If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

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**CONSENT FINAL ORDER**

Respondent, Linda Rowe, and the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) agree that this Consent Order resolves all of the issues between the parties in this case. The parties jointly stipulate to the following facts, conclusions of law, and order.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On November 5, 2021, a complaint was filed with the Commission alleging that Respondent violated Florida's election laws.
2. On June 5, 2023, the Commission entered an Order of Probable Cause finding there was probable cause to charge the Respondent with two counts of violating Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes.
3. Respondent has expressed a desire to enter into negotiations directed toward reaching a consent agreement.
4. Respondent and staff stipulate to the following facts:
  - a. Respondent is the treasurer for Friends of Reggie Gaffney, a political committee registered with the Division of Elections.
  - b. Respondent failed to timely file amendments to the committee's

2021 M7 and 2021 M8 reports.

c. The reports were incorrect or incomplete due to the transactions lacking a zip code or the transactions being reported in the wrong reporting period or the incorrect field.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

5. The Commission has jurisdiction over the parties to and subject matter of this cause, pursuant to Section 106.26, Florida Statutes.

6. The Commission staff and the Respondent stipulate that staff can prove the facts in paragraph four above by clear and convincing evidence and to the Commission's ability to impose a civil penalty in this case.

### **ORDER**

7. The Respondent and the staff of the Commission have entered into this Consent Order freely and voluntarily and upon advice of counsel.

8. The Respondent shall bear her own attorney's fees and costs that are in any way associated with this case.

9. The Commission will consider this Consent Order at its next available meeting.

10. Respondent voluntarily waives the right to any further proceedings under Chapters 104, 106, and 120, Florida Statutes, and the right to appeal this Consent Order.

11. This Consent Order is enforceable under Sections 106.265 and 120.69, Florida Statutes. Respondent expressly waives any venue privileges and agrees that if enforcement of this Consent Order is necessary, venue shall be in Leon County, Florida, and Respondent shall pay all fees and costs associated with enforcement.

12. Payment of the civil penalty by cashier's check, or money order, good for at least



120 days, or attorney trust account check, is a condition precedent to the Commission's consideration of this Consent Order.


**PENALTY**

**WHEREFORE**, based upon the foregoing facts and conclusions of law, the Commission finds that the Respondent violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, and imposes a civil penalty in the amount of \$100.

Therefore, it is

**ORDERED** that the Respondent shall remit to the Commission a civil penalty in the amount of **\$100**, inclusive of fees and costs. The civil penalty shall be paid cashier's check or money order, good for at least 120 days, or attorney trust account check. The civil penalty shall be payable to the Florida Elections Commission and sent to 107 West Gaines Street, Collins Building, Suite 224, Tallahassee, Florida, 32399-1050.



**THIS MATTER** was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting on May 16, 2023, in Tallahassee, Florida.

On October 7, 2022, Staff recommended to the Commission that there was probable cause to believe that the Florida Election Code was violated. The facts articulated in Staff's Recommendation are adopted by reference and incorporated herein. Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following violation(s):

**Count 1:**

On or around October 20, 2021, Linda Rowe violated **Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes**, when she failed to timely file an addendum to Friends of Reggie Gaffney's 2021 M7 report within seven days after receiving notice from the Department of State, Division of Elections, that the report required amendment.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING**

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by consent order where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s) and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

Second, you may request an informal hearing held before the Commission, if you do not dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to make written or oral arguments to the Commission concerning the legal issues related to the violation(s) and the potential fine. At the request of Respondent, the Commission will consider and determine willfulness at an informal hearing. Otherwise, live witness testimony is unnecessary.

Third, you may request a formal hearing held before an administrative law judge in the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH), if you dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-

hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to present evidence relevant to the violation(s) listed in this order, to cross-examine opposing witnesses, to impeach any witness, and to rebut the evidence presented against you.

