions. Finally, Respondent certified that the campaign's 2022 P1 and 2022 P2 Reports were true, correct, and complete when they were not.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find **no probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.07(2)(b)1.**, **Florida Statutes**, and that the Commission find **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating the following:

Count 1:

On June 8, 2022, Christopher Proia violated Section 106.09(1)(b), Florida Statutes, when he accepted a \$60 cash contribution.

Count 2:

On June 16, 2022, Christopher Proia violated Section 106.09(1)(b), Florida Statutes, when he accepted a \$1,804.84 cash contribution.

Count 3:

On June 24, 2022, Christopher Proia violated Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes, when he certified that the campaign's 2022 P1 Report was true, correct, and complete when it was not.

Count 4:

On July 8, 2022, Christopher Proia violated Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes, when he certified that the campaign's 2022 P2 Report was true, correct, and complete when it was not.

Complainant: Division of Elections

On August 29, 2022, the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) received a referral alleging that Respondent violated Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. Commission staff investigated whether Respondent violated the following statutes:

Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, failed to timely make necessary amendments to the 2022 P1 and 2022 P2 campaign treasurer reports; and

Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes, may have certified the 2022 P1 campaign treasurer report was true, correct, and complete when it was not; and

Section 106.09(1)(b), Florida Statutes, may have accepted one or more cash contributions in excess of the \$50.00 per campaign limit, based upon contributions reported during the 2022 P1 reporting period.

I. Preliminary Information:

- 1. Respondent was a 2022 candidate for State Senate, District 27; he was defeated in the general election on November 8, 2022.
- 2. An Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository (DS-DE 9) was filed on May 25, 2022. Respondent was appointed as campaign treasurer. To review the DS-DE 9, refer to Exhibit 1.¹
- 3. Respondent filed a Statement of Candidate with the Division on May 25, 2022, in which Respondent certified he had been provided access to read and understand the requirements of Chapter 106, F.S. To review the Statement of Candidate, refer to Exhibit 2.
- 4. An acknowledgment letter was mailed to the address provided on the DS-DE 9 on May 31, 2022. The letter advised Respondent that all candidates filing reports with the Division are required to file by means of the Division's electronic filing system (EFS). Respondent was provided with a user identification number and initial password allowing access to the EFS.
- 5. The acknowledgment letter also advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms are available on their website, including Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook* and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*. The letter further advised that it was Respondent's responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. To review the acknowledgment letter, refer to Exhibit 3.

¹ A duplicate form was subsequently filed on May 27, 2022.

II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes:

- 6. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by failing to file amended report(s) for the following campaign treasurer report(s) after receiving notice from the filing officer: 2022 P1 and 2022 P2.
- 7. The Division sent correspondence to the address provided on the DS-DE 9 notifying Respondent that one or more campaign treasurer report(s) were incomplete. The correspondence included error report(s) referencing the following report(s): 2022 P1 and 2022 P2. To review the correspondence and errors report(s), refer to Exhibit 4.
- 8. On July 25, 2022, the Division sent a letter marked "Final Notice" with delivery confirmation to the address provided on the DS-DE 9 notifying Respondent that one or more campaign treasurer report(s) were incomplete. The letter included an error report referencing the following report(s): 2022 P1 and 2022 P2. However, delivery confirmation was not provided with the referral. Commission staff requested that the Division provide delivery confirmation, but in response Division staff indicated, "We've located the documents, but the delivery confirmation is missing." Division staff further indicated that they tried without success to pull a new delivery confirmation; "Unfortunately, information over six months old is no longer available on their site." On March 10, 2023, the Division sent another letter marked "Final Notice" to Respondent. However, the second "Final Notice" was not part of the referral, and it was sent several months after the referral was filed. To review the first "Final Notice" and error report(s), refer to Exhibit 5. To review the second "Final Notice" and error report(s), refer to Exhibit 6. To review emails with Division staff regarding delivery confirmation, refer to Exhibit 7.
- 9. As noted above, the "Final Notice" was sent on July 25, 2022. The referral was filed on August 29, 2022. By filing the referral, the Division affirmed that as of that date, the report(s) at issue had not been amended to correct all errors identified by the Division. However, the Division was unable to provide proof of delivery for the "Final Notice" sent on July 25, 2022. The "Final Notice" sent on March 10, 2023, was sent after the referral was filed. To review the report(s) at issue at issue, refer to Exhibit 8.

III. Alleged Violation of Sections 106.07(5) and 106.09(1)(b), Florida Statutes:

- 10. I investigated whether Respondent violated these sections of the election laws by certifying that the 2022 P1 campaign treasurer report was true, correct, and complete when it was not, and accepting one or more cash contributions in excess of \$50.00 per campaign limit, based upon contributions reported during the 2022 P1 reporting period.
- 11. Respondent filed the 2022 P1 report on June 24, 2022. By filing the report, Respondent certified it was true, correct, and complete. In the report, Respondent disclosed receipt of 19 cash contributions, each from a different individual. The date of receipt for 18 of the contributions was June 14, 2022; no date was specified for the final cash contribution. Of the reported cash contributions, 17 were in the amount of \$100.00, one was in the amount of \$85.00, and one was in the amount of \$55.00. The 19 cash contributions thus totaled \$1,840.00. To review the 2022 P1 report, refer to Exhibit 8, pages 1-6.
- 12. I subpoenaed and reviewed bank records from the designated campaign depository. The account was opened on June 8, 2022, upon deposit of \$60.00 in cash. There is no record of another cash deposit in June 2022. However, the bank records show that an \$1804.84 deposit was made via Venmo on June 16, 2022. To review the bank records, refer to Exhibit 9.

