#### **ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE**

Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following violation(s):

#### Count 1:

On or about February 10, 2022, NOW PAC of Florida NOW violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2022 M1 Report.

#### Count 2:

On or about March 10, 2022, NOW PAC of Florida NOW violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2022 M2 Report.

#### Count 3:

On or about June 24, 2022, NOW PAC of Florida NOW violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2022 P1 Report.

#### STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.07(7)**, **Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on January 10, 2024, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

- 1. On September 14, 2022, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a referral from the Department of State, Division of Elections ("Division" or "Complainant"), alleging that NOW PAC of Florida NOW ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
  - 2. Respondent is a political committee registered with the Division. (ROI Exhibit 2)<sup>1</sup>
- 3. By letter dated February 9, 2023, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provision:

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent, a political committee registered with the Division of Elections, failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because it had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the following reporting periods:

- 2022 M1
- 2022 M2
- 2022 M3
- 2022 P1
- 2022 P1A
- 2022 P2A
- 2022 P4
- 2022 P5

4. By letter dated July 23, 2013, Kristi Reid Bronson, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, sent Respondent a letter acknowledging that the Division had received its Statement of Organization and Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Political Committees forms. (ROI Exhibit 3, page 1)

- 5. The acknowledgment letter advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms were available on its website and directed Respondent to print out the *Calendar of Reporting Dates* as well as other relevant documents. (ROI Exhibit 3, page 3)
- 6. Pursuant to Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, in any reporting period during which a political committee has not received funds, made any contributions, or expended any reportable funds, the filing of the required report for that period is waived. However, the political committee is required to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that no report is being filed on that date.
- 7. The *Political Committee Handbook* references the statutory requirement regarding written notification and directs political committees to notify the Division by way of the Division's electronic filing system. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 2) The *Political Committee EFS User's Guide* shows the process through which to notify the Division. The user's guide instructs political committees to select the relevant reporting period and place a checkmark in a box titled "Waiver" to indicate the lack of reportable financial activity. (ROI Exhibit 5, page 2)
- 8. Respondent failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting dates that no reports would be filed for the following reporting periods, as set forth in the table below. (ROI Exhibit 6, page 1)

9. Suzanne Southard, treasurer for Respondent, stated that at the close of 2021, the committee's board resigned due to a death in the family or relocation. (ROI Exhibit 7) Ms. Southard stated that she was a first-time treasurer and that she originally submitted notices of no activity on paper as she was unaware of the requirement to file electronically. (ROI Exhibit 10) She stated that she had to contact the Division for filing credentials which took some time to receive. (ROI Exhibits 7 & 10)

- 10. The Division's records show that Deborah C. Deland was appointed as chairperson for Respondent on January 24, 2022, and Suzanne Southard was appointed as treasurer for Respondent on March 7, 2022. (ROI Exhibit 1, pages 3 & 4)
- 11. On April 6, 2022, Respondent's chairperson called the Division regarding resetting her password. In response, the Division emailed the chairperson a copy of the EFS Credential Request Form. (ROI Exhibit 8, page 1) On April 11, 2022, the Division received a letter from Respondent's chairperson requesting EFS credentials. (ROI Exhibit 9, page 3) That same day, the Division provided the chairperson with her credentials and left a voicemail for the treasurer to call the Division to receive her new PIN. (ROI Exhibit 8, page 1)
- 12. On April 14, 2022, the Division received an EFS Credential Request Form requesting the chairperson's password. (ROI Exhibit 8, page 3) That same day, the Division telephoned the chairperson who stated that she already had her password. (ROI Exhibit 8, page 1)
- 13. On May 9, 2022, Respondent called the Division regarding password issues. (ROI Exhibit 8, page 1) On June 9, 2022, the Division received an EFS Credential Request Form requesting the treasurer's password. (ROI Exhibit 8, page 4) That same day, the Division contacted the chairperson and created a new password which was provided to her. The Division confirmed that she successfully logged into the EFS. (ROI Exhibit 8, page 1)
- 14. On March 7, 2022, the Division received a paper copy of a Waiver of Report form ("DS-DE 87"). The form stated that "Joanne Sterner" as a political committee had no reportable financial activity from June 1, 2022, through December 31, 2022. The form was signed by Joanne Sterner and Suzanne Southard on March 1, 2022. (ROI Exhibit 1, page 10; ROI Exhibit 9, page 1) Joanne Sterner is the registered agent for Respondent. (ROI Exhibit 1, page 6)
- 15. On April 11, 2022, the Division received a paper copy of a DS-DE 87 which stated that Respondent had no reportable financial activity from December 1, 2021, through March 31, 2022. The form was signed by Deborah C. Deland on April 3, 2022, and Suzanne A. Southard on March 31, 2022. (ROI Exhibit 9, page 2) The notification was not submitted through the EFS; however, it resulted in timely written notification of no activity for the 2022 M3 reporting period. (ROI Exhibit 6, page 1)
- 16. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. Schmitt v. State, 590 So. 2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).
- 17. The facts set forth above show that Respondent is a political committee registered with the Division. Respondent failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting dates that no reports would be filed for the following reporting periods: 2022 M1, 2022 M2, 2022 P1, 2022 P1A, 2022 P2A, 2022 P4, and 2022 P5.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find probable cause to charge Respondent with violating the following:

