NOTICE OF HEARING (AUTOMATIC FINE (AF))

A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on, **April 22, 2026 at 10:00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard, at the following location: via Webinar at: **Registration URL** <https://attendee.gotowebinar.com/register/17181422935246175>, **Webinar ID 325-697-827**.

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: Eduardo Flores was a candidate for the City of Hollywood Mayor in the 2024 elections. Mr. Flores was his own treasurer.

Eduardo Flores is appealing the fine claiming that he submitted the report two days prior to the deadline. According to Mr. Flores, the City had a clerical error that caused the late fee.

The City submitted a note stating that staff spoke with Mr. Flores on October 28, 2024, regarding the missing report. Mr. Flores stated that he did everything right with the filing program and that the program was not working. Staff then spoke with Greg Whiten with Easy Vote Campaign Finance. Mr. Whiten stated there were no reported issues with the filing program during the time frame Mr. Flores provided.

- The 2024 G2 Original Report covers the period from 10/05/24-10/18/24; it was due on 10/25/24.
- The 2024 G2 Report shows that it was filed on 10/28/24 at approximately 1:04 p.m.
- Eduardo Flores reported receiving zero contributions while making 1 expenditure.
- The City of Hollywood City Clerk's Office provided one note that pertains to Eduardo Flores's 2024 G2 Report.

Dear Mr. Flores:

Your Treasurer's Report (2024 – G2), which was due on October 25, 2024, was not received by Easy Vote Campaign Finance Software Program until October 28, 2024.

According to Section 106.07(8)(b), Florida Statutes, you are hereby assessed a fine of \$50.00 per day for the first three days late, and thereafter, \$500.00 per day for each additional day the report was late. The statute restricts the fine to an amount not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.


Your report was 3 days late resulting in a \$150.00 fine, however, since you had \$74.90 in total receipts/expenditures during the relevant period, the 25% rule does apply, and you are hereby fined the amount of \$18.73.

The fine shall be paid only from personal funds of the candidate and must be paid to the City of Hollywood, City Clerk within 20 days of receipt of this notice unless appealed to the Florida Elections Commission.

Section 106.07(8)(c), Florida Statutes, provides for appealing or disputing the fine, based upon, but not limited to, unusual circumstances surrounding the failure to file on the designated due date, and the candidate may request and shall be entitled to a hearing before the Florida Elections Commission, which shall have the authority to waive the fine in whole or in part.

Any such request shall be made within 20 days after receipt of the notice of payment due (this notice). In such case, the candidate shall, within the 20-day period, notify the filing officer in writing of his intention to bring the matter before the Florida Elections Commission.

Dear Mr. Flores:

Your Campaign Treasurer's Report (G2-2024), which was due on October 25, 2024 covering the period from October 5, 2024 to October 18, 2024 has not been received by this office.

Section 106.07(8)(b), Florida Statutes, requires that the filing officer immediately notify you of the failure to file said report and that a fine of \$50.00 per day will be assessed for the first three (3) days late and, thereafter, \$500.00 per day for each late day; however, the fine may not exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Once your report is received, this office will notify you of the specific amount of your fine. Fines must be paid to the filing officer within 20 days of receipt of the payment due notice, unless appealed to the Florida Elections Commission. Section 106.07(8)(c), Florida Statutes, provides for appealing or disputing the assessed fine by submitting a Notice of Appeal in writing to the Florida Elections Commission within 20 days of the date of receipt of notice of payment due, stating any unusual circumstances surrounding the failure to file on the designated due date. A failure to file such notice will constitute a waiver of the right of appeal.


Please be advised that a willful failure to file a campaign treasurer's report constitutes a violation of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, independent of the automatic fine violation referenced above. Therefore, if you fail to file a report, such failure will be considered a willful violation of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and this office will turn the matter over to the Florida Elections Commission for prosecution.

Section 106.265(1), Florida Statutes, authorizes the Florida Elections Commission, upon finding a willful violation of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, to impose a civil penalty up to \$1,000.00 per count for each willful violation of Chapter 106. Moreover, pursuant to Section 106.19, Florida Statutes, the knowing, willful and deliberate failure to file a report constitutes a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in Sections 775.082 or 775.083, Florida Statutes.

