NOTICE OF HEARING (AUTOMATIC FINE (AF))

A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on, **April 22, 2026 at 10:00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard, at the following location: via Webinar at: **Registration URL** <https://attendee.gotowebinar.com/register/17181422935246175>, **Webinar ID 325-697-827.**

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: Orange County FIREPAC is a (political committee) registered with the State of Florida. The PC's chair is Andre Perez, and its treasurer is Laurita Sweeney.

The PC is appealing the fine claiming that the report was filed in error. According to the treasurer, Ms. Sweeney, she was dealing with multiple family medical issues when the report was due. She initially filed a waiver of the report, recalled that she made a deposit over \$3,000, disclosed the amount on the 2024 Q4 Report, and then realized the transaction was previously disclosed on the 2024 G2A Report. She requests a waiver of the fine due to the circumstances.

The Division's records reflect that an automatic fine of \$776.20 was assessed for the 2024 G2A Report, which involved the same activity. The committee paid the fine.

- The 2024 Q4 Original Report covered the period from 11/01/24-12/31/24; it was due on 01/10/25.
- The 2024 Q4 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created on 01/11/25, filed on 1/11/25, and amended on 02/18/25.¹
- Orange County FIREPAC reported receiving 1 contribution while making zero expenditures. The contribution was dated 09/11/24 and disclosed on the 2024 G2A Report, which covered from 09/07/24-09/13/24.
- FEC staff was advised, "The committee filed a notice of no activity (waiver) on 01/11/25. A waiver is not a report. On 02/18/25, the committee filed a report showing \$3,104.80 of activity. The fine is based on 25% of the activity."
- The Division of Elections does not have any notes that pertain to Orange County FIREPAC's 2024 Q4 Report.

PRIOR CASES: None.

Dear Florida Elections Commission:

I am writing to appeal a late fine of \$776.20 incurred inadvertently during the filing of the 2024 4th quarter Campaign Treasurer's report for PAC 61541.


Unfortunately, during the last 2 months of 2024 and the first of 2025 I was dealing with my mother's and another close relative's death in very rural Georgia, that made accessing the Internet challenging at times. I filed a waiver for the 2024 4th qtr. report to assure it was submitted in the early morning hours of January 11th, realizing I could complete an amendment when I returned to work if necessary. Soon I was called back to Central Florida to deal with my husband's new cancer diagnosis. In trying to stay abreast of my treasurer's duties I recalled that a large deposit of over \$3000 was the last one made and I amended the report apparently on February 18, 2025 to reflect that. This is what triggered the late fine, but in fact that amendment was in error itself. Actually, the correct amount of \$3104.81 had already been captured on 09/11/2024 in the G2A report.

When I researched and realized this was in conflict I contacted the Division of Elections to determine how this could best be corrected and was advised it really could not be at this point, and that a letter was enroute to our PAC with a fine imposed. We do not have daily employees at our building, but I determined after speaking to those employees that check the mail that the letter from the DOE was received on either March 4th or 5th, 2025.

As suggested by Mr. Howard at DOE, I am appealing this fine with the above stated facts, and I also deleted the amendment made on February 18th, 2025, which accurately reflects no activity for the 4th qtr. of 2024. Any necessary banking documents can be provided upon your request. Thank you for your consideration.



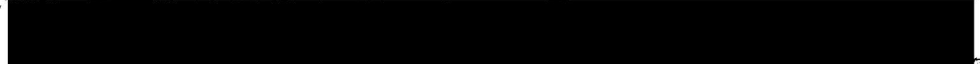

Each political committee chairperson is required to provide the Division of Elections with confidential personal information that may be used to allow access in the event that the password is forgotten or lost. When you enter the campaign account screen, there will be a drop down box where you pick a question (such as *What is your mother's maiden name?*) and supply an answer. All passwords and answers to questions are stored as encrypted data and cannot be viewed by Division staff and given out over the phone. Please notify the Division if your credentials have been compromised.

Timely Filing

All reports must be completed and filed through the EFS no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date is subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the chairperson and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.


