ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE

THIS MATTER was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting on August 14, 2024, in Tallahassee, Florida.

On March 6, 2024, Staff recommended to the Commission that there was probable cause to believe that the Florida Election Code was violated. The facts articulated in Staff's Recommendation are adopted by reference and incorporated herein. Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following violation(s):

Count 1:

On August 19, 2022, Angela Chenaille violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when she failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that she would not be filing the campaign's 2022 P7 Report.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by consent order where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s) and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

Second, you may request an informal hearing held before the Commission, if you do not dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to make written or oral arguments to the Commission concerning the legal issues related to the violation(s) and the potential fine. At the request of Respondent, the Commission will consider and determine willfulness at an informal hearing. Otherwise, live witness testimony is unnecessary.

Third, you may request a formal hearing held before an administrative law judge in the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH), if you dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to present evidence

relevant to the violation(s) listed in this order, to cross-examine opposing witnesses, to impeach any witness, and to rebut the evidence presented against you.

If you do not elect to resolve the case by consent order or request a formal hearing at the DOAH or an informal hearing before the Commission within 30 days of the date this Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission, the case will be sent to the Commission for a formal or informal hearing, depending on whether the facts are in dispute. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order.

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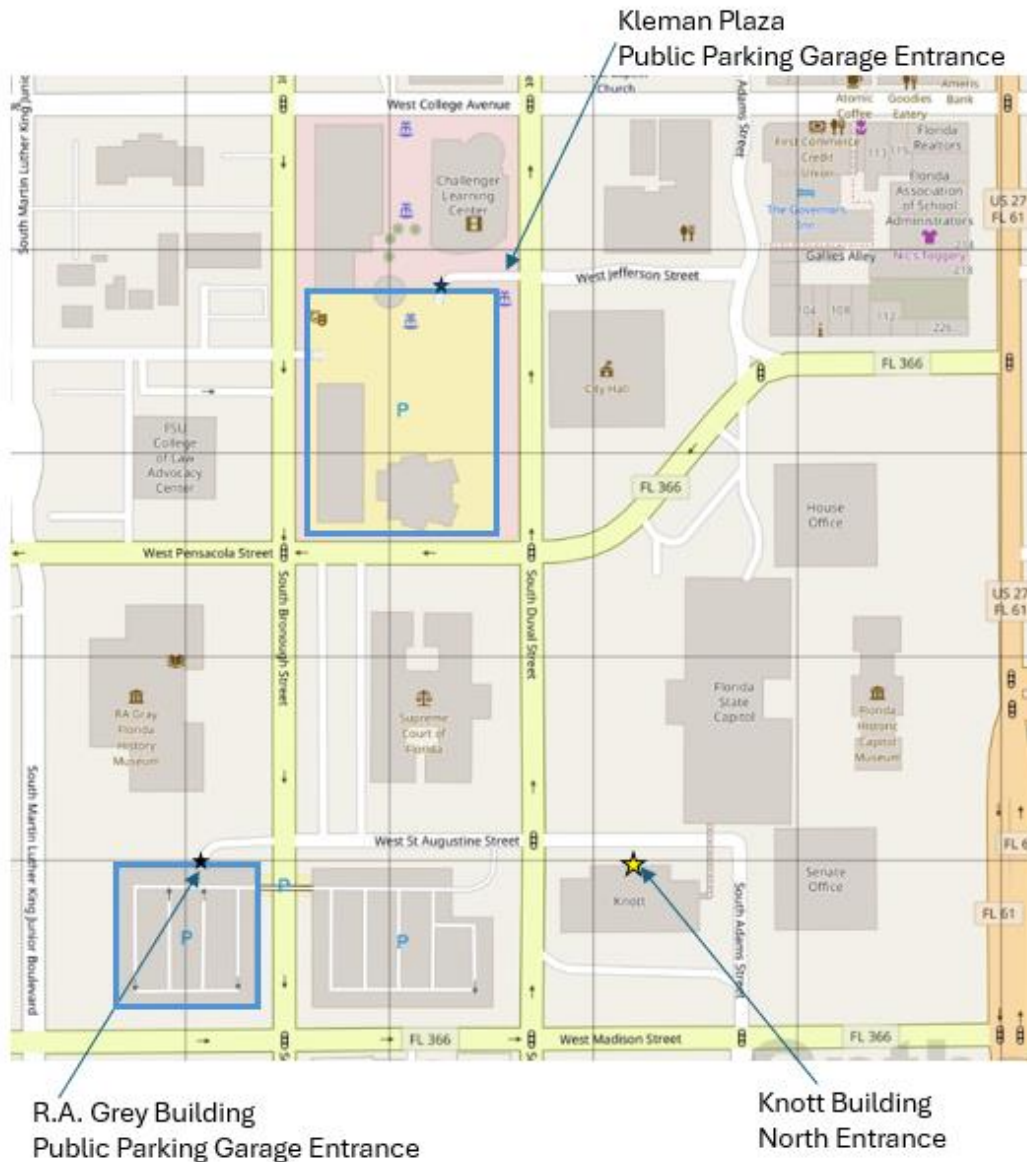

STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the sworn complaint in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on January 10, 2024, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

1. On August 29, 2022, the Florida Elections Commission (“Commission”) received a sworn complaint from Cheryl Futch, Qualifying Officer for the Lee County Supervisor of Elections, (“Filing Officer” or “Complainant”) alleging that Angela Chenaille (“Respondent”) violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

2. Respondent was a candidate for Lee County Commissioner, District 5, in the 2022 election. Respondent’s Statement of Candidate form (“DS-DE 84”) was filed on June 28, 2022. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 1)¹ Respondent was defeated in the general election held on November 8, 2022. (ROI, page 1, ¶1; Attachment A, page 1)

3. By letter dated October 11, 2022, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provision:

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent, a 2022 candidate for Lee County Commissioner, District 5, failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because she had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the 2022 P7 reporting period.

4. On June 28, 2022, Respondent filed her Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates form (“DS-DE 9”) appointing herself to serve as treasurer for the campaign. (ROI Exhibit 1, page 1)

5. On the same date, Tammy Lipa, Administration Support Specialist for the Lee County Supervisor of Elections, sent Respondent an email acknowledging that the Filing Officer had received her DS-DE 9 and that her name was placed on the 2022 active candidate list. (ROI Exhibit 3, page 1)

¹ The Report of Investigation is referred to herein as “ROI.”

6. The acknowledgment email advised Respondent that all candidates filing reports with the Filing Officer are required to use the Campaign Financial Reporting System (“CFRS”) and provided Respondent with a user identification number and initial password to grant access to the CFRS. (ROI Exhibit 3, pages 1-2) The email further advised Respondent that all necessary publications and reporting forms were available on its website and directed Respondent to read the relevant documents. (ROI Exhibit 3, page 2)

7. Pursuant to Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, in any reporting period during which a candidate has not received funds, made any contributions, or expended any reportable funds, the filing of the required report for that period is waived. However, the candidate is required to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that no report is being filed on that date.

8. The *Candidate & Campaign Treasurer Handbook* references the statutory requirement regarding written notification and directs candidates to notify their filing officer in writing on or before the prescribed reporting date that no report is being filed. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 2) The *Voter Focus Campaign Financial Reporting System* guide shows the process through which to notify the filing officer. The guide instructs candidates to select the relevant reporting period and click “Submit Waiver” to indicate the lack of reportable financial activity. (Attachment B, page 2)

9. Respondent failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed for the following reporting period, as set forth in the table below. (ROI Exhibit 6, page 1; ROI Exhibit 7, pages 1, 3, 5, 7, 11, 15 & 19)

10. Respondent did not reply to the Filing Officer or to the Commission’s investigation. (ROI Exhibit 7, pages 1-19; ROI Exhibit 8, pages 1-2)

11. “Probable Cause” is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. *Schmitt v. State*, 590 So. 2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. *Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino*, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).


12. The facts set forth above show that Respondent was a 2022 candidate for Lee County Commissioner, District 5. Respondent failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed for the 2022 P7 reporting period.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find probable cause to charge Respondent with violating the following:


Count 1:

On August 19, 2022, Angela Chenaille violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when she failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that she would not be filing the campaign's 2022 P7 Report.

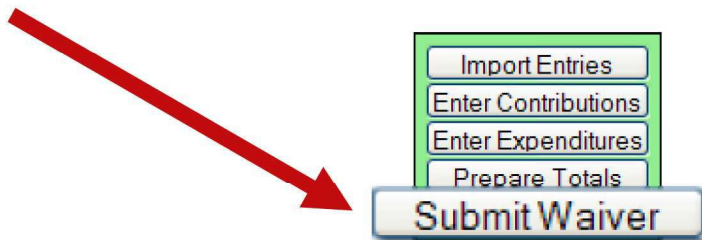



On August 29, 2022, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging you violated Florida's election laws. I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more **legally sufficient allegations**. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violation(s):

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent, a 2022 Candidate for Lee County Commissioner, District 5, failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because she had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the 2022 P7 reporting period.