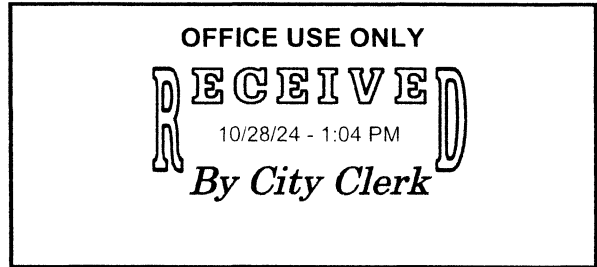

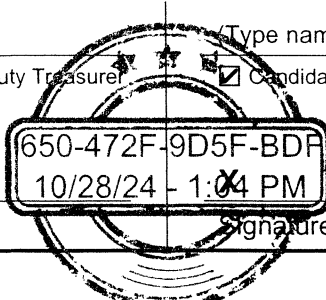

October 28, 2024 at 12:53 pm I emailed Mr. Flores a copy of the certified letter being sent to him that he did not submit his G2 report on Friday, October 25, 2024.

At 1:01 pm Mr. Flores called me explaining he submitted his report last Thursday through the program and I should have it. He wanted to know who he can talk to about contesting the fine. I explained it would be Tallahassee. He stated he did everything right with the program. I stated when he submitted the report, he should have gotten an email from the program stating he submitted the report. He kept saying the program is not working. I told him I would check with the company to see if there was any type of error and if he submitted his report on Thursday.

After hanging up with Mr. Flores at 1:04 pm I received confirmation from the program that he submitted his report.

At 2:49 pm I spoke with Greg Whiten, Easy Vote Campaign Finance, regarding if there were an issue with the program and if he could tell me if Mr. Flores submitted his report on Thursday. Mr. Whiten replied there were no issues with the program and when Mr. Flores submitted his report, he should have gotten a confirming email from the program.

At 3:01 pm left a message with Mr. Flores to call me.

At 3:32 pm Mr. Flores returned by call. I explained there was no issues with the program and if he submitted his report he would have received a confirming email. He wanted information about the fine and where to contest it. I explained I would be sending him the information and if he contests it, to please let me know.

Electronic Filing of Campaign Reports and Electronic Signatures

Campaign Finance is an Internet system for the recording and reporting of campaign finance activity. All reports of campaign finance activity must be filed with the City Clerk using the electronic campaign finance reporting system (the "System") available online at <https://cityofhollywoodfl.easyvotecampaignfinance.com/login> unless an alternative filing procedure is required by the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 or other applicable law.

Credentials to log into the System are approved on an individual basis and may not be shared – even with a member of the same campaign or committee. Each user who is approved for credentials is responsible for protecting those credentials from disclosure or compromise. Once credentials have been approved for a user, that user is deemed responsible for every report filed using those credentials until such time as the City Clerk is notified of disclosure or compromise of those credentials. The campaign or committee must immediately notify the City Clerk if any user associated with that campaign or committee becomes ineligible to hold the credentials issued to that user.

Each report must be completed and filed through the System before midnight, Eastern Time, at the end of the due date. Reports not filed by this time are late and are subject to penalties pursuant to Florida Statutes section 106.07(8) or 106.29(3), as applicable.

By filing a report through the System, a candidate, treasurer or deputy treasurer and committee chair (i) is deemed to have electronically signed the report under oath and to have certified the correctness of the report in accordance with Florida Statutes section 106.07(5) or 106.29(2), as applicable; (ii) is responsible for the accuracy and veracity of the report; and (iii) commits a criminal act by certifying a report that is known to be incorrect, false, or incomplete.

A report is deemed filed with the City Clerk only when the System issues a receipt confirming the date and time at which the report was filed. The System will issue a separate notice for the subsequent acceptance or rejection of the report by the City Clerk. Once a report has been filed with the City Clerk, it may be changed only by filing an amendment to that report.

The City is not responsible for providing the internet access necessary to access the System, and problems with an individual candidate's internet access at a residence, office, coffee shop, etc. do not excuse late filing by that candidate. The City Clerk will provide an alternate filing deadline for candidates only in the event that the System is *generally* unavailable and all candidates are affected.

By signing this Application and Acknowledgement of Email and Electronic Filing Information, I acknowledge that I have read, understood and agree to the above provisions, and understand that notifications from the City Clerk's Office will be via email, unless otherwise required by Florida law. Furthermore, I affirmatively agree that my electronic signature is

legally equivalent to my handwritten signature (F.S. 668.004). Whenever I execute an electronic signature, it has the same validity and meaning as my handwritten signature. I understand and acknowledge that I am accountable and responsible for actions performed under such electronic signature and I agree that it is my responsibility to safeguard my electronic signature and my Campaign Finance Account by using all appropriate measures, such as safeguarding all user login and password information and logging out of the system.


