ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE

THIS MATTER was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting held on August 20, 2025, at 1:00 p.m. via Zoom teleconferencing.

On September 11, 2024, Staff recommended to the Commission that there was probable cause to believe that the Florida Election Code was violated. The facts articulated in Staff's Recommendation are adopted by reference and incorporated herein. Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following violation(s):

Count 1:

On or around November 3, 2022, Pierre M. Prime violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when he failed to timely file an addendum to the campaign's 2022 P1 Report within seven days after receiving notice from the Department of State, Division of Elections, that the report required amendment.

Count 2:

On or around June 25, 2022, Pierre M. Prime violated Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes, when he certified the 2022 P1 report was true, correct, and complete when it was not.

Count 3:

On or around June 16, 2022, Pierre M. Prime violated Section 106.09(1)(b), Florida Statutes, when he accepted and deposited a cash contribution in excess of the \$50 per campaign limit.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Sections 106.07(2)(b)1., 106.07(5), and 106.09(1)(b), Florida Statutes.** Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on January 19, 2024, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

- 1. On January 17, 2023, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a referral from the Department of State, Division of Elections ("Division" or "Complainant"), alleging that Pierre M. Prime ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
- 2. Respondent was a 2022 candidate for State Representative, District 107; he withdrew on September 1, 2022. (ROI Exhibit 1)¹ Respondent's Statement of Candidate form ("DS-DE 84") was signed September 27, 2021. (ROI Exhibit 3)
- 3. By letter dated February 21, 2023, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provisions:

Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2022 candidate for State Representative, District 107, failed to timely make necessary amendments to the 2022 P1 campaign treasurer's report, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2022 candidate for State Representative, District 107, may have certified the 2022 P1 campaign treasurer's report was true, correct, and complete when it was not, based on a reported cash contribution in excess of the \$50 per campaign limit, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.09(1)(b), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2022 candidate for State Representative, District 107, may have accepted a cash contribution in excess of the \$50 per campaign limit, based upon a contribution reported during the 2022 P1 reporting period, as alleged in the complaint.

¹ The Report of Investigation is referred to herein as "ROI."

- 4. On November 8, 2021, Respondent filed his Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates form ("DS-DE 9") appointing himself as treasurer for his campaign. (ROI Exhibit 2)
- 5. By letter dated November 9, 2021, Donna S. Brown, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, sent Respondent a letter acknowledging that the Division had received his DS-DE 9. (ROI Exhibit 4)
- 6. The acknowledgment letter advised Respondent that all candidates filing reports with the Division are required to use the electronic filing system ("EFS") and provided Respondent with a user identification number and initial password to grant access to the EFS. The letter further advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms were available on its website and directed Respondent to print out Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*, as well as other relevant documents. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 2)

Alleged Violation: Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes

- 7. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by failing to timely make necessary amendments to the campaign's 2022 P1 campaign treasurer's report. *See* Compl.
- 8. Respondent's 2022 P1 report was filed on June 25, 2022. (ROI Exhibit 7, page 6) The report was incomplete when filed. (ROI Exhibits 5 and 6). The report omitted the dates and addresses for six separate transactions that took place during the relevant reporting period, as well as contribution types for four transactions. (ROI Exhibit 5, pages 2-3 and 5-6; ROI Exhibit 6, pages 2-3)
- 9. The Division sent three letters notifying Respondent that the campaign's 2022 P1 report was incomplete, and that Respondent was required to amend the report within 7 days of receipt of the notification. An Error Report showing why the report was incomplete was attached to each notification. (ROI Exhibits 5 & 6) The final notification was confirmed delivered on October 27, 2022. (ROI Exhibit 6, page 4)
- 10. As of September 9, 2024, Respondent has not filed the required amendments to the report. (Attachment A)
 - 11. Respondent did not reply to the investigation. (ROI Exhibit 10, pages 2 and 4)
- 12. Respondent failed to timely make necessary amendments to the campaign's 2022 P1 campaign treasurer's report.

Alleged Violation: Section 106.09(1)(b), Florida Statutes

13. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by accepting a cash contribution in excess of \$50.00. *See* Compl., page 4.

- 14. Respondent's 2022 P1 report shows an undated cash contribution in the amount of \$500.00 received from Kevin Baptiste. (ROI Exhibit 7, page 2)
- 15. A subpoena was issued to Respondent's designated campaign depository to ascertain whether Respondent's campaign received an excess cash contribution. Respondent's bank records show a cash deposit in the amount of \$1,300.00 on June 16, 2022. (ROI Exhibit 8, p. 3-6)
- 16. In addition to the \$500.00 reported cash contribution, four other contributions totaling \$800.00 were disclosed on Respondent's 2022 P1 report, each lacking a date and contribution type. (ROI Exhibit 7, p. 2) The total amount of reported 2022 P1 contributions was \$1,300.00, which could account for the \$500.00 cash contribution from Kevin Baptiste as well as the other four contributions totaling \$800.00.
 - 17. Respondent did not reply to the investigation. (ROI Exhibit 10, pages 2 and 4)
 - 18. Respondent accepted a cash contribution in excess of \$50.00.