#### Count 1:

On or about February 10, 2022, NOW PAC of Florida NOW violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2022 M1 Report.

#### Count 2:

On or about March 10, 2022, NOW PAC of Florida NOW violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2022 M2 Report.

#### Count 3:

On or about June 24, 2022, NOW PAC of Florida NOW violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2022 P1 Report.

#### Count 4:

On or about July 1, 2022, NOW PAC of Florida NOW violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2022 P1A Report.

#### Count 5:

On or about July 15, 2022, NOW PAC of Florida NOW violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2022 P2A Report.

#### Count 6:

On or about July 29, 2022, NOW PAC of Florida NOW violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2022 P4 Report.

#### Count 7:

On or about August 5, 2022, NOW PAC of Florida NOW violated Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, when it failed to notify the filing officer in writing on the prescribed reporting date that it would not be filing its 2022 P5 Report.

#### Report of Investigation for Failure to Notify Filing Officer

Case Number: FEC 22-351

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, failure of a candidate or political committee that did not receive any contributions or make any expenditures during a reporting period to timely notify the filing officer, in writing, that no report is being filed.

**Respondent:** NOW Pac of Florida NOW

#### I. Preliminary Information:

- 1. Respondent is a political committee registered with the Division.
- 2. An Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository (DS-DE 6) was filed on July 22, 2013. Natalie Andre was appointed as campaign treasurer. On July 22, 2020, another DS-DE 6 was filed appointing Cynthia Harris as campaign treasurer. On January 24, 2022, a letter was filed with the Division notifying them that Deborah Deland was Respondent's new Chairperson. On March 7, 2022, another DS-DE 6 with accompanying documentation was filed appointing Suzanne Southard as campaign treasurer. To review the DS-DE 6s, refer to Exhibit 1.
- 3. Respondent filed a Statement of Organization on July 22, 2013. To review the Statement of Organization, refer to Exhibit 2.
- 4. An acknowledgement letter was mailed to the address provided on the DS-DE 5 on July 23, 2013, advising Respondent that all political committees filing reports with the Division are required to file by means of the Division's electronic filing system (EFS). Respondent was provided with a user identification number and initial password allowing access to the EFS.
- 5. The acknowledgement letter also advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms are available on their website, including Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the *Political Committee Handbook*, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*. The letter further advised that it was Respondent's responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. Similar letters were sent to Ms. Deland and Ms. Southard on March 7, 2022. To review the acknowledgement letters, refer to Exhibit 3.
- 6. The *Political Committee Handbook* discusses filing a waiver when there is no activity to disclose. To review the relevant page of the *Handbook*, refer to Exhibit 4.
- 7. The *Political Committee EFS User's Guide* discusses how to notify the Division on the prescribed reporting date that no report will be filed using the EFS. Specifically, the *Guide* instructs the user to click the box next to "waiver" if there is no activity to disclose. To review the relevant pages from the *EFS User's Guide*, refer to Exhibit 5.

#### **II.** Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes:

8. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by not timely notifying the filing officer, in writing, that no report(s) would be filed due to not receiving any contributions or making expenditures during the following reporting period(s). To review Respondent's filing history reflecting the untimely filed notifications summarized below, refer to Exhibit 6.

