ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE

THIS MATTER was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting on August 14, 2024, in Tallahassee, Florida.

On May 21, 2024, Staff recommended to the Commission that there was probable cause to believe that the Florida Election Code was violated. The facts articulated in Staff's Recommendation are adopted by reference and incorporated herein. Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following violation(s):

Count 1:

On or about April 16, 2020, Jeffrey Alan Siegmeister violated Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes, when he certified that the campaign's 2020 TR Report was true, correct, and complete when it was not.

Count 2:

On or around April 16, 2020, Jeffrey Alan Siegmeister violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when he deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2020 TR Report.

The Commission finds that there is **no probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. 

STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Sections 106.07(5)**, and **106.19(1)(c)**, **Florida Statutes**, and **no probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.141(1)**, **Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on May 10, 2023, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

- 1. On August 31, 2020, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a referral from the Department of State, Division of Elections ("Division" or "Complainant"), alleging that Jeffrey Alan Siegmeister ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. On October 15, 2020, the Commission received an amended referral from the Division.
- 2. Respondent was a 2020 candidate for State Attorney, Circuit 3. Respondent's Statement of Candidate form ("DS-DE 84") was filed on March 27, 2019. (ROI Exhibit 3)¹
- 3. By letter dated November 12, 2021, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate Sections 106.07(5), 106.141(1), and 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, with regard to the 2019 M3, 2019 M7, and 2020 TR reporting periods. By letter dated January 24, 2023, the Executive Director amended the prior letter and notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provisions:

Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2020 candidate for State Attorney, Circuit 3, may have certified one or more campaign treasurer's reports were true, correct, and complete when they were not, based on an apparent surplus after the 2020 TR report was filed, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2020 candidate for State Attorney, Circuit 3, filed a 2020 TR report that may have failed to accurately reflect the disposition of all remaining campaign funds, based upon an apparent surplus balance after the 2020 TR report was filed, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2020 candidate for State Attorney, Circuit 3, may have falsely reported or

deliberately failed to include information in one or more campaign treasurer reports, as required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, based upon an apparent surplus balance after the 2020 TR report was filed, as alleged in the complaint.

- 4. On March 11, 2019, Respondent filed his Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates form ("DS-DE 9") appointing himself as treasurer for his campaign. (ROI Exhibit 2)
- 5. By letter dated March 12, 2019, Kristi Reid Willis, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, sent Respondent a letter acknowledging that the Division had received his DS-DE 9. (ROI Exhibit 4)
- 6. The acknowledgment letter advised Respondent that all candidates filing reports with the Division are required to use the electronic filing system ("EFS") and provided Respondent with a user identification number and initial password to grant access to the EFS. The letter further advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms were available on its website and directed Respondent to print out Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*, as well as other relevant documents. (ROI Exhibit 4)

Alleged Violation: Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes

- 7. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by failing to dispose of the funds on deposit in his campaign account.
- 8. On March 9, 2020, Respondent withdrew his candidacy. (ROI Exhibit 1, page 1) Respondent was required to dispose of the funds on deposit in his campaign account within 90 days after withdrawing his candidacy.
- 9. A subpoena was issued to Respondent's designated campaign depository. The campaign's bank records show that Respondent had a zero balance as of the last day of the 2020 TR reporting period, i.e., June 7, 2020. (ROI Exhibit 6, page 11)
- 10. It does not appear that Respondent failed to dispose of the funds on deposit in his campaign account within 90 days after withdrawing his candidacy.

Alleged Violation: Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes

- 11. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by certifying that the campaign's 2020 TR Report was true, correct, and complete when it was not.
- 12. Under Section 106.07, Florida Statutes, a campaign treasurer's report is required to contain all contributions received and all expenditures made during the reporting period. Additionally, Section 106.07(4)(a), Florida Statutes, provides that each report must also contain the full name, address, and occupation or description of business, together with the amount and

date of such contributions, and the full name and address to whom expenditures have been made along with the amount, date, and purpose for said expenditures.

- 13. On April 16, 2020, Respondent certified the campaign's 2020 TR Report was true, correct, and complete. (ROI Exhibit 5; ROI Exhibit 8, page 1) The campaign's report was incomplete as Respondent failed to disclose an expenditure in the amount of \$2,500 to Respondent's personal account on March 13, 2020, and a contribution in the amount of \$2,500 from Respondent's personal account on April 4, 2020. (ROI Exhibit 6, pages 6 & 8; ROI Exhibit 8, pages 2-6; See ROI, pp. 2-3)
- 14. Respondent stated that he thought he had loaned his campaign \$2,500 so he transferred that amount to his personal account. He stated that once he determined that he did not have that much coming back to him, and that it was not the proper disposal method of remaining funds, he returned the money and wrote a check to a charity. (ROI Exhibit 7, pages 2 & 4) Respondent stated that he did not report the financial activity because the funds were never spent but that it was a series of errors. (ROI Exhibit 7, page 2)
- 15. Respondent's campaign finance activity reported to the Division shows that Respondent received 27 contributions during his campaign including loans from self. Prior to the 2020 termination reporting period, Respondent reported seven loans from self and reported two loans as a negative number indicating that the loans were potentially refunded to self. (Attachment A)
- 16. Respondent certified that the campaign's 2020 TR Report was true, correct, and complete when it was not.