Alleged Violation: Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes

- 19. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by certifying that the campaign's 2022 P1 report was true, correct, and complete when it was not, based upon a contribution reported during the 2022 P1 reporting period.
- 20. The 2022 P1 report omitted the date and address for a cash contribution of \$500.00 from Kevin Baptiste. The report also omitted the dates and addresses for five separate transactions that took place during the relevant reporting period, as well as contribution types for four transactions. (ROI Exhibit 5, pages 2-3 and 5-6; ROI Exhibit 6, pages 2-3)
 - 21. Respondent did not reply to the investigation. (ROI Exhibit 10, pages 2 and 4)
- 22. Respondent certified that the campaign's 2022 P1 report was true, correct, and complete when it was not.
- 23. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. Schmitt v. State, 590 So. 2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).
- 24. The facts set forth above show that Respondent was a 2022 candidate for State Representative, District 107. Respondent failed to timely make necessary amendments to the campaign's 2022 P1 campaign treasurer's report. Respondent certified that the campaign's 2022

P1 report was true, correct, and complete when it was not. Respondent accepted a cash contribution in excess of \$50.00.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating the following:

Count 1:

On or around November 3, 2022, Pierre M. Prime violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when he failed to timely file an addendum to the campaign's 2022 P1 Report within seven days after receiving notice from the Department of State, Division of Elections, that the report required amendment.

Count 2:

On or around June 25, 2022, Pierre M. Prime violated Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes, when he certified the 2022 P1 report was true, correct, and complete when it was not.

Count 3:

On or around June 16, 2022, Pierre M. Prime violated Section 106.09(1)(b), Florida Statutes, when he accepted and deposited a cash contribution in excess of the \$50 per campaign limit.

On January 17, 2023, the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) received a referral from the Division of Elections (Division) alleging that Respondent violated Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. Commission staff investigated whether Respondent violated the following statutes:

Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, failed to timely make necessary amendments to the 2022 P1 campaign treasurer's report; and

Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes, may have certified the 2022 P1 campaign treasurer's report was true, correct, and complete when it was not; and

Section 106.09(1)(b), Florida Statutes, may have accepted a cash contribution in excess of the \$50.00 per campaign limit, based upon a contribution reported during the 2022 P1 reporting period.

I. Preliminary Information:

- 1. Respondent was a 2022 candidate for State Representative, District 107; he withdrew on September 1, 2022. To review the withdrawal letter, refer to Exhibit 1.
- 2. An Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository (DS-DE 9) was filed on November 8, 2021. Respondent was appointed as campaign treasurer. To review the DS-DE 9, refer to Exhibit 2.¹
- 3. Respondent filed a Statement of Candidate with the Division on November 1, 2021², in which Respondent certified he had been provided access to read and understand the requirements of Chapter 106, F.S. To review the Statement of Candidate, refer to Exhibit 3.
- 4. An acknowledgment letter was mailed to the address provided on the DS-DE 9 on November 9, 2021. The letter advised Respondent that all candidates filing reports with the Division are required to file by means of the Division's electronic filing system (EFS). Respondent was provided with a user identification number and initial password allowing access to the EFS.
- 5. The acknowledgment letter also advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms are available on their website, including Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*, and the Calendar of Reporting Dates. The letter further advised it was Respondent's responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. To review the acknowledgment letter, refer to Exhibit 4.

¹ Another DS-DE 9 was subsequently filed on June 17, 2022, but Respondent remained campaign treasurer.

² The Statement of Candidate is not date-stamped, but on the Division's website it was dated November 1, 2021.

II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes:

- 6. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by failing to file amended report(s) for the following campaign treasurer report(s) after receiving notice from the filing officer: 2022 P1.
- 7. The Division sent correspondence to the address provided on the DS-DE 9 notifying Respondent that one or more campaign treasurer report(s) were incomplete. The correspondence included error report(s) referencing the following report(s): 2022 P1. To review the correspondence and errors report(s), refer to Exhibit 5.
- 8. On October 25, 2022, the Division sent a letter marked "Final Notice" with delivery confirmation to the address provided on the DS-DE 9 notifying Respondent that one or more campaign treasurer report(s) were incomplete. The letter included an error report referencing the following report(s): 2022 P1. It was confirmed delivered on October 27, 2022. To review the "Final Notice," error report, and the delivery confirmation, refer to Exhibit 6.
- 9. As noted above, the "Final Notice" was confirmed delivered on October 27, 2022. The Division filed the referral on January 17, 2023. By filing the referral, the Division affirmed that as of that date, the report(s) at issue had not been amended to correct all errors identified by the Division. To review the report(s) at issue, refer to Exhibit 7.