- 9. Respondent responded to the referral by email sent from Respondent's Treasurer, Suzanne Southard. She stated, "At the end of 2021, the members of the Board of NOW, PAC of Florida, all resigned. Death in the family, moved out of state and several other catastrophic issues for members. It was not a happy time for them. Several of us volunteered to take up the mantle at the beginning of 2022. The paperwork for Treasurer had to be gotten from the west coast of Florida, I live in Deland, east coast. That took some time. When I finally understood what needed to be done for the Florida Division of Elections, several months had past [sic]. I began filling out paperwork for the monthly filing and mailing it in. I finally got a notice saying it had to be done electronically. I sent a letter to Donna S. Brown explaining the issues with our group. It took a while for Debbie Deland, Chairperson and myself as Treasurer to be given passwords to process that. You have to have a password and it has to be mailed to you. The learning curve was slow. Finally, all the reports were processed online. They are now being filed on time and correctly. 99% of the filings for 2022 were waived as we were so new to this, we didn't want to spend the money incorrectly. Each time I processed it with a payment, I called and walked through the process with their help desk to make sure I did it correctly." To review the response, refer to Exhibit 7.
- 10. Division records show several contacts between Respondent's officers and Division staff between April and June 2022 regarding EFS access and password issues. Division records also include two EFS credential requests filed by Respondent in April and June 2022. To review the Division records, refer to Exhibit 8.
- 11. On March 7, 2022, Respondent filed a hard copy Waiver of Report for the period of June 1, 2022, through December 31, 2022; it accompanied the DS-DE 6 that was filed on the same date. On April 1, 2022, Respondent filed a hard copy Waiver of Report for the period of December 1, 2021, through March 31, 2022. To review the Waivers of Report, refer to Exhibit 9.
- 12. I called Respondent's Treasurer, Suzanne Southard, for the purpose of providing an opportunity to discuss the allegations made in the referral. Ms. Southard acknowledged this was her first time working as a treasurer for a political committee. She stated that she initially was not advised of the Division's website, calendar of reporting dates, or anything else from the Division. She advised that prior to her being appointed as treasurer, the committee had a high turnover rate with the administration staff. Initially, she wrote reports out on paper and was not aware the reports had to be electronically filed. She told me that she had to contact the Division to get a new PIN for the committee to file the reports. Once she learned that the reports needed to be electronically filed, she began to work on getting them all filed and has since developed a system to ensure that they are all subsequently timely filed. 

## Florida NOW 2021 State Conference Minutes of Plenary Sessions December 4 and 5, 2021

The Conference was held on Zoom. Two Plenary Session meetings were held on December 4<sup>th</sup> – one at the opening and one following two workshops. A third Plenary Session was scheduled for December 5, 2021, but not convened.

#### **Opening Plenary**

- 1. Vice President Deland called the conference to order at 12:00 noon. After the conference opened, Linda Miklowitz was appointed timekeeper and parliamentarian.
- 2. Rep. Val Demings opened the conference with extended remarks.
- 3. Election Committee Chair Kathy Mayo presided over the elections. She reported the nominations received. No other nominations were made for such positions from the floor, and these nominees were deemed elected as follows:
  - President Debbie Deland
  - Secretary Diane Lebedeff
  - Treasurer Suzanne Southard
  - Legislative Director Linda Miklowitz

For the position of Vice President, Sandra Weeks was nominated; no other nominations were received from the floor, and she was deemed elected. No nominations were received for Membership Director nor for Communications Director; the election for those positions were laid over to the February 6, 2022, State Council meeting.

- 4. The Vice President advised that the 2022 budget will be presented to the next State Council meeting.
- 5. The Florida NOW Educational Fund status and objectives were explained by NOW Educational Fund Chair Terry Sanders and by Ed Fund Board Secretary Diane Lebedeff.
- 6. A report on the current status of the Equal Rights Amendment was delivered by Constitutional Equality Committee Chair Nancy Terrini.
- 7. National NOW President Christian Nunes delivered remarks. National NOW Vice President Bear Atwood congratulated the officers elect.
- 9. Vice President Deland called for a moment of silence to honor the passing of members and allies and closed the plenary meeting at 1:45 pm.

10. An all member workshop on legislative affairs commenced at 1:48 pm, lead by Amy Weintraub and Barbara DeVane; Barbara DeVane's report was supplemented by additional information provided by Lakey Love and Karen Woodall. At 3:05 pm, our second all member workshop on chapter activities opened, lead by Kathy Mayo.