If you do not elect to resolve the case by consent order or request a formal hearing at the DOAH or an informal hearing before the Commission within 30 days of the date this Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission, the case will be sent to the Commission for a formal or informal hearing, depending on whether the facts are in dispute. **STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION**

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating **Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on September 6, 2022, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

1. On November 5, 2021, the Florida Elections Commission (“Commission”) received a referral from the Department of State, Division of Elections (“Division”), alleging that Linda Rowe (“Respondent”) violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

2. Respondent is a campaign treasurer for Friends of Reggie Gaffney, a political committee registered with the Division. (ROI, page 1, ¶2)<sup>1</sup>

3. By letter dated December 20, 2021, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provision:

**Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes:** Respondent, treasurer for Friends of Reggie Gaffney, a political committee registered with the Division of Elections, failed to timely make necessary amendments to the 2021 M7 and 2021 M8 reports, as alleged in the complaint.

4. By letter dated July 29, 2021, Donna S. Brown, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, sent Respondent a letter acknowledging that the Division had received its Statement of Organization and Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Political Committees forms. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 1)

5. The acknowledgement letter advised Respondent that all committees that file reports with the Division are required to use the electronic filing system (“EFS”) and provided Respondent with a user identification number and initial password to grant access to the EFS. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 1)

6. The acknowledgement letter further advised Respondent that each of the Division’s publications and reporting forms were available on its website and directed Respondent to print out the *Calendar of Reporting Dates* as well as other relevant documents. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 2)

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<sup>1</sup> The Report of Investigation is referred to herein as “ROI.”



7. Pursuant to Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, any report that is deemed to be incomplete by the filing officer must be accepted on a conditional basis. Once the campaign treasurer is notified by certified mail or common carrier as to why the report is incomplete, the treasurer must file an addendum providing all information necessary to complete the report. Failure to do so within 7 days of receipt constitutes a violation of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

8. The committee's 2021 M7 and M8 reports were incomplete when filed. *See* Compl.

9. The Division sent multiple letters notifying Respondent that the reports were incomplete, and that Respondent was required to amend the reports within 7 days of receipt of the notification. (ROI Exhibits 3 & 4) Each notification contained an "Error Report," which explained why the reports were incomplete. *Id.* The final notification was certified as delivered. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 5)

10. Commission staff successfully contacted Respondent by phone on February 25, 2022. (ROI Exhibit 7, page 1) Respondent asked for and was emailed a copy of the referral and Letter of Legal Sufficiency. *Id.*

11. Respondent stated she had not seen any error report but that she was aware of her reporting errors. (ROI Exhibit 7, page 2) Respondent further stated she asked for clarification from a Division representative who said no amendments were necessary. *Id.*

12. The Division's Report Detail notes that Respondent made phone contact with the Division on September 29, 2021. (ROI Exhibit 6, page 1) A Division representative told Respondent to disregard one error but correct all remaining others. *Id.*

13. On January 10, 2022, the Division emailed FEC staff, writing that Respondent has not corrected the reports' errors. (ROI Exhibit 5, page 1)

14. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. *Schmitt v. State*, 590 So. 2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. *Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino*, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).

15. The facts set forth above show that Respondent was a campaign treasurer for Friends of Reggie Gaffney. Respondent failed to timely file the required amendments to the political committee's 2021 M7 and M8 reports within 7 days of receiving notification from the Division that the reports were incomplete and required amendment.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating the following:



**Count 1:**

On or around October 20, 2021, Linda Rowe violated **Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes**, when she failed to timely file an addendum to Friends of Reggie Gaffney's 2021 M7 report within seven days after receiving notice from the Department of State, Division of Elections, that the report required amendment.


**Count 2:**

On or around October 20, 2021, Linda Rowe violated **Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes**, when she failed to timely file an addendum to Friends of Reggie Gaffney's 2021 M8 report within seven days after receiving notice from the Department of State, Division of Elections, that the report required amendment.

