This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 minutes to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 *minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: David Howard was a candidate for Broward County Sheriff in the 2024 elections. Laurie Boutin was his treasurer.

David Howard is appealing the fine and claims the "fine is only due to a flawed submission and incomplete communication processes on the part of Broward County." According to Mr. Howard, the data was uploaded into the campaign reporting system on April 10, 2024. He observed that the report's status was "submitted," but it did not display as "received" since the filing officer was responsible for completing the process. The filing officer's staff called on April 11th but did not state a reason in the voicemail. When Mr. Howard's team returned the call on April 16th, they were informed that the report had not been filed. The team called back on April 17th, provided screenshots showing that the data was uploaded (Exhibit 2), was told that the filing officer's staff could not see the submission, and was asked to unlock the report on the campaign's end so that it could be seen by staff and marked as received. The report was then marked as received on April 17th. On April 18th, staff called and confirmed that the data was submitted on April 10th, but no confirmation email was provided. Mr. Howard asks that the fine be dismissed based on his and his team's efforts to comply despite these circumstances.

The filing officer's notes reflect that staff called Mr. Howard on April 11th, received a call back from Mr. Howard on April 15th, spoke to Jim Lawlor on April 16th, and received the report on April 17th.

- The 2024 Q1 Original Report covers the period from 01/01/24 to 03/31/24; it was due on 04/10/24.
- The 2024 Q1 Report's timestamp shows that it was filed on 04/17/24.
- David Howard reported receiving 37 contributions while making 39 expenditures. No changes were made to the number of transactions or amounts shown on the filing system before the submission was made when compared to the original report.

PRIOR CASES: None.

2B-1.005 Appeal of Fines Imposed by Filing Officers.

- (1) To appeal a fine imposed pursuant to Sections 106.04(8) or 106.07(8), F.S., the party against whom the fine is levied shall file a notice of appeal with the Commission, and a copy filed with the filing officer, within 20 days of the appealing party's receipt of notice that a fine is being imposed. The notice of appeal shall contain:
 - (a) The name, address and telephone number of the appealing party;
 - (b) A copy of the notice of imposition of fine issued by the filing officer; and
 - (c) A request for hearing if a personal appearance before the Commission is desired. If no hearing request is made, the appeal shall be decided solely on the documents submitted by the appealing party and Commission staff.
- (2) Upon receipt of a timely notice of appeal, the Commission staff shall notify the appealing party that the appeal has been accepted. The appealing party shall have 20 days from acceptance of the appeal to submit any documents supporting the appeal. Any subsequent supplemental documents shall be filed no later than five business days before the hearing.
- (3) The Commission shall uphold the fine imposed by the filing officer unless the appealing party demonstrates that the report was timely filed or that there were unusual or other circumstances beyond the control of the candidate or committee that caused the report to be filed late.

2B-1.0052 Fine Imposed; Timely Filed Reports.

2B-1.0055 Late-filed Reports; Unusual Circumstances.

- (1) Unusual circumstances mean uncommon, rare or sudden events over which the actor has no control and which directly result in the failure to act according to the filing requirements. Unusual circumstances must occur within a time period that would clearly prevent the person legally responsible for filing the report from doing so in a timely manner. Unusual circumstances shall include, but are not limited to, the following circumstances:
 - (a) Natural disaster or other emergency that prevented timely filing, Evidence submitted shall include copies of newspaper reports or other documents from an independent and reliable source that document the nature, date, and location of the natural disaster or emergency.
 - (b) Death of the candidate or campaign treasurer or an immediate family member of the candidate or campaign treasurer Evidence submitted shall include a copy of the death certificate, newspaper obituary, or funeral program or notice.
 - (c) Serious illness, disability or non-elective surgery of the candidate or campaign treasurer, Evidence submitted shall include a physician's certification on professional letterhead stationery that includes the dates of the illness, disability, or surgery; a statement regarding the period of time that the patient was incapacitated; and a statement that surgery, if any, was not elective. The period of incapacitation may also be shown by copies of hospital records reflecting the dates of hospitalization.
 - (d) Serious illness, disability or non-elective surgery of the candidate's or campaign treasurer's immediate family member, Evidence submitted shall include evidence of the candidate or treasurer's relationship to the family member, the location of the family member, and the reason the candidate or campaign treasurer's presence was required. Evidence submitted shall also include a physician's certification on professional letterhead stationery that includes the dates of the illness, disability or surgery; a statement regarding the period of time that the patient was incapacitated; a statement that surgery, if any, was not elective; and a statement that the patient required the care of a family member.
 - (e) Computer or equipment failure caused by events that could not have been anticipated and that made timely filing of the report impossible.

- (f) The abrupt and unexpected loss of the campaign treasurer; over which the appealing party had no control. The loss of the campaign treasurer shall not constitute unusual circumstances if the appealing party failed to monitor the campaign treasurer's performance before his or her departure or if' the appealing party failed to assure prompt preparation of the report after the treasurer's departure.
- (g) Failure of the filing officer to e-mail, telephone, or mail a letter to the candidate, chairman of a political committee, or treasurer of a committee of continuous existence that a report is late no later than seven days after the report was due shall constitute unusual circumstances if the appealing party establishes that lack of notice clearly interfered with the timely filing of the report. The fine imposed by the filing officer shall be reduced to the amount that would have been imposed had the report been filed 13 days.
- (2) Unusual circumstances shall not include:
 - (a) Failure of the United States Postal Service or other mail delivery service to postmark an envelope, legibly postmark an envelope, or timely deliver mail.
 - (b) Failure of the sender to affix sufficient postage to a report that is being mailed.

Dear Commission,

We are writing today to appeal the late report fine that was issued on April 22, 2024 (see exhibit 1). We feel that the fine is excessive and because of the facts listed below, unnecessary.