Alleged Violation: Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes

- 17. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by falsely reporting or deliberately failing to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2020 TR Report. The reporting period at issue ran from March 1, 2020, through April 16, 2020. (ROI Exhibit 8, page 2)
- 18. A subpoena was issued to Respondent's designated campaign depository to ascertain whether any contributions were received, or expenditures were made during the relevant reporting period which were not reported or falsely reported.
- 19. Respondent's bank records show one contribution and one expenditure in the amount of \$2,500 each that Respondent failed to disclose on the campaign's 2020 TR Report. (ROI Exhibit 6, pages 6 & 8; ROI Exhibit 8, pages 2-6; See ROI, pp. 2-3)
- 20. Approximately one month prior to the start of the reporting period at issue, Respondent made a similar expenditure in the amount of \$2,500 to Respondent's personal account on January 31, 2020, and a contribution in the amount of \$25 from his personal account to the campaign on February 3, 2020, followed by a contribution in the amount of \$2,475 from his personal account to the campaign on February 20, 2020. The funds transferred to Respondent's

personal account were not returned in full for 20 days. (ROI Exhibit 6, pages 1 & 4) During the 2020 Termination reporting period, the funds transferred to Respondent's personal account were not returned for 22 days. (ROI Exhibit 6, pages 6 & 8) The issuance of funds to and from Respondent's personal account was not reported. (Attachment A)

- 21. Respondent stated that he made the first transfer in error as he thought he transferred \$2,500 from his personal savings account to his personal checking account. He stated that when he discovered the error at the end of January 2020, he transferred the funds back to his campaign account but due to a typo only transferred \$25, not \$2,500. He stated that once he discovered the typo, he transferred the remainder of the funds. (ROI Exhibit 7, page 2)
- 22. Respondent was not a first-time candidate. (Attachment B) Respondent indicated that he was incarcerated at the time he filed his affidavit with the Commission; however, he has since been released. (ROI Exhibit 7, page 1; Attachment C)
- 23. Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, requires candidates to report any contributions received and any expenditures made for the purpose of influencing the results of an election. Respondent deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2020 TR Report.
- 24. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. *Schmitt v. State*, 590 So. 2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. *Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino*, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).
- 25. The facts set forth above show that Respondent was a 2020 candidate for State Attorney, Circuit 3. Respondent certified that the campaign's 2020 TR Report was true, correct, and complete when it was not. Respondent deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2020 TR Report. It does not appear that Respondent failed to dispose of the funds on deposit in his campaign account within 90 days after withdrawing his candidacy.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find no probable cause to charge Respondent with violating Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes, and find probable cause to charge Respondent with violating the following:

Count 1:

On or about April 16, 2020, Jeffrey Alan Siegmeister violated Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes, when he certified that the campaign's 2020 TR Report was true, correct, and complete when it was not.

Count 2:

On or around April 16, 2020, Jeffrey Alan Siegmeister violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when he deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2020 TR Report.

I. Preliminary Information:

- 1. Respondent was a 2020 candidate for election to State Attorney, Circuit 3; he withdrew his candidacy on March 9, 2020. Respondent was not a first-time candidate. To review Respondent's withdrawal and the Division's acknowledgement, refer to Exhibit 1.
- 2. An Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository (DS-DE 9) was filed on March 11, 2019. Respondent was appointed as campaign treasurer. To review the DS-DE 9, refer to Exhibit 2.
- 3. Respondent filed a Statement of Candidate with the Division on March 27, 2019, in which Respondent certified he had been provided access to read and understand the requirements of Chapter 106, F.S. To review the Statement of Candidate, refer to Exhibit 3.
- 4. An acknowledgement letter was mailed to the address provided on the DS-DE 9 on March 12, 2019. The letter advised Respondent that all candidates filing reports with the Division are required to file by means of the Division's electronic filing system (EFS). Respondent was provided with a user identification number and initial password allowing access to the EFS.
- 5. The acknowledgement letter also advised Respondent that all the Division's publications and reporting forms are available on their website, including Chapter 106, F.S., the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook* and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*. The letter further advised that it was Respondent's responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. To review the acknowledgement letter, refer to Exhibit 4.

6. In his withdrawal letter, Respondent stated, "I was advised by your office that I would be advised and cleared on how to donate/close my remaining campaign funds and final reporting requirements after this letter was accepted as a formal termination of my continued candidacy. I look forward to any final requirements after this correspondence has been received and processed." In the Division's letter acknowledging Respondent's withdrawal, the Division cited the requirement of Section 106.141, F.S., to dispose of all funds on deposit in the campaign account within 90 days of withdrawal. To review Respondent's withdrawal and the Division's acknowledgement, refer to Exhibit 1.