### I. Preliminary Information:

1. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by failing to file amended reports for the following campaign treasurer reports after receiving notice from the filing officer: 2021 M7 and 2021 M8.

2. An Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository (DS-DE 6) was filed on July 28, 2021. Respondent was appointed as campaign treasurer for Friends of Reggie Gaffney, a political committee registered with the Division. To review the DS-DE 6, refer to Exhibit 1.

3. On July 29, 2021, the Division sent Respondent a letter acknowledging Respondent's appointment as the campaign treasurer for Friends of Reggie Gaffney. The letter advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms are available on their website, including Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the *Political Committee Handbook*, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*. The letter further advised that it was Respondent's responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. To review the acknowledgement letter, refer to Exhibit 2.

### II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(2)(b)(1), Florida Statutes:

4. The Division sent correspondence to the address provided on the DS-DE 6 notifying Respondent that one or more campaign treasurer reports were incomplete. The correspondence included error reports referencing the following reports: 2021 M7 and 2021 M8. To review the correspondence and error reports, refer to Exhibit 3.

5. On October 11, 2021, the Division sent a letter marked "Final Notice" with delivery confirmation to the address provided on the DS-DE 6 notifying Respondent that one or more campaign treasurer reports were incomplete. The letter included an error report referencing the following reports: 2021 M7 and 2021 M8. It was confirmed delivered on October 13, 2021. To review the "Final Notice," error report and delivery confirmation, refer to Exhibit 4.

6. In an email dated January 10, 2022, Division staff confirmed that Respondent had not correctly amended any of the reports at issue. To review the email from Division staff, refer to Exhibit 5.

7. Respondent did not respond to the referral.

8. As noted below, Respondent claimed she asked the Division for clarification and was told no amendment was necessary. Division records show that on September 29, 2021, which was after the first correspondence regarding this issue was sent to Respondent, she was told by Division staff to disregard the written letter requirement for one error but was also told that there were other errors that needed correcting. Division records also show that Division staff made two further attempts to contact Respondent by phone after the "Final Notice" was sent to her. To review the Division Report Detail, refer to Exhibit 6.

9. On February 25, 2022, I called Respondent for the purpose of providing an opportunity to discuss the allegations made in the referral. Respondent stated she was not notified of any errors but was aware of errors. Respondent further stated that she asked the Division for clarification and was told no amendment was necessary. Respondent indicated that she possessed copies of and had read Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and the *Political Committee Handbook*, though she stated this was the first time she had been treasurer for a political committee. To review the phone log and email, refer to Exhibit 7.

However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

### **Electronic Receipts**

The person submitting the report on the EFS will be issued an electronic receipt indicating and verifying the report was filed. Each campaign treasurer's report filed by means of the EFS is considered to be under oath by the chairperson and campaign treasurer, and such persons are subject to the provisions of Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes.



On November 5, 2021, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging that you violated Florida's election laws. I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more **legally sufficient allegations**. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violation:

**Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes:** Respondent, treasurer for Friends of Reggie Gaffney, a political committee registered with the Division of Elections, failed to timely make necessary amendments to the 2021 M7 and 2021 M8 reports, as alleged in the complaint.

When we conclude the investigation, a copy of the Report of Investigation (ROI) will be mailed to you at the above address. Based on the results of the investigation, a staff attorney will prepare and present a written Staff Recommendation (SR) to the Commission as to whether there is probable cause to charge you, the Respondent, with violating Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. You will have an opportunity to respond to both the ROI and the SR. Notice will be mailed to you and the Complainant at least 14 days before any hearing at which your case is to be considered.

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(i)3., Florida Statutes, the Commission may enter into a consent agreement with a Respondent to settle a complaint prior to a finding of probable cause. If you are interested in entering negotiations directed towards reaching a consent agreement to resolve this matter, please contact the Commission and request to speak with the attorney assigned to this case.