On April 10, 2024, we uploaded the data into the Broward County campaign reporting system. The status of the report read "submitted" with the total of the contributions and expenses matching our upload. It did not read received as it is the responsibility of the Broward County to complete that process on April 11, 2024.

On April 11, 2024, the Broward election office left a message on our voicemail system without a reason for the call. No message was left on the candidate's cell phone, nor was an email sent to the candidate. Both communication methods are available to the Broward County but were not used.

On April 16, 2024, we contacted Broward County and spoke to Claudette Hamilton, who informed us that the report was not filed. We informed her that the data was uploaded on the 10th.

On April 17, 2024, we again contacted Ms. Hamilton and again informed her that the data was submitted and then forward her the screen shot (see exhibit 2) that shows the data was loaded. She stated that she could not see our submission and indicated that a certified letter was sent on April 11th (see Exhibit 3) to notify us of the issue. The letter was dated April 15th, postage was added on April 17th and the US Postage Service corrected PO Box number on April 22nd. Mrs. Hamilton upon receiving the screen shot instructed us to reopen the report, so she could see it in her system and mark it received. We requested that she contact the software vendor to determine the date of our submission and why she was unable to see our data on the 10th. The report was marked received on the 17th. Note – the Exhibit 2 shows that the report was only 6 days late, but we were fined for being 7 days late.

On April 18, 2024, Ms. Hamilton contacted us via telephone and confirmed that the data was submitted on the 10th and she was unaware of a system report that would have confirmed this on the 10th. We requested an email confirming these facts, but have not received such a confirmation.

The facts above provide us with our reasons for appealing this fine. We feel that since the Broward County does not allow candidates to fully file reports, they become a part of the submission process which make them equally responsible for the on-time delivery of those reports. Broward County's procedure to wait a day before accepting reports also contributes to delays in reporting. Further the fact that Broward County did not communicate the issue in a manner of their described processes (voice mail that lack a concern, certified mail was sent after the issue was resolved, and no call to a secondary cell phone number) or with the level of import that is necessary for such a matter; and no email notification was sent when it was an available option, are the central reasons for why we feel that this is an excessive fine.

We ask that the fine be removed as we demonstrated our efforts to comply with the requirements and this fine is only due to a flawed submission and incomplete communication processes on the part of Broward County. We further believe that including the weekend in the calculation for the fine is unfair as there is not fair way for a campaign to correct an error that it does not believe has occurred, is aware of, or is incapable of correcting on their own.

Your Campaign Treasurer's Report (Q1) which was due 4/10/2024, covering the period 1/1/2024 to 3/31/2024 was not received until 4/17/2024. According to Section 106.07(8)(b), Florida Statutes, a fine of \$50 per day for the first three days late and \$500 each day thereafter, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report shall be assessed. **Therefore, you are fined** \$2,150.00, 3 days at \$50 per day and 4 days at \$500 per day.

The fine shall be paid to the Supervisor of Elections within 20 days of receipt of this notice unless appealed to the Florida Elections Commission, 107 West Gaines Street, Suite 224, Tallahassee, FL 32399-1050. Section 106.7(8)(c), Florida Statutes, provides for appealing or disputing the assessed fine by submitting a notice of appeal in writing to the Florida Elections Commission within 20 days of the date of receipt of the notice of payment due, stating any unusual circumstances surrounding the failure to file on the designated due date. A failure to file such notice will constitute a waiver of the right of appeal.

Moreover, the notice of appeal must be accompanied by any and all supporting evidence you wish the Commission to consider in making its determination. Examples of such evidence that the Florida Elections Commission will consider are: 1) an affidavit attesting, in specific detail, to a timely mailing; 2) an affidavit or letter from the post office documenting a mailing problem; or 3) an affidavit or statement from an attending physician or a hospital bill, setting forth specific dates, if there is a health-related reason as to why your report was not timely filed.

Page - 2 -

If you fail to submit documentation or evidence demonstrating the unusual circumstances which prevented you from timely filing your report within the 20 day period stated above, no documentation or evidence submitted thereafter will be considered by the Florida Elections Commission.

You also have the right to a hearing before the Commission. However, if you desire a hearing before the Commission, you must request such hearing in the notice of appeal within the 20 days of receipt of this notice. If no timely request for hearing is made in your notice of appeal, you will be deemed to have waived your right to a hearing and the Commission's determination shall be based upon the written record.

We urge your prompt attention to this matter.

Your Treasurer's Report (Q1) which was due as required by Florida law on 4/10/2024, covering the period 1/1/2024 through 3/31/2024 has not been received by this office. Section 106.07(8)(b) Florida Statutes, requires that the Broward Supervisor Of Elections notify you of the failure to file this report and that a fine of \$50 per day for the first three days late and \$500 per day for each day late thereafter will be assessed. Once your report is received, this office will notify you of the specific amount of your statutory fine. Fines must be paid to the Broward Supervisor Of Elections within 20 days of receipt of notice, unless appealed to the Florida Elections Commission. Section 106.7(8)(c), Florida Statutes provides for appealing the assessed fine by submitting a written notice of appeal to the Florida Elections Commission within 20 days of the date of receipt of the notice of payment due. A failure to file such notice constitutes a waiver of this right of appeal.

A willful failure to file a campaign treasurer's report constitutes a violation of Florida law, independent of the automatic fine violation referenced above. Therefore, if you fail to file a report, such failure is a willful violation of Florida law and this office will refer the matter to the Florida Elections Commission for prosecution. Section 106.265(1), Florida Statutes authorizes the Florida Elections Commission, upon finding a willful violation of Florida law, to impose a civil penalty up to \$1,000 per count for each violation. Additionally the knowing, willful and deliberate failure to file a report constitutes a misdemeanor criminal offense.