#### Dec. 4th Closing Plenary

11. The day's closing plenary opened at 4:30 pm. The body was presented with a Resolution adopted by the Chapters Back in Action Workshop, permitting and empowering the Florida NOW Board, should the President becomes unavailable or unable to communicate, to authorize official verbal or written communications to the membership in the name of Florida NOW, which resolution reads as follows:

#### RESOLUTION ON FLORIDA NOW MEMBER COMMUNICATIONS

WHEREAS the Bylaws of Florida National Organization for Women ("NOW") provide that "all official verbal or written communications in the name of Florida NOW must have prior authorization from the President"; and

WHEREAS the President may become unavailable or unable to communicate for any number of reasons, which would disrupt, delay or prevent necessary membership communications including the setting of meeting dates and the transmission of significant information;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that if the President becomes unavailable or unable to communicate, the Executive Board upon a majority vote as to such need and of the communication shall be permitted and empowered to authorize an official verbal or written communication to the membership in the name of Florida NOW, including the setting of meeting dates and the transmission of significant information; and

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that this resolution shall be effective from the date of adoption at the 2021 Florida NOW State Conference until the date of the concluding session of the 2022 Florida NOW State Conference.

The resolution was adopted unanimously. The plenary session closed at 4:45 pm.

#### Dec. 5 Closing Plenary

12. A Task Force and Caucus Roundtable was the single workshop scheduled for Dec. 5<sup>th</sup>; it started at 2:05 pm and concluded at 3:20 pm. No resolution was adopted by the concluding workshop. There being no further business to be placed before the conference, a plenary session was not convened.

#### Pin Numbers

Pin numbers are confidential secure credentials that allow you to submit reports and update information. The enclosed sealed envelope provides a confidential pin number for the chairperson. By copy of this letter, a confidential pin number to access the EFS was sent to the treasurer.

Each political committee chairperson is required to provide the Division of Elections with confidential personal information that may be used to allow access in the event that the password is forgotten or lost. When you enter the campaign account screen, there will be a drop down box where you pick a question (such as *What is your mother's maiden name?*) and supply an answer. All passwords and answers to questions are stored as encrypted data and cannot be viewed by Division staff and given out over the phone. Please notify the Division if your credentials have been compromised.

#### **Timely Filing**

All reports must be completed and filed through the EFS no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date is subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

#### Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the chairperson and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.

must file reports on the 60<sup>th</sup> day immediately preceding the primary election and bi-weekly on each Friday thereafter through and including the 4<sup>th</sup> day immediately preceding the general election, with additional reports due on the 25<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> days before the primary election and the general election.

Unless the electronic filing requirements of Section <u>106.0705</u>, Florida Statutes, apply, reports shall be filed no later than 5 p.m. of the day designated. A report postmarked by the U.S. Postal Service no later than midnight of the day designated is deemed timely filed. A report received by the filing officer within five days after the designated due date that was delivered by the U.S. Postal Service is deemed timely filed unless it has a postmark indicating the report was mailed after the designated due date. A certificate of mailing obtained from and dated by the U.S. Postal Service at the time of mailing or a receipt from an established courier company, which bears a date on or before the date on which the report is due, is proof of mailing in a timely manner.

Reports filed with the Division through the <u>Electronic Filing System</u> (<u>EFS</u>) are due no later than midnight, Eastern Time, of the due date.

(Sections <u>106.07</u>, <u>106.0705</u>, and <u>106.141</u>, Fla. Stat.; <u>Chapter 11: Electronic Filing of Campaign Reports</u>)

#### **Penalty for Late Filing**

Any political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first three days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports due immediately prior to the primary and general elections, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.


#### **Notice of No Activity**

When there has been no reportable activity in the campaign account during a reporting period (no funds expended or received) the filing of the report is waived. However, the political committee must still notify the filing officer in writing on or before the prescribed reporting date that no report is being filed on that date. (A notice of no activity filed with the Division must be filed electronically using the EFS.) The next report filed must specify that the report covers the entire period between the last submitted report and the report being filed. Note: Any activity added to the waived report after the due date is subject to a late filing fine.



On September 14, 2022, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging your committee violated Florida's election laws. I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more **legally sufficient allegations**. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violation(s):

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent, a political committee registered with the Division of Elections, failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because it had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during following reporting periods:

- 2022 M1
- 2022 M2
- 2022 M3
- 2022 P1
- 2022 P1A
- 2022 P2A
- 2022 P4
- 2022 P5

However, prior to an investigation, you have the option to <u>resolve your case now by</u> signing a minor violation consent order and <u>paying a fine of \$400</u>, per Rule 2B-1.003, Florida Administrative Code, <u>rather than the potential \$1,000 per violation</u> provided for in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes.

If you sign the consent order, you would not be required to admit or deny the allegation(s) in the complaint, but you would be required to immediately correct the violation, if feasible.

The signed consent order would then be considered by the Commission at its next available meeting and would constitute final action by the Commission once it is accepted and approved by the Commission. You and the Complainant will receive notice at least 14 days before any hearing at which your case is to be considered.
