A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on, **August 19, 2025 at 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard**, at the following location: **Virtual Meeting via Webinar link: <https://register.gotowebinar.com/register/3863768971242962781> and Webinar ID 748-293-987.**

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: The Honorable Gary L. Wilkinson was a candidate for Circuit Judge, Circuit 4, Group 24, in the 2024 elections. William J. Scott was his treasurer. Ronald G. Meyer, Esq. is representing Judge Wilkinson in this matter.

Judge Wilkinson is appealing the fine. According to Ronald Meyer, Esq., Judge Wilkinson promised all contributors that their donations would be refunded if no one qualified against him. Judge Wilkinson was elected without opposition and fulfilled his promise by issuing refund checks in June 2024. The campaign's treasurer, William Scott, believed that all refund checks had to clear and the campaign account had to close before the TR Report could be filed. As some checks had not been cashed, the treasurer filed a waiver believing it could be amended without penalty. On the day the waiver was filed, the treasurer contacted the Division, asked about the waiver, and confirmed that nothing else was needed by the campaign. The treasurer provided a declaration detailing his communications with the Division.

- The 2024 TR Original Report covers the period from 06/01/24-07/25/24; it was due on 07/25/24.
- The 2024 TR Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created and filed on 07/31/24.¹
- Judge Wilkinson reported receiving zero contributions while making 84 expenditures. Except for Judge Wilkinson's loan repayment, all expenditures were contribution refunds.
- FEC staff was advised, "The candidate filed a notice of no activity (waiver) on 07/31/24. A waiver is not a report. On 09/09/24, the candidate filed a report showing \$80,533.48 of activity. The fine is based on 25% of the activity.
- The Division does not have any notes that pertain to Judge Wilkinson's 2024 TR Report. However, on 04/16/25, a Division representative confirmed that the fine letter amount (\$20,138.37) was incorrect and provided a detailed report of the TR expenditures for FEC review.

Dear Commissioners:

Judge Gary Wilkinson appeals the automatic fine in the amount of \$20,138.37 which was imposed as a result of an amendment being made to a waiver notice which had been filed earlier when his Termination Report became due. We respectfully request that the fine be set aside under the circumstances which are present as stated below.

Initially, we note that the amount of the fine was calculated wrong. Section 106.07(8)(b), Florida Statutes states, in relevant part, that “[f]or reports required under s.106.141(8), the fine is \$50 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater for the period covered by the late report.” That section refers to Termination Reports. Accordingly, the fine should have been calculated at \$50 per day for the 46 days late, or \$2,300, a revision with which FEC and Division of Elections staff agree. Notwithstanding the lowered amount of the fine which should have been imposed, Judge Wilkinson appeals its imposition.

Judge Wilkinson is an incumbent Judge in the Fourth Judicial Circuit. He qualified for re-election during the 2024 election cycle. Shortly after filing his initial paperwork, Judge Wilkinson, on February 2, 2024, contributed \$50,000 of his own money to his Campaign. At about that same time, he advised potential contributors to his Campaign that if nobody qualified against him, he would return the full amount of the contribution made by each contributor. Nobody qualified to run against Judge Wilkinson and he was thus elected without opposition.

Judge Wilkinson paid the \$7,646.52 qualifying fee from his Campaign account and, true to his word, he refunded each contributor the full amount of his, her or its contribution. Other than the filing fee and return of contributions, no other expenditure was made. The checks returning the contributions were sent to contributors during the month of June 2024. The balance in the account, representing the money that Judge Wilkinson contributed, was not immediately refunded to the Judge so that if any unanticipated expense charges had come in, there would be money with which to pay them. No unanticipated expenses came in.

All of the contributors, including Judge Wilkinson, were refunded their contributions on or before July 25, 2024, the date the Termination Report became due.

The Campaign Treasurer believed that in order to file the Termination Report, the refund checks which had been sent to contributors had to clear the bank so that the bank account would reflect a zero balance and be closed. Accordingly, since checks had not yet cleared when the Termination Report came due, the Campaign Treasurer filed a waiver notice erroneously believing that it could be amended, without penalty, when the Campaign bank account was closed after all refund checks had cleared.

I have attached the Declaration of William J. Scott, the Campaign Treasurer for Judge Wilkinson. It explains, among other things, that on several occasions he discussed the status of reporting with Division of Elections' staff. Indeed, on July 31, 2024, when discussing the waiver with the Division, he was told that the report was complete and that nothing else had to be done (Scott Declaration, Paragraph 8). Again, on August 15, 2024, after receiving notice that an earlier report was incomplete, Scott spoke with Tracy Setzer with the Division of Elections about what steps needed to be taken. He was not advised that there were any other problems with the Campaign reporting (Scott Declaration Paragraph 9). Accordingly, in reliance upon the statements made by Division staff, Scott was led to believe the reporting was correct and accurate.

On September 9, 2024, a letter from the Division was received which prompted Scott to call Donna Brown at the Division. She advised Scott that the Termination Report needed to be corrected because it reflected that there was money in the account. Scott advised Ms. Brown that all contributions had been returned to contributors and Ms. Brown advised him that he needed to record each returned contribution in the Termination Report (Scott Declaration, Paragraph 10). Until the September 9, 2024, conversation with Ms. Brown, Scott had not been told there was any problem with the Termination Report during his several conversations with the Division (Scott Declaration, Paragraph 12).