However, prior to an investigation, you have the option to **resolve your case now by** signing a minor violation consent order and **paying a fine of \$50**, per Rule 2B-1.003, Florida Administrative Code, **rather than the potential \$1,000 per violation** provided for in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes.

If you sign the consent order, **you would not be required to admit or deny the allegation(s)** in the complaint, but you would be required to immediately correct the violation, if feasible.

The signed consent order would then be considered by the Commission at its next available meeting and would constitute final action by the Commission once it is accepted and approved by the Commission. You and the Complainant will receive notice at least 14 days before any hearing at which your case is to be considered.





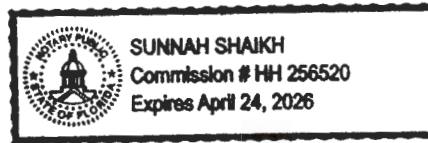

In the event that the CFRS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed before midnight (11:59 p.m.) of the first business day the CFRS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the CFRS was inoperable.

Any candidate failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. 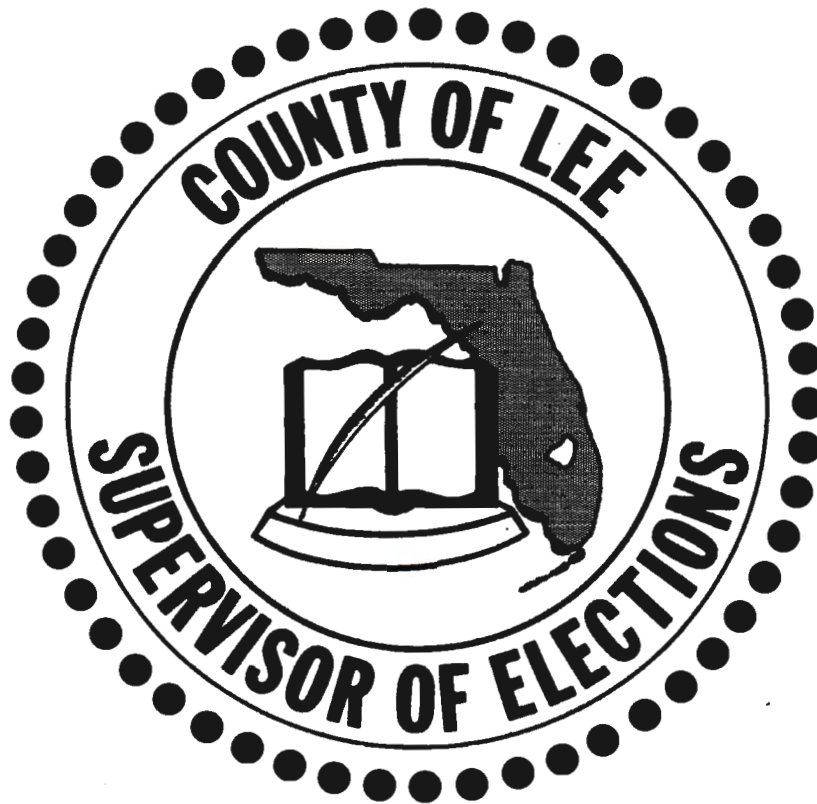

Timely Filing

All Reports and Notices of No Activity filed must be completed and filed through the CFRS before midnight (11:59 p.m.) of the due date. Reports not filed by before midnight (11:59 p.m.) of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the CFRS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed before midnight (11:59 p.m.) of the first business day the CFRS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the CFRS was inoperable.

Any candidate failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. Notices of No Activity do not constitute a report therefore if filed late it will be reported to the Florida Election Commission who will impose their own penalties.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the CFRS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying a Report or Notice of No Activity was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the CFRS is considered to be under oath by the candidate and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes. Additionally, each candidate, campaign treasurer, deputy treasurer, committee chairman, organizational officer, principal officer, or individual receiving CFRS log-in, credentials and PINs will be required to submit a CFRS Affidavit with the Lee County Supervisor of Elections.





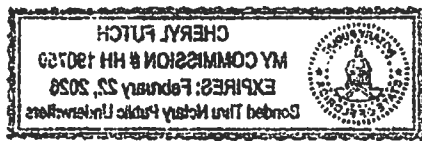
