This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE

THIS MATTER was heard by the Florida Elections Commission (Commission) at its regularly scheduled meeting held on August 20, 2025, at 1:00 p.m. via Zoom teleconferencing.

On September 24, 2024, Staff recommended to the Commission that there was probable cause to believe that the Florida Election Code was violated. The facts articulated in Staff's Recommendation are adopted by reference and incorporated herein. Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following violation(s):

Count 1:

On or about September 5, 2022, Kyle KC Gibson violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when he failed to timely file an addendum to the campaign's 2022 M2 Report within seven days after receiving notice from the Division that the report required amendment.


Count 2:

On or about September 5, 2022, Kyle KC Gibson violated Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, when he failed to timely file an addendum to the campaign's 2022 M3 Report within seven days

after receiving notice from the Division that the report required amendment.

With regard to Respondent's 2022 M5 Report, the Commission finds that the public interest would not be served by proceeding further due to the missing information being available in an earlier report such that the omission did not raise transparency issues. Therefore, the alleged violation of Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, pertaining to the 2022 M5 report, is **DISMISSED** pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(j), Florida Statutes.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO A HEARING

As the Respondent, you may elect to resolve this case in several ways. First, you may elect to resolve this case by consent order where you and Commission staff agree to resolve the violation(s) and agree to the amount of the fine. The consent order is then presented to the Commission for its approval. To discuss a consent order, contact the FEC attorney identified in the Order of Probable Cause.

Second, you may request an informal hearing held before the Commission, if you do not dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to make written or oral arguments to the Commission concerning the legal issues

related to the violation(s) and the potential fine. At the request of Respondent, the Commission will consider and determine willfulness at an informal hearing. Otherwise, live witness testimony is unnecessary.

Third, you may request a formal hearing held before an administrative law judge in the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH), if you dispute any material fact in the Staff Recommendation. You have 30 days from the date the Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission to request such a hearing. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order. At the hearing, you will have the right to present evidence relevant to the violation(s) listed in this order, to cross-examine opposing witnesses, to impeach any witness, and to rebut the evidence presented against you.

If you do not elect to resolve the case by consent order or request a formal hearing at the DOAH or an informal hearing before the Commission within 30 days of the date this Order of Probable Cause is filed with the Commission, the case will be sent to the Commission for a formal or informal hearing, depending on whether the facts are in dispute. The date this order was filed appears in the upper right-hand corner of the first page of the order.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the referral in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with two counts of violating **Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes**, and recommending that **it is not in the public interest** to proceed further with regard to a third count of violating **Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes**. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on July 1, 2024, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

1. On October 28, 2022, the Florida Elections Commission (“Commission”) received a referral from the Division of Elections (“Division” or “Complainant”), alleging that Kyle KC Gibson (“Respondent”) violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.

2. Respondent was a 2022 candidate for Governor. Respondent’s Statement of Candidate form (“DS-DE 84”) was filed on October 16, 2018. (Attachment A) Respondent withdrew his candidacy on September 1, 2022. (Attachment B)

3. By letter dated April 22, 2024, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provision:

Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2022 candidate for Governor, acting as his own treasurer, failed to timely make necessary amendments to the 2022 M2, 2022 M3, and 2022 M5 campaign treasurer’s report, as alleged in the complaint.

4. On October 16, 2018, Respondent filed his Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates form (“DS-DE 9”) appointing himself as treasurer for his campaign. (ROI Exhibit 1)¹

5. By letter dated October 18, 2018, Kristi Reid Willis, Chief, Bureau of Election Records, sent Respondent a letter acknowledging that the Division received the DS-DE 9 form and Respondent’s appointment as the campaign treasurer for his own campaign. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 1)

¹ The Report of Investigation is referred to herein as “ROI.”

6. The acknowledgment letter advised that all candidates filing reports with the Division are required to use the electronic filing system (“EFS”) and provided Respondent with a user identification number and initial password to grant access to the EFS. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 1) The letter further advised that all the Division’s publications and reporting forms were available on its website and directed Respondent to print out Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*, as well as other relevant documents. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 2)

7. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida’s election laws by failing to timely file the required amendment to the campaign’s 2022 M2, 2022 M3, and 2022 M5 Reports within 7 days of receiving notification from the filing officer that the reports were incomplete and required amendment. *See* Compl.

8. The campaign’s 2022 M2 Report was filed on March 10, 2022. (ROI Exhibit 5, page 7). The report was incomplete when filed. (*See* Compl. and ROI Exhibit 4, pages 1 and 2) The report omitted the occupation/business information for a contribution from Chitinomy Marshall that exceeded \$100.00. (ROI Exhibit 3, page 4; ROI Exhibit 4, page 2). The report also lists Joan Gibson as a contributor with her occupation/business being described as a retired educator. (ROI Exhibit 5, page 2)

9. The campaign’s 2022 M3 Report was filed on April 11, 2022. (ROI Exhibit 5, page 13). The report was incomplete when filed. (*See* Compl. and ROI Exhibit 4, pages 1 and 3). The report was missing the description of an in-kind contribution of \$100.00 from Joan Gibson. (ROI Exhibit 3, page 7; ROI Exhibit 4, page 3)