Accordingly, on September 9, 2024, an amendment to the Termination Report was filed by Scott. This precipitated the November 13, 2024, letter from the Division imposing an automatic fine in the amount of \$20,138.37 as a result of the amendment of the waiver notice.

We respectfully submit that the unusual circumstances which are present, including the reasonable reliance the Campaign Treasurer made on statements made by the Division, and the fact that no voter was misled by the delayed correction of the Termination Report, warrants the Commission setting aside the automatic fine.

This Commission has often been confronted with the circumstance, such as is present here, where a filer mistakenly believes that they may amend a "waiver notice" to ensure a correct disclosure of Campaign activities, without such an amendment resulting in punishment. The Commission has, generally, set aside the automatic fine thereby generated because the error is a common one.

The facts here are straightforward. Judge Wilkinson's Campaign raised a total of \$88,180 in contributions with \$50,000 of that amount being contributed by Judge Wilkinson to his own Campaign. The only expenditure made, other than for refunding contributors the amounts they contributed, was for payment of the qualifying fee of \$7,646.52. The remaining balance of \$80,533.48 was returned to contributors, including Judge Wilkinson, who was paid back his \$50,000 contribution less the qualifying fee expense (payment to Judge Wilkinson of \$42,353.48) by July 25, 2024, the date when the Termination Report became due.


However, because of a misunderstanding on the part of the volunteer Campaign Treasurer who believed all of the checks must have cleared rather than have just been issued before they could be reported on the Termination Report, he filed a waiver notice for the Termination Report and then filed an amendment once he was notified to do so by the Division, the checks had all cleared and the bank account was closed.

That simple mistake resulted in the automatic fine equal to 25% of the expenditures being imposed.

We request that the Commission take into account all of the circumstances and reach the conclusion that there has been no effort to misrepresent any contribution or expenditure and that the delayed correction of the Termination Report was because of the mistaken belief that a waiver notice could be amended to correctly display financial activity without incurring a substantial penalty. The Treasurer's reliance on statements from the Division that there were no problems with the reporting also contributed to the delayed correction.

We respectfully ask that the fine be set aside.

DECLARATION OF WILLIAM J. SCOTT

The undersigned, William J. Scott, being duly sworn, hereby deposes and states:

1. I am over the age of 18 and a resident of the State of Florida. I suffer no legal disabilities. I have personal knowledge of the facts stated herein, and if called as a witness would testify completely thereto.

2. I am providing this declaration in *Case No.: FEC 24-454*, pending before the Florida Elections Commission, in which Judge GaryL. Wilkinson is the Respondent.

3. As a volunteer, I served as Judge Wilkinson's campaign treasurer during the 2024 election cycle in which Judge Wilkinson was re-elected without opposition.

4. When Judge Wilkinson announced his campaign for re-election, persons wishing to contribute to the campaign were advised that if nobody qualified to run against Judge Wilkinson, the campaign would refund the full amount of any contribution which was made.

5. Judge Wilkinson contributed \$50,000 to his campaign. Individual contributions totaled \$38,180.

6. At the close of qualifying, nobody filed to run against Judge Wilkinson leaving him unopposed for re-election.

7. During the month of June 2024, I prepared checks refunding contributors their contributions. The last contribution refund was to Judge Wilkinson and was made on July 25, 2025.

8. Because at the time the Termination Report became due on July 25, 2024, many of the checks had not yet been cashed, I contacted the Florida Division of Elections Helpline on July 31, 2024, to review a waiver I had prepared since the campaign account had not yet been closed. I was told at that time that the report was complete and that nothing else needed to be done.

9. On August 15, 2024, I received a letter from the Division of Elections advising that one or more campaign reports were incomplete. I called the Division Helpline and spoke to Tracy Setzer. Ms. Setzer explained the discrepancies (she explained that the date a check is received not the check date should be reported). I was not told of any other problems with the campaign's reporting.

10. On September 9, 2024, I received a letter from the Division dated September 3, 2024, which caused me immediately to contact Donna Brown, the person who signed the letter. Ms. Brown informed me that the Termination Report needed to be corrected because it reflected that there was still cash in the campaign account. I advised Ms. Brown that all contributions had been refunded. Ms. Brown told me that I needed to record each refund check in the Termination Report. I immediately amended the Termination Report to reflect the return of all contributions as advised by Ms. Brown.

11. During my conversation with Ms. Brown, she told me that there was the possibility of a fine of up to \$1,000 being levied against the campaign.

12. Up until my conversation with Ms. Brown on September 9, 2024, I was not made aware of any problem with the Termination Report despite my several conversations with the Division of Elections.

13. I relied on the statement from the Division of Elections' representative on July 31, 2024, that the Termination Report was complete and that no additional action was necessary.



Timely Filing

All reports filed must be completed and filed through the EFS no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the due date. Reports not filed by midnight of the due date are late filed and subject to the penalties in Section 106.07(8), Florida Statutes. In the event that the EFS is inoperable on the due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any candidate failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first three days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the candidate and campaign treasurer, and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.



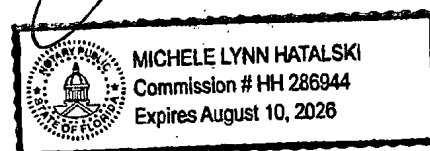


