If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: Green Party of Florida is a political party executive committee (PTY) registered with the State of Florida. The PTY's chair was Randy Toler and its treasurer is Aaron Frost. The current chair is Laura Potts.

The PTY is appealing the fine and claims the treasurer was given the incorrect credentials from the Division of Elections. According to Mr. Frost, he was given the chair's information instead of his. He states that he contacted the division the next day and received the correct information to file the report. They request a waiver of the fine due to the circumstances.

- The 2024 Q1 Original Report covers the period from 01/01/24-03/31/24; it was due on 04/10/24.
- The 2024 Q1 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created on 04/10/24 and filed on 04/11/24.
- Green Party of Florida reported receiving 7 contributions, while making 16 expenditures.
- The Division of Elections provided two notes that pertain to Green Party of Florida's 2024 Q1 report. On 04/10/24, the treasurer was given a new password and pin. And on 04/11/24, the note states that Mr. Frost was "inadvertently given the chair pin number instead of his."

Subject: Appeal of Fine - Green Party of Florida

Dear Commissioners,

I am writing to formally appeal the fine imposed on the Green Party of Florida, as I have been directed by the Florida Division of Elections, for the late submission of our most recent Electronic Filing System (EFS) report. As the treasurer of the Green Party of Florida, I need to relay an explanation of the circumstances that led to the delay and respectfully request a waiver of the fine.

On the due date of the fine EFS report, I attempted to file the necessary documentation. However, the Department of Elections HelpDesk incorrectly provided the chairperson's PIN to me instead of my treasurer's PIN, which is required for submission. This error prevented me from submitting the filing before midnight, as the office had closed for the night. I was unable to file the report until the next business day, after contacting the Division of Elections and receiving the correct PIN. During this interaction, I was assured by the Division


of Elections representative that the mistake was theirs and that I would simply need to send this appeal to address the situation.

Furthermore, I would like to bring to your attention that the Division of Elections had incorrectly recorded my home mailing address. As a result, I have not been receiving important notices in a timely manner, leading to the delay of this appeal. Despite updating my address in the EFS several months ago, the notices have not arrived. This has contributed to the delay in receiving critical information and has compounded the difficulties in meeting filing deadlines, otherwise I would not have been filing at the eleventh hour on the night of the due date.

Given these circumstances, I request your understanding and leniency. The delay in filing was due to factors beyond my control, specifically errors made by the Division of Elections in providing an incorrect PIN and transcribing my address incorrectly. I have acted in good faith and have taken all necessary steps to rectify these issues as per instructions.

I respectfully request that the Florida Elections Commission waive the fine imposed on the Green Party of Florida for the late filing of our EFS report. Thank you for your attention to this matter and for your understanding.

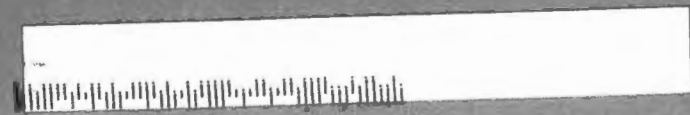

Dear Mr. Toler:

Your campaign treasurer's report, which was due April 10, 2024, has not been received.

Section 106.29(3)(b), Florida Statutes, requires that the filing officer immediately notify you of the failure to file this report and that a fine will be assessed of \$1,000 per day for each late day, although a fine cannot exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the report immediately preceding the general election, the fine shall be \$10,000 per day for each late day.


Once your report is filed, this office will notify you of the specific amount of your fine. Fines must be paid to the filing officer within 20 days of receipt of the payment due notice.

Please be advised, however, that failure to file a campaign treasurer's report may constitute a violation of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, independent of the automatic fine violation referenced above. Therefore, if you fail to file a report, the division will turn the matter over to the Florida Elections Commission.

Section 106.265(1), Florida Statutes, authorizes the Florida Elections Commission to impose a civil penalty up to \$1,000 per count for each willful violation of Chapter 106.

Article 1. Name.

The name of the corporation shall be: Green Party of Florida, Inc. (also known as Florida Green Party, Inc.).

Article 2. Principle Place of Business and Mailing Address.

The principle place of business and the mailing address of this corporation shall be:

Article 3. Purpose.

The purpose of the Green Party of Florida, Inc. is as follows:

- (a) To foster the creation and development of a Green Party in each county of Florida and to support those already existing.
- (b) To facilitate communications and learning about electoral politics and office-holding among all the Green Parties in the State of Florida.
- (c) To work in concert with other groups which strive to create an independent politics that is based on ecological wisdom, grassroots democracy, personal and global responsibility, non-violence, decentralization, community based economics, post-patriarchal values, respect for diversity, social justice and future focus/sustainability.
- (d) To promote Green values within the existing political process.
- (e) The Green Party of Florida, Inc. is organized under Section 527 of the Internal Revenue Code to serve as a separate segregated fund for political contributions in keeping with current IRS and FEC regulations as specified in their current Working Guidelines. No part of the net earnings of the Green Party of Florida, Inc. shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its trustees, officers, other private individuals or organizations organized and operated for a profit (except that the Green Party of Florida, Inc. shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes hereinabove stated).

Article 4. Manner of Election of Trustees.

The manner in which the trustees are to be elected or appointed shall be as set forth in the Bylaws of the Green Party of Florida, Inc.

Article 5. Limitation of Corporate Powers.

The corporate powers authorized under section 617.0302, Florida Statutes (1991), shall not be limited in these Articles of Incorporation.

BYLAWS OF THE
GREEN PARTY OF FLORIDA, INC.
A FLORIDA CORPORATION

Preamble.

