FINAL ORDER

THIS CAUSE came on to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting held on January 7, 1994, in Tallahassee, Florida.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Commission is charged with enforcing Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the campaign financing law.
2. The Respondent's campaign treasurer's report was not received by the filing officer on the due date.
3. The filing officer fined the Respondent for the late filing of the report which Respondent timely appealed, claiming that the report was timely filed.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Florida Elections Commission has jurisdiction over the parties to and subject matter of this case, pursuant to Section 106.04 or 106.07, Florida Statutes.

2. The Commission determined that the report was timely filed.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing facts and conclusions of law, it is hereby

ORDERED that the assessed fine is waived in full.