III. Alleged Violation of Sections 106.07(5) and 106.09(1)(b), Florida Statutes:

- 10. I investigated whether Respondent violated these sections of the election laws by certifying that the 2022 P1 report was true, correct, and complete when it was not, and accepting a cash contribution in excess of the \$50.00 per campaign limit, based on a contribution reported during the following 2022 P1 reporting period.
- 11. Respondent filed the 2022 P1 report on June 25, 2022. By filing the report, Respondent certified it was true, correct, and complete. In the 2022 P1 report, Respondent disclosed receipt of a \$500.00 cash contribution from Kevin Baptiste on an unspecified date during the reporting period, which covered from June 1, 2022, through June 17, 2022. To review the 2022 P1 report, refer to Exhibit 7.
- 12. I subpoenaed and reviewed bank records from the designated campaign depository. Respondent opened the campaign account on June 16, 2022. On the same date, he made a \$1,300.00 cash deposit. On June 17, 2022, Respondent wrote a check to the Division for his qualifying fee in the amount of \$1,187.88; the check was debited from the account on June 22, 2022. Respondent withdrew \$100.00 via ATM on June 27, 2022, leaving \$12.12 on deposit in the account. To review the bank records from June 2022, refer to Exhibit 8.
- 13. No other activity occurred through the campaign account until August 31, 2022, when a \$10.00 service fee was imposed by the bank. Another \$10.00 service fee was imposed on September 30, 2022, taking the account to a -\$7.88 balance. On November 29, 2022, the bank credited the account \$7.88 to zero out and charge off the account. To review the bank records from July November 2022, refer to Exhibit 9.
- 14. There is no evidence of any checks having been deposited into Respondent's campaign account. Respondent reported a total of \$1,300.00 in monetary contributions on the 2022 P1 report, which corresponds to the \$1,300.00 cash deposited on June 16, 2022. The cash deposit could thus account for the reported \$500.00 cash contribution from Kevin Baptiste at issue and the

other four contributions disclosed on the 2022 P1 report, which ranged from \$100.00 to \$300.00. Respondent omitted dates and contribution types for the other four contributions. To review the 2022 P1 report, refer to Exhibit 7. To review the bank records for June 2022, refer to Exhibit 8.

- 15. Respondent did not respond to the referral.
- 16. I attempted to contact Respondent via phone and email for the purpose of providing an opportunity to discuss the allegations made in the referral. As of the date of this report, Respondent has not returned my phone calls or replied to my email. Therefore, I am unable to ascertain whether he has read Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and/or the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*. To review the phone log and email, refer to Exhibit 10.

On January 17, 2023, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging that you violated Florida's election laws. I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more **legally sufficient allegations**. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violations:

Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2022 candidate for State Representative, District 107, failed to timely make necessary amendments to the 2022 P1 campaign treasurer's report, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2022 candidate for State Representative, District 107, may have certified the 2022 P1 campaign treasurer's report was true, correct, and complete when it was not, based on a reported cash contribution in excess of the \$50 per campaign limit, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.09(1)(b), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2022 candidate for State Representative, District 107, may have accepted a cash contribution in excess of the \$50 per campaign limit, based upon a contribution reported during the 2022 P1 reporting period, as alleged in the complaint.

When we conclude the investigation, a copy of the Report of Investigation (ROI) will be mailed to you at the above address. Based on the results of the investigation, a staff attorney will prepare and present a written Staff Recommendation (SR) to the Commission as to whether there is probable cause to charge you, the Respondent, with violating Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. You will have an opportunity to respond to both the ROI and the SR. The Commission will then hold one or more hearings to determine whether the alleged violations occurred and, if so, the amount of the fine to be imposed upon you. Notice will be mailed to you and the Complainant at least 14 days before any hearing at which your case is to be considered.

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(i)3., Florida Statutes, the Commission may enter into a consent agreement with a Respondent to settle a complaint prior to a finding of probable cause. Please note that all documents related to this matter will be mailed to the above address unless you notify us of a new address.

Pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, complaints, investigations, investigative reports, and other documents relating to an alleged violation of Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes, are confidential until the Commission finds probable cause or no probable cause, unless the Respondent files a written waiver of confidentiality with the Commission. The confidentiality provision does not apply to the Complainant or the Respondent.

Should you retain counsel, your attorney must file a notice of appearance with the Commission before any member of the commission staff can discuss this case with him or her.
