If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: Building a Prosperous Florida is a political committee (PC) registered with the State of Florida. The PC's chair is Senator Warren Keith Perry and its treasurer is Kena Little.

The PC is appealing the fine, claiming that they "did not receive the crucial dates for the 2024 reporting period." According to Kena Little, the last notification they received was in July 2023, when the report schedule changed to quarterly. She notes that the PAC had been filing quarterly and on time until Q1 of 2024 and claims that they believed the Q2 report was due at the end of June. They filed the report once they received notice from the division. She claims the PAC usually receives late notices in a span of two days, but this specific notice took them eleven days to receive. Ms. Little provided documents to support the appeal.

- The 2024 Q2 Original Report covers the period from 04/01/24-05/31/24; it was due on 06/10/24.
- The 2024 Q2 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created on 06/21/24 and filed on 06/22/24.
- Building a Prosperous Florida reported receiving 1 contribution, while making 25 expenditures.
- The Division of Elections does not have any notes that pertain to Building a Prosperous Florida's 2024 Q2 report.

The Florida Elections Commission received a letter from *Kena N. Little* appealing the fine assessed against your committee for failing to timely file a required report. However, Section 106.07(8)(c), Florida Statutes, provide that only the ***candidate or chair*** of a political committee, may appeal a fine assessed by a filing officer for the late filing of a campaign treasurer's report.

Therefore, to preserve your right to appeal the automatic fine, the Commission must receive your written statement confirming that the person who submitted the initial intent to appeal the fine, was representing you in that request. To whom it may concern:

I am writing in response to your letter dated June 28, 2024 (see attachment #1), concerning the campaign treasurer's report for PAC 69601 that was due on June 10, 2024. We respectfully request an appeal for the late fine of \$4,650.

As the treasurer, I take full responsibility for the delay in submitting the report. However, I believe the penalty imposed on our PAC is unjust, as we did not receive the crucial dates for the 2024 reporting period. The last notification we received, which informed us of the filing dates, was in July 2023 when the report schedule changed to a quarterly basis (see attachment #2).

The fine is due to the late filing of the Q2 report. Our PAC had been filing quarterly and on time up until Q1 of 2024. Despite the Q2 report being labeled as such, it only covers the period from April 1, 2024 – May 31, 2024. We were unaware of this adjustment and had prepared to file at the of Quarter 2(Q2), which we understood to be the end of June.

Upon receiving the initial letter of June 21, 2024(dated June 17, 2024), indicating that the Q2 report was late, we promptly submitted the report on June 22, 2024, to prevent further penalties. Typically, our PAC receives late notices within two days, but we did not receive this particular notice until eleven days after the report was already overdue (see attachment #3). Since then, all subsequent weekly reports have been submitted on time.

Building a Prosperous Florida hereby appeals the late filing penalty. Thank you for your understanding and consideration.

Effective July 1, 2023, Section 106.07, Florida Statutes, has been amended to change campaign finance reporting frequency for candidates and political committees from monthly to quarterly under specified circumstances.

Reporting changes will be made to both election year and off election year calendars. The last monthly report you will file in 2023 is the 2023 M6 report covering the month of June 2023.

Dear Senator Perry:

Our records indicate that you have not filed either your campaign treasurer's report or notification that no reportable activity occurred, whichever is applicable. The filing date was June 10, 2024.

The law (s. 106.07(8)(b), Fla. Stat.) requires the filing officer to immediately notify you about the missed filing date and the automatic fines that will be assessed for late filing of a report, if a report was due.

- If reportable activity occurred and you have not filed a report, statutory fines are automatically assessed as follows until you file your report:

\$50 per day for the first 3 days late

\$500 per day for each day after the 3rd day late

If the required report immediately precedes a primary and general election, the automatic fine is \$500 for each late day.

The total fine for the untimely report cannot exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the cover period. Even if you end up filing your report late, we cannot waive the statutory fines. We will notify you of the specific amount of fines owed once you file your report. You have 20 days from the day you receive the notice to pay the fine or to appeal the fine to the Florida Elections Commission.

- If no reportable activity occurred for the report date(s), you are still required to notify us in writing, via the Division's Electronic Filing System, that no reportable activity occurred. No automatic fines are statutorily assessed.

However, in all cases, failure to file and/or untimely filing of a report of reportable activity, or if applicable, a notice that no reportable activity occurred, may constitute an apparent violation of chapter 106, Fla. Stat. If we refer such matter to the Florida Elections Commission, the Commission may subsequently impose a civil penalty for each violation under chapter 106.265(1), Fla. Stat.

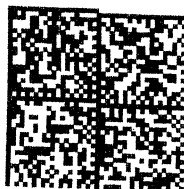

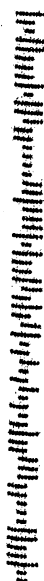

Dear Senator Perry:

Our records indicate that you have not filed either your campaign treasurer's report or notification that no reportable activity occurred, whichever is applicable. The filing date was June 10, 2024.

The law (s. 106.07(8)(b), Fla. Stat.) requires the filing officer to immediately notify you about the missed filing date and the automatic fines that will be assessed for late filing of a report, if a report was due.

- If reportable activity occurred and you have not filed a report, statutory fines are automatically assessed as follows until you file your report:
 - ⊗ \$50 per day for the first 3 days late
 - ⊗ \$500 per day for each day after the 3rd day late
 - ⊗ If the required report immediately precedes a primary and general election, the automatic fine is \$500 for each late day.

The total fine for the untimely report cannot exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the cover period. Even if you end up filing your report late, we cannot waive the statutory fines. We will notify you of the specific amount of fines owed once you file your report. You have 20 days from the day you receive the notice to pay the fine or to appeal the fine to the Florida Elections Commission.

- If no reportable activity occurred for the report date(s), you are still required to notify us in writing, via the Division's Electronic Filing System, that no reportable activity occurred. No automatic fines are statutorily assessed.

However, in all cases, failure to file and/or untimely filing of a report of reportable activity, or if applicable, a notice that no reportable activity occurred, may constitute an apparent violation of chapter 106, Fla. Stat. If we refer such matter to the Florida Elections Commission, the Commission may subsequently impose a civil penalty for each violation under chapter 106.265(1), Fla. Stat.

Each political committee chairperson is required to provide the Division of Elections with confidential personal information that may be used to allow access in the event that the password is forgotten or lost. When you enter the campaign account screen, there will be a drop down box where you pick a question (such as *What is your mother's maiden name?*) and supply an answer. All passwords and answers to questions are stored as encrypted data and cannot be viewed by Division staff and given out over the phone. Please notify the Division if your credentials have been compromised.

Timely Filing

All reports must be completed and filed through the EFS no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date is subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the chairperson and campaign treasurer and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.