10. The campaign’s 2022 M5 Report was filed on June 10, 2022. (ROI Exhibit 5, page 19). The report was incomplete when filed. (*See* Compl. and ROI Exhibit 4, pages 1 and 4). The report omitted the occupation/business information for a contribution from Joan Gibson that exceeded \$100.00. (ROI Exhibit 3, page 9; ROI Exhibit 4, page 4)

11. The Division sent letters regarding the erroneous reports. The letters notified Respondent that the campaign’s 2022 M2, 2022 M3, and 2022 M5 reports were incomplete and that Respondent was required to amend the reports within seven days of receipt of the notifications. Error Reports showing why each report was incomplete were attached to each notification. (ROI Exhibits 3 & 4) The final notification letter was confirmed delivered on August 29, 2022. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 5)

12. As of September 16, 2024, Respondent had not filed the required amendments to the 2022 M2, 2022 M3, and 2022 M5 reports. (Attachments C, D, and E)

13. Respondent was given multiple opportunities to respond to Commission staff’s investigation but failed to do so. (ROI Exhibit 6, pp. 1-2) Respondent was not a first-time candidate. (Attachment F)

14. Respondent failed to timely file the required amendments to the campaign’s 2022 M2, 2022 M3, and 2022 M5 Reports within 7 days of receiving notification from his filing officer that the reports were incomplete and required amendment. However, with regard to the 2022 M5

report, it does not appear that it would serve the public interest by proceeding further since the missing information of Joan Gibson's business/occupation was previously included in the 2022 M2 report. Therefore, the omission of this information did not raise transparency issues.

15. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. *Schmitt v. State*, 590 So. 2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. *Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino*, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).

16. The facts set forth above show that Respondent was a 2022 candidate for the Office of the Governor. Respondent failed to timely file the required amendments to the campaign's 2022 M2, 2022 M3, and 2022 M5 Reports within 7 days of receiving notification from his filing officer that the reports were incomplete and required amendment.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that, with regard to the 2022 M5 Report, the Commission dismiss the alleged violation of Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes, pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(j), Florida Statutes, as the public interest would not be served by proceeding further based on the specific facts and circumstances set forth above. However, I recommend that the Commission find **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating the following:


Count 1:



2. An Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository (DS-DE 9) was filed on October 16, 2018. Respondent was appointed as his own campaign treasurer, a 2022 candidate for Governor. To review the DS-DE 9, refer to Exhibit 1.

3. On October 18, 2018, the Division sent Respondent a letter acknowledging Respondent's appointment as the campaign treasurer for his own campaign. The letter advised Respondent that all of the Division's publications and reporting forms are available on their website, including Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*, and the *Calendar of Reporting Dates*. The letter further advised that it was Respondent's responsibility to read, understand, and follow the requirements of Florida's election laws. II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(2)(b)(1), Florida Statutes:

4. The Division sent correspondence to the address provided on the DS-DE 9 notifying Respondent that one or more campaign treasurer report(s) were incomplete. The correspondence included error report(s) referencing the following report(s): 2022 M2, 2022 M3, and 2022 M5. To review the correspondence and error report(s), refer to Exhibit 3.

5. On August 24, 2022, the Division sent a letter marked "Final Notice" with delivery confirmation to the address provided on the DS-DE 9 notifying Respondent that one or more campaign treasurer report(s) were incomplete. The letter included an error report referencing the following report(s): 2022 M2, 2022 M3, and 2022 M5. It was confirmed delivered on August 29, 2022. To review the "Final Notice," error report and delivery confirmation, refer to Exhibit 4.

6. As noted above, the "Final Notice" was confirmed delivered on August 29, 2022. The Division filed the referral on October 28, 2022. By filing the referral, the Division affirmed that as of that date, the report(s) at issue had not been amended to correct all errors identified by the Division. To review the report(s) at issue, refer to Exhibit 5.

7. Respondent did not respond to the referral.

8. I attempted to contact Respondent on three occasions for the purpose of providing an opportunity to discuss the allegations made in the referral. As of the date of this report, neither my telephone calls nor email have been returned. Therefore, I am unable to ascertain whether Respondent has read Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and/or the *Candidate and Campaign Treasurer Handbook*. 

On October 28, 2022, the Florida Elections Commission received a complaint alleging that you violated Florida's election laws. I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more **legally sufficient allegations**. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violation:

Section 106.07(2)(b)1., Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2022 candidate for Governor, acting as his own treasurer, failed to timely make necessary amendments to the following campaign treasurer's reports, as alleged in the complaint:

- 2022 M2
- 2022 M3
- 2022 M5

When we conclude the investigation, a copy of the Report of Investigation (ROI) will be mailed to you at the above address. Based on the results of the investigation, a staff attorney will prepare and present a written Staff Recommendation (SR) to the Commission as to whether there is probable cause to charge you, the Respondent, with violating Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. You will have an opportunity to respond to both the ROI and the SR. The Commission will then hold one or more hearings to determine whether the alleged violation occurred and, if so, the amount of the fine to be imposed upon you. Notice will be mailed to you and the Complainant at least 14 days before any hearing at which your case is to be considered.

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(i)3., Florida Statutes, the Commission may enter into a consent agreement with a Respondent to settle a complaint prior to a finding of probable cause. If you are interested in entering negotiations directed towards reaching a consent agreement to resolve this matter, please contact the Commission and request to speak with the attorney assigned to this case.