The Green Party of Florida, Inc. charts a new course. Being Green means shifting our perception of how we relate to one another - how we relate to human beings, Earth's plants and animals and Mother Earth herself. We are evolving a state of consciousness in which we recognize all aspects of life and components of the earth are an interconnected web. We seek to think globally and act locally.

Article 1. Name of Society.

The name of the society shall be the Green Party of Florida, Inc. (also known as the Florida Green Party, Inc.).

Article 2. Purposes of Society.

The specific objectives and purposes of the Green Party of Florida, Inc. shall be:

- (a) To work in concert with other groups which strive to create ecological wisdom, grassroots democracy, personal and global responsibility, non-violence, decentralization, community based economics, post-patriarchal values, respect for diversity, social justice and future focus/sustainability.
- (b) To foster the creation and development of a Green Party in each county or locale of Florida and to support those already existing, in cooperation with existing area locals recognized by the Greens.
- (c) To facilitate communications and learning about electoral politics and office-holding among all the Green Parties in the State of Florida.
- (d) To work in concert with other groups which strive to create an independent politics that is based on ecological wisdom, grassroots democracy, personal and global responsibility, non-violence, decentralization, community based economics, post-patriarchal values, respect for diversity, social justice and future focus/sustainability.
- (e) To promote Green values within the existing political process.
- (f) To network with the Green Party USA.

The fulfillment of this purpose shall help promote new forms of decentralized political and economic structures based on community grassroots democracy.

Article 3. Members.

Section 1. Membership.

Membership of the Green Party of Florida, Inc. shall be composed of members of the Florida Greens, Inc. or as determined by the Board of Trustees of the Green Party of Florida, Inc.

Section 2. Annual Meeting.

The general membership shall meet at least once each year.

Article 4. Board of Trustees.

Section 1. Membership.

Board of Trustee membership is provided for as follows:

- (a) The Board of Trustees of the Green Party of Florida, Inc. shall be selected from the members of the Coordinating Council of the Florida Greens, Inc.
- (b) The Board of Trustees shall be comprised of not more than thirteen (13) nor less than three (3) members.
- (c) Board of Trustee members must be at least eighteen (18) years of age.
- (d) Board of Trustee membership is established by a process of self-nomination and application to the Coordinating Council of the Florida Greens, Inc. who will appoint members to the Board of Trustees.
- (e) Board of Trustee membership can be ended through:
 - (1) declaration of intent by member,
 - (2) non-renewal of membership,
 - (3) Coordinating Council decision

Section 2. Duties.

The Board of Trustees of the Green Party of Florida, Inc. shall be responsible for keeping the Green Party of Florida, Inc. in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Florida.

Section 3. Annual Meeting.

The Board of Trustees of the Green Party of Florida, Inc. shall meet at least once each year and on an ad hoc basis as necessary. The annual meeting will include, but is not limited to, any actions necessary to comply with the Articles of Incorporation.

Article 5. Corporate Officers.

Section 1. Officers.

Officers required by law shall be members of the Board of Trustees and shall be designated by the Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees shall choose a Scrivener, and it may if it so determines, choose a Chairman and a Vice-Chairman. The Board may also choose a Treasurer and one or more Assistant Treasurer.

Section 2. Election of Officers.

Officers shall be chosen by the Board of Trustees.

Section 3. Officer Qualifications.

Officers shall be chosen from members of the Board of Trustees. Any number of offices may be held by the same person.

Section 4. Term of Office.

Each Officer shall hold office for one year with the term ending upon the election of his successor at the annual meeting of the Board of Trustees or until his earlier resignation or removal.

Section 5. Resignation of Officers.

Any officer may resign at any time upon written notice to the Board of Trustees.

Section 6. Removal of Officers.

The Board of Trustees may remove any officer with or without cause at any time, but such removal shall be without prejudice to the contractual rights of such officer, if any, with the Green Party of Florida, Inc.

Section 7. Vacancies.

Any vacancy occurring in any office by death, resignation, removal or otherwise may be filled for the unexpired portion of the term by the Board of Trustees at any regular or special meeting.

Section 8. Powers and Duties of Officers.

The officers shall have such powers and duties in the management of the Corporation as may be prescribed by the Board of Trustees and, to the extent not so provided, as generally pertain to their respective offices, subject to the control of the Board of Trustees. The Scrivener, among other duties as prescribed by the Board of Trustees, shall be responsible for keeping an updated membership list, taking minutes at annual meetings of the Board of Trustees and the General Membership, and for filing any reports required by law.

Article 6. Decision Making.

Section 1. General Membership.

Decisions of the General Membership shall be made by consensus seeking. If consensus cannot be reached within the time allocated, a vote may be called. A 75% majority is required to call for a vote. A 75% majority is required to confirm decisions brought to a vote. A member shall be eligible to vote or block consensus in a meeting only if the member has been a member in good standing for 2 months prior to the meeting.

Section 2. Board of Trustees.

Decisions of the Board of Trustees shall be made by consensus.

Article 7. Accountability.

All Green Party of Florida, Inc. members shall adhere to the ten key values. Members not adhering to the ten key values may be challenged following standards of due process at the appropriate level of the state structure (local, regional or state) by a duly-selected committee of that body. If they are

found to be participating in activities or behaving in a manner which is contrary to any of the ten key values, their actions may be publicly disavowed.

Article 8. Committees.

Green Party of Florida, Inc. committees shall be provided for as follows:

- (a) Committees shall be established/suspended by decision of the Board of Trustees.
- (b) Committees shall be chaired by active members.
- (c) Committees shall be constituted in ways (consistent with Green Values) that facilitate carrying out the tasks at hand.

Article 9. Amendments.

These by-laws may be altered or repealed, and new by-laws made, by the Board of Trustees, but the general membership may make additional by-laws and may alter and repeal any by-laws whether adopted by them or otherwise.
