The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. **SUMMARY:** Randy Wilkinson was a candidate for State Representative, District 49 in the 2024 elections. Mr. Wilkinson was his own treasurer.

Randy Wilkinson is appealing the fine, claiming there was a misunderstanding with the Division of Elections surrounding the due dates. According to Mr. Wilkinson, he switched his district from House 48 to House 49 a few days prior to the close of qualifying. He claims he discussed the deadline verbally with Division staff and was told the report was not due until the end of the month. He believes the staff member misunderstood his question and provided the information for the upcoming report instead of the one that was due. He requests a waiver of the fine due to the circumstances.

- The 2024 Q2 Original Report covers the period from 04/01/24-05/31/24; it was due on 06/10/24.
- The 2024 Q2 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created and filed on 06/18/24. The report was also amended on 07/26/24.
- Randy Wilkinson reported receiving 7 contributions, while making 3 expenditures.
- The Division of Elections provided two notes that pertain to Randy Wilkinson's 2024 Q2 report. On 06/10/24 and 06/18/24, DOE staff members provided credentials to Mr. Wilkinson.

In during that time when the office was handling a myriad of qualifying candidates. I'm sure my case was confusing because just two days before the end of qualifying I was also switching from House48 to the Florida House 49 seat where I live. During that time I asked the busy elections staff person I'd never talked to previously so may have been new, either that or temporary fill-in perhaps from another department. I'd asked for Mr. Howard but was told he'd just retired. Anyway, I think it was an honest misunderstanding on both of our parts. I asked staff when the next report was due the very day or day before that it was actually due but he probably had jumped to the conclusion that I was talking about the one after the current one, while I meant the current one. I would have looked it up myself but he sounded so sure even after I asked him to repeat that I didn't.

A difference in semantics perhaps but that's why I am appealing feeling I have grounds to do so but not blaming staff for honest misunderstanding on both our parts.

Our records indicate that you have not filed either your campaign treasurer's report or notification that no reportable activity occurred, whichever is applicable. The filing date was June 10, 2024.

The law (s. 106.07(8)(b), Fla. Stat.) requires the filing officer to immediately notify you about the missed filing date and the automatic fines that will be assessed for late filing of a report, if a report was due.

- If reportable activity occurred and you have not filed a report, statutory fines are automatically assessed as follows until you file your report:
  - \$50 per day for the first 3 days late
  - \$500 per day for each day after the 3rd day late
  - <sup>®</sup> If the required report immediately precedes a primary and general election, the automatic fine is \$500 for each late day.

The total fine for the untimely report cannot exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the cover period. Even if you end up filing your report late, we cannot waive the statutory fines. We will notify you of the specific amount of fines owed once you file your report. • If no reportable activity occurred for the report date(s), you are still required to notify us in writing, via the Division's Electronic Filing System, that no reportable activity occurred. No automatic fines are statutorily assessed.

However, in all cases, failure to file and/or untimely filing of a report of reportable activity, or if applicable, a notice that no reportable activity occurred, may constitute an apparent violation of chapter 106, Fla. Stat. If we refer such matter to the Florida Elections Commission, the Commission may subsequently impose a civil penalty for each violation under chapter 106.265(1), Fla. Stat.

## **Electronic Receipts**

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed.