II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes:

- 7. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by not disposing of all remaining campaign funds within 90 days of withdrawing. To review Respondent's filing history, refer to Exhibit 5.
- 8. On the date the 2020 TR was due, June 7, 2020, campaign account records reflect that the balance was \$0.00.2 To review the relevant bank statement, refer to Exhibit 6, page 11.
 - 9. Respondent did not respond to the referral.
- 10. In an affidavit, Respondent stated he was unaware of a surplus in the campaign account other than the last expenditure of \$1,790.19, which he indicated was donated to a charity as advised by Division staff. Respondent indicated that if he knew of any more funds, they would have been included with the final donation to charity. To review the pertinent part of the affidavit, refer to Exhibit 7, question 12.

III. Alleged Violation of Sections 106.07(5), 106.141(1), and 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes:

- 11. I investigated whether Respondent violated these sections of the election laws by certifying that one or more campaign treasurer report(s) were true, correct, and complete when they were not, falsely reporting or deliberately failing to include information in one or campaign treasurer report(s), and failing to accurately reflect disposition of all remaining campaign funds in a termination report due to an apparent surplus balance after the 2020 TR was filed.
- 12. I reviewed bank records from the designated campaign depository and compared them with campaign treasurer report(s) covering the following reporting period(s): 2020 TR.³ The results of my review are reflected in the table below. To review Respondent's filing history, refer to Exhibit 5. To review the bank records, refer to Exhibit 6. To review the 2020 TR, refer to Exhibit 8.

13. Respondent did not respond to the referral.

14. In an affidavit, Respondent was asked about the internet transfers of funds to and from his personal account that are reflected in the campaign account records.⁴ Respondent explained that in January 2020, he transferred \$2,500.00 from his campaign account to his personal account in error; it was supposed to have been transferred from his savings account. Respondent stated that once he realized the funds had been transferred from the wrong account, he transferred funds back to the campaign account but mistakenly transferred \$25.00 instead of \$2,500.00 on February 3, 2020. Respondent explained that, upon discovering the "typo," he transferred the other \$2,475.00 back to the campaign account in late February 2020. Relative to the two transfers occurring during the TR reporting period, Respondent explained, "I erroneously believed I had 2500 campaign loaned funds in my account." Respondent stated that after announcing his withdrawal, "I took the 2500 (I thought were my loan funds) and later determining I didn't have that much coming to me AND that was not the proper disposal method of remaining funds, I returned the money and wrote the final amount (1790.19) to a charity." To review the pertinent parts of the affidavit, refer to Exhibit 7, questions 9 and 15.

15. In an affidavit, Respondent was asked why the transfers of campaign funds to and from his personal account were not reported. Respondent stated, "Because it was never spent/re-paid or properly listed as an expenditure...It was an error or more specifically, several errors." When asked what steps he took to verify the accuracy of his reports, Respondent stated, "balanced checkbook, receipts, deposits and corrected any errors when they became known to me." Respondent added that he was "unaware of any errors" when he filed the 2020 TR and thought he corrected errors when he was notified of them. To review the pertinent parts of the affidavit, refer to Exhibit 7, questions 10-11 and 13.

16. In affidavit, Respondent was asked what action he took to determine his responsibilities under Florida's election laws. Respondent stated, "read all the rules & updates; regularly communicated with Division of Elections when first ran/elected in 2012 & qualified (unopposed) in 2016." To review the pertinent part of the affidavit, refer to Exhibit 7, question 6. To review the phone log, refer to Exhibit 9.5

This will acknowledge receipt of the letter informing us of your withdrawal as a 2020 candidate for the office of State Attorney. This information was placed on file in our office on March 9, 2020.

Pursuant to Section 106.141, Florida Statutes, all candidates must, within 90 days of withdrawing their candidacy, dispose of all funds on deposit in the campaign account. You are required to file a 90-day termination report no later than June 7, 2020. You are not required to close the campaign prior to the due date; however, you must have written checks disposing of all surplus funds by this date. On October 15, 2020, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging that you violated Florida's election laws. I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more **legally sufficient allegations**. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violations:

Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2020 candidate for State Attorney, Circuit 3, may have certified one or more campaign treasurer's reports were true, correct, and complete when they were not, based on an apparent surplus after the 2020 TR report was filed, as alleged in the complaint:

Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2020 candidate for State Attorney, Circuit 3, filed a 2020 TR report that may have failed to accurately reflect the disposition of all remaining campaign funds, based upon an apparent surplus balance after the 2020 TR report was filed, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2020 candidate for State Attorney, Circuit 3, may have falsely reported or deliberately failed to include information in one or msore campaign treasurer reports, as required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, based upon an apparent surplus balance after the 2020 TR report was filed, as alleged in the complaint.

When we conclude the investigation, a copy of the Report of Investigation (ROI) will be mailed to you at the above address. Based on the results of the investigation, a staff attorney will prepare and present a written Staff Recommendation (SR) to the Commission as to whether there is probable cause to charge you, the Respondent, with violating Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. You will have an opportunity to respond to both the ROI and the SR. The Commission will then hold one or more hearings to determine whether the alleged violations occurred and, if
