If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: Belinda Ford is a candidate for State Representative, District 40 in the 2024 elections. Nicole Inmon is her treasurer.

Belinda Ford is appealing the fine. According to Nicole Inmon, they received notification by mail indicating changes in the filing frequency from monthly to quarterly. Following this change, they did not receive any further communication regarding subsequent changes to the filing schedule. Ms. Inmon states, "It was brought to the attention of myself and the candidate that the filing frequency was modified again in May without any notification being sent to our committee." As such, they respectfully request that these fines be waived "due to the extenuating circumstances surrounding the changes in the filing schedule and the absence of proper notification."

- The 2024 P2 Original Report covers the period from 06/15/24-06/28/24; it was due on 07/05/24.
- The 2024 P2 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created and filed on 07/08/24.
- Belinda Ford reported receiving 4 contributions, while making zero expenditures.
- The Division of Elections does not have any notes that pertain to Belinda Ford's 2024 P2 report.

Dear Ms. Ford:

The Florida Elections Commission received a letter from *Nicole Inmon* appealing the fine assessed against you for failing to timely file a required report. However, Section 106.07(8)(c), Florida Statutes, provide that only the *candidate or chair* of a political committee, may appeal a fine assessed by a filing officer for the late filing of a campaign treasurer's report.

Therefore, to preserve your right to appeal the automatic fine, the Commission must receive your written statement confirming that the person who submitted the initial intent to appeal the fine, was representing you in that request. For your convenience, your signed statement can be submitted via email attachment to, FEC@myfloridalegal.com.

If we do not hear from you within 14 days from the date of this letter, we will assume that the person signing the letter is neither your attorney nor your personal representative and that you have waived your right to appeal. The Commission will then enter a Default Final Order, ordering you to pay the fine assessed by your filing officer for failing to timely file your campaign treasurer's report.

I urge your immediate attention to this matter.

I am writing to formally appeal the fines imposed for late filing of campaign finance reports. As the campaign treasurer, I am very well aware that it is my responsibility for ensuring timely and accurate submission of these reports.


In the early months of our campaign, we received a notification by mail indicating a change in the filing frequency from monthly to quarterly for the remainder of the year and into the new year. Following this change, I did not receive any further communication regarding subsequent changes to the filing schedule. With the subsequent understanding that I would receive notification by mail of any changes, I proceeded to calculate and forecast what the reporting dates would be moving forward. However, it was brought to the attention of myself and the candidate, that the filing frequency was modified again in May without any notification being sent to our committee.

As a result of this lack of communication, three reports were filed late, resulting in fines totaling \$617.83 (\$72.49, \$86, and \$459.34). I respectfully request that these fines be waived due to the extenuating circumstances surrounding the changes in the filing schedule and the absence of proper notification.

As requested, enclosed are the notification letters we received regarding each fine. We have always strived to comply diligently with all reporting requirements, even as newcomers to this process, and we will continue to do so.

Dear Ms. Ford:

Our records indicate that you have not filed either your campaign treasurer's report or notification that no reportable activity occurred, whichever is applicable. The filing date was July 5, 2024.

The law (s. 106.07(8)(b), Fla. Stat.) requires the filing officer to immediately notify you about the missed filing date and the automatic fines that will be assessed for late filing of a report, if a report was due.

- If reportable activity occurred and you have not filed a report, statutory fines are automatically assessed as follows until you file your report:
 - \$50 per day for the first 3 days late
 - \$500 per day for each day after the 3rd day late
 - If the required report immediately precedes a primary and general election, the automatic fine is \$500 for each late day.

The total fine for the untimely report cannot exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the cover period. Even if you end up filing your report late, we cannot waive the statutory fines. We will notify you of the specific amount of fines owed once you file your report. You have 20 days from the day you receive the notice to pay the fine or to appeal the fine to the Florida Elections Commission.

- If no reportable activity occurred for the report date(s), you are still required to notify us in writing, via the Division's Electronic Filing System, that no reportable activity occurred. No automatic fines are statutorily assessed.

However, in all cases, failure to file and/or untimely filing of a report of reportable activity, or if applicable, a notice that no reportable activity occurred, may constitute an apparent violation of chapter 106, Fla. Stat. If we refer such matter to the Florida Elections Commission, the Commission may subsequently impose a civil penalty for each violation under chapter 106.265(1), Fla. Stat.

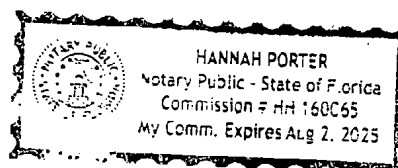
