If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

**SUMMARY:** Seminole County Professional Firefighters is a political committee (PC) registered with the State of Florida. The PC's chair and treasurer is Craig Arthur.

The PC is appealing the fine. According to Mr. Arthur, he took over the PAC's responsibilities as the organization transitioned between elected members. He claims reports were timely filed during his time as Chair and Treasurer until the reporting deadlines changed frequency. He claims he made note of the schedule and saved it in their originations file storage device; however, the "brain in [his] MAC computer went out" and he was unable to access information, including the stored due dates for reports. He notes that this is his first year handling these responsibilities during an election year, and he was unaware of the weekly reports.

- The 2024 Q2 Original Report covers the period from 04/01/24-05/31/24; it was due on 06/10/24.
- The 2024 Q2 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created and filed on 07/02/24.
- Seminole County Professional Firefighters reported receiving 1 contribution, while making 2 expenditures.
- The Division of Elections does not have any notes that pertain to Seminole County Professional Firefighters' 2024 Q2 report.

My name is Craig Arthur, and I am the Treasurer/Chairperson for the Seminole County Professional Firefighters. I have received the notice via mail to impose a fine of \$500.00 upon our organization for the late filing of our campaign treasurer's report.

According to Rules 2B-1.005 and 2B-1.0055, Florida Administrative Code, I am writing this letter to appeal this fine upon our organization. As you may have noticed, there were many dates that reports were not filed on time recently. All of those reports have now been filed. As our organization transitioned between elected members and I took over the PAC responsibilities, there were many items not communicated appropriately. Since I have held the responsibility of Chairperson and Treasurer, our organization has not filed any late reports. When the filing dates changed from monthly to quarterly, I took note of that and scheduled the due dates in our organization's storage device. A couple of months ago, the brain in my MAC computer went out and I was unable to access some information, causing an oversight of my due dates and responsibilities to report for our campaign account.

I am asking your organization to please excuse this oversight of our organization and waive all fees that we may have incurred. This is also my first year handling these responsibilities during an election year and was completely unaware of the weekly reports. As I previously mentioned, the change in elected positions for our organization was not efficient, however, I have insured that everything will be handled smoothly and on time moving forward. Thank you greatly for your consideration to appeal these fines.

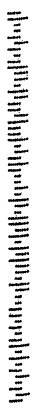

Dear Mr. Arthur:

Our records indicate that you have not filed either your campaign treasurer's report or notification that no reportable activity occurred, whichever is applicable. The filing date was June 10, 2024.

The law (s. 106.07(8)(b), Fla. Stat.) requires the filing officer to immediately notify you about the missed filing date and the automatic fines that will be assessed for late filing of a report, if a report was due.

- If reportable activity occurred and you have not filed a report, statutory fines are automatically assessed as follows until you file your report:
  - ⌚ \$50 per day for the first 3 days late
  - ⌚ \$500 per day for each day after the 3rd day late
  - ⌚ If the required report immediately precedes a primary and general election, the automatic fine is \$500 for each late day.

The total fine for the untimely report cannot exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the cover period. Even if you end up filing your report late, we cannot waive the statutory fines. We will notify you of the specific amount of fines owed once you file your report. You have 20 days from the day you receive the notice to pay the fine or to appeal the fine to the Florida Elections Commission.

- If no reportable activity occurred for the report date(s), you are still required to notify us in writing, via the Division's Electronic Filing System, that no reportable activity occurred. No automatic fines are statutorily assessed.

However, in all cases, failure to file and/or untimely filing of a report of reportable activity, or if applicable, a notice that no reportable activity occurred, may constitute an apparent violation of chapter 106, Fla. Stat. If we refer such matter to the Florida Elections Commission, the Commission may subsequently impose a civil penalty for each violation under chapter 106.265(1), Fla. Stat.