- 13. Respondent did not respond to the referral.
- 14. I called Respondent in order to provide an opportunity to discuss the allegations made in the referral. I asked Respondent if any of the cash contributions at issue in the 2022 P1 report were made via an online contribution platform such as ActBlue.² Respondent answered in the negative. Respondent admitted that the contributions at issue were made in cash. He explained that the cash contributions were received at a small party/event to raise money for his campaign. Respondent further explained that someone assisted him in collecting and holding the contributions until the campaign account was created. Respondent stated that he later received the cash contributions via a Venmo deposit. Respondent indicated that he did not keep any records and did not keep up with contributions, rules, or any regulations about campaign financing. Neither did he take good notes about "who gave what," so he was not able to provide corrections to the reports at issue. Finally, Respondent indicated that he did not familiarize himself with Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, or the Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook. To review the phone log, refer to Exhibit 10.







- Why were you unable to correct (and timely) amend the 2022 P1 (6/1 6/17/22) and 2022 P2 (6/18 7/1/22) campaign reports?
 - o Respondent explained: "I'm just a blue collar guy." He also elaborated that he did not keep any records and did not keep up with contributions, rules, or any regulations about campaign financing.
 - Also, he stated he did not take good notes about "who gave what," so he was not able to provide corrections to the reports.
 - Last, he stated that he has not reached out to anyone who contributed or helped the campaign.
- Did you or someone else complete and file the 2022 P1 and 2022 P2 reports?
 - Respondent acted as his own treasurer. He explained that he couldn't find an "actual treasurer," but was told he was allowed to act as his own.
- You reported 20 cash contributions in the 2022 P1 campaign report. Were any of these contributions made via an online contribution platform, like ActBlue?
 - o No.
- Were all these 2022 P1 contributions made in cash (i.e. hard currency)?
 - o Yes.
 - Respondent explained that the cash contributions were received at a small party/event to raise money for his campaign. Also, it appears that these cash contributions were made prior to filing qualifying documents and opening a campaign depository.
 - o Respondent explained that someone assisted him in collecting (and holding) the contributions until the campaign account was created. Later, Respondent stated that he received the cash contributions via Venmo.
 - Note: I asked Respondent to elaborate about who collected cash contributions and who generated the Venmo deposit. Respondent declined to provide the name of the individual.
- If you used an online contribution platform, can you provide these statements?
 - o Respondent explained that he used ActBlue. However, he didn't keep any of the statements. However, he suggested that I could contact ActBlue, as they'd definitely have the records.

 - Yes. Respondent received notice about pending errors. He called the Division about these errors and the redistricting issue (Resp originally filed to run for District 27, but this later changed).

 - o No. Respondent explained that he attended some partisan events and was encouraged by a candidate to run for office. So he did.

- Have you ever held the office of chairperson, treasurer, or other similar position for a political committee or electioneering communications organization? If so, please name each committee, state the office you held for each, and state when you held each office.
 - o No.
- Have you ever prepared or signed a campaign treasurer's report? If so, please state the name of the candidate or committee whose report you prepared or signed.
 - o No
- <u>Do you possess a copy of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes? If so, when did you first obtain it? Have you read it?</u>
 - o No.
- <u>Do you possess a copy of the Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook?</u> If so, when did you first obtain it? Have you read it?

On August 29, 2022, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging that you violated Florida's election laws. I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more **legally sufficient allegations**. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violations:

Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2022 candidate for State Senator, District 27, acting as his own treasurer, failed to timely make necessary amendments to the 2022 P1 and 2022 P2 campaign treasurer's reports, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2022 candidate for State Senator, District 27, may have certified the 2022 P1 campaign treasurer's report was true, correct, and complete when it was not, based on reported cash contributions in excess of the \$50 per campaign limit, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.09(1)(b), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2022 candidate for State Senator, District 27, may have accepted one or more cash contributions in excess of the \$50 per campaign limit, based upon contributions reported during the 2022 P1 reporting period, as alleged in the complaint.

When we conclude the investigation, a copy of the Report of Investigation (ROI) will be mailed to you at the above address. Based on the results of the investigation, a staff attorney will prepare and present a written Staff Recommendation (SR) to the Commission as to whether there is probable cause to charge you, the Respondent, with violating Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. You will have an opportunity to respond to both the ROI and the SR. The Commission will then hold one or more hearings to determine whether the alleged violations occurred and, if so, the amount of the fine to be imposed upon you. Notice will be mailed to you and the Complainant at least 14 days before any hearing at which your case is to be considered.

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(i)3., Florida Statutes, the Commission may enter into a consent agreement with a Respondent to settle a complaint prior to a finding of probable cause. Please note that all documents related to this matter will be mailed to the above address unless you notify us of a new address.

Pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, complaints, investigations, investigative reports, and other documents relating to an alleged violation of Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes, are confidential until the Commission finds probable cause or no probable cause, unless the Respondent files a written waiver of confidentiality with the Commission. The confidentiality provision does not apply to the Complainant or the Respondent.

Should you retain counsel, your attorney must file a notice of appearance with the Commission before any member of the commission staff can discuss this case with him or her.
