NOTICE OF HEARING (AUTOMATIC FINE (AF))

A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on, **April 22, 2026 at 10:00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard, at the following location: via Webinar at: **Registration URL** <https://attendee.gotowebinar.com/register/17181422935246175>, **Webinar ID 325-697-827**.

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider an **appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: Collier County Citizens Values - Political Action Committee is a political committee (PC) registered with the State of Florida. The PC's chair is Russell Tuff, and its treasurer is Michael Nadolski.

The PC is appealing the fine claiming that the report was filed in error. According to the treasurer, the PC did not make any expenditures to influence Special Election House 24. He mentions that they timely disclosed the transactions on the 2024 G1 Report and tried to delete the transactions from the 2023 SG2 Report, but their efforts were unsuccessful and led to the fine. The treasurer provided screenshots and bank statements for both reporting periods to support the appeal.

- The 2023 SG2 Original Report covers the period from 04/01/23-05/11/23; it was due on 05/12/23.
- The 2023 SG2 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created and filed on 08/15/24.
- Collier County Citizens Values - Political Action Committee reported receiving zero contributions while making zero expenditures. Two contributions were deleted from the report.
- The Division of Elections does not have any notes that pertain to Collier County Citizens Values - Political Action Committee's 2023 SG2 Report.

This letter is a timely appeal of your letter dated February 13, 2025 (attached as Ex. 1), concerning a late filing fine in the amount of \$2,212.50. This fine was imposed as a result of a late filing of the Campaign Treasurer's Report due on May 12, 2023, and filed on August 22, 2024.

The Appeal is based on several errors, primary of which is The Report due on May 12, 2023 was for 2023 Special Election – House 24 which is located in the Miami area. The CCCVPAC supports candidates in the Naples and Collier County area. Moreover, the report filed on August 22, 2024 was filed in error and never should have been filed as the CCCVPAC did not make any expenditures in an effort to influence Special Election – House 24.

The Report for that Special Election – House 24 was for the period April 1, 2023 – May 11, 2023. Attached (Ex. 2) is a copy of the erroneous report showing that it was for Special Election – House 24. Attached also is the Transaction Detail (EX.3) that were incorrectly reported on the May 12, 2023 Report. As shown on the Transaction Detail the two expenditures reported actually occurred on August 18 & 19, 2024 and were related to the 2024 General Election. The transaction details show that we attempted to delete those transactions, but obviously that was done incorrectly as the transactions were not deleted. Attached are the CCCVPAC Bank Statements (EXs. 4&5) for the Period April 1, 2023 – May 11, 2023 which do not show any expenditures made for Special Election – House 24.

The two erroneously reported transactions were correctly reported on August 30, 2024 in the 2024 General Election report (EX. 6) for the August 17, 2024 – August 23, 2024. The Transaction details (Ex. 7) reflect the Transaction which occurred on August 19, 2024 - \$7,250 and August 20, 2024 - \$1,600 and which are supported by the attached August 2024 Bank Statement (ex. 8).

CCCVPAC hereby requests approval to delete the erroneous report dated May 12, 2023 and elimination of the fine in the amount of \$2,212.50.

due date, the report will be accepted as timely filed if filed no later than midnight, Eastern Standard Time, of the first business day the EFS becomes operable. No fine will be levied during the period the EFS was inoperable.

Any political committee failing to file a report on the designated due date is subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first three days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Electronic Receipts

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the chairperson and campaign treasurer, and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.


