If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal of an intent to revoke a registration,** of a Political Committee, Electioneering Communications Organization, or a Political Party, the Division of Elections has issued you a notice of intent, citing the reasons for which it intends to cancel your registration. SUMMARY: The Honorable Betty C. Resch, Esq., was a candidate for Mayor in the 2024 elections. Sam Goodstein was her treasurer.

Mayor Resch is appealing the fine claiming that the treasurer hit "save" instead of "send" when he filed the report. According to Mayor Resch, Mr. Goodstein did not realize his mistake until they received a letter from the City Clerk. Mayor Resch requests consideration of their mitigating and aggravating circumstances. She states this was her second time running for office without any previous acts or omissions, the late filing was an "uncharacteristic mistake," compliance was immediate, and hardship would occur as "[t]he magnitude of the work involved [for mayor] has had a negative effect on my solo family law practice[,]" making the fine "more deeply felt."

- The 2024 G3 Report shows that it was filed on 03/18/24 at 3:06 PM.
- Betty C. Resch reported receiving 6 contributions while making 9 expenditures.

NOTICE OF APPEAL OF FINES IMPOSED PURSUANT TO 106.07 (8) F. S.

COMES NOW, the undersigned, and files this Notice of Appeal. As grounds for this appeal of the assessed fines in the attached letters from the Clerk of the City of Lake Worth Beach, FL, Melissa Coyne, the appellant alleges the following.

For the letter dated March 18, 2024 as well as the letter dated April 3, 2024, the facts are similar.

March 18, 2024 letter:

The report was due on Friday, March 18, 2024. My treasurer, Sam Goodstein, inadvertently hit "save" instead of "send" when he filled out the report due on the 18th. This is the second campaign that Mr. Goodstein has served as my treasurer. He was very upset when he realized that he had neglected to send the report via email to the city clerk. The report was filed the very next business day, Mr. Goodstein did not realize his mistake until we received the email from Ms. Coyne. No changes were made to the report which was filed, it was literally filed the next business day.

April 3.2024 letter:

Apparently, Mr. Goodstein made the exact same mistake for the report due for the runoff election! He hit save rather than send. Again, the letter from Ms. Coyne alerted us to the problem. Neither he nor I can imagine how he could have done this. He is a seasoned campaign treasurer and has done this service for other candidates. He is meticulous and cautious. He feels terrible that he has exposed me to a potential of \$3,000.00 in fines.

I cannot deny the fact that the reports were submitted one business day late. And as such, find it hard to file a "complaint" against Ms. Coyne. It was her duty to write the letters. The reason for my appeal is the fine amount which has been imposed. F. S. 106.265 (3) allows for some consideration of both mitigating and aggravating circumstances regarding the amount of the fine imposed. To have to pay \$3,000.00 would be a tremendous hardship. The role of mayor pays about \$32,00.00 yearly. The magnitude of the work involved has had a negative effect on my solo family law practice. I don't begrudge the time that

being a successful mayor requires, but it does make the financial bite of \$3,000.00 more deeply felt. There was no intentional action, just the uncharacteristic mistakes and omissions of a volunteer treasurer. There was no malicious intent, it was not a willful act but an unintentional mistake. This is my second run for office and there have been no previous acts or omissions. We did show good faith by filing the report on the following Mondays, so compliance was immediate.

In order not to waive the option of requesting a hearing, I do request a hearing if that is necessary. I am hoping that the Commission will review the facts and that a hearing will not be necessary.

This letter is to assess the fine for the late filing of your G-3 report. The report was due on Friday March 15, 2024 by 11:59 PM and was not received by this office until Monday, March 18.

Reports immediately preceding each primary, general or special election shall incur a fine of \$500 for each day late, however, the fine cannot exceed 25% of contributions or expenditures (whichever is greater) (FS 106.07(8)(b).

The assessed fine is calculated using the \$500 per day for the three days late for \$1500 or the percentage of 25% of your expenditures of \$7,105.97 or \$1,776.49. As the fine cannot exceed 25% of your expenditures, it is determined to be \$1500.

As a reminder, this fine is not an allowable campaign expenditure and must be paid in full from your personal funds in our office by 5 PM on Monday, April 8, 2024, 20 days from this notice according to the same Florida Statute.


