The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

**SUMMARY:** Progressives for a Better South Florida is a political committee (PC) registered with the State of Florida. The PC's chair is Martin Glacken and its treasurer is Christopher Davey.

The PC is appealing the fine. According to Christopher Davey, they didn't remember to submit the report until April 12, 2024. He says they discovered they were missing the PIN and the password. When Mr. Davey called the Division of Elections on April 15, he was told to fill out the paperwork to have his PIN and password reset. He claims they received credentials by phone for the treasurer and were unaware that the chair also required credentials. In a subsequent call for credentials, they were told it was "qualifying week" and that the request would take longer than normal. He claims they did not receive the final information until April 17th, the day the report was submitted. Mr. Davey requests a waiver of the fines for April 15th, 16th, and 17th due to the circumstances.

- The 2024 Q1 Original Report covers the period from 01/28/24-03/31/24; it was due on 04/10/24.
- The 2024 Q1 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created on 04/15/24 and filed on 04/17/24.
- Progressives for a Better South Florida reported receiving 5 contributions, while making 3 expenditures.
- The Division of Elections provided two notes that pertain to Progressives for a Better South Florida's 2024 Q1 report. On 04/15/24, Division staff provided credentials for Mr. Glacken and Mr. Davey. On 04/17/24, it states, "The PINS were released to Chris Davey per credential request form received on April 17, 2024".

We are writing to you to appeal a \$2,150.00 fine that was assessed against the PC, Progressives for A Better South Florida.

We absolutely concede that we forgot about filing our report on April 10<sup>th</sup>. It was our mistake and we realized it on Friday, April 12, 2024. However, we did not realize, at that time, that we did not have the Password or Chairman's PIN. We did not even realize there was a Chairman's PIN, until the following week when we submitted a request for a new Password.

Unfortunately, by the time we realized this on Friday, tried to login and couldn' the state offices were closed. On Monday morning (April 15<sup>th</sup>), I reached out for the Division of Elections and was told to fill out the password/PIN reset form, and email or fax to the Commission. On Monday, the Commission called me and gave us the Password to the account. But, we did not realize that we were missing the Chairman's PIN. We received the letter with the Treasurer's PIN, but never received a letter with the Chairman's PIN, so we never knew there was one.

This was the week the Division of Election was working on "qualifying". The receptionist told us everyone in the office was working on that and it might take longer than usual to respond.

Well, that was the case. We did not receive a call back from the Division of Elections, with the Chairman's PIN, until Wednesday, April 17<sup>th</sup>, the day we filed the report.

We respectfully request that the fines for the April 15<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup>, and 17<sup>th</sup> of April be waived as it took the Division much longer than usual to respond due to the fact they were working on qualifying. The Florida Elections Commission received a letter from *Christopher Davey* appealing the fine assessed against your committee for failing to timely file a required report. However, Section 106.07(8)(c), Florida Statutes, provide that only the *candidate or chair* of a political committee, may appeal a fine assessed by a filing officer for the late filing of a campaign treasurer's report.

Therefore, to preserve your right to appeal the automatic fine, the Commission must receive your written statement confirming that the person who submitted the initial intent to appeal the fine, was representing you in that request. For your convenience, your signed statement can be submitted via email attachment to, <a href="FEC@myfloridalegal.com">FEC@myfloridalegal.com</a>.

If we do not hear from you within 14 days from the date of this letter, we will assume that the person signing the letter is neither your attorney nor your personal representative and that you have waived your right to appeal. The Commission will then enter a Default Final Order, ordering you to pay the fine assessed by your filing officer for failing to timely file your campaign treasurer's report.

Dear Mr. Glacken:

Our records indicate that you have not filed either your campaign treasurer's report or notification that no reportable activity occurred, whichever is applicable. The filing date was April 10, 2024.

The law (s. 106.07(8)(b), Fla. Stat.) requires the filing officer to immediately notify you about the missed filing date and the automatic fines that will be assessed for late filing of a report, if a report was due.

• If reportable activity occurred and you have not filed a report, statutory fines are automatically assessed as follows until you file your report:

\$50 per day for the first 3 days late \$500 per day for each day after the 3rd day late If the required report immediately precedes a primary and general election, the automatic

fine is \$500 for each late day.

The total fine for the untimely report cannot exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the cover period. Even if you end up filing your report late, we cannot waive the statutory fines. We will notify you of the specific amount of fines owed once you file your report. You have 20 days from the day you receive the notice to pay the fine or to appeal the fine to the Florida Elections Commission.

• If no reportable activity occurred for the report date(s), you are still required to notify us in writing, via the Division's Electronic Filing System, that no reportable activity occurred. No automatic fines are statutorily assessed.

However, in all cases, failure to file and/or untimely filing of a report of reportable activity, or if applicable, a notice that no reportable activity occurred, may constitute an apparent violation of chapter 106, Fla. Stat. If we refer such matter to the Florida Elections Commission, the Commission may subsequently impose a civil penalty for each violation under chapter 106.265(1), Fla. Stat.

This information appears to comply with the requirements of Section 106.03, Florida Statutes, and the name of this organization has been placed on our active committee list as a political committee.

#### Campaign Treasurer's Reports

Your first campaign treasurer's report will be due on **April 10, 2024**. The report will cover the period of January 1 - March 31, 2024 (2024 Q1). All political committees that file reports with the Division of Elections are required to file by means of the Division's Electronic Filing System (EFS).

#### **Timely Filing**

All reports must be completed and filed through the EFS no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the

due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date is subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first three days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

#### **Electronic Receipts**

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the chairperson and campaign treasurer, and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.

#### **Instructions and Assistance**

An online instruction guide is available to you on the EFS to assist with navigation, data entry, and submission of reports. The Division of Elections will also provide assistance to all users by contacting the EFS Help Desk at (850) 245-6280.

It is your responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. 
